- **2. GOLDEN BROWN -** Confirmed the promise of his debut 3rd at Chantilly in July by improving to finish 2nd at Deauville (6 August), both races over 1400m. Will relish the extra 200m
- **3. MERANO -** Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th on debut at Dieppe over 1400m on 21 August. Would've gained from that experience
- **4. AL AALI -** Caught the eye when finishing 3rd on debut over 1600m at Deauville on 10 August. Will know more about it

He ought to have come on with the benefit of that experience and should appreciate this longer distance. However, the same could be said of CHAUNCEY GARDINER (7) whose 2nd in a coveted 1500m newcomers' at Deauville was very encouraging. GOLDEN BROWN (2), who has finished on the podium in both starts over 1400m, and Godolphin's GREEN CAPE (5), having finished 4th in both 1400m appearances, will also benefit from the extra 200m.

Summary: YOGA MASTER (3) has finished 2nd twice in as many outings on this course. She confirmed the promise of her 1200m debut when touched off over 1400m last time and should go one better if making any improvement going a mile. CHAMPAGNE DANCER (2), a good 2nd on debut in a lucrative sales race at Deauville, is co-owner Davy Bonilla's first runner as a trainer and she ought to fight for victory with progress expected given the benefit of that experience. HOT AND BEAUTY (4) has sufficient means to make her presence felt, while newcomer GINGER ALE (6) is another to consider.
