# C1 - PRIX SERGE CHARLES - 2700m (a1m 1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. HANUGAN Struggling of late and wa 6th in a class F at Caen over 2450m on the 4th of March. Better efforts when last barefoot
- **2. FOLIE DARLING Mostly modest form of late and was 6th in a class E at Reims over 2500m on the 25th of February.** Can play a minor role
- **3. GOSSIP BOY -** Disqualified in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on the 28th of February. His recent efforts don't reflect his ability. Could be the value
- **4. HOPENESS -** In fair form and finished 4th in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on the 7th of February. Well positioned behind the car and can contest the finish again
- **5. HOBAMA -** Needed last two runs and was unplaced in a class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on the 18th of February. Has had two runs back from a break and should be ready for a bold bid
- **6. FRICHTI -** Unplaced in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on the28th of February. Poor recent efforts and others are preferred
- **7. FEUX VERTS -** Disapponting last run when 7th in a class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on the 18th of February. He has previously won at this track and deserves respect
- **8. HORACE DES CHAMPS -** Disqualified at Mons over 2840m on the 27th of February. Reverts to barefoot which is an attraction and can be thereabouts
- **9. FIRST DE ROUGEMONT -** Finished 5th in a Mounted class D at Vincennes over 2700m on the 2nd of February.Remains barefoot and others are preferred
- **10. GUNICA DE CAHOT -** Unplaced in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on the 24th of February.Unplaced the last six efforts and remains barefoot
- **11. GINKGO DES GRANGES -** Finished 6th in a Claimer at Vincennes over 2700m on the 19th of February. Needs to improve on 6th position for the last four efforts
- **12. HAPPY DANOVER -** Unplaced in a class F at Vire over 2825m on the 3rd of March. Poor recent efforts and will be an unlikely winner

**Summary:** HOBAMA (5) has been well prepared for this event and this will be the third run-back, so will be ready. HOPENESS (4) has fair form and could lead the opposition and must have a chance. FEUX VERTS (7) jas won at this course before so deserves some respect. HORACE DES CHAMPS (8) is barefoot and can contest the finish if in the mood.

- 1. ENZO SLIPPER Finished 9th in a class D at La Capelle over 2700m on the 15th of October.Reverts to barefoot
- **2. GUEPARD DE TILLARD -** Unplaced in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on the 8th of January. Poor recent efforts and others are preferred
- **3. EXPEDITIOUS -** Unplaced in a class E at Vire over 2825m on the 3rd of March. Needed the last start but might need one more
- **4. IPALIO -** Unreliable of late and finished 9th in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on the 25th of February. The fact that he remains shod dampens the enthusiasm
- **5. FILOU DE LARRE -** On a long losing run but finished runner-up in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on the 22nd of February. Improved in the latest effort and can confirm
- **6. GLORIEUSE CARNOIS -** Disqualified in a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on the 2nd of March. Major disqualification issues and is best to pass by
- **7. GAULTHERIA -** On a long losing streak and finished 6th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on the 18th of February. Competes well at this track and deserves to be respected
- **8. IALTO D'HERTALS -** Unplaced in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2100m on the 19th of November. Might need the run back after the break but has some serious titles
- **9. FAVORI DE L'ITON -** Unplaced in a class A at Vincennes over 2100m on the 10th of February. He has had three come-back runs and will be fitter
- **10. EMENCOURT D'AZIF -** Disqualified in a Mounted class C at Vincennes over 2700m on the 28th of January.Remains barefoot and in nine attempts at this track has never been out of the top five including three wins

EMENCOURT D'AZIF (10) who enjoys the Croise-Laroche track has to be considered. IPALIO (4) has been unreliable of late but is not out of it.

- **1. JUSTICE D'ORGUEIL -** On a long losing streak since only win and was 11th last time out in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 15 January. Others are preferred
- **2. JAVA DU BAS BOSQ -** Unreliable and was only 6th last time out in Class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 January. Has won over this course and diatance and is not out of it
- **3. JACKIE D'HERTALS -** Has struggled in seven starts since winning in July and was 9th last time out at Mons over 2300m on 22 February. Others are much preferred
- **4. JUST IMAGINE -** Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 1 December. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- **5. JAKARTA** Has some ability but has also been disqualified in four of last six starts including last time out at Cordemais on 1 March. Best watched for now
- **6. JEANNE D'ALEX -** Unreliable but did show her best form when scoring in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 18 February. Deserves respect for that win

- **2. KING DE LA COTE -** Disappointing recent form and was 6th last time out in Class F at this course over 2825m on 26 February. Capable of earning some minor money
- **3. KINGKARL** Has yet to win a race has run some fair races of late and was 7th last time out in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 27 February. Has leading claims
- **4. KEVIN DES OUBEAUX -** Yet to win and has been disqualified in two of last three starts including last time out at Beaumont-de-Lomagne on 1 November. Others are preferred
- **5. KIT ANGOT -** Yet to win a race and was 8th last time out in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 10 January. Others are much preferred
- **6. KHA ETOILE -** Disqualified in four of six starts including last time out at Cabourg on 26 October. Has run well when wise and could be capable of an upset returning from a break

- **3. INOA DE SOMOZA -** Returned to her best when a barefoot winner last time out in Class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 February. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- **4. HIMEROS DU GOUTIER -** Unreliable of late and was 9th last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 26 February. Capable of better and can contest the finish
- **5. ILOT DU TRIEUX -** Unreliable of late but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 24 February. Could play a minor role
