R1 VINCENNES [L-H]

C1 - PRIX CONCORDIA - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders Race - Mounted - EUR € 47,000

- 1. GAROU BEJI** - Won 4 from 6 before finishing 9th of 11 in a 2550m Les Andelys amateurs Class F last Saturday. Can put that run behind him and, although not a priority, must still be respected
- 2. HERMINE DU GUELIER** - Reassured at Saint-Jean-de-Monts before finishing 6th of 12 to GUELIZ (4) in a 2750m Pornichet Class E mid-August, and will struggle to repeat
- 3. HOUARNEAU** - Sanctioned when being conditioned for this in a 2850m Carentan Class F 3 weeks ago. Appreciates Vincennes, seldom disappoints when focused, and can trot his way into the frame
- 4. GUELIZ** - Won a 2750m Pornichet Class E mid-August, first time under the saddle and, if not a flash in the pan, can repeat
- 5. HETRE CHANGEEN** - 3rd to HANIELLE CREPIN (10) at Pornichet before coming 7th of 14, when preparing for this in a 2650m Laval harness Class D on 25 August. In 'competition-mode' this time and will be no easy touch
- 6. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS** - Has been alternating well between both codes, most recently 4th of 15 in a 2950m Vichy harness Class E 10 days ago. Unlikely to win this but can still make his presence felt at the reckoning
- 7. HELIUM DE L'ITON** - Honest type that blew it when faulting at the start, coming last of 9 in a 2750m Cabourg Class E a fortnight ago, but should not be far from the action if Louis Lorent gets him off on the right foot
- 8. GOUNIT DE L'AIROU** - Switches back to the code in which he has never disappointed [runner-up in both starts], after coming 3rd of 15 in a 2800m Castéra-Verduzan harness Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Not a priority but worth keeping an eye on
- 9. GIBOLE DE L'ELLE** - Oddly below-par in a 2750m Cabourg Class F early-July. Has had time to freshen up though and, barefoot this time, should not be entirely overlooked
- 10. HANIELLE CREPIN** - Made it 2 on the trot when successful in a 2725m Pornichet Class D early last month. Will appreciate the inner-track profile and can make this her own
- 11. FOSTER DE L'ITON** - Last of 10 when being conditioned in a 3450m Agon-Coutainville Class F late-July. Will be fully fit, races barefoot for first objective of the season, and can make a big splash
- 12. FERIA DE LIGNY** - Makes first public appearance under the saddle after trotting 10th of 15 in a 2100m Class E here last Saturday, and is not about to cause an upset

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Summary: A revelation since switching yards, HANIELLE CREPIN (10) has been entrusted to Théo Raffin for the occasion and has every chance of pulling off the hat-trick. That said, GUELIZ (4) left quite the impression on his recent monté debut and is not incapable of repeating. HETRE CHANGEEN (5) ran 3rd to the favourite in mid-July and with front pads fitted this time, will be more competitive. HOUARNEAU (3) has never disappointed over the inner track and will justifiably garner support.

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**C2 - PRIX ADELINDA - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR €
59,000**

- 1. IN LOVE DE JIEL** - Produced his 2nd victory of the summer 2.5 weeks ago, winning a 2550m Cherbourg Class E with ease. Has never delivered over 2850m on the main track but in current condition must be retained
- 2. IVOIRE PRESTANCE** - Sanctioned in a valuable 2350m affair at Waregem 10 days ago. Is not without merit but is being aimed too high this time
- 3. IACYNTHE DIDJEAP** - Won over 2875m at Enghien on 20 July before trotting 5th, a place behind INDUS VAL (7) in a 2150m Class B at the same venue on 8 August. Is not about to open his Vincennes account but will still be competitive for a place in the frame
- 4. INSTRUCTOR** - 5th of 9 in a 3150m Class E at La Roche-Posay early last month. Is starting to come good again and looks a reasonable first-5 chance
- 5. IGUANE DE CAPONET** - Performant type returning to the capital on a hat-trick, latterly winning a 2150m Mauquenchy Class E in late-July. Sports a new formula and will take some beating
- 6. IGO CLEA** - Has not been seen out since finishing 6th of 11 in a 2175m monté Class D here late-April. Has bags of talent but stays shod and will need the run
- 7. INDUS VAL** - Quality element that ran 4th of 13 in a 2150m Enghien Class B a month ago. Is plainly close to winning another this summer and is unlikely to let the side down
- 8. INTOUCHABLE** - Reassuring 6th, a place behind INSTRUCTOR (4), in a 3150m Class E at La Roche-Posay early last month. Shod differently this time and others easier to back
- 9. FELINE DE MIRANDA** - 5th of 11 in a 2775m Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne 2 weeks ago. Always gives her best but has more to find this time around
- 10. GUI D'ERABLE** - Serious sort that made it 2 straight sanctions after faulting in a 2700m Graignes Class D on 1 August. Has previously won under these conditions and is not to be underestimated
- 11. IWAY** - Good class of trotter that finished last of 10 in a 2500m Class D at La Rochelle late-July, on first appearance for 22 months. Sports a proven configuration and we can expect to see a different side. Chance

Summary: An exceptional servant when fit and focused, the newly-configured IGUANE DE CAPONET (5) takes on his elders this time but in present shape, looks the obvious candidate for success. Well-entered at the limit of earnings, IWAY (11) is competitively-shod for just his 2nd appearance following a long hiatus and, if fully-fit, can give the favourite something to think about. INDUS VAL (7) finished ahead of IACYNTHE DIDJEAP (3) at Enghien early last month but Benjamin Rochard's charge will be expected to turn the tables.

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C3 - PRIX CAMILLE DE WAZIERES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Gr2 Race - Mounted - EUR € 120,000

- 1. KADANSE DU CORTA** - Sanctioned in a 2175m Class C here last Friday. Has evident talent but recent results do little to inspire confidence
- 2. KASBAH PERRINE** - Takes a big step up in class after coming 4th of 7 in a 2175m Class C here a week ago, and will have little to contribute
- 3. KANTHABELLA** - Disappointing this summer, most recently 6th of 7 in a 2875m Enghien Class D early last month, and must get her house in order
- 4. KAYA DREAM** - Back under the saddle after coming last but one in a 2875m Enghien harness Class B on 10 August. Is far from replicating last season's form, but racing barefoot could make all the difference
- 5. KALIF LANDIA** - Classy colt that would have finished close to KYRIELLE DES VAUX (9) in Prix du Président had he stayed trotting. Form is not in question and Benjamin Rochard will be loathe to let the same thing happen again. Chance
- 6. KAPAULA DE L'EPINE** - Steps back up in class after running 2nd of 6 in a 2175m Gr.3 here 3 weeks ago. Has yet to win in the day's formula but, with morale restored, is unlikely to be far off the mark
- 7. KELLY DE BANVILLE** - Won 2 straight Gr.2's before running 2nd to KYRIELLE DES VAUX (9) in Gr.1 Prix du Président over 2850m here on 23 June. Has nothing to prove under these conditions and is a serious proposition
- 8. KYT KAT** - Last of 9 when prepping for this in a 2175m Vincennes harness Gr.2 3 weeks ago. Reverts to a proven configuration and will be competitive for a spot on the podium
- 9. KYRIELLE DES VAUX** - Has not been seen out since winning Gr.1 Prix du Président over 2850m here on 23 June. Will have been prepared for this and, shod to preference, can impose

Summary: Simply magnificent in the Gr.1 Prix du Président de la République in late-June, KYRIELLE DES VAUX (9) has since been given time to recuperate and, in similar form, can double her money. Sanctioned that day, when competitive for the win, a shod KALIF LANDIA (5) will be a tough nut to crack if he stays trotting, as will KELLY DE BANVILLE (7) who finished runner-up that day.

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C4 - PRIX BRUNA - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. JOSHUA PEJI** - Has looked more composed this season, most recently 2nd [despite faulting early] to JAGUAR DE LAUMAC (8) in a 2700m Class E here a fortnight ago, but looks better prospect of the 2 on this occasion
- 2. JERZINO VICI** - Sanctioned in 3 of last 4, latterly a 2100m Class D here late-August. Sports pads this time though, with JMB reining, and should not be written off
- 3. JORIA MESLOISE** - 2nd of 13 in a 2775m Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne 2 months ago. Comes here fresh, has form under these conditions, but nevertheless faces a stiff test
- 4. JASMINE D'OUILLY** - 6th behind JEREMY D'AS (11), at 132/1, in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class D mid-August, but a repeat looks decidedly unlikely
- 5. JOCKEY** - Reassured at Meslay before coming 10th of 13 in a 2750m Cabourg Class D 2 weeks ago. Reverts to a previous configuration but others still easier to back
- 6. JOYEUX NONNA** - Made up for Cabourg performance when 4th of 11 in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Sports 4 pads for first time and although not a contender, will still be worth monitoring
- 7. JOYAU JICEE** - Useful type making first appearance since running 2nd of 12 in a 2700m Class D here 5 months ago and is sure to need the outing
- 8. JAGUAR DE LAUMAC** - Not once out of first 4 in last 8 starts, most recently winning a Class E over 2700m here on 24 August, and will again be competitive for a place in the frame
- 9. JIRENZO** - Confirmed his Enghien performance when 5th of 13 in a 2700m Class D at La Capelle 10 days ago, but represents a minor place chance at best
- 10. JONAGOLD** - Disappointing 5th of 6 in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 18 August. Is proven at the venue and looks a respectable first-5 chance
- 11. JEREMY D'AS** - 2nd of 10 in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class D mid-August. Is hard to knock when barefoot and will not be far from the action if he takes to the new profile
- 12. JAZZY FLIGNY** - Was enjoying a fine run of form before faulting in a 2775m Craon Class D on Monday. Is clearly in shape but would be preferred on turf
- 13. JOY JENILOU** - Sanctioned when en route to finishing 3rd in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 18 August. Has solid Vincennes credentials and will be dangerous if Gabi Gelormini keeps her trotting
- 14. JOUR DE GLOIRE** - Has not been seen out since finishing last but one in a 2775m Craon Class D on 23 June. Shoes on and no threat
- 15. JET SET** - Returns to racing left-handed after coming 11th of 13 in a 2750m Cabourg Class D 2 weeks ago. Is barefoot with Alexandre Abrivard in the bike and, already a course-and-distance winner, must be afforded respect
- 16. JUPITER DU CORTA** - Sanctioned in a 2775m Craon Class D last Monday on first start for 3 months. Boasts an excellent Vincennes record and can get straight back down to business

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Summary: Well-engaged at the limit of earnings, JUPITER DU CORTA (16) has one conditioner under his belt and, barefoot as he was when imposing here 3 months ago, looks the pick of the field. It is unlikely to be all plain sailing though given how well JOSHUA PEJI (1) has been racing this summer. JAGUAR DE LAUMAC (8) has been a model of consistency this year and steps up in category with a realistic chance of finishing close. JEREMY D'AS (11) has been knocking at the door since the spring and will have his moment in the sun one day soon.

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C5 - PRIX BAPTISTINA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. IPIPOURAX PAULOIS** - Produced a good effort at Pornichet early-August but quickly sanctioned in a 2650m Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne 9 days ago. Form is not in doubt though and will not be far off the mark if Damien Bonne keeps him trotting
- 2. ILIO MANNETOT** - Took no time getting back in shape following the break, latterly 2nd of 13 in a 2725m Pornichet Class F last week. No fan of Vincennes but in present shape is very easy to like
- 3. IVALO DU BOCAGE** - 8th of 10 on comeback in a 3025m Montier-en-Der Class F on 18 August. Goes barefoot this time but is frequently too spirited to warrant much support
- 4. INTELLO D'ERABLE** - Left quite the impression to win a 2750m Cabourg Class E 3 weeks ago. Better racing clockwise but is barefoot again and must not be underestimated
- 5. INEDIT DU PAVILLON** - Looked ordinary when 7th of 12 in a 2600m Plouescat Class F mid-August. Benjamin Rochard reining but still not a priority
- 6. ISSI TOP** - Went into his spell on a high note and returned 12 days ago, coming 4th of 11 in a 2625m Saint-Omer Class F. Respectable in 2 of 4 at the venue but still not an obvious choice
- 7. INDIGO DE NAPPES** - Back at the top of his game this summer, most recently 2nd of 11 finishers in a 2675m Class F at Divonne-les-Bains 3.5 weeks ago. In better company this time but is still capable of holding his own
- 8. IVAN DE L'ERDRE** - In the frame in last 3, most recently runner-up to IVORINO D'ECHAL (15) in a 2775m Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 21 August, and can again finish close
- 9. ILLICO D'AMOUR** - Not quite as sharp as he was earlier in the year, latterly 5th of 14 in a 2800m Langon Class G on 18 July. Has freshness on his side but still no more than a minor place prospect
- 10. IRMA DU VIVIER** - Last of 8, on return from a layoff, in a 2775m Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne 2 weeks ago. Is still being conditioned and best to wait
- 11. ILARIA KILY** - Has come off the boil somewhat, latterly 9th of 11 in a 2600m Cherbourg Class F 2.5 weeks ago, and will first need to re-establish her credentials
- 12. IXTREM D'OURVILLE** - Reassuring 3rd of 8 in a 2800m Strasbourg Class E last week. Regularly in the thick of things when focused but cannot be considered a player this time around
- 13. IN RACE LORRAINE** - Has hardly put a foot wrong over past 4 months, most recently 3rd of 8 in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle 10 days ago. Is proven at Vincennes but others still easier to back
- 14. IMANOLO DE LOU** - 5th of 8 to IVORINO D'ECHAL (15) in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class E 3.5 weeks ago. Front shoes off this time and will be competitive for a place in first 5
- 15. IVORINO D'ECHAL** - Has looked a different horse since moving yards, most recently securing the hat-trick in a 2775m Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 21 August. Reunited with Matthieu Abrivard and will be expected to maintain his fruitful streak

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Summary: It may have taken some time but IVORINO D'ECHAL (15) has started to deliver for his new trainer and, already a winner under these conditions, can pull off the 4-timer. He will nonetheless come under pressure from ILIO MANNETOT (2) who is plainly close to his race, and INTELLO D'ERABLE (4) who won smartly at Cabourg 3 weeks ago. IVAN DE L'ERDRE (8) has been lurking and makes his Vincennes debut with legitimate aspiration.

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**C6 - PRIX KLYMENE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR €
40,000**

- 1. KUNZITE D'EM** - Sanctioned in a 2700m Class D at La Capelle 10 days ago and has nothing to contribute
- 2. KIRENE FLASH** - Briefly lost her way before getting back in the game, latterly winning a 2650m Pornichet Class E a fortnight ago, and looks main threat to KEEP ON ROLLING (13)
- 3. KINO DAB** - Pleasant 5th of 11, a place behind KAPUCINE ZEN (7), on first start back, in a 2100m Class D here 2 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run and is unlikely to go home empty-handed
- 4. KOMREEVEE DIESCHOOT** - Made up for her Pornichet sanction when successful in a 2800m Strasbourg Class E last week, but faces a stiffer test this time around
- 5. KIRA DE CAHOT** - Sanctioned at Cabourg before finishing 8th of 10 in a 2150m Enghien Class D on 24 July. Comes here fresh but others still preferred
- 6. KULTA** - Convincingly won a 2700m Class D at La Capelle 10 days ago when reunited with Franck Nivard, but a repeat seems unlikely
- 7. KAPUCINE ZEN** - Has never disappointed when barefoot, most recently 4th of 11 in a 2100m Class D here a fortnight ago, and is capable of playing another active role
- 8. KARLITA MADRIK** - Sanctioned when preparing for this in a 2775m Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne late last month and, even with hind shoes off, will have few friends
- 9. KANELLE DE TILLARD** - Quality element going barefoot for the first time after finishing last of 9 when preparing for this in a Class D under these conditions 2.5 weeks ago. Not a priority but is one to keep an eye on
- 10. KADIJA MESLOISE** - Not without merit and has won over course and distance, but 3 straight sanctions do little to inspire confidence
- 11. KALINKA MOYA** - 3rd of 9 in a Class D over course and distance on 21 August. Takes on a better bunch this time though and chances limited
- 12. KALITY LOVE** - Close 2nd of 9 finishers in a 2050m Cabourg Class D 2 weeks ago. Seldom seen left-handed but in current condition is very easy to like for a step on the podium
- 13. KEEP ON ROLLING** - Made it 2 wins on the trot when dominating a 2750m Cabourg Class E 3.5 weeks ago. Flopped on lone appearance here but looks the one to beat this time around
- 14. KWINIE JIHAIME** - 5th of 11, at 122/1, in a 2875m Enghien Class D mid-August but confirmation seems improbable
- 15. KATIA DHELPA** - Missed out by little in a 2775m Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne late last month. Hind shoes off and will not be available at 89/1 on this occasion
- 16. KIM DE BEAUM** - Significantly better horse than her 6th of 11 in a 2875m Enghien Class D mid-August would suggest. Races first time barefoot and the change of driver may be just the ticket to her redemption

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Summary: KEEP ON ROLLING (13) may not be the simplest of horses but her ability has been very much in evidence recently and, barefoot at Vincennes for the first time, can pull off the 3-timer. David Thomain will unsurprisingly be keeping a watchful eye on the reinvigorated KIRENE FLASH (2) who has been entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard for the first time, and the superbly-engaged, and barefoot, KIM DE BEAUM (16) who is reunited with JMB who has already won with her. Like a horse reborn since starting to race barefoot, KIRENE FLASH (2) is plainly close to her race and must be respected.

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**C7 - PRIX BELISANA - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR €
46,000**

1. KOLDPLAY - Makes first appearance since faulting in a 2700m Class A here late-January. Hind shoes off for re-entry but will still need the run

2. KANDEL DE BEYLEV - Good 2nd to KAMIKAZE DU CAMPUS (4) in a 2700m Class D here on 26 August. Is untried over 2175m here but appreciates the Vincennes profile and can challenge for a place in the frame

3. KIR NORMAND - Placed in 2 before flopping to 10th of 11 in a 2875m Enghien Class C on 24 July. Has had to time to get his act together and will be expected to show a more competitive side

4. KAMIKAZE DU CAMPUS - Convincing winner of a 2700m Class D here 11 days ago. Appreciates Vincennes and Benjamin Rochard will be legitimately eyeing the double

5. KATIM DU GOUTIER - Rather disappointing of late, latterly last of 8 in a 2850m Class C here last Saturday, and can be passed over

6. KEEP SECRET - Facile winner of a 2050m Cabourg Class D 3 weeks ago. Ran 3rd over course and distance earlier in the summer and, barefoot as he was when imposing at Royan, will be no soft touch

7. KRAKEN CASTELETS - Has not been seen out since coming 3rd of 7 finishers in a 2700m Class B here late-May. Drops marginally in category, is proven over 2175m here, and with Gabi Gelormini reining, can continue his productive ways. Minor place chance

8. KENO PETTEVINIERE - Lacklustre 7th of 9 in a 2875m Enghien Class B on 10 August. Takes a dip in category but still appears to have too much to do

9. KIWI DE TREMONT - Quickly sanctioned in a 2150m Argentan Class D early last month, but nevertheless showed his form. Seldom disappoints at Vincennes and Anthony Barrier will be keen to set the record straight

Summary: A fine colt that has really come into himself this summer, KAMIKAZE DU CAMPUS (4) made up for his Enghien blip with an easy success over 2700m here late last month, and can double up. That said, KEEP SECRET (6) has won 2 of his last 3, latterly with room to spare, and looks the principal danger. Impressive after being sanctioned at Argentan early last month, KIWI DE TREMONT (9) enjoys a very good entry and, with application, can go far.

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C8 - PRIX INO - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- 1. LYSANDRA** - Got off the mark at Guerlesquin before coming a respectable 5th of 8 in a 2150m Argentan Class E early last month, and the addition of pads can make all the difference. Chance
- 2. LEGENDE DU LOISIR** - Improving filly that faulted early in a 2050m Cabourg Class E 10 days ago. Benefits from a good engagement though and, with application, can bring the fight to LATINA QUICK (3)
- 3. LATINA QUICK** - Untroubled winner of a 2850m Carentan Class F mid-August. Steps up in category but is ideally-positioned behind the car and can make it 3 on the trot
- 4. LADY DALM** - Has gone from strength to strength, most recently opening her account in a 2750m Class F at La Ferté-Vidame a month ago. In superior company this time but Anthony Barrier is reigning and, from the 4-spot, can get in on the action
- 5. LEELEY DE BLARY** - 2nd of 9 in a 2200m Agon-Coutainville Class F 11 days ago. Nicely-placed in front and, even sporting front pads, looked no more than a minor place chance
- 6. LLUVIA DU HOULBET** - Steps up in category after coming 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2475m Royan Class E early-August. On front row, with hind pads fitted, and will generate some interest
- 7. LANA DE BEAUMEE** - Unexceptional filly that finished a trounced 7th of 10 in a 2150m Enghien Class E 8 days ago and can be ruled out
- 8. LEEDS** - Won at Agon early-August, followed by 3rd of 9 in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Gets on well with François Lagadeuc and will not be going home empty-handed
- 9. LYNDA CASTEL** - Has not been seen out since faulting, when full of running, in a 2200m Class D here on 11 June. No pads this time around but is still capable of defying the draw and playing a prominent part
- 10. LUNA BLANCA** - 5th of 9 behind LEEDS (8) in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago, but still has more to find
- 11. LOVE ME JIVE** - Sanctioned in 4 of 6, most recently a 2650m Vertou Class F late last month, and can be confidently passed over
- 12. LILY BECO** - Last but one in a 2050m Cabourg Class E 10 days ago. 4 pads fitted this time but still not an obvious choice
- 13. LUNE DE JERSOP** - Got off the mark in a 2850m Class F at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne on 25 August but, at this level, has no possible chance

Summary: Facile winner of both racecourse appearances to date, LATINA QUICK (3) moves to a hard surface, sports 4 pads for the first time, and has every chance of maintaining her perfect record. There will still be opposition from the on-form LEGENDE DU LOISIR (2), provided Yoann Lebourgeois assures her initial strides, and the promising LYSANDRA (1) who has 4 pads fitted for her first left-handed start. Solid at Cherbourg after having opened her account 10 days earlier, LEEDS (8) starts wide but sports front pads, and must be taken seriously.
