- **3. CLAPTON -** Improved with the benefit of an underwhelming (10th) introductory outing under his belt to finish 3rd at Pau on PSF over 2000m on 19 October. Should have more to offer

- **9. OVERLORD -** Anastasia Wattel-trained newcomer with Louis Nomis engaged to ride this Recoletos colt. Watching brief advised

Summary: A toss-up between BEST SECRET (1) and STARLORD (2), both of whom have revealed undeniable means and have the form and experience to fight for victory. ANZOR (7) caught the eye on debut and should make his presence felt, given the benefit of that introductory outing and the likelihood of improvement. CLAPTON (3) showed progress on PSF at Pau recently and is another with legitimate podium aspirations.

- **3. ZIA AGNESE -** Improved in first-time headgear to finish a career-best 2nd over 1900m at Chantilly on 1 October in her first start on PSF. Confirmation expected
- **4. VIENTO DE LEVANTE -** Unplaced (8th of 13) in a newcomers' race over 1600m on turf at Chantilly on 21 September. Would have benefitted from that experience

DANSE ETOILEE (1) didn't go unnoticed on debut and ought to make her presence felt too, with that experience to count on.

- **2. SEE THE DREAM -** Unexposed filly with scope to improve. Won 2 of her 3 starts before finishing a creditable 6th in a 1600m Listed race at La Teste on 30 August supplemented for this and worth another chance
- **3. DARLING DARLING -** Making Quinte+ and handicap debut having finished unplaced in 3 consecutive recent starts the latest (9th) in a 2000m Listed race at Marseille-Borely on 16 September
- **4. CALADBOLG** Good 4th in a well-composed Class 2 conditions race at Lyon-Parilly last month but only 7th over 1800m at Marseille-Borely on 22 October. Has no references on PSF
- **5. DAZZLING JEWEL -** Finished 3rd in a Quinte+ over 1800m on turf at Chantilly in September but unplaced (10th) in a 1900m Quinte+ on PSF on 15 October. Best watched for now
- **6. EVERSTAR -** Proven PSF performer and last-start winner of a course-and-distance claimer on 24 October. Will remain competitive despite a 1,5kg penalty

FOREVER GIVEN (9), after an encouraging Quinte+ introduction (3rd), consistent EVERSTAR (6), and HUNGRY HEART (8), judged on the form of his Quinte+ 2nd on this course in August, are genuine podium contenders. - **2. PARAMECIUM -** Progressive cole rewarded for his consistency with a breakthrough maiden success at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 14 October. More needed in this grade/company
- **3. REGISTRATION -** Debut winner on PSF at Newcastle over 1400m on 27 June with John Butler. Absent since but is open to any amount of improvement on his reappearance/French introduction for the new stable

- **3. MOUNT ATHOS -** PSF specialist but versatile performer whose references include finishing 3rd in a 1400m Group III on turf at ParisLongchamp on 26 May. Runner-up in a 1500m Listed race on this course last year (3 December)
- **4. FAST RAAJ -** Won this race last year and finetuned his preparations for this title defence with an encouraging last-start 3rd in a Class 2 conditions race over 1600m at Chantilly on 12 October. Expected to play a leading role

- **9. CAMERON -** Unreliable of late and was 7th last time out in a Conditions race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1800m on 18 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **10. CENTORINA -** Only modest of late and was 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2100m on 14 October. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: MOUTARDE (2) was lit up and unsuited by how the race developed last time. He was supplemented for this race and boasts a potent turn of foot, so could make amends if the race is run to suit. Proven PSF performer TALK SHOW (3) retains sufficient means to fight victory and shouldn't be hastily condemned for his latest failure either. Veteran LETTY'S MARVEL (8), STRAKO (6), back on the PSF with headgear fitted, and NOSDARGENT (4) appeal most of the remainder.
