- 1. TAAGHI 11th of 12 on debut. Vast improvement required. Hard to make a case for
- **2. DAYJUR -** Finished 9th on only start to date and will need to make significant improvement. Others more persuasive
- **3. LE RAIS -** Beaten over 16l last time out so will need to improve but could do that in a race that lacks form. Place chance
- 4. GHAYATHH 11th of 12 on debut, didn't manage to get involved. Needs to show more
- **5. AL AFREETAH -** Two runs to date and she is progressing nicely. After being close up last time out over 1800m, she should put that experience to good use in this event. Leading claims
- 6. LUWSAIL First timer that bears close watching in the market. Can be shortlisted
- **7. AL ZEER -** Dam was very useful winning three times from 1900m-2100m which could be a sign that this individual will enjoy the trip. Watch

- **4. SUPER CUTE -** No win from nine attempts this year but continues to drop in the ratings and could start to show more. Include
- WAIPA Last win came way back in 2021 and recent form doesn't suggest that he could be a factor here.
