# C1 - PRIX GENY COURSES - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class G Race - Harness - EUR € 19,000

- **1. IMAGE D'AIROU -** Won a provincial claimer before repeating in a 2825m Chartres Class E 2 weeks ago. Is new to the venue but in current form is very easy to like. Chance
- **2. INTEMPOREL -** Makes first start since finishing 13th of 15 in a 2750m Class F at La Capelle 4 months ago. Has been afforded time to freshen up and, given his liking for Mauquenchy, can get straight back down to business
- **3. ISOLACCIO** Back in the professional ranks after coming 4th of 9 in a 2850m Vincennes amateurs Class F a month ago. Enjoys a decent draw, is reconfigured for the occasion, and with Pierre-Yves Verva reining should not be far off the mark
- **4. ICARE DU DOUET -** Encouraged at La Capelle before disappointing in a 2725m Evreux Class H late-September. Hails from a stable in good form and after a short rest, makes his Mauquenchy debut with a good hand to play
- **5. IT'S THE KING -** Reassuring 5th of 14 in a 2750m Cabourg Class D early-October. Drops back in category and, from the 5-spot, can play an active role
- **6. INESTELLE -** Ran 5th of 14, at 52/1, in a 2150m Enghien Class E a month ago. Gabi Gelormini back in the bike and is ideally-placed to play a leading role
- **7. INVECTUS JELOCA -** Won 2 before running 4th of 14 in a 2850m Durtal Class F on 13 October. Is unbeaten over course and distance and must be considered a contender
- **8. IBLISS MAYBE -** Disappointing in last 2, latterly 11th of 11 in a 2500m Reims Class E 3 weeks ago, and will have nothing to offer
- **9. I AM JELOCA -** Sanctioned, at evens, in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle mid-September. Is never far from surprising but with shoes on is unlikely to shake things up
- **10. IBIS D'AUVRECY -** Imposed at Châlons before finishing 7th of 11 in a 2650m Laon Class F on 13 October, and others preferred
- **11. IBRA DE LOU -** Disqualified from 5th at Vincennes before being headed in a 2825m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche 9 days ago. Paul Ploquin back in the bike and, despite the draw, is not one to be underestimated
- **12. INCROYABLE TALENT -** Sanctioned in a 2825m Chartres Class E late last month. Imposed at Pornichet in this configuration but has no love for Mauquenchy and others easier to back this time
- **13. IRONWOOD PARIS -** Placed twice under harness before finishing 5th of 9 in a 2750m monté Class F at La Capelle 2 months ago. Returns to racing barefoot and, with some luck in running, could get a look-in
- **14. INDIEN PASS -** Trounced at Vincennes before finishing 11th of 14, behind INVECTUS JELOCA (7), in a 2850m Durtal Class F on 13 October, and can be ruled out

- **15. ILFUEGO -** Makes first appearance since finishing last but one in a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche late-September and the draw only compounds matters
- **16. IRIS DES MAUPI -** Sanctioned in a 2700m Machecoul Class E 3 weeks ago. Is plainly in form but has little going for her here

**Summary:** Very much an open affair, but it will be very hard to ignore the useful INTEMPOREL (2) if he has come back into himself since the summer break. IMAGE D'AIROU (1) though, comes here on a hat-trick and can pull it off if Antonin André manages to position her early. Solid at Lisieux before pleasantly surprising at Enghien, INESTELLE (6) has a decent spot in front and will have her chances. INVECTUS JELOCA (7) is in cracking form, won here barefoot last autumn, and is unlikely to be far from the action.

- **1. JANGO ELEVEN -** Returned to winning ways a fortnight ago, securing a 3300m Chartres Class F. Forced to start on the rail and, in this company, is not about to spring a surprise
- **2. JAGUAR DE BELFOND -** Surprising 2nd at Graignes before losing his action in a 2875m Enghien Class E a fortnight ago. Hind shoes off but can still be passed over
- **3. JOLIE FLEUR OR -** Blows hot and cold but reassuring 2nd of 11 in a 2550m Reims Class F 3 weeks ago. New to the venue but is drawn well and not incapable of getting a look-in
- **4. JALISCA FLIGNY -** Mare of ample ability but disappointing of late, most recently 9th of 11 in a 2850m Vincennes Class E late last month and, in spite of a good draw, chances still seem limited
- **5. JOG JELOCA -** Honest type racing barefoot for first time after finishing 10th of 15, when prepping for this, in a 2750m Cabourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Solid going left-handed and looks a possible spoiler
- **6. JEROMINUS TURGOT -** Serious sort that ran close 2nd of 14 in a 2850m Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne last Sunday. Faces a moderate bunch this time and can open his autumn account
- **7. JAYZI DU BOURG -** Never-dangerous 7th of 15 in a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel last weekend, and is not about to cause an upset
- **8. JOUR DE TONNERRE -** Takes a dip in category after finishing 12th of 15 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E a month ago. Starts wide on front line but won his only run here and cannot be discounted
- **9. JAIDA DE MAY -** 7th of 14 in a 2700m Le Croisé-Laroche Class E mid-October. Should appreciate this shorter trip and is unlikely to disappoint, provided Jonathan Vanmeerbeck manages to negotiate the draw
- **10. JACKPOT DE L'ENVOL -** Rewarded with victory in a 2700m Segré Class F on 7 October. Unlikely to double his money but can still challenge for a spot on the podium
- **11. JAGGER D'AUT -** Produced 4 fine performances before faulting in a 2400m Amiens Class E on 5 October. Handed a tough draw but Florian Desmigneux in the bike this time and can set things straight
- **12. JERIDIA MENUET** Modest 6th of 9 finishers in a 2625m Cherbourg claimer on 6 October, and has no possible chance
- **13. JULIUS BERRY -** 8th of 11 in a 2150m Enghien Class E mid-October. Has nothing going for him here and can be ignored
- **14. JOIE GIBUS -** Capable mare but makes first appearance since being sanctioned in a 2725m Graignes Class E last February and is going to need the run
- **15. JAZZ -** Sanctioned in 2 of 3 so far this term, latterly a 2750m Cabourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Pulled an unappealing draw and is not easy to make a case
- **16. JAYF -** Tenacious winner of a 2750m Cabourg Class E on 3 October. Imposed on lone run at the venue and can repeat if Pierre-Yves Verva successfully navigates the start

**Summary:** Nicely-positioned on the front line after having shown his form in Brittany a week ago, JEROMINUS TURGOT (6) goes well for Jean-Etienne Abrivard and has every chance of winning this. In stark contrast, JAYF (16) has pulled a shocking draw, but the nature of his recent success bodes well for his prospects. Unlucky last time out, but otherwise in excellent shape, the unappealingly-positioned JAGGER D'AUT (11) can still finish close. Difficult to fault when racing barefoot, JACKPOT DE L'ENVOL (10) debuts at the venue with a reasonable chance of confirming his Segré success,

- **1. KAROLUS FAIR -** Comes here rested, not having been seen out since finishing 6th of 12 in a 2850m Laval Class E late-August. Has yet to deliver at Mauquenchy but has merit and, if focused, can figure prominently
- 2. KALLAGAN Sanctioned in a 2150m Enghien claimer mid-October. Gelormini in the bike again but others still preferred
- **3. KENZO BEACH -** Won a Graignes Class F before running 3rd of 10 finishers in a 2400m Amiens Class E a fortnight ago, and will not be sent out at 57/1 this time
- **4. KING DE LA COTE -** Won a 2750m Class F at La Capelle last Sunday. Handed an excellent draw but stays shod and best to hold off
- **5. KING DU PONT -** Tricky individual starting for first time since being sanctioned in a 2750m Cabourg Class F late-August. Has considerable ability, and is well-drawn, but racing shod may just be the limiting factor
- **6. KOOKY BEN MAX -** 5th of 10 finishers, behind KENZO BEACH (3), in a 2400m Amiens Class E a fortnight ago. Unlikely to improve much on that but can still get in on the action
- **7. KAOLIN MOUROTAIS -** Unexceptional 5th of 8 in a 2725m Graignes Class F 8 days ago. Shoes back on and others easier to back
- **8. KANKAL -** Courageous 4th of 10 finishers, a place behind KENZO BEACH (3), in a 2400m Amiens Class E a fortnight ago, and will again be competitive for a place in the frame
- **9. KONRAD DE CORDAY -** 3rd of 12, on first start back, in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F 9 days ago. Will have come on for the run and, similarly-shod, can impose this time
- **10. KADO DE VANDEL -** Unremarkable colt making first start since finishing last of 8 in a 2925m Cagnes Class D late-July. Shoes off but still not a priority
- **11. KOURASI LEPINE -** 64/1 winner at Le Croise-Laroche before sanctioned, when having difficulty turning, in Amiens race of reference. Returns to racing left-handed and with the aid of P-Y Verva, can pick up some prizemoney
- **12. KILDARE -** Made short work of a 2950m Saint-Malo Class E on 29 September. Unraced since and even though reverting to a previous formula, still has the capacity to finish close
- **13. KOLCANI JEEP -** Surprise 3rd of 10 in a 2150m Enghien claimer mid-October. Handed a 2nd-line draw and chances limited

**Summary:** Impressive on his first start since the spell, KONRAD DE CORDAY (9) has demonstrated very good aptitude when unshod-behind and, draw notwithstanding, looks thoroughly capable of winning this. KILDARE (12) is on the back line but won superbly for his apprentice last time out and has already imposed in the day's configuration. Better-placed on the front row, KENZO BEACH (3) has climbed the category-ladder well lately and must be taken more seriously than he was at Amiens. A place behind him that day, KANKAL (8) starts wide on the first line but is both game and versatile and can trot his way onto the podium.

- GOAL DE LA MORTRIE Serious trotter starting for first time since winning a 3150m Saint-Brieuc Class F last March, and will need the outing
- **2. GALOPIN DE POTES -** Sanctioned in last 4, most recently a 2825m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche on 2 October, and will have few friends
- **3. INDIAN MYSTIC** Last of 11, on first start since the spell, in a 2750m Cabourg Class D 2.5 weeks ago, and will first need to re-establish his credentials
- **4. HATE YOU BEYLEV -** 3rd here before running courageous 2nd of 12 in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 30 September. Shoes on this time but still looks competitive for a spot in the mix
- **5. IQUITA VILI -** 6th of 11 in a 2750m Le Pertre Class E, when preparing for this, a fortnight ago. Has talent in spades and will have a lot to contribute if Pierre-Yves Verva keeps her focused
- **6. IRIS THORIS** 2nd of 7 finishers in a 2250m Enghien Class E 3 weeks ago. Takes on a better bunch this time but still has the wherewithal to get in on the action
- **7. IBILI D'OCCAGNES -** Useful sort making first appearance since being sanctioned in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 19 September. Still in conditioning mode though and best to keep one's powder dry
- **8. HERINE D'OCCAGNES -** Unremarkable 7th of 8 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E a month ago. Out of sorts since the summer though and, with shoes on, cannot be considered a player
- **9. GITAN DE TOUCHYVON -** Won 2 and placed 3 times in last 5 under the saddle, latterly 3rd of 9 in a 2850m Laon Class F on 13 October. Not expected to win this but can still continue the productive run
- **10. GOLD DE JADE -** Last of 10, on return to competition, in a 2875m Enghien Class D mid-October. Will have progressed for the run and, competitively-shod, looks a serious proposition
- **11. HERCULE DU PARC -** Last of 15 in a 2700m harness Class E at Le Croise-Laroche early this month, and will not be springing any surprises
- **12. IN LOVE DE BLARY -** Sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes harness Class D when being conditioned late last month. Has buckets of ability and will be a tough nut to crack if she stays in stride
- **13. GOLIATH DU RIEU -** Debuts in the discipline after finishing 6th of 13 in a 2725m Lisieux harness Class F early this month. Enjoys a good entry though and will be one to watch

**Summary:** Victorious in 2 of her last 4 starts under the saddle, IN LOVE DE BLARY (12) enjoys a fine entry here and, already a winner for Paul Ploquin, she reverts to a successful formula and looks the pick of the field. No slouch either, and proven under these conditions, GOLD DE JADE (10) races unshod-behind for the first time and, with application, will not go down without a fight. GITAN DE TOUCHYVON (9) has been like a horse reborn since July and has shown a particular liking for Mauquenchy. The complicated but talented IQUITA VILI (5) has 2 races under her belt, is barefoot for her first objective of the autumn, and on good behaviour will be no easy touch.

- **1. KELISSA D'AVE -** Unraced since being sanctioned in a 2050m Cabourg Class E last July, and has no possible chance here
- **2. KARMINA DU BREUCQ -** Surprise 7th of 14, on return to competition, in a 2700m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche early last month. Is not short of ability though and, on good behaviour, could pleasantly surprise
- **3. KOME BACK LADY -** Respectable 4th of 13 in a 2400m Amiens Class E a fortnight ago. 4 pads fitted for first time though and represents a minor place chance at best this time
- **4. KALINE DE VIRE -** Went into her vacation on a high note and returned at Nantes 2 weeks ago, coming 2nd of 10 in a 2275m Class E. Ideally-placed behind the car and looks the one to beat
- **5. KALA DES RACQUES -** Has not been seen out since running 6th of 9 in a 2400m Amiens Class E early-August. Sports a new configuration for return and, from the 5-spot, will be worth monitoring
- **6. KELLY DU MENIL -** In the frame in last 3, latterly 3rd of 6 finishers in a 2550m Dieppe Class E mid-September. Takes on a better lot this time and others preferred
- **7. KRYSEIS -** Sent for a rest after finishing 8th of 11 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 24 August. Showed her capacity during the spring and, plainly in competition-mode, can open her autumn account
- **8. KOPAZE DE HOUELLE -** Has been struggling of late, most recently sanctioned in a 3250m Saumur Class F last weekend. Has evident ability however and it is only a question of time before she gets back in the game. Attention

- **14. KANDIA DUCALE -** Opened her 2024 account when successful in a 2700m Graignes Class F 3 weeks ago but, in this category, and sporting hind pads, will struggle to make her mark

Even though placed wide on the first row, KOPAZE DE HOUELLE (8) has nothing to prove at this level and, reconfigured for the occasion, will be competitive...as long as she stays in stride.

- **3. JABIOLE BELLEMARE -** Runner-up in her last 4, latterly a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 22 October, but it is only a matter of time before she gets that maiden monkey off her back. Chance
- **4. JUST BE GOOD -** Last of 10 in a 2700m harness Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche 9 days ago. Has done nothing noteworthy for some time and is not about to break the mould
- **5. JEHAN -** Reassuring 2nd at Cabourg before being sanctioned at the start of a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 22 October, and others preferred
- **6. JADE DE BLARY -** Was being prepped for this when sanctioned in a 2700m Graignes harness Class F 3 weeks ago. Is better than most here and, with application, can wrap this up
- **7. JOIE DE VIVRE -** 6th of 11, behind JABIOLE BELLEMARE (3), in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 22 October. Is better than that though, has Mauquenchy references, and must be taken seriously
- **8. JACK FLUSH -** Encouraging 4th of 12 in a 2500m Reims harness Class F a month ago and, if form transitions, can get in on the action
- **9. JAPPELOUP DES PRES -** Unremarkable 7th of 12 in a 2425m Angers Class F 3 weeks ago. Has otherwise been in fine form but, in this category, cannot be considered more than a minor place prospect
- **10. JOKER DES ISLES -** Makes first appearance since running 9th of 13 in a 2725m Pornichet harness Class D on 21 September. Will have freshness on his side, seldom disappoints in this code, and is unlikely to be going home empty-handed
- **11. JACKPOT BREIZH -** Surprising 3rd of 15 in a 3250m Saumur harness Class F 3 weeks ago. Has otherwise been out of sorts and will have little to contribute

- **15. JOVANY -** Has not been seen out since coming 4th to JINGER (2) in a 2800m Vire Class F early-September. Has bags of class but just hind pads fitted this time and best to wait
- **16. JUNIOR INTRIGANT -** 10th of 12 when preparing for this in a 2725m Pornichet harness Class F 10 days ago. Should take well to the new conditions and will be expected to finish in the mix at the business end of affairs

**Summary:** A quality individual but never far from faulting, JADE DE BLARY (6) races barefoot for this first time this term and will just need to stay in stride to win a race of this nature. JABIOLE BELLEMARE (3) has been knocking at the door over recent months and even racing shod, still looks dangerous. JOIE DE VIVRE (7) went close last time here, takes a dip in category, and will have her chances. Nicely-engaged here, and barefoot after a harness conditioner, JUNIOR INTRIGANT (16) must be afforded respect.

- **3. LUIGI SALICE -** Encouraged at Le Croisé-Laroche before finishing 6th of 7 in a 2900m Amiens Class B a fortnight ago. Takes a dip in category but still has no possible chance
- **4. LEADER WIND -** Won on debut before confirming in a 2725m Lisieux Class E on 22 October. Is brimming with talent and has every chance of keeping his perfect record intact
- **5. LOVE FEELING -** Got off the mark nicely in a 2900m Challans Class E on 13 October. Yet to disappoint when fitted with pads and is unlikely to buck the trend
- **6. LORENZO DE BUCY -** Ran 4th at Laval before coming 3rd of 11 in a 2750m Cabourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Pads fitted once more and will be expected to challenge for a place in first 3
- **7. LADY VICTORY -** Surprise 4th at Caen before being quickly sanctioned in a 2875m Enghien Class D 3.5 weeks ago, and is not about to cause an upset
- **8. LOBSTER DU BELLAY -** 4th of 12 in a 2725m Cabourg Class E on 3 October. Untried left-handed but Gabi Gelormini in the bike this time and will be afforded every chance
- **9. LUDO PAROYO -** Winner of last 2, latterly a 2950m Saint-Malo Class E late-September. Pierre-Yves Verva drafted in and, while unlikely to pull off the hat-trick, can still figure prominently
- **10. LADY DU VALLON -** Flattering 4th at Vincennes before finishing last of 9 in a 2150m Enghien Class D a month back. Shoes back on and others preferred
- **11. LOKIE KADESH -** 6th of 11, on return to competition, in a 2875m Enghien Class D mid-October, but is unlikely to improve on that
- **12. LOCKDOWN POWER -** Useful future prospect making first appearance since coming 3rd of 13 in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle on 23 September. Has had time to recuperate and, if focused, can finish in thick of things

**Summary:** Unbeaten in both starts to date, LEADER WIND (4) goes left-handed for the first time and, even though fully shod, will still garner the lion's share of support. LE BIBI DAIRPET (13) made up at Nantes for his Ecommoy blip and poses the main threat. Winner last month, LOVE FEELING (5) faces a stiffer test going the other direction this time, but has thrived with pads fitted and can still finish close. - 2. FARMONY DE JUPILLE In the frame in 4 of last 5, latterly 3rd of 14 in a 2500m Reims amateurs Class G a month ago. Starts in front and, although unlikely to impose, can still make her presence felt. First 5
- **3. IMOKO HAUFOR -** Showed marked improvement when 3rd of 14 in a 2700m Segre Class F late-September, and from the 3-spot can play a leading role
- **4. GY DU GANEP -** 5th of 14 in a 2700m amateurs Class G at Le Croisé-Laroche mid-October. Has not won for a year but always gives his best and can again figure prominently
- **5. ITALIANO -** Reassured somewhat when 4th of 12 in a 2550m Dieppe Class F mid-September. Is well-positioned in front but still appears to be facing a stiff test
- **6. GOLDEN LORD MIJACK -** 9th of 12 in a 2850m amateurs Class H at Nuillé-sur-Vicoin on 13 October. Is clearly off the boil and can be ruled out
- **7. INDY DES BOTS -** Respectable 5th of 12 in a 2400m Amiens Class F 2 weeks ago. Stable enjoying fine form, is entrusted to a capable amateur, and is eminently capable of lifting this
- **8. HUTA JAZZ -** Drops back to the division in which she has shown potential, after running 5th of 13 in a 2700m Graignes Class F 3 weeks ago. Has previous experience of Mauquenchy and should be taken very seriously
- **9. ILETRO JULRY -** 4th at Amiens before trailing in last of 9 in a 2825m Chartres Class E a fortnight ago. Poorly-drawn and difficult to recommend
- **10. GOVANON -** Unraced since being sanctioned in a 2800m Rambouillet amateurs Class G mid-September. Is confirmed in this division but not easy to trust
- **11. INES PICARDE -** 9th of 11, behind GY DU GANEP (4), in a 2400m Amiens amateurs Class G early last month. Has been off her game for some time and can be passed over

**Summary:** Runner-up in her last 3 amateur starts, both ISBA DU DOME (1) and her driver have earned the right to win one. INDY DES BOTS (7) has less experience of the division but showed good aptitude last June and drops back in category with a realistic chance of imposing. New to the venue and new to the amateur division, IMOKO HAUFOR (3) is nicely-positioned behind the car and even racing shod, still looks a player. HUTA JAZZ (8) twice held her own in Paris during the summer and, sporting a new configuration, is very much in the picture.
