- **1. GRAZIELLA MIP -** Disappointing since imposing at Abbeville in September, most recently 7th of 12 in a 2400m Amiens amateurs Class G a weeks ago. Shoes on again and not a player
- 2. HELOUIS DE ZAERI 8th of 16 in a 3000m Nantes Class F last Sunday. Boasts decent amateur credentials but races shod this time and best to hold off
- **3. HURON DES LANDIERS -** Has looked very ordinary since the spring, latterly 8th of 11, behind HADDOCK D'ECOUVES (4), in a 2825m Chartres amateurs Class G 2.5 weeks ago, and will need to show marked improvement
- **4. HADDOCK D'ECOUVES -** 4th of 11 in a 2825m Chartres amateurs Class G 2.5 weeks ago. Is unlikely to cause an upset but starts in front and has the wherewithal to make his presence felt
- **5. GAMIN DE VIVOIN -** Sanctioned in a 3875m Class H at Nuillé-sur-Vicoin 3 weeks ago. Has otherwise been in excellent shape, enjoys a front row break, and on good behaviour, can finish in the mix
- **6. HICONE DOREE -** In the frame in 2 before running 5th of 11 in a 2400m Amiens amateurs Class G on 5 October. Takes on a better bunch this time but should nevertheless give an honourable account
- **7. GET ON** Modest trotter that finished 7th of 9 in a 2800m Castéra-Verduzan claimer and in current condition has nothing to offer
- **8. FAST FORWARD -** 9th of 12 in a 2750m amateurs Class H at Le Pertre last weekend. Blows hot and cold, has no particular love for Argentan, but starts in front and, with application, can play a leading role
- **9. GALINETTE DE CYM -** Sanctioned in a 2700m Segré Class F on 6 October. Has done nothing of note for some time, seldom delivers in the amateur category and, despite the good entry and a new configuration, can be passed over
- **10. HUNICOIS -** Quality element making first start since running 12th of 14 in a 2725m Cabourg Class F last July. Shoes on and will need the run
- **11. GALTON SAINT BAR -** Last but one in a 2850m Vincennes amateurs Class G on 1 October. Not as sharp as he was earlier in the season and is unlikely to garner much support
- **12. HOTELLO DESBOIS -** 5th of 12 in a 2150m Enghien claimer 2.5 weeks ago. Has won 4 of 7 in the amateur category though and with an experienced hand at the helm, can make a big splash
- **13. HECTOR DU MINON -** Made it 2 straight sanctions when faulting in a 2650m Alencon Class F on 6 October. Is clearly better than most here, has won twice at the venue, and can impose once more
- **14. GALEO -** Won a Class F at Blain-Bouvron-Le Gâvre before being sanctioned in a 3125m Angers Class E a fortnight ago. Shoes back on but is still capable of getting in on the action

- **15. FIRST DES BORDES -** In the frame in 3 before being sanctioned in a 2400m Beaumont Class F on 5 October. Has nothing to prove at this level and will be expected to give HECTOR DU MINON (13) something to consider

Summary: Twice a winner at Dieppe before faulting in his next two, HECTOR DU MINON (13) goes well for Christian Lejeune and given the horse's record here, will be dangerous if applied. FIRST DES BORDES (15) has serious amateur references, is reconfigured for his Argentan debut, and will also have his chances. Winner of his last 4 starts in this category, HOTELLO DESBOIS (12) must be considered a contender, as should the well-engaged, and shod, HASCHELEY BERRY (16) whose last 2 amateur starts in Paris bode well for her prospects.

- 1. IDOLE DE BEYLEV Made the frame twice before being sanctioned in a 2825m Vire Class F last weekend but in this company will struggle to make her mark
- **2. IROISE JISCE -** 7th of 9 in a 3125m Savenay harness Class F on re-entry late-September. Showed significant monté potential last season and, even with shoes on, seems to have a serious chance of making the frame
- **3. INTRIGUE DE MAX -** Disappointing in last 2, most recently sanctioned in a 2250m Enghien Class E a fortnight ago, and can be passed over
- **4. HENRIQUE DE LOU -** Sanctioned in a 2700m Segré harness Class F on 6 October. Has decent monté credentials but in this field can expect to have few, if any, friends
- **5. ILLICO PRIOR -** 6th of 12, when preparing for this, in a 2750m Cabourg Class E a month ago. Shoes off this time and could agreeably surprise if he takes to the new profile
- **6. HIBISCUS D'ANGELY -** 12th of 14 in a 2750m Cabourg Class D on 5 October. In the frame in both ridden starts this year and despite stepping up in category, should nevertheless hold his own
- **7. ISIDORE BONHEUR -** Sanctioned in a 2850m Class H at Nuillé-sur-Vicoin 3 weeks ago. Sports revised shoeing but still not an obvious choice
- **8. HIP HOP D'EURVAD -** Exceptional over recent months before faulting in a 2700m Segre Class F on 7 October. Should not be too hastily judged, sports hind pads this time, and will be expected to get straight back on track. First 5
- **9. HERACLES DU LAYON -** 3rd of 7 in a 2550m Reims Class F 3 weeks ago. Enjoys an excellent entry on front line and for his 60th start deserves to be rewarded with what would be just his second career victory
- **10. HERCULE DES SABLES -** Courageous 5th of 8, behind HERACLES DU LAYON (9), in a 3000m Nantes Class F on 27 September. Evidently in decent shape but is being asked to do too much
- **11. HUBINE KERYVON -** 13th of 14 in a 2750m Cabourg harness Class D, on comeback, a month ago. Has had time to get her game together and even from the 2nd row looks a player

Effective in the discipline and with a conditioner under her belt, HUBINE KERYVON (11) races barefoot for her Argentan debut and will have a good hand to play. - **2. JESSY DES CAILLONS -** Starts for first time in 2 months, latterly finishing last of 9 in a 2800m Vire Class F, and will have nothing to contribute
- **3. KENZO VEETA -** Showed improvement when running 2nd of 11 finishers in a 2750m Cabourg Class E a month ago. Not a priority but can play a role if still on the boil
- **4. KAVIVE -** Fine servant in this branch of the business but has not been seen out since winning over course and distance last May. Is unlikely to secure the 3-timer but will nevertheless generate interest
- **5. KAMAY DES CORONS -** 3rd of 6 finishers in a 2700m Graignes Class F on 13 October. In better company this time, is arguably more performant racing left-handed, but still looks capable of picking up some prizemoney
- **6. KOQUIN DU PERCHE -** 3rd of 12, on monté debut, in a 2450m Caen Class D 2 weeks ago. Is well-placed in front and the engagement of a top jockey will only enhance his already good prospects
- **7. JAFFNA SHAN -** Switches code for first time after finishing 10th of 12 in a 2500m Reims harness Class F on 12 October, but is still not easy to like
- **8. KITO TURGOT -** Debuts in the discipline after coming a reassuring 3rd of 9 in a 2150m Enghien harness Class E 3.5 weeks ago. Has the right profile for the monté code and looks a serious proposition
- **9. KENJI D'AUBERVILLE -** 8th of 9 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 17 September. Comes here fresh but is shod for the occasion and others preferred

- **4. LIVE TO TELL** Makes Argentan debut after comfortably winning a 2150m Enghien Class D a fortnight ago. Has climbed the category-ladder in good order and is not going to be far off the mark
- **5. LA VIE EST BELLE -** 7th of 10 in a 2850m Vincennes Class C 12 days ago. Has been struggling with form and must get her house in order
- **6. LIBRE PENSEUR MEEK -** Encouraged at Vincennes early last month before running 2nd of 9 in a 2550m Reims Class B a fortnight ago. Gabriele Gelormini reining here and is not one to be underestimated

- **4. KOMMUNES DE PLAY -** Sanctioned in a 2800m Vire Class B 2 weeks ago. Shoes on once more and has nothing to give
- **5. KAJAGOOGOO** Has not been seen out since being sanctioned in a 2875m Enghien Class C last July and will have nothing to offer on first start back

- **4. JAGUAR FLORAL -** Won 2 on the trot before being sanctioned in a 2725m Lisieux Class E on 22 September. Entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard this time and must be taken seriously

- **4. FIDELE MADRIK -** Back under harness after being pulled-up in a 2875m Enghien monté Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Shoes on this time and will have other priorities
- **5. FEELING BOY -** Makes first appearance since running 3rd of 14 in a 2850m Vincennes Class C on 26 August. Starts in front and will have an important role to play in Yves Dreux keeps him focused
- **6. CHARMY CHARLY AS -** Hardy element making first start since being sanctioned in a 2850m Vincennes Gr.3 late-June. Races barefoot for re-entry though, has never disappointed for his driver, and will not be going home empty-handed
- **7. KATINKA DU MOUCHEL -** Considerably better than her 6th of 15 in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.3 late last month would suggest. Has a lot to offer against her elders and can make this her own
- **8. IALTO D'HERTALS -** Starts for first time since coming 8th of 14 in a 3025m Class A at Montier-en-Der last August. Has merit but stays shod for comeback and not an obvious choice
- **9. GAI MATIN -** Made up for his Alencon blip when 3rd of 16 in a 2775m Class D at Les Sables a fortnight ago. One of the more consistent trotters here and is easy to like for a step on the podium
- **10. HOLERO LOVE -** Never-threatening, but respectable, 6th of 16 in a 2200m Caen Class B 2 weeks ago. Won his only start at the venue, is barefoot for the occasion, and will have his supporters
- **11. HANDY BOURBON -** Has 2 races under his belt following a long layoff, most recently last of 10 in a 2725m Graignes Class C 3 weeks ago. Has solid references when barefoot and, nicely-engaged on first line, can play a prominent role
- **12. HELIOS SI -** Respectable but never dangerous 7th of 16, behind HOLERO LOVE (10), in a 2200m Caen Class B 2 weeks ago. Goes shod this time and others easier to back
- **13. KSAR -** Classy colt making first start since coming 3rd of 12 in 2850m Vincennes Gr.1 Critérium des 4 Ans mid-September. Shoes on this time but still has the wherewithal to finish in the mix
- **14. FINE PERLE OF LOVE -** Finished a thrashed 8th of 9 in a 2575m Agen Gr.2 11 days ago. Has done nothing noteworthy for over a year and can be passed over
- **15. HIDALGO DES NOES -** Ran 5th at Le Mans before finishing 6th of 13 in a 2600m Cherbourg Gr.3 9 days ago. Would be preferred unshod however
- **16. FOUGUE DU DOLLAR -** Unraced for 2 months after finishing 7th of 9 in a 2175m Vincennes monté Gr.2. Preparing for a campaign under the saddle and can be ruled out

- **17. ESPACE WINNER -** Won a brace before losing his action in a 2600m Cherbourg Gr.3 late-September. Has been afforded time to recalibrate and even under a 25m burden, can return to winning ways
- **18. INA DU RIB** Has not been seen out since finishing 10th of 12 in a 3100m Angers Gr.3 last April. Here solely for reasons of conditioning and, from 3rd line, will have nothing to contribute

Summary: By no means disgraced in a Vincennes Gr.3 late last month, KATINKA DU MOUCHEL (7) may not have won for close to a year but she drops back in category and, from the front line, can remedy that situation. Oddly out of sorts at Cherbourg, ESPACE WINNER (17) has otherwise been at the top of his game and, reunited with Alexandre Abrivard, can defy the handicap and get his nose in front. As game as they come, GAI MATIN (9) ran a very good race at Les Sables-d'Olonne recently and, with form maintained, can make a big impact from the front line. FEELING BOY (5) has not been seen out for over 2 months but he is barefoot for re-entry and must be taken more seriously this time.
