- **3. MADNESS -** Progressive trotter with untapped potential but the form and experience to acquit herself competitively finished 3rd over 2200m at this venue on 23 November. Not taken lightly
- **4. MAGIC AMERICA -** Progressive filly, unbeaten in 3 starts each victory more impressive than the last. Completed the hat-trick here over 2700m on 4 December and could make sufficient progress to remain undefeated this is her acid test!
- **5. MASINA DE TILLARD -** Lost her unbeaten record last time (start #4) in a 27000m Group II at this venue last month missed the start that day but shouldn't be hastily condemned for that 15 December failure. Keep safe
- **6. GEILES LEBEN HOME -** Consistent Italian filly with solid form references/credentials, including a last-start 3rd in a 2100m Group I at Milan on 14 December. Not taken lightly
- **7. MONEGASQUE -** Delicate filly with undeniable means and sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 3rd in a Group II at this venue over 2700m on 15 December. Dark horse

- **3. ELAND -** Complicated trotter, seldom far from a fault although usually acquits himself competitively when applied/remaining wise confirmed as much by finishing 2nd in a Quionte+ over track and trip on 25 December. Confirmation required
- **4. THE LION -** Consistent Scandinavian trotter confirmed under these conditions/in this configuration with sound form references, including a last-start 3rd in a course-and-distance Quinte+ event on 25 December. Not taken lightly
- **5. ERNESTO ROC -** Complicated trotter with sound references, though seldom far from a fault. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 8th in a 2850m harness event on 22 November dark horse
- **6. CAVIAR FROM MINE -** Last-start winner (shod) over 2140m at Romme on 16 December. Not taken lightly in his first start on French soil with all 4 shoes removed
- **7. NELSON GREENWOOD -** Sparked improvement when finishing 4th over 2600m at Wolvega on 20 December. More needed but it's encouraging that his shoes are removed
- **8. EXPRESS D'ARC -** Back to his best recently, winning consecutive Vincennes appearances under these/similar conditions the latest in a course-and-distance Quinte+ event on 25 December. The hat-trick beckons

Summary: EXPRESS D'ARC (8) has looked better than ever recently, winning back-to-back starts at this venue. He's taken to continue his momentum by completing his hat-trick at the expense of KEVISAN (10), who leads the opposition ahead of ELAND (3), runner-up to the selection here on Christmas Day, and KAZAR (11). With Eric Raffin at the helm, UNDERGROUND ARTIST (12) isn't taken lightly in his first start on French soil.

- **3. LISBONNE DRY -** Delicate filly with undeniable means and references at the highest level, including a last-start 3rd in the Group I Prix de Vincennes over track and trip on 15 December. Unshod for the first time, she can fight for victory if remaining wise
- **4. LAMBADA DU GOUTIER -** Runner-up in a 2450m Group I event at Caen in October so shouldn't be hastily condemned for a subsequent failure (disqualification) in a course-and-distance Group II event on 30 October. Not taken lightly on her reappearance
- **5. LONG ISLAND -** Versatile filly with the form and experience in both trotting categories to play a leading role. Did well to finish 5th in consecutive Group races recently, the latest in a course-and-distance Group I event on 15 December on the shortlist

- **3. HEDIC GEMA -** Reliable veteran hard-knocker with undeniable means the form and experience to play a leading role. Finished 3rd over 2925m at Cagnes in a 2925m Group III event on 21 December
- **4. HIDALGO DES NOES -** Bounced back to form with a reassuring 3rd in a 2175m Group III harness event on 11 December. Not taken lightly
- **5. CASH BANK BIGI -** Experienced Italian mare, a regular at this level although out of sorts at present unplaced (7th) in a 2850m Quinte+ at this venue on 15 December. For another day

- **3. LONDON -** Delicate but usually acquits herself competitively when applied/remaining wise confirmed as much by finishing 2nd in her last 3 completed starts, twice at Group II level (runner-up in a 2175m Group II here on 25 October). Dark horse
- **4. L'AMOURPOURBLANCA -** Classy Scandinavian trotter who was soundly beaten (9th) in a 2100m Group I at this venue on 8 December. Others preferred
- **5. LITTLE BROWN -** Complicated colt but has undeniable means and sound references/form credentials at this level. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 8th in a 2100m Group I at this venue on 8 December

- **10. KATYLAND -** Delicate mare with sound form references/credentials, though seldom far from faulting. Disqualified in consecutive recent starts here (the latest on 14 December) but shouldn't be hastily condemned question of wisdom
- **11. KIWA BLEUE -** Unplaced in both comeback outings after an absence of 4 months soundly beaten (14th) at this venue over 2100m on 6 December. Shouldn't be underestimated and a better showing is expected, especially under these conditions
- **12. KHALEESI D'ALESA -** Complicated mare with sound references/form credentials although seldom far from a fault these days disqualified in consecutive Vincennes appearances before a reassuring 6th (shod) over 2150m at Enghien on 9 October. Outsider
- **13. KELLE STAR DI PAO -** Inconsistent but not devoid of ability has references at this level in this barefoot configuration, including an Enghien 3rd over 2875m on 13 July. Absent since finishing 7th at Enghien over 2150m on 31 July
- **14. KISS ME BEJI -** Runner-up in 2 of her last 3 starts, the latest on this course over 2700m on 18 December, so wouldn't be winning out of turn. Candidate for success

15. KARINA STEED - Unplaced (twice) and disqualified in 3 comeback appearances after a 3-month absence, though didn't go unnoticed when finishing 7th in a course-and-distance event on 29 November. Not taken lightly with all 4 shoes removed

Summary: A toss-up between the top 2 picks KAMBRIA JOSSELYN (7), fully unshod, and KISS ME BEJI (14), runner-up in consecutive recent outings. KAROLENE D'ETANG (4) and KARINA STEED (15) also have the means to play leading roles, while KIWA BLEUE (11) and Marc Sassier's duo of KOH LANTA (6) and KATYLAND (10) are competitive for the minor positions.

- **1. LUGANO DE LOU -** Experienced colt whose form and experience will stand him in good stead here, especially from a favourable starting position. Finished 6th in back-to-back Vincennes appearances recently, the latest (2175m) on 13 December beware!
- **2. LATINOS DU NOYER -** Complicated colt disqualified in his last 4 starts, including 3 consecutive recent Vincennes appearances the latest on 28 December over 2100m. Others preferred
- **3. LARABELLO DE LOU -** Delicate trotter with undeniable means seldom far from a fault, though usually acquits himself competitively when remaining wise. Disqualified in consecutive recent starts (latest at this venue on 13 December), all or nothing
- **4. LOUSTIC D'YVEL -** Tricky customer but not devoid of ability won here over 2200m last month so shouldn't be hastily condemned for a subsequent failure (disqualification) on 28 December, especially with all 4 shoes removed for the first time. Beware
- **5. LEZZO FIGHTER -** Promising trotter with undeniable means and scope for improvement won 3 of his 4 starts before faulting behind the autostart in a 2100m event here on 7 December. Deserves another chance and is taken to set the record straight
- **6. LATINO PURA VIDA -** Unreliable colt at fault in 2 of his last 3 starts, the latest on this course over 2100m on 28 December. For another day
- **7. LOUSTIC DELAURIERE -** Experienced colt with sound references/form credentials, albeit at a lower level. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 10th in a course-and-distance event on 18 December after a 3-month absence open to improvement racing unshod
- **8. LUCKY LOVE -** Experienced colt with sound references at this level, albeit without success (12-start maiden). Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th over 2100m at this venue on 28 December
- **9. LENNON D'HERFRAIE -** Unexposed colt with undeniable means and room for improvement shouldn't be hastily condemned for his failure (12th) in a 2850m Group III here on 1 December. Respected with all 4 shoes removed for the first time
- **10. LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE -** Tricky customer undeniable means and sound references/form credentials but seldom far from a fault. Disqualified in consecutive recent starts here (latest on 18 December) but respected with Eric Raffin engaged and shoes removed
- **11. LUGANO -** Regaining momentum after a 5-month absence and finished a reassuring 4th here on 28 December over 2100m. More needed
- **12. LOVELY TRIP -** Complicated colt disqualified in 4 of his last 5 starts, including consecutive recent outings at this venue the latest on 28 December over 2100m. Question of wisdom
- **13. L'AMIRAL GAGNANT -** Delicate but undeniably capable trotter with sound references/form credentials never finished worse than 4th in his 6 completed races (10 appearances). Shouldn't be hastily condemned for his disqualification here on 28 December
- **14. LISTER VEDAQUAIS -** Weakened late after an unfavourable trip to finish unplaced (8th) in a course-and-distance event on 18 December but is better than that performance suggests. Could make amends with all 4 shoes removed for the first time keep safe

15. LUDO PAROYO - Progressive trotter with consistent form references/credentials, including a last-start 2nd at this venue over 2175m on 13 December. Not taken lightly

Summary: LEZZO FIGHTER (5) blotted his copybook when galloping behind the autostart last time but this looks a good opportunity for him to gain compensation. Barefoot rivals LISTER VEDAQUAIS (14), LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE (10) and stablemate LENNON D'HERFRAIE (9), and LUDO PAROYO (15) are open to improvement in their lightened configurations, so they aren't taken lightly. LUGANO DE LOU (1) and LOUSTIC DELAURIERE (7) appeal most of the remainder.
