## R4 CABOURG [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE TREVIERES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness -  
EUR € 22,000**

- 1. KIMMAJO** - Sanctioned, on first start for 7 months, in a Class F over course and distance 10 days ago. Is still in conditioning-mode and can be ruled out
- 2. KELLOU DES BRUMES** - 9th of 12 behind KOBALT (8) in a Class E conditioner over 2725m here 2 weeks ago. Is confirmed at a superior level and, at peak fitness, can give this a good go
- 3. KIT ANGOT** - Won on Reims re-entry before coming 5th of 13 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 6 December. Seldom disappoints for Pierre-Yves Verva and will be expected to contest the finish
- 4. KER DE TOUES** - Sanctioned when suffering interference in a 2850m Vincennes Class E on 10 December, but is still out of his depth here
- 5. KID DE LA BANIO** - Going well before losing his action in a 2725m Class E here a fortnight ago. Form is not in question though, reverts to a successful formula, and will not be far off the mark if Alexis Collette keeps him trotting
- 6. KANDAR JIEL** - Back in business following an extended absence, comfortably winning a 2875m Argentan Class F on Boxing Day. Steps up in category but must still be considered a leading protagonist
- 7. KEILER DU BAS BOSQ** - Has been knocking at the door lately, most recently 2nd of 11 in a 2050m Class E at Lyon-La Soie 3 weeks ago. In this field though looks more a minor place prospect
- 8. KOBALT** - 6th of 12 in a Class E over 2725m here 2 weeks ago. Just pads fitted this time and others preferred
- 9. KARMA LIGHT** - Has not been seen out since faulting early in a Class D over course and distance 5 months ago and will need the run
- 10. KAMIKAZE** - Easy winner of a 2725m Graignes Class E 3 weeks ago. Has never disappointed when barefoot but takes on a better lot and chances limited
- 11. KANTOUTSTART** - Cabourg-loving colt making first start since coming 2nd of 11 in a 3125m Angers Class E on 20 October. Entrusted to Benjamin Rochard for first time and must be taken at face value
- 12. KILLER ZOFÉ** - 3rd of 14 in a 3150m Saint-Brieuc Class F on 6 December. Reunited with Yoann Lebourgeois who ran 2nd with him here mid-October and has the wherewithal to make first 5
- 13. KORINTO BELLO** - Imposed at Saint-Brieuc before running 4th of 10 in a 3000m Nantes Class E a month ago. Barefoot this time and even though in more-exalted company, can still hold his own

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**Summary:** Very competitive over this kind of course, KIT ANGOT (3) is clearly in shape and returns to racing right-handed with every chance of opening his 2025 account. KANDAR JIEL (6) however, is patently back on the right track following an enforced hiatus and has a realistic chance of doubling his money. KANTOUTSTART (11) has never failed to deliver under these conditions and has been lurking. KELLOU DES BRUMES (2) will be fit by now, sports a fresh configuration, and is not going to be far off the mark.

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## C2 - PRIX DE NEGREVILLE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Mounted - EUR € 33,000

**1. IMELDA** - Headed into 2nd of 10 in a Class E over course and distance on 17 December. Won here during the autumn and looks eminently capable of adding another victory to her tally

**2. IDYLLE COPAISE** - Made short work of a 2700m Vincennes Class E 3 weeks ago. Has no monté references here but is nonetheless capable of playing a prominent role

**3. IRESINE DU LUPIN** - Placed at Chartres before running 4th of 7 in a 2175m Vincennes Class E a month ago. Was not disgraced that day and, even racing shod, at this level should be able to finish in the mix

**4. GUERRIER LUDOIS** - Has twice failed to confirm Mont-Saint-Michel success, latterly 6th of 16 in a 2650m Bordeaux Class E on 17 December, and chances seem limited

**5. HOMMAGE DE TILLARD** - Debuts in the discipline after finishing last of 18, on re-entry, in a 2800m Pontchateau harness Class E on 22 December. Barefoot this time but others still preferred

**6. HAND DES ELIES** - Courageous 4th of 11 in a 2850m Laval Class F mid-November. Comes here fresh and looks main threat to IMELDA (1)

**7. IN YOUR EYES** - Oddly below-par in last 2, most recently 6th of 8 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 10 December. In this small field though could pick up a first-5 cheque

**8. GARD** - Useful sort but has not raced since coming 6th of 15 in a 2500m Saint-Brieuc Class E 2 months ago. Shoes on and best to hold off

**9. FELINE DE JANVILLE** - Flattering last of 3 finishers in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 14 December. Is not without merit though, reverts to a configuration last used in 2021, and could pleasantly surprise

**Summary:** A tough nut to crack when focused, IMELDA (1) just missed out by little here recently and, reconfigured for the occasion, can put things right. Clearly in shape and very much a fan of these conditions, HAND DES ELIES (6) has never failed to fire here when barefoot and Benjamin Rochard stays faithful. IDYLLE COPAISE (2) trounced the opposition in Paris early last month and will have a lot to offer if she takes to the Cabourg profile.

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## C3 - PRIX DE VIERVILLE-SUR-MER - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 33,000

1. **GEDEON DAIRPET** - 7th of 11 in a 2550m Bordeaux Class E last week. Associated with a top driver this time and will have a lot to offer if he positions his charge early
2. **IDEAL DANCER** - 6th of 8 behind IMPARTIAL (13), on re-entry, in a 2550m Reims Class E on 7 December. Handed a good draw but would be preferred barefoot
3. **HETRE D'OURVILLE** - In the frame in last 2, latterly 3rd of 16 in a 2875m Argentan Class E a week ago, and provided he stays in stride, should have this in the bag
4. **GAMIN DU GAULTIER** - Encouraging 5th of 12 in a 2825m Class F at Le Croise-Laroche 2.5 weeks ago. Handed an excellent draw but can expect to find the going somewhat tougher
5. **IF YOU CAN** - Given time to come to hand after finishing 11th of 13 in a 2100m Vincennes Class C mid-November. 4 pads fitted for first time and the draw will do his chances no harm. First 5
6. **GERGOVIE DE GODREL** - Returns to racing barefoot after finishing 12th of 16 in a Saint-Brieuc Class E early last month. Encouraged last time here and while not a priority can still finish in the mix
7. **HIRONDELLE FEE** - Put on a good show to run 2nd of 10 in a 2725m Graignes Class E 3 weeks ago. Will not be sent out at 21/1 this time and a place in the frame is well within her capacity
8. **HARDY DES LANDES** - Unable to confirm Chartres performance when 7th of 12 behind GERGOVIE DE GODREL (6) in a 2725m Graignes Class E on 12 November, and the draw only compounds matters
9. **HUITRE D'OR** - Reassuring 2nd of 17 in a 3000m Chateaubriant Class E a month back. Races shod this time however and best to wait
10. **HAMIGO** - 4th of 10 behind HIRONDELLE FEE (7) in a 2725m Graignes Class E 3 weeks ago. Is considerably better than that, has previously won here, and even from the 2nd row has a lot to contribute
11. **FRISE PONT VAUTIER** - Unremarkable mare that finished last but one in a 2700m Vincennes Class D a fortnight ago and is not easy to recommend
12. **IXELLE BLEUE** - Fine mare that ran 3rd of 12 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 25 November. Has other priorities though and can be passed over
13. **IMPARTIAL** - Reassuring 4th of 8 in a 2550m Reims Class E on 7 December. Has been afforded ample time to recover and despite a tough draw still looks a serious proposition
14. **HELL GIRL CHATHO** - Respectable 5th of 10 finishers in a 2750m Toulouse Class F late-October. Shoes on, poorly-drawn, and can be ruled out

**Summary:** It didn't take long for HETRE D'OURVILLE (3) to show his form after a 5-months' absence and from the 3-spot can impose. Alexis Collette will still want to be wary of the less-favourably-drawn IMPARTIAL (13) who caught the eye at Reims, and the wonderfully-consistent HAMIGO (10) who should logically turn the tables on the widely-drawn, but on-song, HIRONDELLE FEE (7) who has front shoes off this time.

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## C4 - PRIX DE BERNESQ - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 23,000

- 1. JEHAN** - Sanctioned in 3 of last 4, most recently a 2950m Le Mans Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and can expect to have few friends
- 2. KRESUS LOVE** - Imposed over Vincennes short track before finishing 6th of 8 behind KENYAN BLUES (7) in a 2700m Class D here on Christmas Eve. Tends to go well for his jockey and looks a respectable place prospect this time around
- 3. KENOBI D'HERFRAIE** - Won on re-entry at Caen before faulting in a 2700m Class E on 19 November. Entrusted to Adrien Lamy for first time and if there is a spoiler here, this is it
- 4. KRACKSMAN** - Hardy element that faulted early in a 2800m Pontchateau Class F on 22 December. Is significantly better than recent numbers would suggest and the engagement of Guillaume Martin will do his prospects no disservice
- 5. JOKER DES ISLES** - Worthy 2nd of 13 in a 2725m Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne 2.5 weeks ago. Is easy to like at present and is not going home empty-handed
- 6. KENJI D'AUBERVILLE** - Last of 8 behind KENYAN BLUES (7) in a 2700m Class D here on Christmas Eve. Can trot when focused but faces a tough test once again
- 7. KENYAN BLUES** - 4th of 8 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on Christmas Eve. Has better references racing clockwise and should not be ignored
- 8. KYO FERFAY** - Well-beaten last of 8 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 8 December. Seems a long way from his best and must first reaffirm
- 9. KELLY D'ESSARTS** - 4th of 9 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 7 December. Has previously placed under these conditions and looks a major player
- 10. KRONOS DU KLAU** - 7th of 11, on first start since June, in a 2650m Bordeaux harness Class E on 17 December. Disregard
- 11. KARINA DE BOMO** - Unraced since finishing last of 10 in a 2825m Chartres harness Class E 2 months ago. Races first time barefoot but still no more than a minor place chance
- 12. JOYEUSE D'OCCAGNES** - 8th of 10 in a 2200m Vincennes Class E on 26 November. Is confirmed at Cabourg, and reconfigured for the occasion, but recent results do little to inspire confidence
- 13. KALIMERO JASMA** - 6th of 10, on re-entry, in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 27 November. Will have come on for the run and has a legitimate claim on the spoils

**Summary:** With a race under his belt, and barefoot for his return to racing clockwise, KALIMERO JASMA (13) enjoys a wonderful entry here and should be able to wrap this up. KELLY D'ESSARTS (9) has twice shown her form in Paris, is confirmed at Cabourg, and will be no pushover. KRESUS LOVE (2) should not be condemned for his recent performance behind her and Alan Gendrot will be eager to set the record straight. JOKER DES ISLES (5) has been enjoying a productive run in both codes recently and his latest effort augurs well for another podium place.

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## C5 - PRIX DE COLOMBIERES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. KYUSHU** - Has pleased in both since the break, latterly 4th of 9 in a 2175m Vincennes Class E 3 weeks ago, and will not be available at 76/1 this time. First 5
- 2. KINAYA D'OCCAGNES** - Pleased on re-entry before finishing 7th of 10 in a 2050m Class E at Lyon-La Soie 3 weeks ago. Is undeniably capable though and can play a small role if she takes to the new conditions
- 3. KALINKA DU GREMAT** - Sanctioned early in a 2175m Vincennes Class E on 13 December. Reverts to a previous formula and cannot be considered a priority
- 4. KERNEZIA DU CORTA** - Left a good impression when 7th of 9 behind KYUSHU (1) in a 2175m Vincennes Class E 3 weeks ago. Is better than most here and will be expected to bring the fight to KATIA DE MUZE (12)
- 5. KALINA LOVE** - Reassuring 2nd of 10 in a 2950m Le Mans Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Stormed up on course-and-distance debut in October and racing barefoot this time could make all the difference. Chance
- 6. KLARA** - 5th of 10 behind KANELLE D'OUVILLE (13) in a 2725m Class E here a fortnight ago. Consistently gives her best, is shod to preference, but may be taking on too much this time
- 7. KALIFA MESLOISE** - Sanctioned but not disgraced in a 2725m Class E here 2 weeks ago. Races shod this time though and is not about to cause an upset
- 8. KININE DE MONTCEAU** - Last of 13 on return to competition in a 2700m Vincennes Class E a month ago and has no realistic chance
- 9. KIARHA DE NAPPES** - Unexceptional 5th of 9, a place behind KYUSHU (1), in a 2175m Vincennes Class E 3 weeks ago. Unlikely to shake things up but can still get a look in
- 10. KALINE DJOB** - Sanctioned in 19 December race of reference. Has been out of sorts for some time and can be passed over
- 11. KINJAL DE BELLANDE** - 3rd of 11 finishers, at 41/1, in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 8 December and in similar form can again trot her way onto the podium
- 12. KATIA DE MUZE** - Made it 5 on the trot when dominating a 2800m Pontchateau Class F on 22 December. Takes on a better lot this time but sports just front pads for the occasion and Robin Lamy can be confident of another big run
- 13. KANELLE D'OUVILLE** - Sprang a 48/1 surprise when 2nd of 10 in a 2725m Class E here on 19 December, however a repeat seems most improbable
- 14. KASSIOPEE DREAM** - Showed great tenacity to win a 2725m Graignes Class E 3 weeks ago. Has never excelled at Cabourg though and others easier to back
- 15. KANDIE DJOB** - 4th of 10 behind KANELLE D'OUVILLE (13) in a 2725m Class E here a fortnight ago. Hind shoes off, with Yoann Lebourgeois reining for first time, and considering the entry is not to be underestimated
- 16. KASTA DU RIB** - Quality element that has been held back since faulting in a 2725m Graignes Class E on 23 November. Could not have asked for a better entry, sports front pads this time, but nevertheless faces a tough task



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**Summary:** Like a horse reborn since moving stables, KATIA DE MUZE (12) makes her Cabourg debut, sporting modified shoeing, on a 6-timer and has a realistic chance of pulling it off. Robin Lamy can still expect to feel the heat from KERNEZIA DU CORTA (4) whose return to racing last month was better than the result would suggest, and a barefoot KALINA LOVE (5) who flew up under these conditions during the autumn. KINJAL DE BELLANDE (11) defied her odds in Paris last month, will be barefoot this time, and Gabriele Gelormini is back in the bike.

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**C6 - PRIX DE MATHIEU - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR  
€ 22,000**

- 1. LOVER DE TAGOR** - Quality colt that ran close 3rd of 12 in a 2700m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche on 25 November. Races first-time right-handed but considering what he has done to date, a place on the podium is well within his reach
- 2. LEADER DE CERISY** - Steps up in category after coming 2nd of 10 in a 2650m Bordeaux claimer 3.5 weeks ago. Is confirmed here and the draw will only work to his advantage. Place prospect
- 3. LUPIN DE BEAUFOUR** - Has 2 races under his belt, latterly sanctioned early in a 2200m Vincennes Class D a month ago. Seems far off his best and even though freshly-configured still looks out of his league
- 4. LOUP SOLITAIRE** - Handy colt starting for first time since being sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes Class C late-May, but is going to need the run
- 5. LORENZO GEDE** - 5th of 7 finishers in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 5 December. Goes first time barefoot but others still preferred
- 6. LOVEBIRD** - Tenacious winner of a 2750m Class E here a fortnight ago. Is a colt with bags of potential and legitimately bids to keep his perfect Cabourg record intact
- 7. LION SUR MER** - Makes first start since being sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 30 October. Starts wide, with shoes on, and best to hold off
- 8. LUCIANO ROYAL** - Sanctioned, after a short spell, in a 2575m Saint-Brieuc Class E on 6 December. Is proven here but looks race-rusty
- 9. LUCIFER DU PONT** - Useful sort that faulted when going well, on re-entry, coming 9th of 12 in a 2175m Vincennes Class E on 21 December. Has yet to disappoint racing clockwise and even though handed a tough draw will not be far from the action
- 10. LABRAX DU SKY** - Put 3 sanctions behind him to comfortably win a 2350m Angers Class F 3.5 weeks ago. On the back line but is plainly in excellent condition and, with application, will be no soft touch
- 11. LUNDU DE LOU** - 3rd of 12 in a 2700m Class E at Lyon-La Soie 3 weeks ago. Competitively-shod for first time but appears to be taking on too much
- 12. LONDON RECALL** - Qualified in 1'15"3 at Caen in October before running 3rd of 10 to LOVEBIRD (6) in a 2750m Class E here a fortnight ago. Has significantly more to give, races unshod-behind, and in spite of a poor draw must be taken seriously
- 13. LOUPIAC** - Unable to confirm Amiens victory when 8th of 12 behind LOVER DE TAGOR (1) in a 2700m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche on 25 November. Should not be hastily-condemned though and Alexis Garandeaou will be keen to put things right
- 14. LOULOU DE L'AUNAY** - 3rd over course and distance before finishing 8th of 10 finishers in a 2200m Vincennes monté Class E mid-November. Failed to win the draw-lottery and even though barefoot, looks no more than a minor place prospect

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**Summary:** Worthy winner over 2750m here a fortnight ago, LOVEBIRD (6) starts wide but enjoys a front-row break nevertheless and with hind shoes off this time can double his money. He will come under pressure though from the complicated LABRAX DU SKY (10) provided Théo Duvaldestin keeps him focused, and the consistent LOVER DE TAGOR (1) whose return to competition was particularly encouraging. LEADER DE CERISY (2) has earned the right to step back up in category, is competitively-shod, and Gabi Gelormini has been engaged for the occasion.

**C7 - PRIX DE PICAUVILLE - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness -  
EUR € 22,000**

**1. LITTLE ROAD** - 5th of 11, a place behind LADY D'ECOTAY (4), in a 2175m Vincennes Class E on 21 December. Cobwebs will have been blown away and makes Cabourg debut with a realistic chance of finishing close

**2. LIFE IS BRIGHT** - Sanctioned in last 3, most recently 21 December race of reference. Plainly in shape though, races unshod-behind for first time, and will be no easy touch if Pierre Courval keeps her focused

**3. LILY ROSE MYSTIC** - Last of 11 behind LADY D'ECOTAY (4) in a 2175m Vincennes Class E on 21 December. Must be forgiven that run and can backed with confidence this time. Place chance

**4. LADY D'ECOTAY** - Surprise 4th of 11 in a 2175m Vincennes Class E 12 days ago. Races first-time barefoot and is sufficiently well-positioned to play a prominent role

**5. LET'S GO SMART** - Made it 2 in a row when dominating a 2400m Amiens Class F mid-November. Has freshness on her side, with a top driver reining, and will take some beating

**6. LACIENDA FLASH** - Imposed at Reims before coming 3rd of 11 in a 2575m Saint-Brieuc Class E on 6 December. Races barefoot for first time but others still easier to back

**7. LAISSEZ FAIRE** - Last of 9 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 6 December. Just front shoes on this time but still not a player

**8. LADY VICTORY** - Sanctioned in a 2200m Vincennes Class E 3 weeks ago. Is no slouch when focused, races barefoot for first time and, despite the draw, still looks a respectable first-5 chance

**9. LADIVINA** - Races first-time clockwise after comfortably winning a 2700m Graignes Class F 3 weeks ago. Competitively-shod for the occasion but will still need to find more

**10. LITTLE ITALY** - Has not been seen out since coming 2nd of 11 in a 2550m Dieppe Class E 4 months ago and will need the race

**Summary:** Although something of a late-developer, LET'S GO SMART (5) has nonetheless shown significant potential and, freshly-configured with Yoann Lebourgeois in the bike, looks the pick of the field. The similarly-promising has a pair of runs in her and represents the principal danger. The tricky LILY ROSE MYSTIC (3) did not enjoy the best of trips recently but has a lot going for her here and can put things right.

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## C8 - PRIX DE BRICQUEVILLE - 2050m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MIRZA DU BOUILLON** - Unraced since getting off the mark in a 2500m Class E at Bihorel-lès-Rouen early-October and will not be given a hard race
- 2. MADOKA JIEL** - In the frame in 3 before faulting early in a 2750m Class D here 10 days ago. Well-placed in front but in this category seems no more than a minor place prospect
- 3. MY LOVE ALWAYS** - Opened his account at Vire before finishing 9th of 11 in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.2 mid-December. Faces a more realistic objective this time and the draw bodes well for his chances of finishing in the thick of things
- 4. MODESTY** - 5th of 7 finishers in a 2750m Class D here 10 days ago. Enjoys a fine entry behind the car and has a reasonable chance of losing her maiden tag
- 5. MANONEGRA** - Debuted successfully in a 2750m Class F here on 7 December. Has considerably more to give and from the 5-spot can remain undefeated
- 6. MAGNUS MAXIMUS** - Good 2nd of 7 finishers in a 2400m Amiens Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Has done nothing but improve over recent months and can challenge for a place in the frame
- 7. MA PASSION** - Steps up in category after dominating a 2550m Reims claimer on 7 December. Forced to start wide and others easier to back
- 8. MALOU DU BOIS** - Sanctioned in 4 of last 5, most recently a 2050m Laval Class F 3.5 weeks ago, and will have few friends in the markets
- 9. MIX CASH** - Makes first appearance since coming 3rd of 9, a place behind MIRZA DU BOUILLON, in a 2225m Moulins Class G mid-September. Not ideally-entered but debuts on a hard surface with a every chance of finishing close
- 10. MARIUS DE DUSSAC** - Flattering last of 4 finishers in a 2825m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche 2 months ago and has no possible chance
- 11. MISS JABA** - Faulted in a 2400m Chateaubriant Class E on 11 November, first time out. Showed considerable promise in qualification and can get in on the action if Romain Congard keeps her trotting
- 12. MISTRAL JANEIRO** - 4th of 9 in a 2275m Nantes Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Takes a notable step up the category-ladder though and will struggle to make his mark

**Summary:** A fairly open affair this but it is hard to ignore MANONEGRA (5) who looked a serious horse when imposing over longer on debut here early last month and with Yoann Lebourgeois in the bike this time can repeat. He will still be keeping a watchful eye on the well-positioned MODESTY (4) who will have come on for her recent run here, and the less-favourably-drawn MIX CASH (9) who is not to be underestimated on his first start of the winter. MAGNUS MAXIMUS (6) is quite obviously on the right road and Alexis Prat will be justifiably anticipating another competitive performance.
