- **1. HOLD UP DU DIGEON -** Pleased at Caen before finishing 7th of 12 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 29 March. Paul Ploquin reining this time but still no more than a minor place prospect
- **2. GOAL STAR -** Has done nothing but improve lately, imposing with room to spare, in a 2850m Vincennes Class D 12 days ago and is not incapable of repeating
- **3. GALAGO DU CADRAN -** Steps up in category after winning 2 on the trot, early last month a 2450m Caen Class D. Has earned the right to race here and the front line start will do his prospects no disservice
- **4. FALCON D'ESPACE -** Races barefoot after finishing last of 15 when being conditioned in a 2450m Caen Class D on 11 March, but nonetheless appears to be biting off more than he can chew
- **5. IGREC DE CELLAND -** Has 2 races under his belt since the break, latterly 2nd in a 2850m Laval Class D late last month, and has a reasonable chance of getting his nose in front this time
- **6. FRANKLIN PARK -** More a specialist in the claiming category but sprang quite the surprise when 5th of 16, at 99/1, in the Gr.3 Marseille-Borély GNT stage over 3000m on 27 March. A repeat, however, seems improbable
- **7. FALCO DU DOUET -** Rejuvenated lately, most recently 3rd to GOAL STAR (2) in a 2850m Vincennes Class D 12 days ago and, ideally-engaged, is unlikely to be available at 49/1 this time around
- **8. FLOWER BY MAGALOU -** Disappointing so far this term, most recently 6th of 7 finishers in a 2525m Cavaillon Class B, and from the 2nd row, will struggle to make her presence felt
- **9. HONKY TONK BLUES -** Struggling to recapture last year's form, latterly 9th of 16 in a 3000m Marseille-Borély Gr.3 late-March, and needs to pull his socks up
- **10. HAVE A DREAM -** 4th, 2 places behind GALILEO BELLO (13), in a 2700m Vincennes Class B. Is confirmed in this class and looks good enough to make the first 5
- **11. IBIKI DE HOUELLE -** Finished 5th, a place behind GALILEO BELLO (13), in a 2850m Vincennes Class A last week, and makes his Cordemais debut with legitimate ambition
- **12. FILOU D'ANJOU -** 10th of 16 in 3250m GNT Gr.3 at Lyon-La Soie a fortnight ago. Has other priorities and can be passed over
- **13. GALILEO BELLO -** Has turned a corner over recent weeks and most recently came 4th in a 2850m Vincennes Class A last Friday. Benjamin Rochard reining this time and, even from the 2nd row, looks competitive for the win
- **14. EVEIL DU CHATELET -** Last of 15, on return to competition, in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.2 earlier in the month. Is still being conditioned and can be ruled out

- **15. GIGOLO LOVER -** 8th of 13 in a 2850m Vincennes Gr.3 on 6 April. Shoes back on and no threat
- **16. ECHO DE CHANLECY -** Not short of ability but only 11th of 15 in a 2859m Vincennes Gr.3 a month ago and, with an extra 50m to travel, and shoes on, will have nothing to offer

Summary: After an encouraging performance at Laval, on just his second start back, IGREC DE CELLAND (5) finds himself on the front line here and looks very close to his race. David Thomain would still be wise to be wary of GALILEO BELLO (13) who won a highly-competitive race on his only appearance here, and IBIKI DE HOUELLE (11) who finished just behind him in Paris last Friday, both of whom are portioned on the second line. Front-row starter, GOAL STAR (2) has shown fine progress this year and thrives in the hands of Yoann Lebourgeois.

- **3. KATIA DHELPA -** Never-threatening 9th of 13 in a 2150m Enghien Class D last week. Shoes on and best to leave alone
- **4. KILLER SUN DRALIAM -** Beat a number of these when 5th in a 2600m Saint-Galmier Class D in early-March. 4 pads fitted this time, is reunited with Benjamin Rochard who has already won with him, and should not be overlooked

Summary: Entrusted to Eric Raffin after having made a solid re-entry at Lisieux last month, KEEP SECRET (10) should appreciate the new conditions and can make his Cordemais debut a winning one. Even though sanctioned in his last two, KOLOSSE (2) won for David Thomain earlier in the year, races shod this time and, on good behaviour, can give the favourite something to think about. KEOPS DU BUHOT (7) put in a lacklustre effort at Vincennes last time but can start to redeem himself. KOSMOPOLITAINE (5) was not given a hard race on comeback but is otherwise one of the more dependable horses here and, barefoot for the occasion, will be expected to set the record straight.

- **3. GAMME DE BASSIERE -** Won an amateur event at Machecoul before coming 3rd of 13 in a 2750m Elbeuf Class F, in the professional ranks, on 7 April. Has a front-row start, races with 4 pads for the occasion, and could well get a look-in
- **4. HOLY D'AIMTE -** 4th, 2 places behind FUN DE BANVILLE (8), in a 3100m Class H at Nortsur-Erdre 10 days ago. Boasts an excellent amateur record and, from the front row, can play a prominent role

- **3. IRESINE DU LUPIN -** Sanctioned, when well-supported, in a 3125m Angers Class F 2 weeks ago. Has won 2 for 2 here and, barefoot for the occasion, is not incapable of maintaining her perfect Coerdemais record
- **4. FEE FRAULEIN -** 6th of 8 finishers in a 3125m Angers Class F 2 weeks ago. Placed just once in 4 under the saddle and appears to be out of her league
- **5. FAX MADRIK -** 7th of 14 in a 2100m Vincennes harness claimer last week and will have few, if any, takers
- **6. HURIEL LUDOIS -** Won a 2950m Saint-Malo harness Class F 10 days ago. Has solid monté credentials and looks competitively well-in
- **7. GEORGES L'AVENTURE -** Returns to the monté discipline after trotting a decent 5th of 14 in a 2625m Cherbourg harness Class E early-March but can nevertheless expect to find this a stiff test
