- **1. JAHYPUR DU PERCHE -** Consistent form this year, a nice 3rd over 2400m in mid-August last time. Hard to ignore
- 2. IVRESSE LADY 2nd last time over 2650m at Chateaubriant 10 days ago. Will not lack fitness. Merits consideration
- 3. IRISH VOCATION Decent 2nd last time over 2600m at Vichy in mid-August. Live chance
- **4. JEANNE PRINCESS -** Fair 3rd last time over 2600m at Mauron in mid-August. Ought to be thereabouts
