- **1. LITTLE DREAM D'ERI -** Disqualified in his first 3 appearances and unplaced in both subsequent/completed starts, the latest (7th) at Cagnes over 2925m on 18 December. Improvement needed
- **2. LOVE D'AMOUR -** Disqualified for the 6th time in 7 appearances (all shod) in his last start at Beaumont on 20 December. Retains undeniable ability and may well confirm as much lightened in his shoeing (barefoot) for the first time all or nothing with him!
- **3. LANCIA DE LOU -** Complicated filly disqualified in 4 consecutive starts (latest at Vichy on 20 June) after a pleasing debut 3rd at Carpentras in late April. One to note on her reappearance
- **4. LAIKA DE L'ISOP -** Caught the eye (2nd) on debut at Vichy in May 2023 but finished unplaced in both subsequent appearances latest (6th) at Montauban over 2400m on 29 December resuming after a 6-month absence. Not taken lightly with improvement expected
- **5. LETOILE AMERICAINE -** Complicated filly with undeniable means disqualified in 7 of her 12 outings, though usually acquits herself competitively when applied/remaining wise. Didn't go unnoticed (5th) at Cagnes on 23 December and races unshod for the first time
- **6. LITTLE ATOUT -** Delicate but not devoid of ability. Disqualified in 6 of 9 appearances, including 3 consecutive recent outings the latest on 22 December at this configuration at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 22 December
- **7. LEA DANSE -** Caught the eye with a fast-finishing 3rd at Bordeaux over 2650m on 17 December and will be competitive for the leading positions with a repeat of that performance. Keep safe
- **8. LOVE METHOD -** Complicated trotter with undeniable means seldom far from a fault, though usually acquits herself competitively when applied/remaining wise. Returned to form with a reassuring 3rd over 2725m at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 22 December
- **9. LA DIVINE DU PARCQ -** Experienced 18-start maiden with sound references, albeit without success (seldom finishes far off the mark). Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th over 2725m at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 22 December
- **10. LUSTY -** Delicate and seldom far from a fault disqualified in 3 of his last 6 appearances, including his latest in this configuration at Montauban on 29 December. Others preferred
- **11. LITTLE KING ELEVEN -** Made amends for his 11 November Saint-Galmier failure (disqualification) by winning at Grenade-sur-Garonne last month over 2725m (on 22 December). Needn't improve much in this configuration unshod for the first time to win again
- **12. LICORNE DU VAAL -** Experienced 18-start maiden lightened in her shoeing (barefoot) for the first time. Soundly beaten in her last 3 starts, the latest (10th) over 2400m at Montauban on 29 December best watched for now

13. LOVELY GAZELLE - Returned to form in her comeback from a 5-month absence, finishing 4th at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 5 December. Further improvement on the cards with her hind shoes removed

Summary: LITTLE KING ELEVEN (11) was an authoritative winner of his last start at Grenade-sur-Garonne last month and needn't improve much with his shoes removed to score again. Enigmatic LOVE METHOD (8) and LEA DANSE (7), who caught the eye at Bordeaux last time out, could make life difficult for the selection. They lead the opposition ahead of Stéphane Cingland's other representative LOVELY GAZELLE (13), after her pleasing comeback, and unreliable LOVE D'AMOUR (2) who has sufficient means.

- **1. IMPERIAL GAMER -** Experienced hard-knocker. Finished 5th in 3 consecutive starts, the latest (shod) on 22 December at Grenade-sur-Garonne in his first start since joining Pierre Repichet's stable races unshod for just the 2nd time in his career
- 2. JORIS DE L'ELLE Experienced hard-knocker with better references under the saddle and currently out of sorts unplaced in his last 3 starts, the latest (11th) in a 2725m mounted race on 15 December. Others preferred
- **3. JERRY LOVES GINGER -** Unreliable but confirmed under these conditions (shod) with sound references. Finished 8th (barefoot) at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 5 December so is probably best watched for now
- **4. JIRELLA DU LOISIR -** Unplaced (shod) in both comeback outings after a 4-month absence, the latest (a creditable 6th) over 2550m at Bordeaux on 17 December. Candidate for success lightened in her shoeing for this commitment
- **5. JEU ROYAL -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start victory at Villeréal. Hasn't been seen since that 2450m success on 17 August 2023
- **6. JULIETTE D'OO -** Course-and-distance winner on 22 November in her only previous appearance with this shoe-fitting. Shown her form and well-being recently with consecutive 4th-place finishes, the latest (2550m) at Bordeaux on 17 December winning chance
- **7. ITUMELANG PAULOIS -** Experienced hard-knocker with sound references but unlikely to trouble the judge on the evidence of his comeback 7th in a 2650m amateur harness race at Bordeaux on 27 December
- **8. HARKONNEN -** Well-performed veteran trotter with sound references under these conditions/in this shoeing configiration, so he shouldnt be hastily condmened for a last-start disqualification at Beaumont on 1 December. Keep safe
- **9. IMPULSIF D'AVENIR -** Versatile but inconsistent veteran with sound references in both codes seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Didnt go unnoticed (5th) in a 2550m mounted race at Beaumont on 20 December so not taken lightly back in this category
- **10. JOGGER KILY -** Consistent hard-knocker with the form and experience under these conditions/with this unshod configuration to fight for victory. Runner-up over 2400m on 1 December and 3rd over 2550m on 20 December in recent Beaumont appearances
- **11. IPSI DE BENAC -** Unplaced in both (shod) 2725m comeback outings at Grenade-sur-Garonne, the latest (11th) on 15 December but better is expected of him in this configuration. Runner-up over track and trip on 1 July 2023 when last seen in this shoe-fitting
- **12. IMPULSE LADY -** Consistent veteran mare with sound references/form credentials. She shouldn't be hastily condmened for a recent failure (disqualification) at Montauban on 29 December keep safe
- **13. JUPPY UP -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials although most efficient without irons (unshod). Well-beaten 11th (shod) at Beaumont on 20 December after a 4-month absence so needs to improve to stake a claim here

14. HIDALGO BOY - Experienced hard-knocker with sound references, which include finishing 4th in back-to-back amateur races last month in this shoeing configuration - the latest over 2650m at Bordeaux. Not taken lightly

Summary: JOGGER KILY (10) deserves a reward for his consistency and this seems an ideal opportunity after encouraging recent displays at Beaumont. He gets the nod ahead of JULIETTE D'OO (6), ideally engaged under these conditions, and JIRELLA DU LOISIR (4), of whom better is expected, espeically in this unshod configuration, after 2 much-needed comeback (preparation) outings. HARKONNEN (8), HIDALGO BOY (14), IMPULSE LADY (12) and IMPERIAL GAMER (1) complete the shortlist.

- **1. KWEEN PIYA -** Experienced 19-start maiden racing in this shoeing configuration for the first time. Soundly beaten in her last 3 starts, the latest (9th) over 2400m at Montauban on 29 December best watched for now
- **2. KALINKA DE VANDEL -** Experienced mare (17-start maiden) with sound references, albeit without success seldom far off the mark but unplaced (8th) over 2925m at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 26 December. Others preferred
- **3. KENDLY DU PADOUENG -** Inconsistent but not devoid of ability finished 2nd in consecutive starts before back-to-back subsequent Cagnes failures over 2925m, the latest (10th) on 26 December. Capable of better so shouldn't be underestimated
- **4. KALINE BEY -** Unreliable mare with references under these conditions/in this shoe-fitting, including a good 3rd over 2575m at Agen on 17 November. Must reaffirm after a disappointing subsequent display (9th) at Bordeaux on 23 December
- **5. KUEEN DES PRES -** Last-start winner over 2725m at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 22 December but raced unshod/barefoot on that occasion and is presented with her irons (shod) for this commitment. Respected all the same
- **6. KENDAYA -** Absent since finishing 7th (barefoot) over 2250m at Auch on 2 September. Best watched for now on her return
- **7. KIERA MAGIC -** Made a winning start for Benjamin Goetz at Montauban in October but failed to confirm that form/improvement when 6th on this course over 2750m on 6 December. Not written off
- **8. KAZA DU TRIO -** Won all 3 completed races (4 starts) in this barefoot configuration, the latest over 2750m at Angoulême on 6 October. Open to improvement on her reappearance
- **9. KATARINA D'HERMES -** Delicate and seldom far from a fault but usually acquits herself competitively when applied/remaining wise. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for consecutive recent failures (disqualifications), the latest at Cagnes on 23 December all or nothing!
- **10. KAELIE DU DAN -** Delicate and seldom far from a fault disqualified in 5 of her last 7 starts (and each of her last 3), the latest at Beaumont on 20 December. Others preferred
- **11. KRAQUANTA BELLA -** Honest hard-knocker with the form and experience under these conditions/in this unshod configuration to play a leading role, including a last-start 4th over 2400m at Beaumont on 20 December
- **12. KUEENTRASS -** Complicated mare with undeniable means seldom far from a fault but does acquit herself competitively when remaining wise. Didn't go unnoticed when 5th (shod) over 2400m at Beaumont on 20 December and is unshod for this commitment
- **13. KHARA DUEM -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials seldom finishes far off the mark when applied/remaining wise. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for her disqualification at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 8 December
- **14. KERIDA DU PADOUENG -** Complicated mare with undeniable means/sound form references, including a reassuring last-start 3rd at Montauban over 2400m on 29 December. Dark horse

Summary: A toss-up for race honours between KAZA DU TRIO (8), who's at her best when fully unshod, and last-start winner KUEEN DES PRES (5). They're likely to fight out the finish with the remaining podium berth up for grabs. KATARINA D'HERMES (9), capable when wise, KUEENTRASS (12) and KRAQUANTA BELLA (11), ideally entered at the limit of retreat, seem best equipped to complete the minor positions.

- **1. GRACIEUSE MIC** Unreliable and currently out of sorts unplaced in both recent comeback appearances, the latest (12th) over 2725m at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 22 December. However, she did win his last 2 appearances in this shoe-fitting
- **2. GIGOLO DU NOYER -** Versatile veteran trotter with sound references in both codes, including a last-start win at Vichy in the mounted category. Absent since that 2200m victory on 20 June but did win his last harness appearance at Castillonnès on 8 May
- **3. HEYDAY -** Rejuvenated since joining Benjamin Goetz's stable, winning back-to-back 2150m Toulouse races (latest on 6 December). Should continue his momentum
- **4. HORIZON DU THAY -** Thriving veteran trotter in good form and physical condition finished 3rd (plated) in consecutive recent starts but did win over 2575m at Agen on 17 November in his last barefoot appearance. Keep safe
- **5. HANA D'OCCAGNES -** Versatile hard-knocker maintaining remarkable consistency alternating between the codes showed her form when 3rd in a 2650m mounted race at Marseille-Vivaux on 30 November. Candidate for success back in the harness category
- **6. GENIE DE L'OUEST -** Unreliable veteran who is most efficient without his irons (unshod) and out of sorts at present unplaced in consecutive recent appearances, the latest (7th) on this course over 2750m on 6 December
- **7. GUNNER -** Inconsistent and delicate veteran trotter with undeniable means seldom far from a fault but usually acquits himself well when applied/remaining wise. Didn't go unnoticed (6th) at Cagnes over 2150m on 18 December
- **8. HEROINE DE GUERRE -** Honest hard-knocker with undeniable means and references at a higher level. ideally entered under these conditions and may well redeem herself after a last-start failure (disqualification) at Nantes on 8 December
- **9. HOTOT -** Honest hard-knocker with undeniable means and sound references under these conditions/in this shoeing configuration, including a last-start 6th over 2150m at Cagnes on 28 December
- **10. HOPE -** Inconsistent but not devoid of ability finished 2nd on this course over 2150m last month but unplaced (7th) over 2150m at Cagnes on 28 December. Shouldn't be underestimated
- **11. FIANARANTSOA -** Experienced mare (100-start veteran) with sound references under these conditions/in this configuration, including a 5th over 2725m at Grenade in her last start on 22 December. Dark horse
- **12. HALADIN D'ARGENT -** Honest hard-knocker with undeniable means and sound references under these conditions in this shoeing configuration at a higher level. Shouldn't be condemned for his failure (12th) in a stronger race/field at Vincennes on 30 November
- **13. HASPARNE DUEM -** Experienced hard-knocker with sound references but unlikely to trouble the judge on the evidence of unplaced comeback outings on this course recently, the latest (9th) over 2150m on 6 December
- **14. HEPICETOU -** Versatile but inconsistent veteran with references in both codes, though seldom far from a fault. Disqualified at Meslay on 19 December in a 2875m mounted race others preferred

- **15. GOLD SPEED -** Caught the eye with a fast-finishing 3rd on this course over 2150m on 22 November. Should be competitive for the leading positions with a repeat of that performance
- **16. HERMES DE GIRONDE -** Honest hard-knocker with the form and experience under these conditions/in this unshod configuration to play a leading role, including a last-start 4th over 2400m at Bordeaux on 27 December

Summary: HEROINE DE GUERRE (8) could not dream of a more favourable commitment and she ought to capitalise on this ideal entry by making amends for her recent failure. HEYDAY (3) is at the top of his game trained and Benjamin Goetz's charge should continue his momentum by threatening the selection for top honours. HORIZON DU THAY (4), most efficient without his irons, HALADIN D'ARGENT (12), whose Vincennes failure is best ignored, and versatile mare HANA D'OCCAGNES (5) have legitimate podium ambitions too.

- **2. GLADIATOR DE NIMES -** Inconsistent but not devoid of ability and is confirmed under these conditions/with this shod configuration confirmed as much by finishing 4th over 2650m at Saint-Galmier on 19 November. Dark horse
- **3. HYDIS DE VASTERIE -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials under these conditions at a higher level, including a recent 4th over 2650m at Marseille-Vivaux on 5 December. Not taken lightly
- **4. IZAYA DE COUSSERAT -** Bounced back to form with a reassuring 3rd in this barefoot configuration at Beaumont over 2550m on 20 December. Will be competitive with a repeat of that performance
- **5. HISTORIQUE ELDE -** Confirmed the form/improvement of his 2750m victory at Nimes last month by finishing 4th over 2550m at Beaumont on 20 December. Gets along well with Edouard Coubard-Meunier and should remain competitive
- **6. HOUKO SPORT -** Complicated veteran with undeniable means seldom far from a fault and disqualified in 3 consecutive starts, the latest at Beaumont on 20 December. Question of wisdom
- **7. HAZARD D'AMOUR -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 3rd (barefoot) in a 2550m harness race at Beaumont on 20 December. Confirmation required without his irons
- **8. ISSALIO -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials under these conditions at a higher level. Unplaced (12th) in a 2550m event at Beaumont on 20 December but had legitimate excuses for that performance can set the record straight
- **9. IVANHOE PAULOIS -** Unreliable veteran, most efficient without his irons (unshod). Absent since finishing 8th at Meslay-du-Maine on 30 July
- **10. HIDALGO DES LUCAS -** Confirmed the form and improvement of his 2725m victory in this shoe-fitting at Grenade-sur-Garonne in November with a good 2nd (barefoot) over 2750m at Nimes on 1 December. Keep safe
- **11. HAMPTON AMERICA -** Experienced veteran with proven references at this level and recent 5th on this course over 2150m on 6 December. Can get into the picture
- **12. HADES DE SUCE -** Last-start winner of a 2725m amateur race at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 8 December in this shoeing configuration. Remains competitive at this level
- **13. GHOST DE BEAULIEU** Bounced back to form with a reassuring 3rd in a 2650m amateur race at Bordeaux on 27 December in this shoe-fitting. Confirmation expected
- **14. IMPACT DES BAUX -** Struggling veteran, soundly beaten in both starts last month the latest (16th) over 2550m at Beaumont on 20 December. Others preferred
- **15. IMAGE DE NERET -** Inconsistent mare with undeniable means (sound references under these conditions/in this configuration). She shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 9th over 2550m at Beaumont on 20 December dark horse

16. GASC - Experienced hard-knocker unlikely to trouble the judge on the evidence of his 3 (unplaced) comeback appearances - the latest at Beaumont on 20 December. Others preferred

Summary: ISSALIO (8) should not be condemned for his recent Beaumont failure and is good value to make amends, especially against opposition of this ilk. He is preferred to IZAYA DE COUSSERAT (4), after a reassuring last-start 3rd, last-start amateur winner HADES DE SUCE (12), HOUKO SPORT (6), for whom everything remains a question of wisdom, and HISTORY ELDE (5) who has found a new lease on life.

- **2. JAVA DE BOUTEAU -** Complicated 44-start maiden disqualified in her last 3 starts the latest at Grenade on 22 December. Others preferred
- **3. JO DE L'ORMERIE -** Inconsistent but not devoid of ability, though best watched for now after his recent failure (disqualification) at Grenade on 15 December. Others preferred
- **4. JAMAICA VERDERIE** Inconsistent but not devoid of ability and is confirmed under these conditions/with this shoeing configuration. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for her recent disqualification at Grenade on 22 December
- **5. JALTO DU TREMONT -** Consistent hard-knocker with the form and experience to fight for victory on his reappearance. Absent since finishing 4th at Auch on 2 September
- **6. JAVA DE LIGNY -** Honest hard-knocker with undeniable means and sound references/form credentials under these conditions. Should fare better with her shoes removed after a last-start disqualification (shod) at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 22 December
- **7. JAS DU TRUFIER -** Opened his account with a last-start victory over 2725m at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 15 December. Remains competitive
- **8. JET DU RAVARY -** Delicate but versatile hard-knocker with references in both trotting disciplines, though seldom far from a fault a question of wisdom with him after 3 consecutive disqualifications, the latest under the saddle at Cagnes on 21 December. Beware!
- **9. JUST BLACK -** Honest hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials although most efficient/competitive when racing unshod. Absent since her disqualification at this venue on 6 June but not taken lightly on her reappearance
- **10. JALNA DU PALAIS -** Struggling veteran trotter disqualified in a 2400m mounted race at Montauban on 29 December. Best watched for now
- **11. JANTARA DESBOIS -** Returned to form with a reassuring last-start 2nd in this unshod configuration at Bordeaux over 2650m on 20 December. Will fight for victory if repeating that performance
- **12. JAKARTA D'ALOUETTE** Inconsistent but not devoid of ability, though most efficient/competitive racing unshod. Shouldnt be hastily condemned for finishing 13th (shod) over 2650m at Bordeaux on 20 October
- **13. JUMPER STAR -** Consistent hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials (albeit without success) to play a leading role, including a last-start 2nd over 2725m at Grenade on 15 December. Keep safe
- **14. JEANNE D'AUTHISE -** Experienced hard-knocker with sound references, though most efficient without her irons not likely to trouble the judge on the evidence of her comeback 13th (shod) at Grenade on 22 December. Others preferred
- **15. JETLAG DE BEAUFOUR -** Inconsistent but not devoid of ability and has references under these conditions (shod). Shouldn't be hastily condemned for his latest failure (disqualification) at Montauban on 29 December

Summary: Yannick Henry is strongly represented by JANTARA DESBOIS (11), whose encouraging 2nd at Bordeaux last month augurs well for her chances here, and JAVA DE LIGNY (6), who should resurface in a race of this ilk with her shoes removed after necessary comeback/preparation outings. JADE GERBEHAYE (16) and the returning JALTO DU TREMONT (5), who never disappoints when unshod, complete the shortlist with JUMPER STAR (13) and JETLAG DE BEAUFOUR (15) best of the rest.

- 2. KILOU DE BERTRANGE Only modest of late and was 6th in Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 22 December. Others make more appeal
- **3. KIKI VAQUERO -** Yet to win a race and was 8th in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 23 December. Capable of popping up in a place when in the mood
- **4. KIRIKOU DU DROPT -** Has major disqualification issues but does win when in the mood and was victorious last time out in Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 22 December. Can win if wise
- **5. KISS OF THE KING -** Finished 7th last time out in Class F at this track over 2750m on 6 December. Needs major improvement to win
- **6. KAOLIK DE GUEZ -** Hard to trust and was disqualified in his last three starts with the latest being at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 15 December. Capable of a surprise when smart
- **7. KYLIO DE BERTRANGE -** Yet to win a race but was runner-up last time out in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 29 December. Has a winning chance
- **8. KASH D'URZY -** Unreliable but was third last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 18 December. Barefoot this time and could do better
- **9. KING OF PARADISE -** On a very long losing run and was tenth last time out in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 29 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **10. KING TRACK -** Showed some improvement when 5th in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 29 December. Capable of contesting the finish
- **11. KALIMERO -** Disappointing form of late and was 7th in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 29 December. Might play a minor role
- **12. KSAR BLUE BOCAIN -** Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 8 December. Probably best watched for now
- **13. KANGCHENJUNGA -** Has struggled of late and was 12th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 27 December. Others make much more appeal

Summary: KIRIKOU DU DROPT (4) is talented but even more complicated, winning 3 times and disqualified 10 times in his last 13 appearances. He needs only to remain wise to add to his tally. KASH D'URZY (8) seems best equipped to pick up the pieces should the selection fluff his lines although KING TRACK (10) and KYLIO DE BERTRANGE (7) are also genuine candidates for a podium finish.
