- **3. KING DES FONTAINES -** Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 28 August. Others are preferred
- **4. KADOR DES TITHAIS -** Did not show his best when 7th last time out in Class F at Vibraye over 2500m on 25 August. Capable of better and has a place chance
