**C1 - PRIX DU LIMOUSIN - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR €
59,000**

- 1. GAROU LIONNAIS** - Unreliable but was third last time out in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 22 December. Might play a minor role
- 2. IGGY POP DE CHENU** - On a long losing run but was fourth in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 22 December. Needs to do a bit more to win
- 3. FLASH DE VOUEDE** - Has really struggled of late and was 8th in Class E over this track and trip on 24 December. Others make much more appeal
- 4. HIATUS** - Unreliable and was 6th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 27 December. Might pop up in a place
- 5. INDOCILE** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 27 December. Has won over this course and distance and should be a threat
- 6. I STILL LOVING YOU** - Has struggled since his return and was 11th in Class E over this track and trip on 21 December. Capable of an upset
- 7. HASHTAG CHAMANT** - Disqualified last time out at Amiens on 9 December. Capable of winning but others make much more appeal
- 8. IACYNTHÉ DIDJEAP** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 15 December. Capable of better and has a winning chance
- 9. EQUEJUELO** - Hard to trust but was not disgraced when 5th in Class C over this track and trip on 18 December. Capable of making the frame when in the right mood
- 10. FEELING BOY** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 21 November. In good form before that and could be the surprise package of the race
- 11. GUAPO MARBOULA** - Has major disqualification issues but was not disgraced when 5th in Class C over this track and trip on 18 December. Could earn some money
- 12. IALTO D'HERTALS** - On a long losing run but was barefoot and fourth in Class C at this track over 2700m on 24 December. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset
- 13. INDY DE JYR** - Very consistent when barefoot and was third in Class C at this track over 2700m on 24 December. Big chance
- 14. GREZ** - Unreliable and was 6th in Class C over this track and trip on 18 December. Capable of making the frame
- 15. GAMIN DE MAHEY** - Disqualified at this track on 18 December. Usually gives of his best and is not out of in this division
- 16. FRANKLIN PARK** - Did not win last year and was 7th in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 27 December. Needs major improvement to win

Summary: INDY DE JYR (13) ran some solid races last December against stiffer opposition and seems ideally entered here. He gets the vote to resume winning ways at the expense of IACYNTHE DIDJEAP (8) who has run well over the course & distance before and gets the valuable assistance of Eric Raffin. INDOCILE (5) is not the easiest horse to handle but if he turns up, there is no doubt that he can win a race of this nature. I STILL LOVING YOU (6) and GREZ (14) are best of the rest.

C2 - PRIX DE VIC-BIGORRE - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 38,000

1. **MAGDA DE VANDEL** - Disappointing form of late and was 8th in Class C over this course and distance on 20 December.
2. **MY SAVE QUICK** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class C over this track and trip on 20 December. Has a winning chance
3. **MANHATTAN RAIN** - Has disqualification issues but did run well when third in Class C over this track and trip on 20 December. Big chance in this line-up
4. **MONA D'AVRIL** - Did not show her best when 7th in Class D at this track over 2850m on 13 December. In good form before that and is not out of it
5. **MERCEDES DU LOISIR** - Fair form and was fourth last time out in Class B over this distance on 14 December. Has a winning chance
6. **MAMZELLE DREAM** - Did not run too badly when fourth in Class C at this track over 2850m on 13 December. Might play a minor role
7. **MARA AULNAIES** - Consistent so far and was runner-up in Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 23 December. Clearly not out of it
8. **MADONE DU TRIEUX** - Hard to trust but was runner-up in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 11 December. Might play a minor role
9. **MISS DE LA COTE** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at this track over 2175m on 27 November. Capable of contesting the finish
10. **MY LADY CASTELLE** - Finished 5th in Class F at Laval over 2050m on 8 December. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
11. **MY QUALITA PIYA** - Disqualified in all three starts, with the latest being at this track on 6 December. Has shown promise before faulting and could surprise
12. **MAKINA DANICA** - Finished third on her debut in Class F at La Capelle over 2000m on 11 November. Has a place chance

Summary: MANHATTAN RAIN (3) was a good 3rd last time out over the course & distance. She has a much better starting berth this time around and has every chance. The well-related MY SAVE QUICK (2) has shown enough thus far to think she can play a leading role in a race like this. MY QUALITA PIYA (11) surely has ability and would not be a surprise winner if she can keep her action together. MARA AULNAIES (7) is another one to follow closely on her first run at Vincennes.

**C3 - PRIX DE BOULAY - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR
€ 40,000**

- 1. LITTLEBOY DE PLANY** - Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at this track on 29 December. Barefoot this time but is very hard to trust
- 2. LOTUS DES SABLES** - Yet to win a race and was 8th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 29 December. Others are preferred
- 3. LEADER DE SEVRE** - Has struggled of late and was 6th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 20 December. Others are much preferred
- 4. LUKAS D'OLIVERIE** - Unreliable but was third in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2175m on 6 December. Barefoot this time and should make a bold attempt
- 5. LEANDRO DE MER** - Has only been moderate of late and was In a Class D Mounted race on 20 December. Others make more appeal
- 6. LYNX ATOUT** - Did not show his best when 7th in a Class B Mounted race over 2850m on 6 June. Returns from a break but is not out
- 7. LOVE'S SECRET** - In good shape and was victorious in a Class E over this track and trip on 13 December. Can double up
- 8. LOMBARDO** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2700m on 27 December. Has a place chance
- 9. LOVI CADENCE** - Yet to win a race but was fourth in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 28 November. Can contest the finish if in the same mood
- 10. LOVE ME DO MESLOIS** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a Class D Mounted race over 2700m on 29 December. Can go one better this time
- 11. LENNON D'ANS** - Yet to win a race and was 7th in a Class B Mounted race at this track over 2175m on 28 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 12. LOTUS PAULOIS** - Yet to win a race and was 9th in a GR.1. Mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 12 October. Returns from a break but is not out of it

Summary: An eye-catching 3rd last time on the main track, LUKAS D'OLIVERIE (4) clocked an excellent chrono that day and in similar form will take a power of beating. LOVE'S SECRET (7) caught the eye when successful over the course & distance last month and looks a big threat too. LOVE ME DO MESLOIS (10) is a good reliable performer in this class of event and is a must for the shortlist. LYNX ATOUT (6) is well spoken on return from a spell and can pop-up at a nice price.

C4 - PRIX DE SALBRIS - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- 1. LIEGO DU NOYER** - Unreliable and was 8th in Class e at Meslay-du-Maine over 2650m on 19 December. Might play a minor role
- 2. LOUIS D'HAUFOR** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified for the third time in a row at this track on 24 December. Capable of winning when smart
- 3. LORENZO BERRY** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 5 December. Barefoot this time and has a winning chance
- 4. LE MAESTRO** - Won on debut but has battled a bit since then and was 7th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 27 December. Can bounce back to be a serious threat this distance
- 5. LITTERAIRE** - Only modest of late and was 8th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 31 December. Barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
- 6. LIGHTNING JIEL** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class E at Argentan over 2800m on 26 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 7. LASCAR PILE** - Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class E at this track over 2200m on 10 December. Could be better this distance and has a winning chance
- 8. LAY UP** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class E at this track over 2100m on 19 November. Needs major improvement to win
- 9. LUCKY MIX** - Unreliable and was 5th at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 26 December. Might play a minor role
- 10. LORENZO DU NOYER** - Not disgraced when 5th at Graignes over 2700m on 23 November. In good form before that and is not out of it

Summary: LORENZO BERRY (3) was in need of a run last time out and should be fitter here. He runs barefoot for the first time and warrants the utmost respect. LE MAESTRO (4) should also strip fitter after two comeback runs and is a big player if back at the top of his game. LOUIS D'HAUFOR (2) can prove a handful but he has a lot of ability and can score if applied. LORENZO DU NOYER (10) boasts some solid credentials in the province and is worth a mention on his Vincennes debut.

C5 - PRIX DE CASTERA-VERDUZAN - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C Race - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

- 1. KOQUIN DU PERCHE** - In very good form and was runner-up in a Class D Mounted race over this course and distance on 8 December. Not out of it
- 2. KEY BISCAYNE** - Only modest of late and was 7th in a Class B Mounted race at this track over 2175m on 28 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. KENTUCKY FIRST** - In very good form and was runner-up in a Class D Mounted race over this course and distance on 24 December. Should contest the finish
- 4. KILOU D'YMER** - Has struggled of late and was 14th in a Class C harness race 2700m on 29 December. Better under the saddle and could be the surprise package of the race
- 5. KOBALT DU VALLON** - Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at this track on 28 December. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. KING OF JIEL** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 22 November. Capable of contesting the finish but others make much more appeal
- 7. KIF DU BIEF** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in a Class C harness race over this course and distance on 29 December. Can improve in a Mounted race
- 8. KIKI AND CO** - Very unreliable but was winner last time out of a Class D Mounted race over this course and distance on 24 December. Can double up
- 9. KALINE DE VIVOIN** - Has disqualification issues but scored last time out in a Class D Mounted race over this course and distance on 7 December. Not easy to trust but has a winning chance
- 10. KARNA DES BAULTS** - Still improving and was victorious in a Class D Mounted race over this course and distance on 8 December. Big chance in this line-up
- 11. KID DES MOLLES** - Unreliable and was tenth last time out in a Class C harness race over this course and distance on 8 December. Did better under the saddle before that and has a place chance
- 12. KILDARE OF LOVE** - In good form and was fourth in a Class B Mounted race at this track over 2175m on 28 December. Capable of an upset

Summary: A sound winner of a Class D last time out at the venue, KARNA DES BAULTS (10) runs for the first time without his shoes and can take another step forward. He gets a vote of confidence ahead of KIKI AND CO (8) who clocked an excellent chrono in his last winning outing two weeks ago. KALINE DE VIVOIN (9) just showed last month how good she can be when applied and is another to consider. KENTUCKY FIRST (3) has missed the frame only once in six starts in this code.

- 1. KAMELIA DU CORTA** - Ignore the last at this track over 2100m on 28 December. Consistent before that and has a winning chance
- 2. KABYLIE DE BOMO** - Has some fair form of late and was fourth in Class F at Laval over 2050m on * December. Capable of earning some money
- 3. KISS ME CRAZY** - Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at this track on 28 December. Capable of getting involved with the finish when wise
- 4. KHADIDJA CASTELETS** - Battling to find best form and was 7th in Class E at this track over 2100m on 28 December. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 5. KALIE TEJY** - Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2600m on 19 December. Has a place chance
- 6. KALINE DU PONCHET** - Holding form and was third in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 16 December. Has a place chance
- 7. KOURSE MAGIC** - On a long losing run but was a good third last time out in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 1 December. Remains barefoot and could be ready to score
- 8. KINOHA D'OURVILLE** - Unreliable and was barefoot and third in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 13 December. Remains and could cause an upset
- 9. KUEEN DE MONGUERET** - Unreliable but was third in Class F at Argentan over 2875m on 26 December. Might play a minor role at best
- 10. KARMINA DU BREUCQ** - In good form and was third in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 25 November. Can make the frame
- 11. KASANE DU BISET** - Did not show her best when 8th in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 19 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 12. KALINE DE LA COUR** - Has disqualification issues but was a winner in Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2600m on 19 December. Capable of following if in the same mood

Summary: KOURSE MAGIC (7) is one of the very few in this race who has run well over this very specific course & distance. She is selected to get back in the winner's box following a nice rebound of form last month at Vire. KALINE DE LA COUR (12) comes in this race in good form and can make a big impact on her first run at Vincennes. KAMELIA DU CORTA (1) is obviously better than her last start shows and is worth another chance. KISS ME CRAZY (3) is not devoid of ability but must get her house in order.

- 1. KAP ORNE** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 18 December. Others make more appeal
- 2. KERRO DE HOUELLE** - Not disgraced when third in Class E over this track and trip on 10 December. Has a winning chance
- 3. KRICK DU GUESCLIN** - Hard to trust but was third last time out in Class E at this track over 2100m on 22 December. Capable of winning if wise
- 4. KENNEDY FRANCE** - Unreliable and was 8th in Class E at this track over 2100m on 22 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. KOPECK DE CHENU** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 22 December. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 6. KNOCK OUT MAKER** - Much improved of late and was a winner last time out in Class E at this track over 2700m on 6 December. Can complete the hat-trick
- 7. KAVANI** - Has some fair form of late and was fourth in Class E at this track over 2700m on 18 December. Could play a minor role
- 8. KING SUN DRALIAM** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at this track over 2100m on 22 December. Has a place chance

Summary: KNOCK OUT MAKER (6) has yet to reach his full potential and gets the vote to complete the hat-trick. KAZACHOK (9) has been given plenty of time to mature and connections have just been rewarded. He can surely follow up on his last success. KOUROUX (11) is not the most consistent trotter but can pop up on a good day. KRICK DU GUESCLIN (3) showed last time that he is a worthy trotter when he keeps his stride in check.

- 1. JACK IS HAUFOR** - Unreliable but was barefoot and runner-up in Class E at this track over 2100m on 10 December. Not easy to trust but can go one better
- 2. JADORE D'ISQUES** - Unreliable of late and was 6th in Class E over this course and distance on 15 December. Needs to do a bit more to win
- 3. JARDYLAND** - In good shape and was fourth in Class E over this course and distance on 15 December. Has a place chance
- 4. JIRENZO** - Did not show his best when 13th in Class D at this track over 2850m on 6 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- 5. JUST A MAN** - Not disgraced when barefoot and 5th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 4 December. Remains unshod and has a place chance
- 6. JET DES BAUX** - Has some fair form and was 5th in Class E over this track and trip on 15 December. Could earn some money
- 7. JEWEL TOUCH** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when third in Class E at Dieppe over 2550m on 14 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- 8. JASMIN D'AVE** - On a long losing run but was third in Class E over this track and trip on 4 December. Can play a minor role
- 9. JAG HAUFOR** - Returned to form with a barefoot victory in Class E at this track over 2100m on 10 December. Remains unshod and can double up this longer distance
- 10. JASMIN DU NORD** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class D at this track over 2100m on 25 November. Can get involved with the finish again

In case the selection happens to run below-par, the reliable JASMIN DU NORD (10) is the best alternative for success. JUEN EMONDEVILLE (12) stays all day and will enjoy every yard of the trip. Second to the selection last time out, stablemate JACK IS HAUFOR (1) cannot be excluded of the equation.
