# C1 - PRIX CNBPP - 3350m (a2m1/8) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 30,000

**1. HORUS DE VAL -** Has won three in a row, the latest in a class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 21 July. This resident of Eric Lambertz is in fine form and can win again

**2. HOOLIGAN -** Finished 6th in a class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 13 July. He has not won for some time but when last at this track was second

**3. HANACK DE VIVOIN -** A winner in a class E at Le Roche-Possay over 3150m on 21 July. Remains barefoot. Will find this tougher

**4. HED -** Finished 5th in a class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 13 July. If allowed to lead can be a factor

**5. HOPPELA THEPOL -** A winner in a class F at Langon over 2800m on 18 July. Moves up a category here but has good place prospects

**6. FIRST DU MILAN -** Disqualified in a class F at Argentan over 2875m on 15 July. Remains barefoot. Others are preferred in this line up

**7. HAPPY COCO** - A runner up in a class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 17 July. Improved in the latest effort and must confirm that

**8. HARISON DU PLESSIS -** In good form and won in a class C at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 8 July. Remains barefoot. Has a good winning chance

**9. FEU DE REVOLTE -** Disqualified in a class D at Lignieres over 2775m on 20 July. Must be wise. Others are preferred in this line up

**10. HAMONET DE CHOISEL -** Fourth in a class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 21 July. He has won four times this year.Philippe Monclin will be on the sulky and will give every assistance

**Summary:** HARISON DU PLESSIS (8) is in good form and is barefoot. A good opening race bet. HAMONET DE CHOISEL (10) was not disgraced when fourth last time out and has already won four times this year so is likely not to go down without a fight. HORUS DE VAL (1) has won his last three starts and is clearly not out of it. HOPPELA THEPOL (5) tackles stronger this time but could make the frame.

**1. IVOIRE DU CHATELET -** Finished 6th in a class F at Lucon over 3025m on 21 July. Two poor efforts this year and others are preferred in this line up

**2. INES DE MAJEAN -** Unplaced in a class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 17 July. Not in the best of form and is best watched for now

**3. ISCHIA -** Disqualified in a class F at Carentan over 2850m on 28 July. Major disqualification issues and is best watched for now

**4. IFALCO DE MAY -** Disqualified in a class H Mounted race at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2200m on 20 July. Tries barefoot. If wise can be involved in the finish

**5. INCROYABLE TALENT -** A runner up in a class F at La Ferté-Vidame over 2750m on 21 July. He has place prospects in this line up

**6. IBIZA PACHA -** A runner up in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 18 July. Has sufficient means to fight for a place on the podium

**7. IBRAHISCO** - Fourth in a class E at Lucon over 3025m on 7 July. Unplaced since winning in February. Can pop up in a place at best

**8. IMPACTS LUDOIS -** Ran well when fifth in a class E at Lignieres over 2775m on 21 July. A runner up in the penultimate under the saddle at this track.

**9. ILANO DE MONGOCHY -** Disqualified in a class F at Rochefort-sur-Loire over 3000m on 22 July. Others are preferred in this line up

**10. INCONTOURNABLE -** A winner in a class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 13 July. Showed vast improvement to win the latest and must confirm that

**11. IFF LOUZEEN -** After winning two in a row, was fifth in a class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 8 July. Eric Raffin is on the sulky and will give every assistance

**12. INDUCTIF** - Disqualified in the last three, the latest in a class G at Caen over 2200m on 24 June. If wise he can be involved in the finish

**Summary:** IFF LOUZEEN (11) was a bit of a disappointment last time out but could bounce back to beat these rivals. INDUCTIF (12) is very hard to trust but is quite capable of winning when wise. IMPACTS LUDOIS (8) is competitive under the saddle and deserves respect in this line-up. IBIZA PACHA (6) only found one better last time out and has a winning chance.

**2. ELDER SHADOW -** Has struggled all year and was 9th last time out in Class E at Les Sablesd'Olonne over 2775m on 26 July. Needs major improvement to win

**3. HA YES MAX -** In good shape and was a barefoot winner last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 18 July. Can follow up

**4. FAKIR STARDUST -** Has struggled for some time now and was well beaten last time out in Class F at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 20 July. Very unlikely to win

**5. HALMA D'AMER -** In very good form and was runner-up again last time out in Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 8 July. Barefoot this time and can go one better

**6. GEORGES L'AVENTURE -** Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at La Roche-Posay on 21 July. Needs major improvement to win

**7. HARIBO DU CARNOIS -** Very consistent of late and was third last time out in Class F at Savenay over 3100m on 14 July. Has a winning chance

**8. GAROU DES CHALIERS -** Unreliable but was a winner last time out in Class E at Les Sablesd'Olonne over 2650m on 8 July. Can contest the finish again

**9. FRODON THONIC -** Continues to struggle and was 9th last time out in Class C at Les Sablesd'Olonne over 2775m on 26 July. Others are much preferred

**3. HAMISH -** Disappointing form of late and was 7th in class C as Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 26 July. Won well in June and is barefoot. Respect

**4. GALIE DE CELINIERE -** Finished tenth in class D at Enghien over 2150m on 27 July when barefoot. Not unshod this time and others are preferred

**9. ENJEU DAIRPET -** Finished tenth in class D at Lignieres over 2775m on 20 July. Returns barefoot but is on a long losing streak. More is needed to win

**Summary:** HANIELLE CREPIN (1) was an impressive winner last time out and will have every chance of doubling up if in the same mood. GLADIATOR BOY (8) was disqualified last time out but is barefoot and capable of bouncing back to be a serious threat. HOLIDAY WELL (2) was not disgraced but is better judged on is runner-up performance in May. HAMISH (3) has been disappointing of late but is not out of it.

**2. KIVIVE DE HOUELLE -** Finished 5th in class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 13 July. Has major disqualification issues and has yet to win. Others preferred

**3. KLAOUSOU D'AMOUR -** Not disgraced when third in class G at Pornichet-La Baule over 2650m on 19 July. Yet to win after 13 attempts and others are preferred

**4. KAVANGO -** Disqualified in class F at Sables-sur-Sarthe over 2825m on 28 July. Won well on debut and can bounce back to score

**5. KIWI DE LAVRIGNAIE -** Finished third in class F at La Gacilly over 2300m on 15 July. Consistent and capable of making the frame

**6. KHEOPS DORE -** Disqualified in class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 18 July. In good form before that and is not out of it

**7. KYMI JACK -** Disqualified in class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 18 July. Barefoot and has a place chance

**8. KITY DE LA MORTRIE -** Not disgraced when third in class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 18 July. Won well in January but needs to improve. Others are preferred

**9. KAVIASE -** Disqualified in class F at Cholet over 2800m 1 April. Won well in December last year and deserves some respect in this line-up

**10. KING DU PRESSOIR -** Finished tenth in class F at Brehal over 2850m on 22 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**11. KASH DIBAH -** Finished 5th in class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 18 July. Needs to do a bot more to beat these rivals

**12. KRISTINA BELLA -** Finished 8th in class F at La Roche-Posay over 3150m on 21 July. Yet to win and others are much preferred

**13. KSAR DU CORTA -** Disqualified in class F at Clairfontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 21 July. Returns barefoot and is capable of winning

**14. KOOL LUDOIS -** Finished 7th in class E at Vichy over 2950m on 1 July. Yet to win but has placed on five occasions and is barefoot. Deserves some respect

**Summary:** KAVANGO (4) showed talent when scoring on debut. He has battled with disqualification but can win if smart this time. KSAR DU CORTA (13) was disqualified last time out but is barefoot and capable of bouncing back to win. KHEOPS DORE (6) was in good form before the last-start disqualification and should be competitive. KAVIASE (9) won well in December and could surprise if finding that level of form.

**3. JOKER WIC -** Disappointing of late and was 9th in class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 17 July. Capable of an upset on best form

**4. JIBRIL SNOB -** Finished rd in class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 25 July when barefoot. Has room to improve but others are preferred

**4. LIKE DESBOIS -** A three-year-old gelding by Repeat Love out ofQuiphyle Coglais who is making his debut. Watch the betting

**5. LOVELIE LEMAN -** Has struggled so far and was 6th in class F at Lignieres over 2100m on 20 July. Yet to win and others are much preferred
