- **1. LOVELY DES BROUETS -** A three-year-old filly by Ducato Bourbon out of Amorce des Brouets who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **2. LOVE ME HAUFOR -** Two promising runs so far and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Chartres over 2800m on 14 April. Should contest the finish again
- **3. LORENZO GEDE -** Has been fair so far and followed a fair debut with a win in Class G at Orléans over 2200m on 21 April. Tackles stronger but deserves some respect
- **4. L'AS DES AS -** Improving and was victorious last time out in Class F at Strasbourg over 2200m on 1 April. Can follow up in this line-up

- **4. KORINA DE BEYLEV -** She has been disqualified in her last five starts, with the latest being at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 15 April. Capable of playing a minor role when smart
- **5. KOLOSSE RHODES -** Yet to win a race after 14 attempts and was 7th last time out in a harness race at Amiens over 2400m on 19 April. Disqualified when last seen in a Mounted race so others are preferred
