- **1. SKADOOSH -** Finished 8th in a Handicap at Strasbourg over 2000m on 15 September. A track and trip winner in January. Returning to a Claimer and is capable of contesting the finish
- 2. ASRIEL Well beaten 8th in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 6 September. Yet to make the frame
- **3. HER CHRISTOPHER -** Third in a Claimer at Chantilly over 1900m on 2 September. Improved effort in the latest and can be involved in the finish again
- **4. APOLINO -** Finished 8th in a Handicap at La Teste-du-Buch over 1600m on 12 September. First-time Claimer that should make a bold bid for victory
- **5. BEST OFFER -** Finished 6th in a Conditions race at Vitteaux over 2600m on 22 September. Not in the best of form and is best watched for now

- **2. GAIDAR -** Finished 7th in a Claimer at La Croise-Laroche over 2500m on 17 September. Suited to the surface and the stable is in form
- **3. MORCOTE -** Fourth at Baden-Baden over 2000m on 31 August. Track and distance suited. Has sufficient means to fight for victory
- **4. ARTURO -** Finished 10th in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2400m on 11 September. Three poor efforts after a break
- **5. GLACIER PEAK -** Well beaten 9th in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 20 May. Probably will need the run-back

- **3. SIR WALTER -** Finished 9th in a Handicap at Strasbourg over 2000m on 8 September. Well weighted and is track-suited. Could be a surprise package
- **4. SEA URCHIN -** Third in a Conditions race at Vannes over 2200m on 21 September. Holding form and deserves to be respected

- **2. HAGLER -** Disappointing when unplaced in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 13 July. Dropping by 1.5 Kg in the weights and is sand-suited. Deserves to be respected
- **3. DESERT RHAPSODY -** Fifth at Avenches over 1600m on 14 September. Unplaced since winning in June and must do more
- **4. TANTOMILE -** Fifth in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 21 September. Finished off the latest well and can get closer. Unproven on the sand

- 2. EGGLESTON Bought for €20,000 at a Breeze-Up Sale in the spring and has revealed sufficient means to be competitive at this level finished 6th in both starts, the latest in an 1800m maiden at Chantilly on 16 September. Respect
- **3. FUJI HANA -** Failed to confirm the form and improvement of her previous start (4th in a 1300m PSF claimer at Chantilly) when only 6th in a 1000m turf maiden at Vichy on 24 September. Better expected back at this level on PSF
- **4. LILAROSE -** Has the form and experience to acquit herself competitively in a race of this ilk, having finished 4th and 6th twice each in her last 4 starts. Not disgraced when 6th in an 1800m Compiegne claimer on 17 September
- **5. MOONSHINE -** Unplaced and soundly beaten in both appearances, the latest (9th) in a 1700m Divonne-les-Bains claimer on 1 September. Improvement needed in his first start on the PSF
- **6. GUAPAK -** Improved when a career-best 3rd in a 1700m claimer at Divonne-les-Bains on 1 September before finishing unplaced (9th) in first-time headgear over 2000m in a Vichy conditions race on 23 September. Can do better

- **9. PERLE ARDENTE -** Didn't go unnoticed on debut, finishing 6th of 11 in a 1700m claimer at Divonne-les-Bains on 1 September. Open to improvement with the benefit of that experience
- **10. ALNAIR -** Elauryne Cury-trained Stellar Mass newcomer to be ridden on debut by Gabriele Congiu. Watch the betting

Summary: KENDJA (1), despite finishing a well-beaten 8th in a Class 2 conditions race at Dax recently, is best judged on her 1400m victory at La Teste in July when beating a subsequent winner. On the strength of that form, she ought to establish herself at this level and is good value to reconnect with success dropped to this class/category for the first time. FUJI HANA (3) finished 4th in this grade on the PSF at Chantilly in her penultimate outing and could fight for victory if bouncing back to that sort of form over this extended trip. LILAROSE (4), experienced in this category, and unexposed EGGLESTON (2), whose trainer rarely makes the trip to this course without good reason, aren't taken lightly.

- **1. BELAFONTE -** Won 2 of 4 appearances in this category, notably beating Central Park West (last Tuesday's Quinté+ winner) on the PSF at Deauville in early August. Showed his form and well-being by winning a 2100m handicap at Saint-Cloud on 27 September
- **2. PUMP PUMP CITY -** Two-time course-and-distance winner in handicaps, including on his last visit here in November. Unplaced (9th) off his current mark in a 2000m handicap at Salon-de-Provence on 9 September now drops in class
- **3. DUNSBOROUGH -** Lightly raced 4-year-old gelding with sound PSF references, including a last-start 3rd at Chantilly when last seen on 11 October 2023. Best watched for now
- **4. BOLSHKINOV -** Was returning from an 8-month absence when finishing 2nd, beaten 6 lengths by the winner, over 1400m at Dresden on 21 September. Fitter, has sound references at this level and is well treated under the conditions
- **5. WILMOT -** Consistent performer in Germany with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 4th over 1800m at Baden-Baden on 28 August. Not taken lightly in his start on French soil and on this surface
- **6. ZAMNESIA -** Rewarded for her consistency with a maiden career victory at München-Riem over 2000m on 12 September. Has more to do here
- **7. LOUBEISIEN -** Lightly raced five-year-old who didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th in a 1600m claimer at Fontainebleau on 22 September. Place chance
- **8. EDITED -** Well-performed veteran with 11 victories to his name and sound references at this level on the PSF, though he is no longer the force of old. Unplaced (6th) in a 2000m handicap at Salon-de-Provence on 9 September
- **9. ROYAL SAXO -** Soundly beaten (14th) in a 1400m Quinté+ handicap on PSF at Deauville on 30 July but shouldn't be taken lightly on his reappearance given the significant drop in class. Keep safe

Summary: Stefan Richter has won and placed 3 times each with 8 runners at Lyon-La-Soie this year and that impressive record bodes well for the chances of BOLSHKINOV (4) who finished an encouraging 2nd on his reappearance at Dresden recently. He gets the nod ahead of top-weight BELAFONTE (1) whose candidacy/competitiveness in this category is beyond doubt. ROYAL SAXO (9) isn't taken lightly either and he should fare a lot better in this grade than he did when last seen in a Quinté+ at Deauville in July. Dual course winner PUMP PUMP CITY (2) completes the shortlist in his first start at this level.

- **1. VADIRUM -** Boasts 2 wins and a 2nd in 4 visits to this track, including a course-and-distance claiming success. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th over 3000m at Le Lion d'Angers on 4 August and will find this trip more to his liking
- **2. SANTURIN -** Hard-knocking handicapper with sound form references/credentials, including 3 consecutive recent efforts in Quinte+ events not beaten far in each, the latest (6th) over 2400m at ParisLongchamp on 1 September
- **3. RODAINAH -** Versatile filly with sound references on both surfaces, including a win and a 4th in 2 starts on this surface. Rewarded for consistency with a last-start win in a 2400m ParisLongchamp handicap and ought to remain competitive under a 2,5kg penalty
- **4. LISMORE -** Unplaced in both handicap appearances but is lightly raced and remains open to improvement. Proved her form and well-being by winning over 2850m at Sablé-sur-Sarthe on 15 September but will find this tougher
- 5. SAINTE RITA Honest performer with consistent form references/credentials, including 15 top-five finishes on this course. Acquitted herself well (5th) in a course-and-distance handicap on 11 September can't be underestimated
- **6. KINGDOM -** Capable handicapper who finished 2nd in a handicap over track and trip on his last visit to this venue. Only 6th off his current mark (under a 2,5kg penalty) in a 2500m ParisLongchamp Class 3 event on 12 September
- **7. PANGAEA -** Unreliable and out of sorts, though did finish 2nd in his only attempt at 2400m (albeit off a lower mark). Finished a well-beaten 10th in a 2000m Saint-Cloud handicap on 13 September dark horse over this trip
- **8. HONGUEMARE -** Lightly raced mare with references at a higher level seldom far off the mark but has been hard to win with (just 1 win from 20 starts). Was a well-beaten 9th in a 2500m Class 3 at ParisLongchamp on 12 September
- **9. WILLY WINNER -** Consistent, versatile handicapper whose best references (both career victories) were achieved on the PSF. Caught the eye with a reassuring 4th off this mark in a 2400m turf handicap at Lyon-Parilly on 11 Septmber
- **10. SIYOUCHKA -** Versatile filly with sound references/form credentials on both surfaces, including a course-and-distance 3rd in early January. Lost her way recently unplaced in her last 3 starts, the latest (6th) in a 2350m handicap at Strasbourg on 15 September
- **11. FORBIDDEN SECRET -** Won back-to-back PSF claimers over this distance at Cagnes earlier this year off his current mark but hasn't been seen since finishing 6th in a course-and-distance handicap on 24 March. Best watched for now

Summary: Honest veteran SANTURIN (2) has acquitted himself well in considerably stronger Quinté+ handicaps in each of his last 3 starts and should prove even more competitive at this level, especially returning to this venue where he has already been successful. Last-start winner RODAINAH (3), a proven PSF performer, could make life difficult for the selection, despite her resultant 2,5kg penalty, along with course-and-distance specialist VADIRUM (1) who will enjoy this shorter trip after stretching out to 3000m at Le Lion-d'Angers in early August. WILLY WINNER (9) and SAINTE RITA (5) know this track inside out and can get into the picture.
