- **5. LEONARDO PASS -** Showed some improvement when third last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 2 June. Place chance
- **6. LEADER BOY -** Won well on debut in Class G at Mondoubleau over 2925m on 16 June. Deserves respect for that win
- 7. LE BIEF Hard to trust and was disqualified again last time out at Angers on 11 June. Can win if smart
- **8. LORD DE FONTAINE -** Won well on debut in Class G at Villedieu-les-Poëles over 2800m on 24 March. Can contest the finish again
- **9. LETS GO UP -** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 17 June. Others are preferred

Summary: LE BIEF (7) has the undeniable means to win a race of this nature but it remains a question of wisdom with him - all or nothing. Debut scorers LOULOU DE L'AUNAY (3) and LEADER BOY (6) are open to improvement with the benefit of a winning introduction under their belts, so could pick up the pieces if the selection were to fluff his lines.
