C1 - PRIX DES CHRYSANTHEMES - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 27,000

- **1. NIZAM -** A winner on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1500m on 10 October. Should make a bold bid for victory
- **2. SPANISH PRINCE -** Third in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 13 October. Finished off the latest well and deserves to be respected
- **3. FOUR FOUR -** A winner in a Conditions race at this track over 1600m on 18 October. Has track experience and can double up
- **4. GREEN CAPE -** A runner-up in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1500m on 10 October. Place prospects in this line-up
- **5. MISS LACOUMA -** A winner in a Claimer at Deauville over 1500m on 23 October. Faces stronger and others are preferred
- **6. EYWA -** Third in a Claimer at Deauville over 1500m on 23 October. Will find this tougher and needs to find a few lengths

Summary: An easy winner on debut at Saint-Cloud earlier this month NIZAM (1) made a beautiful impression and could remain unbeaten. FOUR FOUR FOUR (3) was a convincing scorer on this track last month and appears to be the main danger. Despite being hampered last time out, SPANISH PRINCE (2) finished the race off well and can be involved in the finish again. GREEN CAPE (4) was a game second last time at Saint-Cloud and can go close too.

C2 - GRAND PRIX DES AMATEURS - 3150m (a2m) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,000

- **1. PASIPHAE -** Fourth in a Handicap at Vichy over 2400m on 24 July. A consistent sort that should be involved in the finish again. Track suited
- **2. AMANTA COVE -** A runner-up in a Handicap at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 25 October. Florent Guy will give every assistance from the saddle and can go one better
- **3. MATGIWELL -** Finished 9th in a Handicap at Aix-les-Bains over 2500m on 27 June. Might need the run-back. Place prospects in this line-up
- **4. TARCENAY -** Well beaten 9th in a Handicap at Chantilly over 3200m on 28 October. Unreliable but has won two Handicap's this year
- **5. MORNING SPIRIT -** Third in a Conditions race at Cavaillon over 2900m on 27 October. Coming down in the weights and has sufficient means to be involved in the finish
- **6. SCILIAR -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at Nancy over 3000m on 27 October. Seldom far off them and has won a Handicap this year
- **7. GIOTTO DES PLACHIS -** A runner-up in a Hurdle Handicap at Nancy over 3000m on 27 October. Returning to the flat and can play a minor role at best
- **8. WUKOLINA -** A winner in a Conditions race at Cavaillon over 2900m on 27 October. Has confidence and appears to enjoy the longer courses
- **9. SPIRITATO -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Nancy over 3000m on 27 October. Others are preferred in this line-up

Summary: (2) AMANTA COVE remains on two good runner-up performances at this level and should soon return to victory. PASIPHAE (1) usually goes well at this track. She is in good form and has to be respected. MORNING SPIRIT (5) is improving and seems to be on a competitive mark on her handicap debut. WUKOLINA (8) won well at Cavaillon and does enjoy this distance so also deserves some respect.

- **1. LESSLEPASSER -** Fifth in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1100m on 3 October. Well Handicaped and deserves to be respected. Can go close
- **2. CAPITANO -** has been in excellent form of late in the Czech Republic. Returns to France and if not needing it can be involved in the finish
- **3. PUREST TIME -** Unplaced in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1300m on 6 October. Has won over 1000m previously and is capable of bouncing back
- **4. MARY GOLD -** A runner-up in a Listed race at Milan over 1000m on 13 October. Should make a bold bid for victory
- **5. LOYAL PRINCE -** Finished 7th in a Handicap at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 8 October. Seldom far off them and can play a minor role
- **6. WASACHOP -** Third in a Handicap at Marseille-Borely over 1200m on 22 October. Needs to find a few lengths to be competitive
- **7. ROGUE ENFORCER -** Fifth in a Claimer at Chantilly over 1100m on 26 October. Yet to place on French soil and others are preferred
- **8. CIAO PA' -** Fourth in a Handicap at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 4 November. Holding form well and can have a say
- **9. DAIQUIBERRY -** Finished 9th in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1100m on 3 October. Third run back and will be fitter this time

Summary: MARY GOLD (4) is going through a purple patch of form. She looks better than ever after her second place in a Listed Race in Italy last time out and gets the vote to score. LESSLEPASSER (1) has the highest rating in this race and is the biggest threat to the selection. PUREST TIME (3) comes back in distance but has won over 1000m previously. CAPITANO (2) proved his form in the Czech Republic and should not be taken lightly.

C4 - PRIX GILLES DENIS - 1350m (a7f) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- **1. ASTRA DREAM** Fourth in a Handicap at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 8 October. Can play a minor role at best
- 2. SALALAH Third in a Handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 12 October. Improved effort and must confirm that
- **3. BAIGNADE -** A winner in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1400m on 22 October. In good condition and is not out of it
- **4. KING ROBBE -** A winner in a Handicap at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 4 November. It has just won a Quinté+ and seems capable of confirming even with the weight penalty
- **5. NOLITO -** A runner-up in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 10 October. Three kilos better off and has sufficient means to be involved in the finish again
- **6. MANAROLA -** A runner-up in a Conditions race at Nimes over 1200m on 1 November. Holding form well and is track-suited. Capable of contesting the finish
- **7. LE CENTRAL -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 4 November. Unreliable and not proven over this distance
- **8. IDEE DE CHEVAL -** A runner-up in a Handicap at Marseille-Borely over 1200m on 22 October. Consistent at this level and deserves to be respected
- **9. NADO TREZY -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Vichy over 1400m on 16 July. Probably will need the run-back

Summary: MANAROLA (6) is holding form and only found one better on the day last time out at Nîmes. She is very effective on soft tracks and gets a narrow vote to score. KING ROBBE (4) carries a penalty for a good win last time out but will remains interesting to follow. IDEE DE CHEVAL (8) is consistent and will give everything he has once again. NOLITO (5) is one of a few more that has a winning chance in a competitive race.

C5 - PRIX BAGUENAULT DE PUCHESSE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 18,000

- **1. CAZADERO -** Improved with each start and has finished 2nd in back-to-back recent outings, the latest at Les Sables in a 1950m maiden on 12 October. Has a serious winning chance on his handicap debut
- **2. BERLINETTA -** Improved considerably in 3 starts with cheekpieces fitted (finished 3rd twice before her career-best 2nd in a 1600m maiden at this venue on 18 October) but the headgear is dispensed with on her handicap debut
- **3. DUCHESSE DE MORNY -** Benefitted from the step up to this distance to finish an improved (career-best) 3rd in a 2000m maiden at Angers on 27 October and will likely confirm/build on that progress on her handicap debut. Keep safe
- **4. CERVINIA** Capable filly with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 2nd over 1800m in a claimer at Compiegne on 17 September. Not taken lightly in her first handicap appearance
- **5. ZOLIA -** Won a 1900m Argentan claimer on heavy ground last month but failed to confirm that form/improvement when finishing unplaced (7th of 10) in a 2000m maiden at Angers on 27 October. Needs to reaffirm
- **6. RUE DU PERCHE -** Improving filly whose last-start 3rd in a 1600m maiden at Saint-Malo on 22 August was encouraging. Open to further progress on her handicap debut over this extended trip
- **7. MASTER CATH -** Made marked improvement in first-time headgear to finish 2nd in a 1900m maiden at Nimes on 6 October. Has more to do on his handicap bow but is open to further progress with the headgear retained
- **8. SIGNORIA PIAZZA -** Finished 3rd on debut over 1000m at this venue in April but flattered to deceive in 9 subsequent outings, the latest (9th) on her handicap debut over 1700m at Marseille-Borely on 30 October. Others preferred
- **9. DIYAA -** Unplaced in all 3 appearances, including back-to-back recent starts (8th in both) at Marseille-Borely with headgear on the latest a 2000m maiden on 22 October. Blinkers replace cheekpieces on handicap debut
- **10. TAGA -** A 7-start maiden with references at this level acquitted herself well in both handicap appearances, the latest (4th) over 1700m at Marseille-Borely on 30 October. Attractive outsider

Summary: CAZADERO (1) is improving with each start and every step up in distance, so this extended trip should unlock further progress. He gets the nod on his handicap debut ahead of BERLINETTA (2), despite the removal of the latter's headgear in which she had improved. Nevertheless, she leads the opposition although DUCHESSE DE MORNY (3), whose encouraging last start over this trip bodes well for her chances, also has the means to play a leading role. RUE DU PERCHE (6) and CERVINIA (4) complete the shortlist.

C6 - PRIX DE PONT-DE-VIVAUX - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Race - Flat - EUR € 14,000

- **1. MOMO NELSON -** Experienced hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials at this level and in handicaps on both surfaces. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th in a 2150m Lyon-La Soie (PSF) handicap on 25 October keep safe
- 2. KATE DADDY Experienced filly in good form and physical condition with sound references on deep/heavy ground. Finished 3rd last time out in a 2500m handicap at Nancy on 22 October
- **3. ALAMSAR -** Inconsistent but has references in handicaps at this level off a higher mark seldom far off the mark on a going day. Unplaced (10th) in a 2150m PSF Lyon-La Soie handicap on 4 October, so has to redeem himself
- **4. BLACK FALCON -** Debut winner at Cagnes last year but has lost his way/form in 2024 soundly beaten (unplaced) in each of his last 9 starts, the latest a well-beaten 13th in a 2000m PSF handicap at Marseille-Vivaux on 9 October
- **5. ROI DE FLANDRE -** Won a 1600m PSF handicap at Cagnes in January but lost his way/form since unplaced in 13 subsequent outings, the latest (15th) in a 2150m PSF handicap at Lyon-La Soie on 25 October. Can be ruled out
- **6. SINNDARILLO -** Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th on this course in a 1600m handicap in September off a 3kg higher mark. Best watched for now, though, after finishing 9th in a 1600m Lignières handicap on 1 November
- **7. KARMINA BELLA -** Soundly beaten in both comeback appearances after a 4-month absence. Finished 13th in a 2000m Nancy handicap on 27 October others preferred
- **8. RUE D'ALBRET -** Rediscovered her form/momentum after a 2-month break, finishing 3rd in consecutive recent starts the latest on this course over 2800m on 18 October. Candidate for success
- **9. TIMBALLINA -** Unplaced in all 3 of her appearances in turf handicaps, albeit off higher marks. Most effective on PSF but would've benefitted from her comeback run (7th) in a 2150m PSF handicap at Lyon-La Soie on 25 October
- **10. DEL CIELO -** Has sparked improvement recently in 2 starts with blinkers fitted, having dropped in the weights/ratings. Finished a reassuring 4th off this mark in a 1600m Le Mans handicap on 16 October
- **11. ZAMNESIA -** Didn't go unnoticed in his first start on French soil when 3rd at Aix-les-Bains over 1800m in July. Unplaced (7th) on his return in a PSF claimer over 1800m at Lyon-La Soie on 4 October

Summary: Consistent RUE D'ALBRET (8) has regained momentum and wouldn't be winning out of turn - she is a genuine candidate for success. However, KATE DADDY (2) fits a similar profile so should fight for victory too. MOMO NELSON (1) didn't go unnoticed on PSF last time and has the means to play a leading role back on the turf. DEL CIELO (10) has shown progress with the addition of the blinkers and could also have a say in the outcome.

C7 - PRIX DU GRAND CAMP - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Listed Race - Flat - EUR € 52,000

- **1. KANESHYA -** Finished 2nd in a 2400m Class 1 conditions race at Saint-Cloud on 9 September before winning a recent Listed race in Poland. Warrants respect on his return to France
- **2. BIRR CASTLE -** Consistent well-performed gelding with rock-solid form references/credentials at a higher level, including a last-start 3rd in the Group II Prix Dollar over 1950m at ParisLongchamp on 5 October. Sets the standard
- **3. SINGLEDON -** Experienced and consistent hard-knocker with sound form references in his native Switzerland, including a last-start victory over 2475m at Zurich-Dielsdorf on 22 September. Returns to France with high hopes
- **4. PLEASEMAN -** Unbeaten in 2 starts since joining Conny Whitfield. Won a 2200m Quinte+ on heavy ground at Chantilly on 26 October steps up in class but shouldn't be underestimated
- **5. MALKA -** Consistent filly with sound references. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th in a 2400m Listed race at Toulouse on 2 October
- **6. DARING PRINCE -** Lightly raced colt with sound/consistent references at this level, including a last-start 4th in a Listed event over 2500m on heavy ground at Deauville on 21 October. Should have a role to play
- **7. BREMEN -** Absent since finishing last of 5 in the 2000m Group III Derby Trial Stakes at Leopardstown on 12 May when in the care of Donnacha O'Brien only recently joined Krzysztof Ziemianski. For another day
- **8. QUE BELLA** Made a winning comeback from a 3-month absence in a 2400m Quinte+ handicap on very heavy ground at Clairefontaine on 22 October. Not taken lightly
- **9. FULL OF HOPE -** Lightly raced filly whose last-start 5th in an 1800m Listed race on heavy ground at Chantilly on 12 October wasn't without merit. Lacks references over this distance so is best watched for now

Summary: BIRR CASTLE (2) sets the standard here and need only repeat his Prix Dollar performance (3rd), behind subsequent Group I Champion Stakes winner Anmaat, to resume winning ways. DARING PRINCE (6) has the form and experience to pose a threat along with PLEASEMAN (4) who deserves a crack at this level having won both starts under Conny Whitfield's tutelage. Listed winner in Poland recently, KANESHYA (1) appeals most of the remainder.

C8 - PRIX DU PARC BORELY - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- 1. TOLLEVAST Former Quinte+ winner who didn't go unnoticed when 6th on very heavy ground in an 1800m handicap at Clairefontaine on 25 October. Dropped to an attractive mark and will benefit from his rider's 2,5kg claim
- **2. SAINTE RITA -** Well-performed mare with sound/consistent references in handicaps on both surfaces. Soundly beaten in consecutive PSF handicaps at Lyon-La Soie recently, the latest (12th) over 2150m on 25 October beware!
- **3. DAZZLE AT DAWN -** Productive on French soil in 2023 but hasn't looked the same in either comeback outing after returning from Italy. Unplaced (5th) in a 2500m claimer at Le Croise-Laroche on 7 October, so best watched for now
- **4. ZLARA -** Course-and-distance winner on her last visit to Lyon-Parilly in June. Unplaced in consecutive recent starts (8th in both), the latest a 2400m Class 4 on PSF at Lyon-La Soie on 25 October. Not hastily condemned
- **5. MOZART DES BRIERES -** Last-start winner of a 2600m Marseille-Borély handicap on 22 October. Remains competitive despite a 2kg penalty
- **6. SOUND OF SIXTIES -** Caught the eye with an encouraging last-start 3rd on 10 October in a 2500m Saint-Cloud handicap off his current mark. Keep safe
- **7. MOONFLIGHT -** Experienced hard-knocker with sound references seldom finishes far off the mark. Returns to French soil after finishing 5th over 2150m at Avenches in Switzerland on 25 October
- **8. DECBOU -** Well-performed handicapper with references at a higher level, including Quinte+success. Unplaced in all 7 starts this year, the latest (8th) a 2400m Salon-de-Provence handicap on 30 September watch for now
- **9. LA TOUR DU BOIS -** Consistent, versatile filly with sound references/form credentials in handicaps on both surfaces, including a last-start 4th over 2500m at Nancy on 22 October. Not taken lightly
- **10. I'M ON MY WAY -** Has sparked improvement in consecutive recent outings, albeit at a lower level (Class 4 conditions races). Finished 3rd at Durtal over 2900m on 1 November more needed in this grade/company
- **11. CANIAR DE LUXE -** Experienced hard-knocker with references at this level off his current mark, including a 3rd at Compiegne in a 2800m handicap (22 June). Finished 7th in a 2900m Clairefontaine handicap recently can do better

Summary: TOLLEVAST (1) changed hands after winning a Saint-Cloud claimer last month and made an encouraging debut for his new connections when finishing 6th in a handicap at Clairefontaine, and a repeat of that performance should suffice against this opposition. Last-start scorer MOZART DES BRIERES (5), course-and-distance winner ZLARA (4), whose return to turf shouldn't be underestimated, and recent Saint-Cloud eye-catcher SOUND OF SIXTIES (6) are best equipped to expose any chinks in the selection's armour.
