**3. LES PAVOTS -** High-class juvenile last year, winning both Listed and Group III races over 1400m in 2023. Yet to reach those heights as a three-year-old but thrives on straight courses - finished 4th on a 1600m Group II at Chantilly on 2 June

**4. VALDIVARA -** Showed promise last year but has built on that encouragement in either outing this term, finishing 4th on both occasions - the latest over this track and trip in a Class 2 conditions race on 10 April

**5. WILD GODDESS -** Started her career with Charlie Appleby in England but joined Henri-Alex Pantall after finishing 9th of 10 in a 1600m conditions race on dirt at Meydan on 19 January. One to note on her reappearance

**3. BATWAN** - Showed his form and well-being by finishing 3rd in a 1000m Listed race at Chantilly on 29 June. Runner-up to SPYCATCHER (5) in the 2023 edition of this Group III

**4. SAINT LAWRENCE** - Out of sorts - finished 19th of 25 runners in the Wokingham Stakes (Handicap) at Ascot on 22 June -but was 3rd in the Group I Prix Maurice de Gheest on this track last summer, close to SPYCATCHER (5). Keep safe

**9. SHARTASH -** Has won two of three starts this year for Wathnan Racing and shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 8th in the Group I Jubilee Stakes at Ascot on 22 June
