- **2. GOHAKI -** Unreliable and was disqualified when last seen at this track but was runner-up last time out in Class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 21 May. Can go one better
- **3. FORMIDABLE VOYAGE -** Has struggled all year and was disqualified last time out at Oraison on 8 May. Best watched for now
- **4. HIRO MAGIS -** Disappointing form of late and was tenth last time out in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 17 April. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **5. GET UP DE VAUVILLE -** Unreliable and was 7th last time out in Class E at Hyères over this distance on 29 May. Capable of making the frame
