- **4. MISS LADY D'ALESA -** Improved to finish a career-best 2nd in a course-and-distance event on 26 December. Confirmation is expected
- **5. MISTER BARRA -** Impressive debut winner over 2200m at Salon-de-Provence on 24 November. Would've gained from that experience and is open to any amount of improvement
- **6. MIAMI DREAM -** Delicate filly with undeniable means and sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 6th in a stronger race at Vincennes over 2175m on 6 December. Question of wisdom
- **7. MISTER D'ECROVILLE -** Debut winner on this course over 2925m on 14 December but showed enough speed that day to suggest that this shorter distance won't trouble him. Could pay to follow his progress
- **8. MAJESTUEUSE -** Confirmed the promise of her debut 2nd over 2400m by finishing 3rd over 2300m at Marseille-Borely on 2 December. Not taken lightly
- **9. MARIA DE VALNY -** Improved to finish 4th in back-to-back recent starts, the latest at this venue in a course-and-distance race on 26 December
- **10. MY GIRL -** Debut 4th over 2725m at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 8 December. Open to improvement but will find this tougher
- **11. MADE IN GEDE -** Disqualified on debut in a 2925 harness race at this venue on 14 December but didn't go unnoticed. Would've gained from that experience
- **12. MIDNIGHT MELODY -** Runner-up on debut at Chartres in November but unplaced in subsequent starts, finished 8th on both occasions latest at this venue in a course-and-distance race on 26 December. Others preferred
- **13. MALIBU -** Disqualified in all 3 appearances, the latest over 2750m at Cabourg on 7 December. Hard to make a case for
- **14. MACARENA D'HOULBEC -** Soundly beaten (10th) on debut over 2400m at Marseille-Borely on 2 October. Open to improvement on her reappearance but best watched for now
- **15. MA COPINE FLAC -** Caught the eye on debut when finishing 2nd behind MISTER D'ECROVILLE (7) on this track over 2925m on 14 December. Keep safe
- **16. MAMBA DES DURIEZ -** Inconsistent but not devoid of ability twice 3rd (4 starts) but finished a disappointing 8th over 2300m at Marseille-Borely on 2 December. Remains open to improvement

Summary: Debut winners MISTER D'ECROVILLE (7) and MISTER BARRA (5) make obvious appeal and will logically be prominent in the betting exchanges. However, preference is for the former who scored at this venue first-up and that track experience should stand him in good stead. MAURICIEN (1) and MIAMI DREAM (6) have shown enough to play leading roles, which can also be said of last-start scorer MAC KINLEY (2) and MATIGNON (3), runner-up in consecutive outings and likely to open his account sooner rather than later.
