1. LORD DU BASSIN - Tenacious winner over 2100m on the inner track before coming 4th of 11, despite being denied a run, in a 2700m Class D here on 14 November. Starts in front and will be expected to make amends. Claim

2. LOOKING D'AURCY - Easy winner of a 2850m Class E on the short course 10 days ago. Handed a respectable draw and even though stepping up in category, will be dangerous if focused

3. LE GRAND FLAC - Good 3rd of 11 in a 2825m Chartres Class E on re-entry early last month. Hind pads fitted for Paris debut and warrants respect

4. LOUSTIC DE SALOMAX - Placed over the main track a month ago before faulting in a 3000m Nantes Class A 8 days later. Enjoys a good draw but still not an obvious choice

5. LOVELY TRIP - Showed his form despite being sanctioned early in a 2700m Class D here, on comeback, mid-November. Well-placed behind the car and can play an active role if he gets off on the right foot

6. LED ZEP VET - Placed 3rd at Enghien before running good 2nd of 12 in a 2175m Class D here on 9 November. Well-positioned on the front line and even though deserted by Eric Raffin, still looks competitively well-in

7. LINDSTEDT - 3rd of 9 finishers behind LINDSTEDT (7) in a 2850m Class D over the short course 12 days ago, but a repeat seems improbable

8. LOCKI DU FER - Useful colt that ran 3rd of 8 in a 2825m Class A at Le Croise-Laroche a month ago, but has little to contribute in this category

9. LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE - Got off the mark early last month before running 4th of 9 finishers behind LINDSTEDT (7) in a 2850m Class D over the short course 12 days ago. Was not the luckiest that day and can play a role if he defies the draw

10. LATINO PURA VIDA - Sanctioned in a 2700m monté Class C here 9 days ago and in current form will have nothing to offer

11. LUGANO - Makes main-track bow after coming 5th of 9 finishers behind LINDSTEDT (7) in a 2850m Class D over the short course 12 days ago. Has ample ability but others still easier to trust

12. LINARO - Close 2nd of 11 in a 2100mm Class E over the inner course 2.5 weeks ago. Has never failed to deliver in the day's configuration and in spite of an unfavourable draw, should still not be discounted

13. LEZZO FIGHTER - Opened Vincennes account 3.5 weeks ago, at first time of asking, smartly winning a 2700m Class E. On 2nd line but still has the wherewithal to mix it up. First 5

14. LITTLE TWO - Has not been seen out since coming 3rd of 11 in a 2875m Enghien Class D late-September and will need the run

Summary: Thoroughly professional since his first steps on the track, LORD DU BASSIN (1) is forced to start on the rail but has shown a liking for the distance and can score his second of the meeting. LOOKING D'AURCY (2) has more nervous disposition but he imposed with ease over the inner track recently and, with hind pads fitted this time, can repeat. Beaten only by a very good horse here a month back, LED ZEP VET (6) is plainly close to getting losing his maiden tag but he may have to settle for a place cheque this time. The capricious LOVELY TRIP (5) put in a decent effort on re-entry, despite being sanctioned, and Julien Dubois will be eager to make good on the draw.

3. IBRAHISCO - Imposed at Alencon before finishing 9th of 16 to IQUEM D'AMER (13) in a 3000m Nantes Class F a month ago. Hind shoes off this time and, even from front row, cannot be considered a player

4. IN AMERICA - Left a good impression before being disqualified in a 2500m Reims Class E on 20 October but, barefoot or not, is still not up to the task

5. IVORINO D'ECHAL - Reassuring 3rd of 14 in a 2100m Class E here on 18 November but in this company will have too much to do

6. IGGY POP DE CHENU - Unremarkable 9th of 13 in a 3300m Chartres Class F 3 weeks ago and even with Yoann Lebourgeois in the bike is unlikely to cause an upset

7. IOUPY TOLLEVILLE - 8th of 13 when preparing for this in a 3300m Chartres Class F 3 weeks ago. Second to INHERIT (9) under these conditions during the autumn and, barefoot this time, will have a small band of supporters

8. IQUEM - Sprang quite the surprise when 3rd of 14 to INSTANT D'HAUFOR (14) in a 2700m Class D here a fortnight ago, but a repeat seems improbable

9. INHERIT - Secured a 3-timer before encountering all kinds of trouble when 11th of 14 to INSTANT D'HAUFOR (14) in a 2700m Class D here a fortnight ago. Is plainly in rude health and Pierre-Yves Verva will be keen to set the record straight

10. INDOCILE - Last but one, on return to competition, in a 2100m Class C here 3 weeks ago. Is no slouch when focused, has nothing to prove in this category and, if fit, can challenge for a place in the frame

11. I STILL LOVING YOU - Not the horse he was before the extended absence, most recently sanctioned in 22 November race of reference, and can be passed over

12. INSTINCTIF - Game type that ran 4th of 14 to INSTANT D'HAUFOR (14) in a 2700m Class D here a fortnight ago. Has yet to deliver over 2850m here but latest performance bodes well for his chances

13. IQUEM D'AMER - Pulled off the hat-trick when 9th of 16 in a 3000m Nantes Class F a month ago. Has won just twice over main track but in current condition is easy to recommend for a spot in first 5

14. INSTANT D'HAUFOR - Dominated a 2700m Class D here a fortnight ago. Boasts fine credentials during the winter meeting and is thoroughly capable of repeating

15. IBIS PETTEVINIERE - Imposed at La Capelle before finishing close 3rd of 16, a place behind INDIAN PACIFIC (16), in a Class D over track and trip on 5 November, and must be taken more seriously this time. Place chance

16. INDIAN PACIFIC - Solid as a rock lately, most recently 2nd of 16 in a Class D over track and trip on 5 November. Is clearly close to winning another and can bring the fight to INSTANT D'HAUFOR (14)

Summary: INSTANT D'HAUFOR (14) may not always be the easiest of horses to gauge but he trounced the opposition here late last month and in similar form should have the edge over the superbly-engaged INDIAN PACIFIC (16) who has been a model of consistency over recent months. Runner-up to him at 69/1 last time out, IBIS PETTEVINIERE (15) is clearly back at his best and Damien Bonne will be hopeful of another big run. Winner of his only start under these conditions, INDOCILE (10) is barefoot following his mid-November conditioner and must not be underestimated.

3. KELLY D'ESSARTS - Reassuring 4th of 11 behind KALINE DE VIVOIN (10) in a Class D over track and trip on 25 November. Will not be springing any surprises but will not be going home empty-handed either

4. KINDY PERRINE - Sanctioned when being conditioned in a 2850m Laval harness Class A 3 weeks ago. Will be fully fit and returns to her code of preference with a good hand to play

5. KALINA PRINCESS - Makes first appearance since running 4th of 14 behind KNITULIA (9) in a 2100m harness Class D here on 13 September. Will have been specifically prepared for this and can impose at first time of asking

6. KALINE DU RIB - Unexceptional 6th of 11 behind KALINE DE VIVOIN (10) in a Class D over track and trip on 25 November and others easier to back

7. KALLAS IN SALLAZ - Has not been seen out since faulting in a 2150m Vichy harness Class D in June, and will have nothing to contribute

8. KAMILLE D'AUTHISE - Back under the saddle and shod to preference after being sanctioned in a 2700m harness Class C conditioner on 18 October. Comes here fresh but may just be a race shy

9. KNITULIA - Takes first competitive steps in the discipline after coming a very unlucky 7th of 15 behind KANELLE DE TILLARD (13) in a 2100m harness Class D mid-November. Confirmed in the category and can run into first 3

10. KALINE DE VIVOIN - Made up for early-November sanction when 2nd of 11 in a Class D over course and distance 3 weeks later and with application will be no soft touch

11. KIMIKO DU DOUBS - Debuts under the saddle after finishing 11th of 15 behind KANELLE DE TILLARD (13) in a 2100m harness Class D mid-November. Has bags of ability and the change of code may be just her ticket to redemption

12. KANDISSIME - Quality filly that was sanctioned when never dangerous in a 2175m Class D here on 5 November and appears to need another outing

13. KANELLE DE TILLARD - 3rd on monté debut early-November before running 4th of 15 in a 2100m harness Class D here 10 days later. Plainly in excellent condition and even in the absence of Eric Raffin, can play a leading role

Summary: KALINA PRINCESS (5) has already established her credentials in the other code, sports a new formula, and given her pedigree should be able to win a race of this nature. The main threat is expected to come from the tricky, but reconfigured, KALINE DE VIVOIN (10) who put in an excellent effort here late last month, and the nicely-engaged KANELLE DE TILLARD (13) who reverts to a successful formula for the occasion. KIMIKO DU DOUBS (11) may have lost her way with the bike but she takes her chances under the saddle with a decent chance of finishing in the thick of things.

2. BARON TILLY - Pleased in a competitive Breeders Crown semi-final in Stockholm before faulting in the Final over 2140m at Eskilstuna 3 weeks ago. Has won over 2609m and will be worth watching

3. KOBAYASHI - Disappointing 11th of 12 to JAZZMAN (GER) (6) in a 2850m Class A over the short track here on 22 November. Barefoot this time but can still be passed over

4. KANTO AVIS - Pleasant 3rd of 9, a place behind KARLITO, in a 2850m Laval Class A 3 weeks ago. Has ground to make up but is reconfigured and should be able to hold his own

5. IMMORTAL DOC - 10th of 13, on Vincennes debut, in a 2100m Class A 9 days ago. Has ample aptitude but will nevertheless need to show marked improvement

6. JAZZMAN (GER) - Held on well to win a 2850m Class A over the short track here on 22 November. Appears to be back on track and, similarly-configured, should have a lot to contribute

7. KAVIARISSIME - Unlucky to be sanctioned in Gr.1 Grand Prix de l'UET before running 3rd of 12 to JAZZMAN (GER) (6) over the inner track a fortnight ago. Unlikely to cause an upset but can still get in on the action

8. KEENAN DE JOUDES - 7th of 15, when being prepped, in a 3000m Nantes Class B a month back. Has never failed to deliver over course and distance and, competitively-shod, can bring home the bacon

9. KAMEHAMEHA - 5th of 10 in a Gr.3 over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Has ability but is clearly not up to the task

10. KHAL'S FELLA - Comfortably won a 2100m Gr.3 here 3 weeks ago. Has yet to win in this class but is still progressing and legitimately bids for a first-5 payout

11. KARLITO - Missed out by little in a 2850m Laval Class A 3 weeks ago. Has placed at the highest level under these conditions and his recent effort bodes well for his prospects

12. KANADA - Quickly excluded in a 2100m Gr.3 here 3 weeks ago. Has solid references at this level, races barefoot for the first time, and could well set the cat among the pigeons

13. KRISTAL JOSSELYN - Last but one behind KAMEHAMEHA (9) in a Gr.3 over course and distance a fortnight ago, and will again have little to offer

14. KSAR - Sanctioned when preparing for this in a Gr.3 over course and distance a fortnight ago. Just front pads fitted this time but should still have the wherewithal to finish in the mix

16. KILMISTER - Serious Swedish-trained American import making Vincennes debut after running 6th of 11 over 2140m in Bergsåker a month ago. Is being aimed at Critérium Continental and must not be overlooked

17. KOCTEL DU DAIN - Unraced since finishing 7th of 8 when being conditioned in a 2100m Gr.1 almost 2 months ago. Excels over 2700m on the main track and has every chance of imposing

Summary: Not once out of the frame in three appearances at this level, KEENAN DE JOUDES (8) has a conditioner under his belt, sports a fresh configuration on his first mission of the season, and may just be the one to beat. That said, KOCTEL DU DAIN (17) has had ample time to recalibrate after his Grand Prix de l'UET conditioner and, in competition-mode this time, can win his first since May. JAZZMAN (GER) (6) took little time getting back down to business following the summer break, will have come on for the run, and must be taken seriously. KARLITO (11) may not be the most dependable but he has talent in spades and, barefoot following a convincing Laval performance, must be considered a contender.

4. HASUR DAIRPET - Good 3rd in a Laval Class A before coming 4th of 14, a place behind HOCHE (7), in a 2700m Class C here 12 days ago. Enjoys a better draw and is not incapable of turning the tables

5. GREZ - Did not enjoy the best of runs when 6th of 14 behind HOCHE (7) in a 2700m Class C here 12 days ago. Handed a good draw, went close last time over course and distance, and will legitimately garner support

6. HABIT DE SOIREE - Blows hot and cold but reassuring 3rd of 13 in a 2700m Class C at Le Croise-Laroche on 25 November and, in this company, can get in on the action

7. HOCHE - Serious sort that ran 3rd of 14, on first start since the spell, in a 2700m Class C here 12 days ago. Will have progressed from the run and has a realistic chance of imposing

8. HANDY BOURBON - Last of 13 behind HABIT DE SOIREE (6) in a 2700m Class C at Le Croise-Laroche on 25 November and recent numbers do nothing to inspire confidence

9. GYS - Encouraging 4th of 8 in a 2750m Toulouse Class C 2 weeks ago but still has more to find

10. FOGO PICO - Disappointing on re-entry then sanctioned in a 2700m Class D here 2 weeks ago and will have few friends

11. HELIOS SOMOLLI - Runner-up in 2 before being rewarded with success in a 3000m Nantes Class E 3 weeks ago. Would have hoped for a better draw but in present shape is very easy to like

12. BEHIND BARS - Decisive winner, on return from a break, in a 2200m Class D at Salon-de-Provence a fortnight ago. Will have progressed for the run but the draw will do him no favours

13. GOLDEN VISAIS - Returns to racing barefoot after finishing 7th of 13 in a 2700m Class D here 2 weeks ago, but still appears to be biting off too much

14. ASTRONASCENTE ZAC - Won 3 from 4 then ran 5th of 7 over 2300m at Mons 2.5 weeks ago. Races barefoot this time and is reunited with Eric Raffin who won with him here late-September. Handed a tough draw but can still pick up some prizemoney

Summary: Hard to fault when focused and barefoot, HOCHE (7) left a very good impression on his recent return run here, is confirmed under these conditions, and from the front line can win this. Handed a good spot behind the car, HASUR DAIRPET (4) finished runner-up to him that day, and given his record over 2100m here, will be no pushover. Excellent during the autumn and recently successful at Nantes, HELIOS SOMOLLI (11) cannot be discounted, despite the draw. GREZ (5) enjoys a better place on the front line, put in a good finish last time out, and warrants respect.

JOCONDE SIBEY (6) put in a fine Class A performance here recently and Eric Raffin has been engaged for the occasion. JIOSCO DE PHYT'S (12) has 3 runs in him and, barefoot under conditions he appreciates, is unlikely to let the side down.

8. KOKOTE - 3rd over track and trip before running close 2nd of 12 in a 2850m Class A here a fortnight ago. Has merit but has yet to produce the goods at this level and more a minor place chance this time

9. KELLE BEAUTE - 7th of 13 in a 2100m Gr.3 here 3 weeks ago. Has twice imposed under these conditions, ran 2nd to KANA DE BEYLEV (17) during the summer, and if applied will be no easy touch

10. KARLA DE MAI - Has struggled in both codes, latterly sanctioned in a Gr.2 over course and distance 3.5 weeks ago, and has no possible chance

11. NORTOLANDA - Won 4 on the trot, including German 4yo Derby, before coming 2nd of 9 over 1900m at Berlin-Mariendorf on 20 October. Boasts an extraordinary record with hind shoes off and while not a priority still warrants respect

12. KEEN WINNER - Unremarkable 10th of 13 behind KELLE BEAUTE (9) in a 2100m Gr.3 here 3 weeks ago. Boasts fine barefoot references and over this trip, must be afforded respect

13. KATINKA DU MOUCHEL - Pleasant 4th of 16 in a 2875m Argentan Class A on 3 November. Has form at the highest level, has previously beaten KANA DE BEYLEV (17), and is not without a chance of doing so again

14. KIARA DE VANDEL - Never taxed when 7th of 10 in a Gr.3 over track and trip 2 weeks ago. Not always the most faithful but a repeat of her Grand Prix de l'UET performance would see her shake things up

15. KYRIELLE - Last of 9 when being conditioned in a 2850m Laval Class A mid-November. Regularly in the mix when barefoot and while unlikely to win this, can still get in on the action

16. NINETTA BOKO - Pulled-up in Breeders' Crown semifinal before coming 3rd of 7 over 1609m at Wolvega a month back. Is barefoot for Vincennes debut, however others still easier to back

17. KANA DE BEYLEV - Last but one, on return from her spell, in a Gr.2 over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Has class to burn and can make this her own if she stays in stride

Summary: The wealthiest horse here for a reason, KANA DE BEYLEV (17) was conditioned against older horses in the Prix de Bretagne, is barefoot for her first winter objective, and will be expected to get straight down to business. Benjamin Rochard will still be wary of the tricky but classy KATINKA DU MOUCHEL (13) who is barefoot for just the 2nd time, and KELLE BEAUTE (9) who is similarly barefoot for a return to a distance she appreciates. Also relieved of her shoes, KEEN WINNER (12) is unlikely to win this but can still finish close.

1. JULIA QUESNOT - 10th of 11 behind JASMINE DE JYR (15) in a Class C over track and trip 2 weeks ago. Forced to start on the inside and although confirmed over course and distance, may still need to find more

2. JOMA OV - Reassuring 2nd of 10 in a 2875m Argentan Class A early-November. Capable on a good day, is plainly in form, but is being aimed too high

3. JUSQUINE FOUTEAU - In the frame in last 3, most recently 2nd of 9 in a Class D over course and distance 10 days ago. Takes on a better lot this time but has been handed a good draw and Anthony Barrier will be keep to capitalise

4. JOYCE DES GRANGES - Drops down the category-ladder after coming 6th of 15 in a 2700m Class C here on 5 November. Seldom gets her nose in front but always gives her best, and the draw will do her chances no disservice

5. JALMAROSA - Races barefoot after finishing last of 9 when being conditioned in a 2700m Class C here 8 days ago. Excellent in 2 of 3 under these conditions and has a reasonable chance of getting a look-in

6. JUJUBEE - 9th of 11 behind JASMINE DE JYR (15) in a Class C over track and trip 2 weeks ago. Barefoot this time but will still need the run

7. JAMAICA BROWN - Just pipped in a 2700m Class D here on 18 November. Is a tough nut to crack when barefoot and focused, and securing this is well within her capacity

8. JEEDAYA DU VIVIER - Missed out by the smallest of margins when 3rd of 13, a place behind JAMAICA BROWN (7), in a 2700m Class D here on 18 November. Starts wide on front line but has a decent chance of turning the tables

9. JAYA DES BROUSSES - Held on well to win a 2700m Class E here a month ago. Ran 3rd on only appearance over track and trip but has little going for her this time

10. JUBLA VIKING - Starts for first time since being sanctioned in a 3000m monté Gr.1 here last June. Disregard

11. JORIA MESLOISE - Reverts to a previously unsuccessful formula after finishing 6th of 13 behind JAMAICA BROWN (7) in a 2700m Class D here on 18 November, and can be ruled out

12. JUST PRINCESS - Fine class of mare that won a 2700m Class E here in good order a fortnight ago. Has never disappointed when barefoot and is not about to start. Chance

13. JALOUZ D'OLIVERIE - Ran a decent 4th of 13 behind JAMAICA BROWN (7) in a 2700m Class D here on 18 November. Returns to her distance of preference and even though starting from behind, looks a serious proposition

14. JAVA DE CASTELLE - 8th of 10 when being conditioned for this in a 2825m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche 12 days ago. Not blessed with the draw and others easier to back

15. JASMINE DE JYR - Ran JAYA DES BROUSSES (9) close a month back, then not at her ease when 6th of 11 in a Class C over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Has merit and will not be far from the action if Benjamin Rochard positions her early

Summary: A very open affair this with the line of last month's Prix de Paimpol the one to follow. The consistent JEEDAYA DU VIVIER (8) ran a very good 3rd that day and given her liking for the main track can impose this time. A serious sort, JAMAICA BROWN (7) just pipped her that day and can again figure prominently, but may first have to see off 2nd-line starters, JUST PRINCESS (12) who won well here late last month, and JALOUZ D'OLIVERIE (13) who ran 5th in the race of reference.
