- **1. JILPA KALONIG -** 4th of 10 in a 2900m Arras Class F on 22 September. Sports a new configuration but at this level will have her work cut out
- **2. JOY BRETONNIERE -** Won 2 earlier in the summer but less performant since, latterly sanctioned in a 3200m Vannes Class F a fortnight ago. Breaks in front though and can play a part if Matthieu Abrivard keeps her trotting
- **3. JUSTICE PROUVEE -** Reverts to a winning configuration after coming 2nd of 13 in a 2725m Evreux Class F on 22 September. Takes on a tough bunch here but starting in front, with David Thomain in the bike, will do her prospects no harm
- **4. JUBILATION -** Has bags of ability but out of the picture in last 3, most recently sanctioned in a 2800m Rambouillet Class F mid-September. Shod to preference this time but must first reestablish her credentials
- **5. J'ADORE CHENEVIERE -** Pleasant 6th of 11 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class F on 15 September but will struggle to make any impact
- **6. JOHANNA ELEVEN -** Sanctioned, when full of running, in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle on 23 September. Even so, she still looks out of her depth here
- **7. JEZILDA MAUVE -** 7th of 10, behind JOHANNA ELEVEN (6), in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle early last month. Pleased on lone Vincennes start but has too much to do this time
- **8. JUSTE DU GERS -** Winner at Saint-Jean-de-Monts before coming 9th of 11 when preparing for this in a 2750m Ecommoy Class F 12 days ago. Has a golden entry here and can open her metropolitan account
- **9. JOYCE DE LA COUR -** Unremarkable 8th of 15 in a 2100m Class D here 2 weeks ago and again appears to have little to contribute
- **10. JADE DE CASTELLE -** Has not been seen out since finishing last of 8 in a 2250m Enghien Class C early-July, and will have nothing to offer
- **11. JOMA OV -** 9th of 13 in race of reference, on first start since the break. Has never disappointed under these conditions, will have progressed for the run, and must be taken seriously
- **12. JODANNE DIESCHOOT -** Came 2nd at Le Mans before finishing a courageous 5th to JET SET (14) in race of reference. Seldom gets her nose in front, and incurs the penalty, but still looks a respectable first-5 prospect
- **13. JET SOCIETY -** Put a brace of sanctions behind her to run 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2875m Enghien Class D mid-July. Has not been seen out since but won last time she was reined by Eric Raffin and, with application, is unlikely to disappoint
- **14. JET SET -** 3rd of 13 in a 2700m Class C here on 22 September. Appreciates 2850m over the main track and will be reunited with Alexandre Abrivard. Chance

- **15. JALOUSIE MAZA -** Won at Cabourg before enduring some tough luck on 22 September, coming 11th of 13, behind JET SET (14), in a 2700m Class C here, but can more than make amends if Franck Nivard keeps her out of trouble
- **16. JOY JENILOU -** 6th behind JET SET (14), in a 2700m Class C here on 22 September, despite some ill-fortune. Is plainly in shape and will be expected to be more competitive this time around

Summary: Winner in the provinces early last month, JUSTE DU GERS (8) benefits from a tremendous engagement here and, barefoot from the front row, looks just to have the edge over 2nd line starters, the on-form JALOUSIE MAZA (15) who was very unlucky here last time, and JET SET (14) who won under these conditions earlier in the year. 6th to her last time out, JOY JENILOU (16) showed her form here a fortnight earlier and must also be considered a contender.

- **2. HOLSTER -** Has hardly put a foot wrong all year, most recently finishing 2nd of 13 in a 3025m Class F at Montier-en-Der early last month, but can expect to find the going somewhat tougher here
- **3. HELIOS DJEMA -** Versatile and in-form trotter that won smartly on his Vincennes debut late-August, smartly winning a 2700m Class E, and returns to the capital with every chance of repeating
- **4. HIT DE JOBI -** Has not been seen out since being sanctioned in a 2700m Class A at Aix-les-Bains late-July. Barefoot for re-entry, but still not a priority
- **5. HASHTAG CHAMANT -** Honest trotter that ran 6th of 12 in a 2850m Parilly Class D on 18 September. Unlikely to shake things up and others easier to back
- **6. HAPPY DANOVER -** Placed at Pornichet before coming 4th of 12 in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle on 27 August. Has had time to freshen up and although not the biggest fan of Vincennes, can still play a small part
- **7. HELIOS DES CHAMPS -** Pleased at Alençon early last month before trailing in 10th of 15 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E a fortnight later and, even sporting a new configuration, will have little to offer
- **8. HERMES D'ECROVILLE -** On a fine run of form, latterly 2nd of 10 in a 2100m Class D here 12 days ago. Bruno Marie reining again and will have justified ambition on a place in the frame
- **9. HARMONY LA NUIT -** Blows hot and cold but finished a reassuring 4th of 14 in a 2725m Pornichet Class E a fortnight ago. Benjamin Rochard at the helm this time and will be no easy touch
- **10. HAS DE COEUR -** 2nd of 11 in a 2500m Reims Class E mid-September. Has shown solid aptitude in the day's configuration and, given his record under these conditions, must be afforded considerable respect
- **11. HERMES EXPRESS -** Unlucky not to have finished closer than 5th of 11 in a 2850m Class D here on 21 August. Returns refreshed, has won 5 of 7 for Eric Raffin, and will be expected to contest the finish
- **12. HIMBERLAND -** Sent for a break after faulting in a Class D over course and distance late-June. Imposed at this level during the spring and, if fully fit and focused, can get in on the action

Summary: Wonderfully-consistent in the provinces, HELIOS DJEMA (3) left quite the impression on his Vincennes debut late-August, returns fresh to the venue, and has a realistic chance of doubling up. Winner of his only start under these conditions, HERMES EXPRESS (11) was very unlucky here a week earlier, but has had time to recalibrate, and looks the main threat. Reinvigorated since Bruno Marie reassumed driving duties, HERMES D'ECROVILLE (8) showed great courage over shorter here recently and deserves to finish close. HAS DE COEUR (10) returns to racing left-handed, in top condition, and has never disappointed over 2700m here.

- **1. I LOVE IGNY -** Sanctioned, on first start back, in a 2525m Class H at Les Andelys mid-September. Is useful when focused, and races unshod-behind, but still no more than a minor place prospect
- **2. INUKSHUK -** Remarkably-consistent sort that imposed at Feurs early-September before running 2nd of 14 in a 2725m Pornichet Class F a fortnight ago. Races barefoot this time and with Franck Nivard in the bike must be respected
- **3. ILDO DU VIVIER -** Tricky element that pleasantly surprised when 4th of 14 in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E 9 days ago. Unlikely to repeat but should nevertheless acquit himself honourably
- **4. IT'S CLASSIC ROCK -** Would have finished close in a 2850m Class E here on 22 September had he stayed trotting. Is clearly at the top of his game and, with application, can open his Vincennes account
- **5. ILLICO DU GUESNE -** Finished 6th of 13, at 96/1, in a 2725m Pornichet Class F a fortnight ago, and a repeat seems most improbable
- **6. IMPERATRICE HEDEN -** Fast-finishing 3rd of 13 in a 2850m Laval Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Has not delivered at Vincennes for some time but with Raffin back in the bike, will be afforded every chance
- **7. INTELLO D'ERABLE -** Returned to winning ways at Cabourg mid-August but sanctioned over course and distance a month ago. Sports 4 pads for first time and debuts for Willy Michel with every chance of making it worth his while
- **8. INHERIT -** Was enjoying a fruitful summer before finishing 6th of 11 in a 2825m Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche last Monday, and backs up with limited chances
- **9. IHLUNA -** Serious mare that did not enjoy the best of trips at Laval 2.5 weeks ago, coming 8th of 13, behind IMPERATRICE HEDEN (6), in a 2850m Class E. Competitively-shod this time and will be expected to put things right
- **10. IVARUN -** Honourable 3rd of 14 in a 2850m Class E here on 22 September. Will have progressed for the run and is not incapable of rewarding his new trainer with success
- **11. IMAGE DE FLAM -** Capable when focused but has not been seen out since faulting in a 2000m Rambouillet Class D 4 months ago, and will need the run
- **12. INDIGO DE NAPPES -** Sanctioned on Vincennes debut early last month, faulting in the final turn of a Class E over course and distance, but if focused can more than make amends
- **13. IDEE SHANNON -** Makes her Vincennes debut in fine form, most recently 4th of 10 in a 2850m Parilly amateurs Class G on 18 September, but is nevertheless being aimed to high

Summary: IT'S CLASSIC ROCK (4) was on a terrific run of form before faulting, when competitive, here recently; David Thomain gets the nod this time and can set the record straight. 3rd that day, on his first objective of the new season, IVARUN (10) will have come on for the run and should again figure prominently, but he may first have to see off the on-song INDIGO DE NAPPES (12) who has been entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard for the first time. Regularly in the thick of things when barefoot and focused, IMPERATRICE HEDEN (6) thrives with her driver and will have ambitions on a place cheque.

- **1. IROISE DE LA NOE -** Group-class mare that has not been seen out seen out since faulting in 3000m Critérium des 5 Ans just over a year ago here, and will be given an easy re-introduction
- **2. CHERRY TOP -** Back in shape following the spell, most recently 3rd of 12 in a Class C over course and distance 2 weeks ago, and while unlikely to have his day in the sun, should nevertheless hold his own
- **3. HERALDIQUE -** 7th of 12, behind CHERRY TOP (2), on return to competition in a Class C over track and trip a fortnight ago. Is otherwise remarkably consistent and success here would take his win-rate to 50%
- **4. CYRANO DE B. -** Complicated type that showed improvement in a Class C over track and trip 2 weeks ago, coming 4 of 12 [on 1st start for new handler], a place behind CHERRY TOP (2), and must be taken more seriously
- **5. IBISCUS MAN -** Very good 3rd of 13 in a 2600m Cherbourg GNT Gr.3 9 days ago. Has oddly never delivered for Eric Raffin but he is back in the wagon and will be eager to put things right
- **6. HARRY CARISAIE -** Honest sort that ran 5th of 14 in a 2550m Class C at Beaumont-de-Lomagne 3.5 weeks ago. Shoes back on though and others easier to back
- **7. GREAT OF MADRIK -** Makes first start since being sanctioned, when en route to a frame-finish, in a 2850m Class B here late-August. Has ample ability and can get in on the action if David Thomain manages to keep him trotting
- **8. HERE WE GO -** Quality trotter making first appearance since coming 5th of 14 in a 2150m Enghien Class C last April. Shoes on however and best to hold off
- **9. SELF EXPLOSIVE -** Defied his odds to come 6th of 11 in a 2850m Class B here on 14 September, on just 2nd start for new handler. Is plainly on way back up and is not to be overlooked
- **10. FEE LUCERNAISE -** Got back in the game on turf 11 days ago when 4th of 15 in a 3500m Craon Class B. Has no particular love for 2700m here though and can be passed over
- **11. HARMONISTA -** Serious mare with excellent references over course and distance. Ran 10th of 11, when prepping for this, in a monté Class B under these conditions 3 weeks ago, and will be competitive for a place in the frame
- **12. GOAL STAR -** 4th of 13, a place behind GIRL DE BASSIERE (15), in a Class C over course and distance late-August. Comes here fresh, has already won at a similar level here this season, and is not going to be far off the mark
- **13. INDIGO DE FONTAINE -** Somewhat unlucky 5th of 7 in a 2850m Gr.3 here 10 days ago, on first appearance since the break. Has won 7 of 9 under these conditions and should have this in the bag
- **14. FAVORI DE L'ITON -** 9th of 12 in a 2150m Class B at Castéra-Verduzan on 19 August. Disappointing for some time and can be ruled out
- **15. GIRL DE BASSIERE -** 7th of 11, behind SELF EXPLOSIVE (9), in a 2850m Class B here mid-September. Enjoys an entry-made-in-heaven and her driver will be keen to capitalise

Summary: As versatile and as tough as they come, INDIGO DE FONTAINE (13) left a good impression on his recent re-entry in a Gr.3 here and, simply exceptional over 2700m, and barefoot for the occasion, is going to take all the beating. Leading the opposition will be the tricky but talented IBISCUS MAN (5) who reassured at Cherbourg late last month, and the on-form HARMONISTA (11) who comes here barefoot and with a monté freshener under her belt. Cyril Chenu could not have asked for a better entry for GIRL DE BASSIERE (15) and Benjamin Rochard will assure her a competitive drive.

- **2. JUNIOR BERDIERE -** 7th of 9, behind JOKER DE FROULAY (4), in a Class C over course and distance, on first start since the break. Never far from faulting but has decent references over 2700m here and is capable of making first 5
- **3. DENIA -** Back under the saddle after flying up in a 2100m harness Class B here 3 weeks ago. Has previously won over course and distance and will not be far from the action if Eric Raffin keeps her focused
- **4. JOKER DE FROULAY -** Complemented his course-and-distance 2nd with 3rd of 9 in a 2600m Cherbourg Class A on 25 August. Benjamin Rochard in the wagon this time and is an obvious candidate for the podium
- **5. KIMBO BERRY -** No slouch on a good day but unraced since finishing 7th of 9 in a 2850m Vincennes Class B last June. Barefoot but still not a priority
- **6. JUPITER DE PLAY -** Complicated type returning to the monté code after a pair of harness conditioners, most recently sanctioned in a 2850m Gr.3 here 10 days ago. Is shod to preference however and will have his chances if he stays in stride
- **7. JUNE -** Sanctioned when preparing for this in a 2750m harness Class B at Ecommoy on 8 September. Is proven at a superior level and, given the chance, can redeem herself and impose
- **8. JAGUAR DU GOUTIER -** Unraced since finishing 9th of 11 in a 2875m Enghien harness Gr.3 early-July. Hind shoes off this time but others easier to back
- **9. JE REVE DU BOIS -** Nicely-entered and clearly in excellent condition, running 2nd of 7 in a 2850m harness Class A here on 7 September. Has nothing to prove under the saddle and, with application, can make this his own

Summary: Although seldom seen under the saddle, JE REVE DU BOIS (9) always runs on his merits and after producing an excellent effort in the other code last time out, he sports just front pads for the occasion and looks set to play a leading role. Alexandre Angot will still be keeping a watchful eye on the classy but tricky JUNE (7) who will be no soft touch if Mathieu Mottier can keep her trotting, and the ever-consistent JOKER DE FROULAY (4) who has been knocking at the door over recent months.

- **2. KEVIN PRINCE -** Went into his break on a good note and returned to competition mid-September, finishing runner-up to KARAMBAR (7) in a 2700m Class B here. Unlikely to impose but should nevertheless hold his own
- **3. KEEP SECRET -** Won 3 of last 4, latterly a 2175m Class C here, with consummate ease, on 6 September, and tackles a marginally tougher lot with a realistic chance of finishing close
- **4. KILL JOY LADY -** Flew up here only to be placed 2nd after an enquiry, but made amends a fortnight ago, dominating a 2700m Class B here, and must again be considered a serious proposition
- **5. KYOTO DIGEO -** Has not put a foot wrong for some time, coming 3rd of 10, on re-entry, in a 2825m Chartres Class B 3 weeks ago. Races barefoot on this occasion and is unlikely to be far off the mark
- **6. KARAKA WOOD -** Hard to knock lately, latterly headed in a 300om Borély Class B last Sunday. Has previously won over the main track but others preferred this time
- **7. KARAMBAR -** Made short work of a 2700m Class B here on 14 September. Has won 4 from 5 at Vincennes and is in with a realistic shout of pulling off the hat-trick
- **8. KATAR -** Unlucky 3rd of 9 in a 2875m Enghien Class B on 10 August. Has been afforded time to get back in shape and, already twice a winner at the venue, can add a 3rd victory to his tally

- **3. LOVER STILL -** Won 2 of last 4, latterly a Class E over course and distance, with ease, a month back. In better company this time but a similar performance would assure him the double
- **4. LIBRE PENSEUR MEEK -** Got back in the game here 2.5 weeks ago, coming 2nd of 10 in a 2100m Class C. Drawn decently and will not be sent out at 61/1 this time around
- **5. LEWIS RIVER -** Debuted nicely at Vincennes 10 days ago, coming 4th of 9 in a 2700m Class D. Enjoys a good draw in front and, even though stepping up in category, can still get in on the action
- **6. LUCKY JOSSELYN -** Runner-up in last 2, most recently a 2175m Class D here 3.5 weeks ago. Has a lot going for him here and must be taken more seriously on this occasion
- **7. LINDSTEDT -** Showed progress when 5th of 10, a place behind LIBRE PENSEUR MEEK (4), in a 2100m Class C 2.5 weeks ago. 4 pads fitted this time but still has ground to make up
- 8. LOIC BARON 3rd of 10, a place behind LIBRE PENSEUR MEEK (4), in a 2100m Class C 2.5 weeks ago. Forced to break wide but still has a reasonable chance of finishing in the mix
- **9. LOUPIAC DE GODREL -** 8th in race of reference before running 9th of 11 in a 2950m Toulouse Class B a fortnight ago, and can be confidently disregarded
- **10. LORD MIL** Acquitted himself well to finish close 2nd of 8 in a 2700m Class E, on Vincennes debut 2 weeks ago. In considerably better company this time and chances limited
- **11. LITTLEKING FOXGLEN -** Tricky character that won at Mauquenchy before faulting early in a 2600m Cherbourg Class B 9 days ago. Would have preferred a better draw and not an obvious choice
- **12. LORD DES FANES -** Debuts on main track after trotting 5th of 11 in a 2750m Cabourg Class D late-August. Fitted with 4 pads for the occasion but others still easier to back
- **13. LUTIN VENESI -** Useful sort making first appearance since coming 2nd of 8 in a 2500m Class D at La Rochelle early-August. Races shod, starts on back line, and cannot be considered a priority

Summary: Winner over course and distance at the first time of asking, LOVER STILL (3) takes a notable step up in category but still looks the pick of the field. Starting to his inside, the tricky LUGANO DE LOU (2) showed his form here recently before being sanctioned, and Alexandre Abrivard has good motivation to put things right. Reunited with Eric Raffin after winning at Reims last month, LE MAC (1) has not been handed the best of draws but still looks a player. Plainly close to his race, LUCKY JOSSELYN (6) finds himself well-positioned behind the car and David Thomain will be expected to capitalise.

- **3. ISLA MUJERES -** Drops back in category after finishing 5th of 12 in a 2750m Class D at La Capelle 11 days ago. Has placed just once in the amateur category but sports modified shoeing, has a good spot in front, and must be respected
- **4. HORACE DES CHAMPS -** Returns to France after trotting 5th of 7 over 2300m at Mons 9 days ago. Has a good spot behind the car and the addition of a talented driver will be a boost to his chances
- **5. GOSSIP BOY -** 8th of 12, behind ISLA MUJERES (3), in 2750m Class D at La Capelle 11 days ago. Shod to preference this time, with Barbara Guenet in the bike and, from the 5-spot can get in on the action
- **6. HATLAS DE MOUTIERS -** Has been showing his form over recent months, latterly 2nd of 7 over 2350m at home in Avenches on 11 September. Came close to opening his amateur account last time in the capital and has a realistic chance of winning this
- **7. GLAMOUR YOMA -** Finished 2nd of 11 in a 2450m Castillonnès Class F last Sunday. Boasts excellent references under these conditions and must be considered a player
- **8. HAPPY DJOB -** 11th of 12, on first start back, behind ISLA MUJERES (3), in 2750m Class D at La Capelle 11 days ago. Has other priorities and can be ignored
- **9. IVANA DE BERTRANGE -** Back in a category she enjoys after finishing 7th of 9, a place behind HORACE DES CHAMPS (4), in a 3150m Abbeville Class E early last month. Would have preferred a better draw but still looks dangerous
- **10. IQUITO PLANCHETTE -** Has enjoyed quite the renaissance since switching category, most recently winning a 2600m Cherbourg amateurs Class F with ease late last month and, despite the draw, can still impose
- **11. GANYMEDE DE DUSSAC -** Failed to confirm his Nort-sur-Erdre performance when trailing in last but one in a 2700m Segré Class F last weekend, and the draw only compounds matters
- **12. FIER D'ARS -** 8th of 10 in a 2400m Amiens amateurs Class G a fortnight ago and will again have nothing to offer
- **13. GENIALE STAR -** Corsican mare that came in last but one in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E mid-September. Faces a tough test here and is unlikely to cause an upset
- **14. GORLANDO LUDOIS -** 8th of 12 in a 2800m Class E at Villedieu-les-Poëles mid-September. Has placed just once in 4 at this level, and even the shoeing change is unlikely to help his cause

Summary: Close 2nd at Enghien on his most recent amateur exploit, HATLAS DE MOUTIERS (6) returns to France in excellent form, barefoot, and is sufficiently well-positioned to win this. IQUITO PLANCHETTE (10), something of a 'superstar' in this category, has not been as fortunate with the draw but boasts an excellent record with his amateur and will be no pushover.
