- **1. MON FLAMANT -** A winner in a Quinté+ Handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 3 November. Holding form and has won the last three. Can get involved with the finish
- **2. WILL SCARLET -** A good sort who was runner-up in a Conditions race at Deauville over 2500m on 9 November. Big chance and should make a bold bid
- **3. OLYMPIC FLAMBEE -** Unplaced in a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 6 June. Been on a break and might need it
- **4. PALAZZO -** Unplaced in a Handicap at this track over 1800m on 21 September. Disappointing latest and might play a minor role at best
- **5. MISTER URSUS -** Returned to form and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 2000m on 14 November. Improved latest effort and can contest the finish again
- **6. ZABEEL LIGHT -** A bit of a disappointment since winning on debut and finished 6th in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 2000m on 14 November. Capable of bouncing back and contesting the finish

MON FLAMANT (1) has won his last three starts and deserves respect despite the rise in the weight.

- **2. LET THERE BE ROCK -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at this track over 3000m on 23 November. Unplaced in the last three efforts but has won six this year and could cause an upset
- **3. DATO -** Finished 6th at Krefeld over 2050m on 16 November. Poor form and is best watched for now
- **4. LEONELLO -** Finished 7th in a Claimer at Saint-Cloud over 2500m on 15 November. Disappointing latest effort and needs to improve
- **5. ALMACADO GREE -** Fifth in a Conditions race at Deauville over 2500m on 8 November. Competitive at this level and was a runner-up in the penultimate start
- **6. ORION ROCK -** Finished 8th in a Claimer at Saint-Cloud over 2500m on 15 November. Cheek pieces might assist and can play a minor role
- **7. NARCOS -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Deauville over 2500m on 26 November. Capable of doing better and can play a minor role at this level.
- **8. PENTAOUR -** Disappointing last run when he finished 9th in a Claimer at Saint-Cloud over 2500m on 15 November. Was third on this track in his penultimate start and can bounce back to contest the finish

Summary: NACIDO (10) looks the right one if he runs anywhere near his handicap mark. He is well weighted and and can go one better this time. PANGAEA (9) disappointed at Saint-Cloud but could be a threat on this surface. ALMACADO GREE (5) is usually competitive in this division and is not out of it. ALERIO (1) is not reliable but has beaten some of these rivals before so can make the frame.

- **3. AVANT L'ORAGE -** Finished 9th in a Conditions race at this track over 1600m on 19 November. The third time at the races can show improvement
- **4. BOGDANN -** Not disgraced in two starts and was fifth in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1900m on 29 November. Was not far behind SURABAD (1) on debut and can fight out the finish this time

- **4. FAR L'AMORE -** Finished 8th in a Handicap at Goodwood over 3200m on 13 October. Debuts on our soil but has shown enough to win a race like this

CANDELARI (14) is a Frankel gelding who makes his debut and would not be a surprise winner.

- **2. CERVINIA -** Acquitted herself well recently in 2 comeback races after a 2-month break, finishing 4th in both starts the latest at Angers over 2000m on 18 November. More needed
- **3. GAGA GIRL -** Finished a promising 3rd on debut in a course-and-distance contest on 12 November. Will only improve with that experience under her belt
- **4. MIA WAVE -** Experienced filly with sound references in claiming races and a pleasing 3rd in her only handicap appearance. Has to improve on a last-start 5th in a 2000m Durtal claimer (1 November) to be competitive here
- **5. UNE FRAGRANCE -** Didn't go unnoticed on debut when staying on to finish 7th in a 1500m newcomers' race at Saint-Cloud last month (10 November) on heavy ground. Improvement expected
- **6. BOGOTA -** Justified market confidence on debut with an encouraging 2nd in a lucrative 1400m Arqana Sales newcomers' race at Deauville on 15 August, beating subsequent winners. Needn't much on her return to make a winning comeback
- **7. SCENT OF A WOMAN -** Confirmed the promise of her debut 3rd at La Test in June by finishing 4th over 1400m at Vichy on 15 July. Absent since but the booking of Maxime Guyon on her reappearance is encouraging keep safe
- **8. ZIARAH DE SAON -** Well-beaten 13th on debut over 1500m on heavy ground at Saint-Cloud on 10 November. Improvement needed
- **9. LA FERRETCAPIENNE -** Experienced filly with sound references/form credentials in well-composed (stronger) fields, including a last-start 5th on this course over 1600m on 19 November. Attractive outsider
- **10. MADAM SECRETARY -** Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th on debut over 1800m at Dieppe on 27 August and would've improved with that run under her belt. Not taken lightly on her reappearance
- **11. MIMOSA -** Finished a promising 5th on debut in a 1500m newcomers' race on heavy ground at Saint-Cloud on 10 November. Closely matched with CANKOURA (1) on that form, so should have a role to play in the outcome
- **12. REALITY CEN -** Improving sort who finished a career-best 2nd in her first start on this surface at Lyon-La Soie on 18 November over 1800m. Confirmation expected

Summary: BOGOTA (6) was deemed good enough to contest the lucrative Arqana Series des Pouliches on debut and acquitted herself well in defeat. She showed enough on that occasion and, with any improvement, ought to make a winning reappearance at the expense of CANKOURA (1) who would've also benefitted from the experience of a promising introduction. MIMOSA (11) fits a similar profile so shouldn't be underestimated either. SCENT OF A WOMAN (7) completes the shortlist, especially with Maxime Guyon aboard.

- **2. GOLD PALACE -** Versatile hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, including a good 2nd in a 2500m PSF handicap at Deauville last month and last-start 5th over 3000m at Fontainebleau on 14 November. Winning chance
- **3. MONT STEELE -** Unplaced in back-to-back PSF handicap recently, the latest (8th) over 3100m at Pornichet on 23 November. Others preferred
- **4. CUSTARD TARTE -** Won a 2500m Le Croisé-Laroche handicap last month but was a well-beaten 9th under a penalty (current mark) in a 2500m PSF handicap at Deauville on 20 November. Needs to reaffirm
- **5. SUMMIT -** Inconsistent but not entirely incapable of getting into the picture if confirming/building on an improved last start (4th) in a 3000m Fontainebleau handicap on 14 November
- **6. MUNAADRAM -** Finished a well-beaten 15th in a 2500m PSF handicap at Deauville on 26 November but headgear worn that day is dispensed with. Dropped to a dangerous mark
- **7. AND WE DANCED -** Unreliable but has dropped to a competitive mark and confirmed as much with a reassuring 5th in a 2500m PSF handicap at Deauville on 20 November. Keep safe
- **8. RUE DE VOLGA -** Won a 2100m Argentan handicap in October but finished a well-beaten 8th under a penalty (off her current mark) in a 2500m PSF handicap at Deauville on 20 November. Lacks references on this surface
- **9. PALMEIRA EMERY -** Unreliable but has dropped to a competitive mark. Unplaced in back-to-back PSF handicaps last month, the latest (8th) over 2500m at Deauville on 20 November

However, she'll have to thwart the likely challenges of GOLD PALACE (2), who will enjoy racing back on the PSF, and consistent WINGS OF FIRE (12) whose competitiveness at this level is assured. AND WE DANCED (7), MANDOKI (1) and, even PALMEIRA EMERY (9), appeal most of the remainder.

- **2. REKHALE -** Eye-catching 3rd on debut at Deauville on this surface over 1900m under Giovanni Sias on 2 November. Needn't improve much to go one better under the same rider who takes 3,5kg off the back
- **3. DVORJAK -** Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 7th on debut at this venue on the turf course over 1400m on 16 July. Open to improvement on his reappearance
- **4. GARVEY -** Improving colt whose career-best 2nd over 2000m at Strasbourg on 11 November should stand him in good stead here in his first PSF appearance. Dark horse
- **5. GARD FOREST -** Soundly beaten in all 5 starts, the latest (11th) over 1900m in a PSF handicap at Deauville on 29 November. Others preferred
- **6. LE RAPIDE -** Unplaced in consecutive claimers recently, the latest (10th) on this course over 1600m on 19 November. Hard to make a case for
- **7. AMOUR DE LYS -** She has made no impression in 3 (unplaced) appearances finished 9th in a 1650m claimer at Machecoul on 11 November. Others preferred
- **8. GALINETTE** Well-beaten 7th on debut over 1950m at Le Mans on 2 November. Needs to improve so best watched for now
- **9. DARNYA -** Caught the eye when finishing 3rd on debut over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on 19 April. Hasn't been seen since but is open to improvement on her reappearance
- **10. SISSINGHURST -** Cairo Prince debutante trained by Victoria Head who has engaged César Belmont to ride this filly with the aid of a 1,5kg allowance. Keep safe
- **11. WINDBURN -** Experienced filly whose form and consistency ought to stand her in good stead against inexperienced rivals. Lacks references on this surface but did finish a good 4th over 1800m at Clairefontaine on 25 October
- **12. ANGEL FROM ABOVE -** Showed potential in Scandinavia and shouldn't be underestimated in her first start on French soil, especially with Maxime Guyon aboard. Keep safe
- **13. EBADERI -** Well-bred Sea The Stars gelding closely related to well-performed Ebaiyra, who placed at the highest level. Léonard Plommée rides for Francis-Henri Graffard
- **14. ANUQUET -** Faydhan colt closely related to Listed winner (in Italy) Avabin. Jérôme Moutard rides for Gianluca Bietolini
- **15. TRAMONTA -** Lope De Vega debutante closely related to Francesco Guardi, who placed at Group level in Australia. Respected on debut with Pierre Bazire riding for trainer Christopher Head
- **16. BELLE FILLE -** Valérie Dissaux-trained daughter of Mekhtaal debuting with Rosario Mangione in the irons. For another day
- **17. NICE LADY -** Jérôme Claudic rides this Attendu filly on debut for owner-trainer Blaise Mohamed. Best watched for now

Summary: REKHALE (2) caught the eye on debut with a promising 3rd against experienced opposition and, despite his tricky starting position, needn't improve much on the form of that first-up performance to open his account. Well-related TRAMONTA (15) could threaten the selection if forward enough on debut. Experienced rivals WINDBURN (11), ANGEL FROM ABOVE (12), who showed promise in Scandinavia, and well-bred first-up starter EBADERI (13) have legitimate podium ambitions.

- **2. ESCAPADE NOCTURNE -** Veteran handicapper and last-start winner of a 3100m PSF handicap at Pornichet on 1 December. Should remain competitive off an unchanged mark
- **3. SHANGHAI SPIRIT -** Versatile hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 4th in a 3000m handicap on this course last month (23 November). Candidate for success
- **4. LEPTI PRINSADI -** Inconsistent but not entirely incapable of getting into the picture, judged on his best form/references. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for finishing 11th in a 3100m PSF handicap at Pornichet on 23 November dark horse
- **5. PRINCESS ANNE -** Soundly beaten in all 5 appearances this year, the latest (14th) at Châteaubriant on 3 June over 2650m. Unlikely to trouble the judge

- **7. MISTER GOKEN -** Hard-knocking handicapper with better references on turf. Unplaced in consecutive PSF handicaps recently, the latest (9th) over 2500m at Deauville 26 November
- **8. ZARQANA -** Won at Baden-Baden over 2800m in late August but finished unplaced (soundly beaten) in subsequent starts on French soil, both in PSF handicaps the latest (14th) over 3100m at Pornichet on 23 November. For another day
- **9. NIGHTDANCE MAN -** Bounced back to form with a reassuring 2nd on this course in a 3000m handicap on 23 November. Needs only to repeat that performance to go one better
- **10. MYDAVI -** Unreliable but retains sufficient means so is dangerous to discount, despite finishing 8th in a 3200m handicap on this course when last seen (28 October). Shouldn't be underestimated
- **11. STELLA MARINA -** Inconsistent, lightly raced filly with sound references in turf handicaps and scope for improvement. Runner-up in a 3000m Nancy handicap before finishing 17th over 3000m at Fontainebleau on 14 November not taken lightly

Summary: NIGHTDANCE MAN (9) bounced back from a disappointing previous outing to finish a reassuring 2nd on this course recently and needs only to reproduce that form/performance to reconnect with success. He gets the nod ahead of SHANGHAI SPIRIT (3), whose consistency and competitiveness at this level will stand him in good stead, and MYDAVI (10) who has dropped to a competitive mark in the ratings. ARGYRON (12), runner-up at Deauville last time, experienced HERMEVILLE (1) and erratic FREE BREATH (14) seem best of the rest.
