C1 - PRIX DE GUINGAMP - 2850m (a2m) - Class R Claiming Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- HUMORESQUE Unreliable and was 12th last time out in Class E at Craon over 2775m on 2 September. Others are preferred
- 2. HOUBLON BLEU Battling to regain best form and was 8th last time out in Class G at La Capelle over 1800m on 4 September. Needs to do a bit more to win
- **3. ICARE DE LA DORETE -** Did not show his best when 7th last time out in Class E at this course over 2850m on 22 September. Has a winning chance in this line-up
- **4. HORTENSIA DE LARRE -** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this track on 30 August. Others are much preferred
- **5. HEROS NUEVO -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Blain-Bouvron-Le Gâvre on 22 September. Capable of bouncing back to score
- **6. HORUS DE ROMAZ -** Hard to trust and was disqualified last time out at Vitteaux on 22 September. Probably best watched for now
- **7. HOOLIGAN -** Did not show his best when 11th last time out in Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 6 September. In good shape before that and has a winning chance
- **8. I ALONE -** Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class F at Villeneuve-sur-Lot over 2625m on 22 September. Capable of better and could earn some money
- **9. IRON MIJACK -** Unreliable of late and was 7th last time out in Class F at Blain-Bouvron-Le Gâvre over 3200m on 22 September. Others are preferred-
- **10. HANA D'OCCAGNES -** Better under the saddle and was 6th last time out in a Class H Mounted race at Dieppe over 2550m on 14 September. Might play a minor role
- **11. HEROS DU POMMEREUX -** Disappointing form of late and was disqualified last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche on 2 September. Others are much preferred
- **12. HOPE -** Not disgraced when 6th last time out in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 18 September. Capable of contesting the finish

Summary: HEROS NUEVO (5) would have gone very close to winning on the turf at Blain without the disqualification. He is in for redemption today and can resume winning ways. HOOLIGAN (7)'s last run is better than his placing suggests and with all shoes off this time, he should deliver a big performance. HOPE (12) is ideally entered on the front row and can make his presence felt. IRON MIJACK (9) is not the most reliable trotter but has the ability to win a race like this if he is in the mood.

- **1. MACAREUX DU TRIEUX -** Not disgraced when third last time out in Class C at this course over 2200m on 10 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **2. MILORD D'IRAI -** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at this course on 24 September. Others are preferred
- **3. MIX D'ERONVILLE -** Has run well at this course in his last two starts, with the latest being in Class C over 2200m on 17 September. Could earn some money
- **4. MONZON NORMAND -** Has not done much wrong so far winning both starts, the latest in Class D at Enghien over 2250m on 24 July. Can remain unbeaten
- **5. MISTRAL DU GOUTIER** A winner of his first two starts and he was not disgraced when third in Class B at this course over 2100m on 3 September. Can make the frame
- **6. MAT MANATHIS -** Consistent so far and was fourth last time out in Class A at this track over 2200m on 24 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **7. MARSHAL DE CELLAND -** Unbeaten in two starts, with the latest being in Class C at Enghien over 2250m on 10 August. Can complete a treble

- **9. MAGICO DE LOU -** Has yet to win but was runner-up in his last two starts, with the latest being in Class B at Vincennes over 2100m on 3 September. Could play a minor role
- **10. MAGNUM DU CHOQUEL -** Has improved with each run and was victorious last time out in Class C at this course over 2175m on 26 August. Can make the frame

Summary: MONZON NORMAND (4) caught the eye when he scored at Enghien in July and should be most feared despite returning from a layoff. MARATHON MAN (8) won nicely first time up for his new connections and should confirm. The well related MARSHAL DE CELLAND (7) is another one with a winning chance in what looks a quality race.

- **3. LESDY MAGODA -** Has run well in all her starts and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 16 September. Yet to win but does have a place chance
- **4. LEMONADE FIZZ -** Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at this course on 13 September. Best watched for now
- **5. LADY DUCALE -** Has won twice in just four starts, including last time out in Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 13 September. Not out of it
- **6. LUNA KALOUMA -** A bit unreliable but was third last time out in Class D at Reims over 2550m on 15 September. Might play a minor role at best
- **7. LAREDO BAY -** Has won twice in just five starts, including last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 6 August. Could play a minor role

- **2. IBERIK DE MONGOCHY -** Has struggled of late and was 11th last time out in a Class C Mounted race at this course over 2700m on 19 September. Others are preferred
- **3. IES WE KAN -** Has been disqualified in her last start when under the saddle but was 6th last time out in a Class A harness race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 24 August. Deserves some respect
- **4. GO OR NOT -** Consistent of late and was fourth last time out in a Class B Mounted race at this course over 2700m on 13 September. Has a place chance
- **5. INVICTUS MADIBA -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a GR.2. Mounted race at this course over 2175m on 3 September. Keeps that shoe arrangement and can fight out the finish
- **6. HALFA -** Returned to her best with a barefoot win in a Class B Mounted race at this course over 2700m on 13 September. Remains barefoot and can double up
- **7. GOOD GIRL MARCEAUX -** Showed some improvement when 5th last time out in a Class B Mounted race over this track and trip on 13 September. Can do even better this time
- **8. GABIANO -** On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at this track on 14 September. Probably best watched for now
- **9. GOLD VOICE -** Disappointing recent form and was 8th last time out in Class B at this course over 2700m on 13 September. Others are much preferred
- **10. GIBUS -** Has some ability but was 11th last time out in a Class B harness race at this course over 2850m on 31 August. Was disqualified when last under the saddle but can surprise

Summary: HALFA (6) left a very good impression when she scored at the venue last time out. She runs barefoot again today and can add up to her tally. INVICTUS MADIBA (5) posted a promising first start in this code in a Group 2 and has a live chance with improvement expected. IES WE KAN (3) can be tricky but he has a lot of ability and could definitely spring a surprise back in the mounted code. GIBUS (10) is well entered and worth a mention.

- **2. MIRATISSIME -** Victorious in Class D at Cabourg over 2050m on 23 August. Has shown improvement but tackles a tougher field this time
- **3. MARINA ELLIS -** Consistent so far and was third in class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 September. Won well on debut but this is a tougher race
- **4. MUSCADE LEMAN -** Placed in all three starts and was runner-up in class G at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 September. Can earn some more money
- **5. MAGGY JENILOU -** Disqualified in class A at Vincennes over 2200m on 24 September. Won well in August over 2250m. Not easy to trust but is capable of winning if smart

- **4. LE PONT FOULT -** Disqualified in a claimer at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 September. Unreliable and others are preferred here
- **5. LEADER DU CHATAULT -** Disqualified in class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 September. Capable of better and has a winning chance
