## R3 HYERES [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX MARCEL VERCRUYSSSE - 2850m (a2m) - Class G Amateur  
Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 6,000**

**1. GARDIAN TUILERIE** - Did not show his best when 8th last time out in Class G at Toulouse over 2150m on 27 September. Has a place chance this distance

**2. INES DE TESS** - Only modest form of late and was 7th last time out in Class H at Cazaubon-Barbotan over 2600m on 26 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**3. ILANA DE BEYLEV** - On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Oraison on 30 June. Others are much preferred

**4. ICARE GEMA** - Has struggled of late and was 7th last time out in Class G at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 August. Others are preferred

**5. GAMINE DU BAS BOSQ** - Bounced back to her best when a barefoot winner in Class G at Arras over 2925m on 22 September. Deserves respect in this line-up

**6. INSIDER** - Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 22 September. Capable of better and has won twice this year

**7. IDAYA SOMOLLI** - Fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time out at Vichy at Vichy on 14 September. In good form before that but can contest the finish

**8. GOLDENBOY DE CHENU** - Disappointing form of late and was 9th last time out in Class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 22 September. Has won at this course and can bounce back to score

**9. HISTORIQUE ELDE** - Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when 5th in Class G last time out at this course over 28275m on 2 August. Capable of better and has a winning chance

**Summary:** GOLDENBOY DE CHENU (8) has been disappointing of late but has won at this course and could win this very tricky opening event. INSIDER (6) has won twice this year but is unreliable. He should be a threat to these rivals. GAMINE DU BAS BOSQ (5) was a barefoot winner last time out and remains unshod so deserves the utmost respect. IDAYA SOMOLLI (7) was in good form before a disqualification last time out and would not be a surprise winner.

## C2 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DE CAGNES-SUR-MER - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. LIDO SHOW** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when runner-up last time out in Class F at this course over 2050m on 14 September. Has a place chance
- 2. L'ECU DALAMEDA** - Has some fair form and was fourth last time out in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 1 September. Could play a minor role
- 3. LEBEL DU MIDI** - Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borely on 21 September. Others are preferred
- 4. LEONA JENILOU** - Showed what she is capable of with a Class E win at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 September. Can contest the finish again
- 5. LUCKY DE CASROUGE** - Did not show his best when 6th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 21 September. Capable of better and could earn some money
- 6. LESLEY ARCTIC** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borély on 21 September. Won her penultimate start and is not out of it
- 7. LYS ROYAL** - Won on debut and has some fair form since then, including when 5th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 21 September. Might play a minor role
- 8. L'OR DU MELEUC** - Only beaten once so far and that was last time out when fourth in Class D at Cavaillon over 2600m on 20 September. Be right there at the finish once again
- 9. L'AMIRAL D'EURVAD** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time at Cavaillon on 20 September. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 10. LEADER DES RIOULTS** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Vichy over 2200m on 21 September. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
- 11. LAOS DE BANVILLE** - Unreliable but he was victorious last time out in Class E at this course over 2650m on 12 August. Can follow up if in the same mood
- 12. LASKO DES FORGES** - in very good form and was runner-up last time out in Class D at Cavaillon over 2600m on 20 September. Big chance in this line-up

**Summary:** LASKO DES FORGES (12) is in very good form and sets the standard for the race. He should make a bold bid at scoring. LAOS DE BANVILLE (11) won at this track last time out and is an obvious threat but he is also unreliable. L'OR DU MELEUC (8) was not disgraced when fourth last time out and was unbeaten before that so deserves the utmost respect in this line-up. LEONA JENILOU (4) won nicely last time out and also can be considered a possible winner.

## C3 - PRIX DES HIPPODROMES DE MARSEILLE - 2850m (a2m) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 26,000

- 1. JO DE CAZOULENE** - Unreliable but did win a Class F harness race last time out at Oraison over 2650m on 15 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 2. JALON DU GOUTIER** - Unreliable of late and was 6th last time out in a Class E harness race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 21 August. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. JACADY SLY** - Has struggled of late and was 8th last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Cazaubon-Barbotan over 2600m on 30 September. Capable of making the frame
- 4. JAGERSRO** - Ultra-consistent and was third last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 27 September. Be right there at the finish once again
- 5. JOMIZIO** - Disqualified last time out at Divonne-les-Bains on 23 August. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- 6. ILLICO JULRY** - Has very good recent form under the saddle and was a winner last time out in a Class G Mounted race at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 29 August. Big chance
- 7. FIRST BLACK** - Has some fair recent form and was third last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Cavailon over 2600m on 20 September. Capable of earning some more money

**Summary:** ILLICO JULRY (6) is at best in Mounted races and was a winner last time out. This shorter distance is not a problem and he can score again. JAGERSRO (4) is very competitive and should be right there at the finish yet again. JOMIZIO (5) faulted last time out but had some good form before that and can make the frame. JACADY SLY (3) is capable of a surprise when in the mood.

## C4 - PRIX DOMINIK CORDEAU - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. JADE PIERJI** - Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this track on 14 September. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 2. JANE LUIS PORSGUEN** - Did not show her best when 7th last time out in Class F at this course over 2050m on 14 September. Capable of better and can contest the finish
- 3. JOLIE MOME CHIC** - Holding her form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 22 September. Can contest the finish once again
- 4. JERSEY BLEUE** - Modest form of late and was 6th last time out in Class F at Vichy over 2800m on 14 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. JORDANA** - On a long losing run but was third last time out in Class F at this course over 2050m on 14 September. Has a place chance
- 6. JUVANIA** - In good form and was a barefoot winner in Class F at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 1 September. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- 7. JET SET AIMEF** - Disappointing of late and was 11th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 26 September. Probably best watched for now
- 8. JUNON DE BEYLEV** - Disappointing last run when 7th in Class F at this course over 2050m on 29 September. Capable of better and has a winning chance
- 9. JOIE DU GUELIER** - Unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 13 August. Capable of earning some money this distance
- 10. JAVA VENUS** - Battling to regain best form and was 7th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 26 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 11. JOY JELOCA** - Has struggled of late and was tenth last time out in Class F at Evreux over 2725m on 1 September. Others are preferred
- 12. JOLIE SCALA** - Showed some improvement when third last time out in Class F at Oraison over 2650m on 15 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 13. JUNON DU VASSET** - Disappointing recent form and was 8th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 26 September. Others are much preferred

**Summary:** JUVANIA (6) remains in good shape and was an unshod winner last time out. She remains barefoot and has every chance of following up. JUNON DE BEYLEV (8) is clearly capable of better than the last run would suggest and deserves respect in this division. JOLIE MOME CHIC (3) is holding form and should be competitive once again. JANE LUIS PORSGUEN (2) is another who is capable of making the frame.

€ 20,000**

- 1. JAS DU TRUFIER** - Holding form and was third last time out in Class D at Montauban over 2400m on 20 May. Has a winning chance if fit from a break
- 2. JIMMU DU PATURAL** - In good form and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Vic-Fezensac over 2450m on 23 September. Might play a minor role
- 3. JERICO BADREC** - in good form and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Oraison over 2650m on 15 September. Not out of it
- 4. JUST AN EAGLE** - Did not show his best when 9th last time out in Class F at Auch over 2800m on 2 September. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 5. JUMBO DE JA YO** - has really struggled of late and was 8th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 29 August. Others are much preferred
- 6. JALAPENO** - Has disqualification issues but is in good shape and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 1 September. Should fight out the finish
- 7. JIOSCO DES CHASSES** - Has struggled of late and was 12th last time out in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 22 September. Capable of better and is barefoot this time
- 8. JEANNOT DU VALLON** - In good form and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Villeneuve-sur-Lot over 2625m on 22 September. Can make the frame again
- 9. JOUEUR DU METZ** - Has struggled of late and was 7th last time out in Class F at Lyon Parilly over 2850m on 22 September. Others are preferred
- 10. JAMES BOND** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at this course on 29 September. Capable of better but is hard to trust
- 11. JUPITER DE VANDEL** - Has disqualification issues but was third last time out in Class F at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 17 September. Can surprise if wise
- 12. JETSTAR DE VRIE** - Very hard to trust but was a winner last time out in Class F at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 1 September. Can follow up if in the same mood

**Summary:** JALAPENO (6) is in good form and gets a confident vote to score. JAS DU TRUFIER (1) has some good form but is returning from a break and could need this run. JERICO BADREC (3) is in good shape and ran well at Oraison last time. This does look a tougher task. JIOSCO DES CHASSES (7) has struggled of late but is capable of a surprise when in the mood.

## C6 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DE SALON DE PROVENCE - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. KABYLIE DES EDEL** - Has lost his way of late and was disqualified last time out at this course on 14 September. Others are much preferred
- 2. KAWESAQUEL** - Has disqualification issues but was a winner last time out in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 1 September. Can follow up
- 3. KIF DE L'UNE** - Has struggled of late and was 8th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 17 April. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 4. KENAVO DU BOUILLON** - Has major disqualification issues but did run well when third last time out E at this course over 2850m on 14 September. Might play a minor role
- 5. KACY AND GEPE** - Yet to win a race but is in good form and was fourth last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 29 August. Could play a minor role
- 6. KLUSAZ** - On a very long losing run and was 5th last time out in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 7. KANSAS QUICK** - Disappointing last two runs and was 12th last time out in Class D at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 30 May. Returns from a break but has the ability and is not out of it
- 8. KYLLIAN** - Did not show his best when 11th last time out in Class C at Cavaillon over 2600m on 20 September. Capable of better and could contest the finish
- 9. KANEA DE L'ABBAYE** - Disappointing form of late and was 6th last time out in Class C at Cavaillon over 2600m on 20 September. Needs to do more to win this race
- 10. KING'S DAY** - In good form and has won two of his last three starts, including last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 21 September. Has a winning chance
- 11. KRISTAL DREAM** - Did not show his best when 6th last time out in Class B at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 26 September. Barefoot this time and can bounce back to score
- 12. KENZA KALOUMA** - Ultra-consistent and was runner-up last time out in Class C at Cavaillon over 2600m on 20 September. Big chance in this line-up

**Summary:** KENZA KALOUMA (12) is very consistent and has a big chance of another deserved victory. KANSAS QUICK (7) struggled in his last two starts but returns from a break and could be a threat in this line-up. KING'S DAY (10) is in good form and won a Mounted race last time out but is just as good in harness races. KYLLIAN (8) could be the surprise package for the race.

## C7 - PRIX OCTOBRE ROSE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. HORIZON DE BLAY** - Finished 9th in class H at Vic-Fezensac over 2450m on 23 September. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 2. HURON** - Did not show his best when 8th in class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 22 September. Capable of playing a minor role
- 3. HOTELLO DESBOIS** - Unreliable and was 5th in class E at Cavaillon over 2525m on 20 September. Capable of getting involved with the finish when in the mood
- 4. GALVESTON** - Victorious in Class F at Oraison over 2650m on 15 September. Remains barefoot but is inconsistent. Can surprise
- 5. HARCOURT DE PADD** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Vic-Fezensac over 2475m on 23 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. GROOVE DE SYVA** - Well beaten and was 14th in class F at Cavaillon over 2525m on 20 September. Unreliable and has disqualification issues
- 7. HAPPY DE NICE** - Finished 7th in class G at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 26 September. Won in March and can contest the finish if in the mood
- 8. GLADIATOR DE NIMES** - Holding form and was fourth in class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 22 September. Can contest the finish again
- 9. HANNIBAL CARNOIS** - In good form and was third in class G at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 26 September. Shown improvement and can win a race like this
- 10. HEYDAY** - Victorious in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 20 September. Remains barefoot and can repeat if in the mood
- 11. GALANT VENUS** - Finished fourth in class G at Hyeres over 2050m on 29 September. Returns barefoot but is on a long losing streak. Might place

**Summary:** HANNIBAL CARNOIS (9) is in good shape and gets a narrow vote to score in a competitive-looking race. HEYDAY (10) won well enough to suggest another one could be forthcoming so deserves respect once again. GLADIATOR DE NIMES (8) is consistent and can get into the mix of things yet again. HOTELLO DESBOIS (3) is not reliable but did not run badly last time out and can do even better this time.

## C8 - PRIX DU PRESIDENT JEAN-MARIE GIOVANNA - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- 1. JELLO W.** - Disqualified in class E at Dieppe over 2550m on 18 September. Remains barefoot but is on a long losing streak. Best watched for now
- 2. GRAINE D'URZY** - unreliable and was 6th in class F at Cavaillon over 2525m on 20 September. Won in May but has been unreliable since. Might place
- 3. HARDE DESTINEE** - Finished 7th in class F at Cavaillon over 2525m on 20 September. On a long losing streak and others are preferred this time
- 4. BOMBER MAN** - Has some fair form and was 5th in class F at Hyeres over 2850m on 14 September. Won well in April and has prepared the same for this race
- 5. GE DU MANOIR** - Finished 8th in class F at Castillonnes over 2450m on 29 September. Won well in July and has placed twice this year. Place chance
- 6. GOLDEN VIKING** - Finished 7th in class F at Villeneuve-sur-Lot over 2625m on 22 September. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 7. FORREST GUMP SET** - Disappointing last run when 6th in class F at Castillonnes over 2450m on 29 September. Won in September over 2950m and can repeat
- 8. HOOLIGAN JIM** - Finished tenth in class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 12 July. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. GOLD DU RABUTIN** - Finished 11th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 18 September. Capable of better and can bounce back to score
- 10. EREGON DE JUPILLES** - Not disgraced when fourth in class A at Montier over 3025m on 18 August. Barefoot and should contest the finish again
- 11. FRONSAC** - Unreliable and was 8th in class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 September. Returns barefoot and can be a threat

**Summary:** FORREST GUMP SET (7) seems a bit better than the last run would suggest and is better judged on his win in his penultimate start. A lucky last-race winner, perhaps. GOLD DU RABUTIN (9) is capable of better and would not be a surprise winner. FRONSAC (11) is unreliable but will be barefoot this time so deserves respect. BOMBER MAN (4) has some fair form and is another to consider.
