- HERACLES DU MONT Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Châlonsen-Champagne on 25 May. Others are much preferred
- **2. GOLOVKIN NATHANPI -** On a long losing run and was 7th last time out in Class G at Amiens over 2400m on 4 May. More is needed to win this race
- **3. FLEURON DE PADD -** Disqualified in his last five starts with the latest being at Gournay-en-Bray on 26 May. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- **4. GUESS LUFFY -** Not easy to trust but she did run well last time out when runner-up in Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles over 2800m on 20 May. Can make the frame if wise

- **2. INESTELLE -** On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Gournay-en-Bray on 20 May. Others are much preferred
- **3. HOT SHOT -** Holding form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2800m on 222 May. Barefoot this time and can finish in the money
- **4. HAZIEL DU VAL D'OR -** Has lost his way and was 12th last time out in Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2825m on 12 May. Needs major improvement to win
