- **3. JEZABEL JENILOU -** Unplaced in a class C at this track over 2100m on 22 November. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred in this line-up
- **4. JAZZ DE PERVENCHE -** Finished 7th in a class C at this track over 2100m on 19 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
