## C1 - PRIX HOTEL BARRIERE LE ROYAL DEAUVILLE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Race - Flat - EUR € 14,000

- **1. MOUTRAKI -** Disappointing form of late and was 6th last time out in a handicap over this track and trip on 22 October. Has won over this course and distance before and has a place chance
- **2. DOCTEUR TOURNESOL -** In good form and was runner-up last time out in a handicap over this track and trip on 22 October. Can go one better
- **3. ALROMY -** A winner of two of her last four starts but was only 9th last time out in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 2150m on 25 October. Better on the grass and has a winning chance
- **4. WHIP DRALLIV -** Disappointing form of late and was 6th last time out in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 2400m on 4 November. Could play a minor role
- **5. SANCHO -** On a very long losing run but was runner-up last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 2800m on 18 October. Not out of it

**Summary:** A small field but a very competitive race. DOCTEUR TOURNESOL (2) is in very good shape and was only caught very late last time out at this course. He can go one better. ALROMY (3) is in very good form and her last run on the PSf is best ignored. She will be a threat. SANCHO (5) has not won for some time but got close last time out and can contest the finish again. MOUTRAKI (1) has won over this track and trip before and deserves some respect.

- **1. DARLING DARLING -** Has lost the way of late and was 11th last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 3 November. Capable of better back at this track and is not out of it
- **2. ELDIO -** Disappointing of late and was 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 4 September. Better on the PSF
- **3. LORD OF WAR -** Showed improvement when fourth last time out in a Conditions race at this course over 1800m on 22 October. Big chance in this line-up
- **4. PALMAROLA -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a Conditions race at this track over 2000m on 16 September. Better over further but has a winning chance
- **5. THIENE Non partante**
- **6. NOVA KEN -** Unreliable of late and was 5th last time out in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 22 October. May need to do more to win this race

**Summary:** LORD OF WAR (3) has won at this track before. He showed improvement last time and should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. PALMAROLA (4) may be at very best over further but is clearly not out of it. THIENE (5) is in very good and woul not be a surprise winner. DARLING DARLING (1) has struggled of late but could contest the finish back at this course.

## C3 - PRIX LOUIS ESPANET - 1700m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming - Flat - EUR € 16,000

- **1. IZASTEP -** Unreliable but did win a handicap last time out at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 9 October. Can double up back in a claimer
- **2. SLEEPY SUZY -** Has a good record in this division and was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1400m on 25 October. Be right there at the finish
- **3. INDIAN PACIFIC** Disappointing last run when 9th in a Conditions race at this course over 1800m on 30 October. Can contest the finish
- **4. SPIRIT GREY -** Unreliable of late and was 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-La Soie over 2400m on 25 October. Drops in distance could spark improvement
- **5. GOLD PLAYER -** Disappointing recent form and was 12th last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 1500m on 23 October. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **6. PIANINO -** Unreliable and was 7th last time out in a Conditions race at Pau over 2000m on 19 October. Did better at this track before that and has a winning chance
- **7. MAMA IMELDA -** Has lost her way of late and was 12th last time out in a handicap at this track over 1800m on 30 October. Place chance on best form

**Summary:** IZASTEP (1) returned to form with a good win on the PSF last time out. He does seem to prefer that surface but won so well he might just win again. SLEEPY SUZY (2) has done well in claimers before and will not go down with a real fight for top honours. INDIAN PACIFIC (3) is better than the last run would suggest. PIANINO (6) has done well at this course before and is not out of it.

- **1. FORCE TRANQUILLE -** In good form and was third last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 12 October. Be right there at the finish
- **2. LOU MAN -** Did not show his best when tenth in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 21 October. Will do better back on the grass and has a winning chance
- **3. RIO D'OCTOBRE** Has struggled of late and was 11th last time out in a handicap at this course over 1800m on 30 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. INTERSTELLA -** Did not show her best when 6th last time out in a handicap at Vichy over 3000m on 7 August. Better this distance and is not out of it
- **5. MAX VERST -** Good last run when runner-up in a handicap at this track over 1800m on 30 October. can go one better this time
- **6. PERDRIOLLE -** Unreliable but was fourth last time out at Hyeres over 1850m on 29 September. Tougher task in this line-up
- **7. AQUILON -** Unreliable and was tenth last time out in a handicap at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1800m on 25 October. Better this distance and can be competitive
- **8. WILD SWEETHEART -** Only modest of late and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 12 October. Others are preferred
- **9. BEIJINHO -** Unreliable of late but was fourth last time out in a handicap at this course over 1800m on 30 October. Capable of playing a minor role

**Summary:** LOU MAN (2) disappointed on the PSF last time out. He is betetr on the turf and can bounce back to score. MAX VERST (5) only found one better on the day at this course last time out and deserves respect in this line-up. FORCE TRANQUILLE (1) is in good shape and will be right there at the finish yet again. AQUILON (7) is better this distance but is not easy to trust entirely.

- **1. HERMES WOOD -** A winner of both his starts so far, with the latest being in a Claimer at Lyon-La Soie over 1800m on 25 October. Tackles stronger but may well be up to it
- **2. STARNBERG -** Unbeaten in two starts, with the latest being a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 1800m on 30 September. Can complete the hat-trick
- **3. MIDNIGHT ESCAPE -** Has not shown much in two claimers and was 7th last time out at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 12 October. Needs to do more to win
- **4. PASTISSE -** Picked up a handicap win last time out at this track over 1700m on 30 October. Could be even betetr this distance so deserves respect
- **5. TANFEPAS -** Has improved with each run and was victorious last time out in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 22 October. Can follow up
- **6. WEEMAGATEE -** Did not show much on debut when tenth in a Conditions race at this course over 2000m on 22 October. Needs major improvement to win

**Summary:** STARNBERG (2) is unbeaten in two starts and both of his wins were impressive. It will take a big run to beat this time again. PASTISSE (4) was a game winner of a handicap last time out and is more experienced so will be a threat. HERMES WOOD (1) has done all that has been asked of him but this a tougher task. TANFEPAS (5) is improving and can also get into the mix of things.

- **1. DILAWAR -** In a good patch of form with two good recne t wins, the latest being in a Listed race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 1 October. Can complete the hat-trick
- **2. MORPHEWAN -** Very consistent of late and was third last time out in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over this distance on 30 September. Not out of it
- **3. CAMBRONNE -** Back at the top of his game and was victorious last time out in a Conditions race at this track over 1700m on 22 October. Can complete a hat-trick
- **4. BAY D'ARGENT -** Very consistent and was runner-up last time out in a Conditiosn race at Salon-de-Provence over 2000m on 30 September. Could earn some more money
- **5. DAR TOUNGI -** At his best this distance and was runner-up last time out in a Listed race at Strasbourg over 2100m on 15 September. Can go one better this time
- **6. PERLE ROUGE** Disappointing recent form and was 7th last time out in a Conditions race at this track over 1700m on 22 October. Needs to do a bit more to win

# C7 - PRIX PAUL GAUTIER - 1700m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,000

- **1. DON FALCO -** Has struggled of late and was tenth last time out in a handicap at this course over 1200m on 22 October. Better on the PSF and others are much preferred
- **2. NOBLE AMBER -** Unreliable and was 8th last time out in a handicap at Compiègne over 1400m on 11 October. Won her penultimate start and could bounce back to score
- **3. BLANC BLEU -** On a very long losing run but was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 9 October. Can go one better this time
- **4. ESTOKENIA -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 9 Otober. A winner over this track and trip before that and is not out of it
- **5. USER KINDLY -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 21 October. has won at this course before and is capable of a surprise
- **6. EKTORIA -** Unreliable and was 8th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 9 October. Did better at this course before that and has a place chance
- **7. SPORT COUPE -** Did not show his best when 12th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 9 October. Will prefer it back on the grass and has a place chance
- **8. GREYWAY -** Unreliable but was victorious last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 29 April. Could need this run returning from a break
- **9. LIVING NELSON -** On a very long losing run but was third last time out in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 2150m on 25 October. In good form and has a winning chance
- **10. RED TORCH -** Has struggled of late and was 9th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 12 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **11. TOUTELUSIVE -** Disappointing of late and was 8th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 12 October. Others are preferred

**Summary:** LIVING NELSON (9) is in good form and clearly very competitive off this mark so could be ready to break a long losing run. NOBLE AMBER (2) is unreliable but has shone at this track before and should be a lively danger. ESTOKENIA (4) has also won at this track and is capable of contesting the finish. - **1. RABBAH** Much improved of late and was a winner last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 9 October. Carries a 2.50kg penalty but can follow up
- 2. PIERRE LE GRAND On a very long losing run but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 29 October. Can contest the finish again
- **3. SOAN -** Disappointing form of late and was 9th last time out in a handicap over this track and trip on 22 October. Capable of an upset on best form
- **4. LE KAKOU -** Showed some improvement when 5th last time out in a Conditions race at Cavaillon over 1600m on 27 October. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **5. SILVER SCHNOK -** A runner-up three times this year including last time out in a Conditions race at Nimes over 1900m on 1 November. Has a place chance
- **6. COME TI AMO** Holding her form and was third last time out in a Conditions race at Cavaillon over 1600m on 27 October. Not out of it
- **7. CHEEKY TRAOU LAND -** Disappointing of late and was 9th last time out in a Conditions race at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 1600m on 20 May. Capable of better and could earn some minor money
- **8. TERRE SACREE -** In good shape and was fourth last time out in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1900m on 5 November. Has a winning chance
- **9. MOUDIR -** On a very long losing run and was 6th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 9 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
