- **1. HARPIE DE JED -** Surprising 7th of 16 in a 2150m Class E here late last month. Eric Raffin takes over the reins but may still be biting off more than she can chew
- **2. GIRLY VICTORY -** Made up for her Vincennes sanction when 2nd of 13 in a 2850m Lyon-Parilly Class E 2.5 weeks ago. In this company though, has limited prospects
- **3. FEE D'AMARO -** Below-par recently, latterly 10th of 17, behind HEROINE DE GUERRE (6), in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F 10 days ago, and has no possible chance
- **4. HANIKA DU LUPIN -** Unraced since being sanctioned in a 2725m Pornichet Class F in early-July. Has more than once shown her capacity at this level, reverts to a confirmed configuration and, with Matthieu Abrivard reining, will be afforded every chance
- **5. HAPPY MARANCOURT -** Impressive winner of a 2550m Reims Class G 3.5 weeks ago. Has a lot going her way here and can make her Enghien debut a winning one
- **6. HEROINE DE GUERRE -** Went into her spell on a high note and returned 10 days ago with 2nd of 17 in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F. Starts in front and even though more reliable racing clockwise, should nevertheless figure prominently
- **7. GALANTE DE TILLARD -** Back on right road after a reassuring 3rd of 11 in a 2650m Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne early last month. Pleased on lone start at the venue and, with form maintained, can get in on the action
- **8. GRAHIKA -** 11th of 13, when preparing for this, in a 2200m Caen Class D 3 weeks ago. Barefoot this time, ideally-engaged at limit of earnings, and looks a player on Enghien debut
- **9. FELINE DE MIRANDA -** Left a good impression when 5th of 13 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D 12 days ago. Hind shoes on, Gabi Gelormini in the bike this time, but the extra 25m will do her chances no favours
- **10. FOR LOVING YOU -** Encouraged at Le Mans before finishing 9th of 12, behind FEE DU VERNAY (14), in a 2750m Class D at La Capelle on 23 September, and is not about to cause an upset
- **11. HISTOIRE MODERNE -** Would have finished 4th in a 2850m Vincennes Class C 2.5 weeks ago had she not lost her action. Alexandre takes over from cousin Matthieu, and will be dangerous if he keeps her trotting

- **14. FEE DU VERNAY -** Pleasant 6th of 12 in a 2750m Class D at La Capelle on 23 September. Is confirmed at the venue, receives a David Thomain drive for the occasion, and will generate some interest
- **15. GAULTHERIA** Disappointing 9th of 12 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 13 September. Is proven at Enghien but would still be preferred a level down

Summary: Unopposed winner at Reims mid-September, on his just her second start for Mathieu Mottier, HAPPY MARANCOURT (5) finds herself well-engaged here, barefoot, and with her trainer reining, can make it 2 on the trot. She will nevertheless face resistance from second-line starters, HAITIAN FIGHT SONG (12), who imposed in good order last time out, and GIANINA BELLA (13) who gave a reassuringly good account at Laval a fortnight ago. HISTOIRE MODERNE (11) showed her form at Vincennes last time, despite faulting, and Alexandre Abrivard will be keen to put things right.

- **2. LUZZY DE VIVE -** Switches code for first time after running last of 8 in a 2900m Arras Class G 2.5 weeks ago, and already looks outclassed
- **3. LIEUTENANT COLONEL -** Sanctioned, on monté debut last Sunday, in a 2000m Class E at La Capelle, and has no chance here
- **4. LIZARO DU SOLNAN -** Newcomer to the code after finishing last of 11 in a 2000m Rambouillet Class F mid-September. Leading jockey onboard for the occasion but still not an obvious choice
- **5. LUMUMBA CAPELLO -** Sanctioned, when unsupported, in a 2200m Vincennes Class D late last month. Has yet to show any particular aptitude for the game and, shod or not, can be ruled out
- **6. LOMIL D'ECROVILLE -** Debuts in the discipline after being sanctioned in a 2000m Rambouillet Class F mid-September. Benjamin Rochard engaged for the occasion but others still preferred
- **7. LYNX DU LUPIN -** Debuted nicely in a 2850m Laval Class F 2 weeks ago, defying his moderate qualification. Will have come on for the run and will not be sent out at 61/1 this time around

- **2. LIMA MARY -** In the frame in all 3 starts this year, latterly 3rd of 12 in a Class E over course and distance mid-July. Has not raced since but will nevertheless be expected to get straight back in the game
- **3. LETTRE D'AMOUR -** In the frame in 3 of last 4, most recently 2nd of 9 finishers in a 2525m Class D at Les Andelys mid-September. Takes on a bigger challenge here but has been entrusted to Alexandre Abrivard for first time and will be no easy touch
- **4. LADY DU VALLON -** Won twice on turf before coming 4th of 6 finishers in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 20 September. Enjoys a good draw and must be considered a serious player

Sent for a rest after leaving a good impression here, LIMA MARY (2) is not without her chances of getting off the mark. LADY DU VALLON (4) has started to come into herself and, sporting 4 pads from the 4-spot, will not be far from the action.

The better-placed KILLER D'ENFER (3) got off the mark at Caen when first-time barefoot and also appears to be in with a decent shout. Solid as a rock lately, KIMI DU DOME (16) has been handed a shocking draw but goes unshod in front for the first time and will be a tough nut if Philippe Daugeard successfully navigates the start. There is no doubting the potential of KITO TURGOT (6) and, while regularly object of the stewards' scrutiny, he reverts to racing with just front shoes off, and must be worth a punt.

- **10. MISS IRMA -** Sanctioned in a 2100m Vincennes harness Class B 3.5 weeks ago, on just 2nd start following a long layoff. Has monté form in Sweden and, if race-fit, can make first 5
- **11. I AM DE LA COUR -** Produced a pair of good efforts before finishing last but one in a 2800m Moulins Class H mid-September. Placed just once in 3 here and, although not a player, should still acquit himself honourably
- **12. IVALO DU BOCAGE -** 6th of 12 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D 3 weeks ago. Has no references here and appears to be out of his depth
- **13. ICARE DU TRESOR -** Oddly out of sorts when 6th of 9 in a 2750m Cabourg Class F early-August. Has been given time to recalibrate and, on good behaviour, can wrap this up
- **14. ITALIA JADOR -** 6th of 9 on monté debut, behind INTREPIDE NEMO (1), in a 2800m Cholet Class G 10 days ago, and will need to raise her game
- **15. IDEAL D'ARTONGES -** Opened his autumn account on 12 September, winning a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F. Again associated with Cléa Roger and must be respected
- **16. INDIGO GEDE -** Won 3 from 5 before faulting in a 2650m Alençon Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Alexandre Pillon could not have asked for a better entry and will be counting on his pilot to deliver. Chance

Summary: Given a rest after failing to fire at Cabourg in early-August, ICARE DU TRESOR (13) returns to a track he appreciates, shod to preference, with his trainer onboard, and looks the pick of the field. Mathieu Mottier will still be keeping a watchful eye on the wonderfully-engaged, and padded, INDIGO GEDE (16) who receives an Alexandre Abrivard ride for the first time, and a reconfigured INDIGODARCHE (5) who has won 2 of his last 3. INTRIGUE DE MAX (6) has been showing her form and has a reasonable chance of making the frame.

- **1. HERO D'HERTALS -** Serious servant that seldom travels to France without a realistic chance of imposing, which he did at Strasbourg before running 2nd of 123 in a 2750m Class F at La Capelle on 23 September. Attention
- **2. INCOGNITO FAC -** Simply superb so far this term, most recently winning a 3150m Class F at La Roche-Posay early last month. Has had time to freshen up and, from front line, can play an important role
- **3. ILLUSTRE SAX -** Blows hot and cold but finished a reassuring 3rd of 14 in a 2725m Pornichet Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Not a priority but receives a Mathieu Mottier drive and will have his supporters
- **4. IZIJAL -** Reassured at Ploubalay before being sanctioned [after 3 false-starts] in a 2600m Cherbourg Class F 2 weeks ago. On front row, reverts to a previous configuration and, given the chance, can play a part
- **5. IDEAL DU BISTON -** Delivered 3 good efforts before finishing last but one in a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 2 September, and will need to show marked improvement
- **6. IN VIVO -** 10th of 15, behind INDIANO JIM (11), in a 3000m Nantes Class F late last month. Barefoot this time but other more competitive alternatives available
- **7. I AM PHYT'S -** Modest trotter that was sanctioned in a 2825m Chartres Class F on 13 September and already looks outclassed
- **8. HIJO MOKO -** Made short work of a 2725m Lisieux amateurs Class G 2.5 weeks ago. Has never delivered at Enghien but starts in front, with Matthieu Abrivard in the bike, and will be no soft touch
- **9. IDEAL MOSSA -** 2nd of 10 in a 2575m Dieppe amateurs Class H 3 weeks ago. Barefoot this time but appears to have a mountain to climb
- **10. HIBISCUS NORMAND -** Disappointing in last 2, most recently 8th of 16 in a 2450m Caen Class F 2.5 weeks ago, and is unlikely to shake things up
- **11. INDIANO JIM -** 4th of 15 in a 3000m Nantes Class F 12 days ago. Takes on a tougher lot here but is barefoot for the occasion and, nicely-placed on front row, should not be discounted
- **12. IDOLE DE MEAT -** Made it 2 victories in a row when comfortably winning a 2850m Class E at Lyon-Parilly 3 weeks ago. Unlikely to pull off the hat-trick but can still put on a decent show
- **13. INSTALL D'ALOUETTE -** Won here before confirming in a 2100m Vincennes Class E late-August. Returns fresh and will justifiably garner the lion's share of support
- **14. IVANA DES RACQUES -** Produced quite the performance to come 3rd of 11 in a 2100m Vincennes Class B, at 91/1, 3.5 weeks ago. Drops in category but is unlikely to repeat
- **15. IDEAL DE JEAN -** Useful sort that came 6th of 12, on return to competition, in a 2825m Chartres Class F on 13 September. Will have progressed for the run and, even from second row, has a reasonable chance of picking up a check
- **16. IN LOVE DE JIEL -** 5th of 8 in a 2400m Amiens Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Has solid Enghien credentials and given the entry, must be considered a leading hope

Summary: Prolific trotter that has won 5 from 9 in 2024, INSTALL D'ALOUETTE (13) imposed emphatically here during the summer and even with an extra 25m to travel, still looks to have the advantage over the well-entered IN LOVE DE JIEL (16) who has won 2 of his 3 Enghien starts, and the consistently-reliable, and barefoot, HIJO MOKO (8) who steps out of the amateur division with a respectable chance of pulling off the double. Barring the occasional lack of focus, INCOGNITO FAC (2) is a model of consistency, starts in front, and deserves to take his chances at this level.
