**C1 - PRIX CE BELLO ROMAIN - 2875m (a2m) - Class E Race - Mounted -
EUR € 30,000**

1. FIZZ SAINT GERMAIN - Has struggled of late and was 9th last time out in a Class H harness race at Bréhal over 2850m on 22 July. Can improve trying a Mounted race

2. GODEFROY DU LOISIR - On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Royan La Palmyre on 14 July. Others are preferred

3. IKURO JIEL - In very good shape and was third last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 17 July. Big chance in this line-up

4. FALKIR BUIZARDERIE - Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Meslay-du-Maine on 30 July. Disappointing form this year but could play a minor role

5. FAUST DE BEYLEV - Has struggled with disqualifications of late and was disqualified last time out at Enghien on 4 August. Best watched for now

6. HUIS CLOS (SWE) - Holding his form well and was fourth last time out in Class D at Caen over 2450m on 17 June. Barefoot this time and should fight out the finish

7. FARCEUR DE MAI - Battling to regain best form and was 7th last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Cabourg over 2750m on 12 July. Capable of making the frame

8. DOWHATYOUODOWELL - Clearly unreliable but did run well when a runner-up in a Class D Mounted race at Cabourg over 2750m on 12 July. Can go one better this time

9. FERRERO DU LOISIR - Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Vichy on 3 August. Capable of contesting the finish when smart

Summary: IKURO JIEL (3) has been very consistent of late and his third-place finish last month suggested another win was not far away. HUIS CLOS (SWE) (6) is holding form well and is barefoot and ready to fight out the finish once again. DOWHATYOUODOWELL (8) is unreliable but ran well last time out and has a winning chance. FERRERO DU LOISIR (9) is not easy to trust but can contest the finish.

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C2 - PRIX UN MEC D'HERIPRE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. JUDY MATIDY** - Unreliable and was barefoot and third last time out in Class E at Bréhal over 2850m on 29 July. Not unshod this time and this is a tougher task
- 2. KARAKA WOOD** - Unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class B at Enghien over 2875m on 27 July. Has won twice this year and is capable of an upset
- 3. JOURNEE REVEE** - On a very long losing run and was 9th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 27 July. Does pop up in a place every now and then
- 4. JACK DES ASS** - Has disqualification issues but he does win when in the mood and he was a winner last time out in Class D at Craon over 2775m on 23 June. Can complete the hat-trick
- 5. KIWI DE TREMONT** - Struggled in a GR.3. last time out when 13th at Enghien over 2150m on 20 July. In good form before that and is capable of contesting the finish
- 6. JAMES MADRIK** - Has struggled with disqualifications this year and was disqualified last time out at Enghien on 27 July. Could surprise if wise
- 7. JETPACK** - Showed some improvement when runner-up last time out in Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 26 July. Not out of it
- 8. JOYEUX MESLOIS** - Has some fair form of late and was 5th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 27 July. Might play a minor role
- 9. EMIRO CLEMAR** - Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Syracuse on 14 June. Best watched for now
- 10. JET SET** - Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class E at Bréhal over 2850m on 29 July. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 11. JAVELOT** - In good form and was runner-up last time out in Class D at Le Mans over 2200m on 16 July. Has a winning chance
- 12. ERICA JET** - Disqualified last time out Vincennes on 15 May. Returns from a break but can bounce back to score
- 13. DAYTONA DI CECCO** - Has struggled all year and was 6th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 27 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 14. MISS JAJA** - Very unreliable but was a winner last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 27 July. Capable of winning but is hard to trust

Summary: ERICA JET (12) did well enough in better fields than this last winter. She returns from a break but would not be a surprise winner. JACK DES ASS (4) is in good form and is hat-trick-seeking but does have disqualification issues. KIWI DE TREMONT (5) flopped in a GR.3. last time out but could be a threat to these runners. JAMES MADRIK (6) is capable of a surprise if smart.

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C3 - CRITERIUM DE VITESSE DE BASSE-NORMANDIE - 1609m (a1m) - Gr2 Race - Harness - EUR € 120,000

- 1. ELVIS DU VALLON** - Battling to regain winning form and was tenth last time out in a GR.2. at Enghien over 2875m on 27 July. Capable of making the frame this distance
- 2. JUST A GIGOLO** - Has yet to win a race this year and was 6th last time out in a GR.2. at Enghien over 2875m on 27 July. Capable of being competitive this distance
- 3. HOHNECK** - Very good this short distance and was a winner last time out of a GR.2. at Enghien on 13 July. Can follow up
- 4. INMAROSA** - On a very long losing run and was 8th last time out in a GR.2. at Enghien over 2875m on 27 July. Needs to do a bit more to win
- 5. GAMAY DE L'ITON** - Showed some improvement last time out in a GR.2 at Enghien over 2875m on 27 July. Not out of it
- 6. AMPIA MEDE SM** - Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 27 July. Much better these shorter distances and was third to HOHNECK (3) on 13 July. Go close again
- 7. ERIC THE EEL** - Did not show his best form when 11th last time out in Class A at Vincennes over 2850m on 23 June. Capable of an upset on best form
- 8. GANAY DE BANVILLE** - In good shape and was third last time out in a GR.2. at Enghien over 2875m on 27 July. Capable of winning
- 9. BILO JEPSON** - A bit unreliable this year and was 6th last time out in Class A at Vincennes over 2850m on 15 May. Could need this run returning from a break
- 10. FANATIC FLASH** - Holding his form well and was fourth last time out in Class A at Cabourg over 2750m on 19 July. Better under the saddle and others are preferred

Summary: HOHNECK (3) is comfortable going right-handed and was a GR.2 winner last time out over this distance. He has every chance of following up with another victory. AMPIA MEDE SM (6) has been a bit unlucky of late and if there is to be a threat to the selection then she may well be it. JUST A GIGOLO (2) has not won this year but is capable of contesting the finish. GANAY DE BANVILLE (8) is in good form and can get into the mix of things again.

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C4 - PRIX QUAKER JET - 1609m (a1m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. HECTOR DU MINON** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up again in Class H at Berck-sur-Mer over 2600m on 4 August. Could earn some minor money
- 2. I RUN DE JANEIRO** - On a very long losing run and was 9th last time out in Class F at Sainte-Marie-du-Mont over 2425m on 4 August. Others are preferred
- 3. HELIOS D'EURVAD** - Battling to regain best form and was 7th last time out in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 5 August. More is needed to win this race
- 4. ISIA DU CHENE** - Back to her best of late and has won her last two starts, with the latest being in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 21 July. Can complete the hat-trick
- 5. SIDNEY CELEBER** - Has struggled of late and was 9th last time out in Class F at Enghien over 2150m on 24 July. Has won this distance and is not out of it
- 6. ODANA VRIJTHOUT** - Unreliable all year and was 7th last time out in Class F at Enghien over 2150m on 31 July. Might play a minor role
- 7. ILLICO DE BUSSET** - Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class E at Plessé over 3100m on 29 July. Could like this much shorter distance and has a winning chance
- 8. GALTON SAINT BAR** - Did not show his best when 8th last time out in Class E at Saint-Jean-de-Monts over 2625m on 28 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. RAMPANT** - On a very long losing run and was 9th last time out at Rimme over 2140m on 22 December. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 10. BRAVEHEART GRIF** - A runner-up last time out at Taranto over a similar distance on 28 July. Distance-suited and has a place chance
- 11. LOADED LEILA** - Kept to the shorter distance races and was 5th last time out in Class F at Enghien over 2150m on 31 July. Can contest the finish
- 12. OBLIVION** - Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Enghien on 24 July. Capable of a surprise when in the mood

Summary: ISIA DU CHENE (4) looks to be in the form of her life and can complete a hat-trick dropping in distance this time. ILLICO DE BUSSET (7) was not disgraced last time out and could prove far more effective this short distance. LOADED LEILA (11) has speed so this distance should suit nicely. SIDNEY CELEBER (5) has won this trip and is another to consider.

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C5 - PRIX UP AND QUICK - 1609m (a1m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. JEANBAT DANOVER** - Unreliable this year and was 6th last time out in Class E at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 7 August. Capable of making the frame when in the mood
- 2. JEREMICE MERITE** - Did not show her best when 7th last time out in Class E at Vittel over 2700m on 14 July. Has a winning chance dropped in trip
- 3. JUNIOR DE PLAY** - Has struggled of late and was 8th last time out in Class E at Granville over 3125m on 6 August. Others are much preferred
- 4. JUPANQUIE TONIQUE** - Not disgraced when 5th last time out at In Class E at Pornichet-La Baule over 2150m on 18 July. Likely to love this shorter distance and could be the one to beat
- 5. JAZZ VERONE** - At the top of his game and was a winner last time out in Class E at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne over 2850m on 21 July. Can complete a hat-trick
- 6. JET SET DU BELLAY** - Disappointing of late and was 8th last time out in Class E at Sablé-sur-Sarthe over 2850m on 28 July. Capable of making the frame this distance
- 7. JUVAMINE RENARDIER** - On a very long losing run and was 5th last time out in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 21 July. Could play a minor role
- 8. GLOBAL DUTY** - Has some fair form of late and was 5th last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 4 August. Capable of an upset
- 9. JUSTAUCORPS** - On a very long losing run and was 6th last time out in Class E at Biarritz over 2975m on 26 July. More is needed to win
- 10. JACK FOULONIERE** - Probably in need of both runs this year and was 6th last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 4 August, Could be the surprise package of the race

Summary: JUPANQUIE TONIQUE (4) has the speed to thrive from her starting position and could make it all to beat these rivals. JEREMICE MERITE (2) did not show her best last time out but could like this shorter distance and deserves respect. JAZZ VERONE (5) has struck a purple patch of form and could be competitive again. JEANBAT DANOVER (1) is unreliable but could make the frame.

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C6 - PRIX AUBRION DU GERS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. KING GEORGES ELLIS** - Unreliable and was third last time in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 19 July. Can contest the finish again
- 2. KORA DE BLARY** - Battling to regain best form and was 9th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 April. Could need this run returning from a break
- 3. KING OF DAY** - Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class D at Rochefort-sur-Loire over 3000m on 22 July. Can make the frame again
- 4. KING BLACK DANOVER** - Only fair of late and was 6th last time out in Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 2 August. Capable of earning some minor money
- 5. KARAIELLA BOND** - Unreliable all year and was 5th last time out in Class B at Meslay-du-Maine over 2850m on 30 July. Might play a minor role
- 6. KERU DE LOU** - Disappointing last run when 11th in Class D at Engien over this distance on 27 July. Barefoot for the first time and is capable of bouncing back to score
- 7. KLARCK** - In good form of late and was a winner last time out in Class E at La Capelle over 2700m on 7 July. Keeps that shoe arrangement and is not out of it
- 8. KELOWNA LEGEND** - In very good form this year and was a winner last time out E at Cabourg over 2725m on 5 July. Has won three times his year and can win again
- 9. KATHLEEN D'ECOTAY** - Has ability but was 8th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2150m on 29 December. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 10. KARABOUDJAN** - In good form of late and was a winner last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2050m on 16 July. Can double up
- 11. KAID DEL GREEN** - Disappointing of late and was 9th last time in Class D at Cabourg over 2725m on 23 July. Capable of winning when in the mood
- 12. KINGSTON DU BOURG** - Disappointing form of late and was 9th last time out in Class D at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 20 July. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 13. KAMBRIA JOSSELYN** - Has struggled all year and was 12th last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 23 July. Needs major improvement to win
- 14. KIRWAN THORIS** - Yet to win a race but has been runner-up in his last two starts, with the latest being in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 26 July. Place chance
- 15. KAZAN DE VANDEL** - Unreliable again this year and was 6th last time out in Class B at Meslay-du-Maine over 2850m on 30 July. Needs to do more to win this race
- 16. KONG** - Has lost his way this year and was disqualified last time out at Carentan on 13 July. Best watched for now

Summary: KERU DE LOU (6) has been a disappointment this year but is talented. he will be barefoot for the very first time and can bounce back to score. KELOWNA LEGEND (8) has already won three times this year and will not go down without a fight. KING GEORGES ELLIS (1) is unreliable but can contest the finish. KING OF DAY (3) has yet to win but is in good shape and is not out of it.

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C7 - PRIX CAPITAL MAIL - 2875m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Riders Race - Mounted - EUR € 19,000

- 1. JUVACAT DE CAPONET** - Disappointing last run when 12th in a Class F Mounted race at Cabourg over 2750m on 12 July. In good form before that and could play a minor role
- 2. JUST ME NESLE** - Best when barefoot and was 5th last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 25 July. Consistent under the saddle and can earn some money
- 3. JAZZMAN IDEF** - Picked up a fifth win of the year when scoring last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Carentan over this distance on 13 July. Deserves respect for the win
- 4. JADE DU PARC** - Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being in at Pornichet-La Baule on 6 July. Others are preferred
- 5. JOBERMAN DU HOME** - Unreliable of late but was a winner last time out of a Class F Mounted race at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre over 3000m on 4 August. Has a place chance
- 6. JUST PACHA** - Disappointing of late and was disqualified last time out at Carentan on 13 July. Capable of better and could contest the finish if wise
- 7. JOIE DES VENTES** - Much improved this year and has won three of four starts with this shoe arrangement, with the latest win in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 23 July. Be right there at the finish
- 8. JOTT DU BOCAGE** - Not disgraced when third last time out in Class F at Carentan over this distance on 13 July. Has won twice this year and can score again
- 9. INITIALE MACHA** - On a very long losing run and was 7th last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Compiègne over 2800m on 27 July. Others are much preferred
- 10. JURANCON** - Has struggled all year and was 6th last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Feurs over 2225m on 5 July. Needs major improvement to win
- 11. JET BESP** - Unreliable this year but did run well when runner-up last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Vire over 2825m on 1 July. Not out of it
- 12. HARRY DU LYS** - Has been in good shape this year and was a runner-up last time out in a Class H Mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 22 July. Has a place chance
- 13. I LOVE DU CHERISAY** - Has needed both runs this year and was 8th last time out in a Class E harness race at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne over 2850m on 21 July. Could be the surprise package of the race back under the saddle
- 14. HERICK DE LA POTEL** - Has really struggled this year and was disqualified last time out at Domfront on 28 July. Others are much preferred

Summary: A competitive-looking race. JOTT DU BOCAGE (8) ran well when third last time out and could win for the third time this year. JOIE DES VENTES (7) has made vast improvements with the current shoe arrangement and will be a serious threat yet again. JET BESP (11) has been unreliable of late but has to be considered a possible winner. JUST PACHA (6) has been disappointing recently but can make the frame.

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C8 - PRIX QUINOA DU GERS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LUNE DU DOUET** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, with the latest being at Enghien on 31 July. Capable of making the frame when wise
- 2. LICORNE QUICK** - A runner-up in two of three starts so far, with the latest being in Class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 19 July. Be right there at the finish once again
- 3. LYSANDRA** - Has improved with each run and was a winner last time out in Class F at Guerlesquin over 2900m on 28 July. Deserves respect for that win and is not out of it
- 4. LOBSTER DU BELLAY** - Not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 12 July. Big chance in this line-up
- 5. LACERTOSUS** - Disqualified last time out at Rouen-Mauquenchy on 25 July. Better over further before that and others are preferred
- 6. LE BOSS DANOVER** - Needed his last run when 5th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over this distance on 25 July. Could play a minor role
- 7. LYX OF CAMARO** - Consistent so far and was third last time out in Class E at this course over 2875m on 21 July. Can contest the finish again
- 8. LOOKING BEST** - Did not show his best when 8th last time out in Class D at Angers over 2350m on 11 April. Could need this run returning from a break
- 9. LILI DE POMMERAYE** - Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at Carentan on 28 July. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 10. LIBERTANGO** - Showed what he is capable of with a win in Class F at La Ferté-Vidame over 2750m on 4 August. Tackles stronger but has a place chance
- 11. LUNE D'OCCAGNES** - Disqualified in two of four starts but was a winner last time out in Class H at Bréhal over 2325m on 23 July. Can upset
- 12. LILAE D'OSMOZ** - Disqualified last time out at Clairefontaine-Deauville on 20 July. Had some fair form before that but others are preferred
- 13. LOUISIANE** - Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 22 April. Could need this run returning from a break

Summary: A very tough lucky last race. LOBSTER DU BELLAY (4) was not disgraced when fourth last month and should run another decent race. LICORNE QUICK (2) deserves a win after two runner-up performances in just three starts. LYSANDRA (3) is improving and has a winning chance. LYX OF CAMARO (7) is consistent and likely to fight out the finish once again.
