- **3. AL UQDA -** Ghaiyyath filly from the stable of Henri-Alex Pantall who has engaged Tony Piccone to ride this debutante. Shouldn't be underestimated
- **4. DIANARINA** Goken debutante whose half-brother Kendly is a Listed winner over 1600m. Kieran Shoemark rides for trainer David Menuisier
- **5. DARIYA KA DE SAON -** Dariyan newcomer from the stable of Armony Tinchon, who has engaged Benjamin Marie to ride this filly. Best watched for now
- **6. PRINCESSE MANDEL -** Showcasing filly bought for 100,000 euros. Respected on debut with Ronan Thomas aboard for Carlos & Yann Lerner
- **7. MAHALA -** Laura Vanska-trained Recoletos filly whose chances on debut shouldn't be underestimated with Aurélien Lemaitre engaged to ride
- **8. SHUSHI -** Julien Carayon-trained Toronado filly to be ridden on debut by Jérôme Moutard. Best watched for now
- **9. UNE FRAGRANCE -** Clément Lecoeuvre rides this Almanzor debutante for trainer Marcel Rolland. A watching brief is advised
- **10. PRINCESSE TREZY -** Satoshi Kobayashi-trained Goken debutante to be ridden by Eddy Hardouin. Will appeal to lovers of outsiders
- **11. ZIARAH DE SAON -** Malone Favriaux rides this Armony Tinchon-trained Whitecliffsofdover debutante who is best watched for now. Others preferred
- **12. MQSE DES NYMPHES -** Well-bred Saxon Warrior filly related to high-class champion Mqse de Sévigné, a five-time Group I winner. Alexis Puchin rides for Mikel Delzangles
- **13. MIMOSA** Belardo filly bred to appreciate deep/heavy ground. Christophe Soumillon rides this Victoria Head-trained debutante
- **14. NO NAY CEN -** No Nay Never debutante whose dam won a Listed race over the classic distance. Maxime Guyon rides for trainer Henri-François Devin

Summary: CANKOURA (1) and MQSE DES NYMPHES (12) are well-bred fillies closely related to high-class performers. They will attract interest in the preliminaries and could find themselves fighting for victory. David Menuisier has a good record on his travles to France, especially with his young horses and that bodes well for the chances of DIANARINA (4) who should be respected. As a daughter of Showcasing, whose progeny are effective on deep/heavy ground, PRINCESSE MANDEL (6) could make her presence felt too.

- CHAR Confirmed the promise of his debut 2nd on heavy ground at Sandown by winning over 1400m on PSF at Kempton on 23 October. Improving colt with legitimate winning claims
- **2. GLOBAL VENTURE -** Built on the encouragement of his 4th at La Teste to open his account at Tarbes on 23 September over 1500m. Open to further improvement
- **3. GRISELDA -** Finished 4th in a 1400m Listed race at Deauville in July. Hasn't been seen since finishing unplaced (11th) in a lucrative Argana sales race over 1300m at Deauville on 15 August
- **4. GREEN JASPER -** Promising filly with undeniable means and sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 3rd over 1350m at Lyon-Parilly in a well-composed field Class 2. Dark horse
- **5. GLAMIS ROAD -** Wasn't seen to best effect in her first start on French soil but acquitted herself well in defeat to finish 3rd in a 1400m Group III at Chantilly on 26 October. Keep safe
- **6. HOSHIANA** Consistent performer with undeniable means and sound references/form credentials prior to her recent failure (10th) in a Listed race over 1100m at Deauville on 21 October. Best watched for now
- **7. IRON BIRD -** Smart filly with untapped potential and solid form references/credentials at a higher level, including a last-start 3rd in a 1400m Group III event on heavy ground at Chantilly on 26 October. Will be a factor
- **8. PINKY CEN -** Progressive filly whose last-start 5th over 1600m on very heavy ground was a run full of merit. Ought to appreciate the return to this shorter trip keep safe

Summary: CHAR (1) has revealed considerable means in 2 starts across the Channel and could take this step up in class in his stride in his first start on French soil. IRON BIRD (7) was unlucky not to have achieved a better result last time and is well-equipped to challenge the selection, as are GLAMIS ROAD (5) and PINKY CEN (8), who should appreciate reverting to this shorter trip.

- **2. ANTHORUS -** Runner-up in the 2023 edition of this race and showed his form/well-being by finishing 4th in a Group III over track and trip on 27 October. Keep safe
- **3. ZOOM -** Last-start winner on this course over 1500m on 9 September when returning from a 4-month absence. Lacks references over this extended trip but shouldn't be underestimated
- **4. BLUE BROTHER -** Progressive colt on a steep upward trajectory. Won back-to-back (both) Quinte+ appearances recently, the latest over 1600m at ParisLongchamp on 5 October not taken lightly
- **5. OCEAN VIKING** Looked potentially useful when winning on debut over this course and distance on 19 April. Hasn't been seen since but is open to any amount of improvement on his reappearance and holds Classic entries
- **6. TOYOTOMI -** Consistent colt with sound references/form credentials, including a Listed 5th in a 1500m Listed race at La Teste and last-start victory over 1600m at Lyon-Parilly on 29 September. More needed
- **7. SUCHET -** Made a winning comeback from a 4-month absence in a Class 1 at Chantilly over 1600m on 3 October. Should have more to offer
- **8. SAN SEBASTIAN -** Caught the eye when finishing 3rd in a 1600m Listed race at Nantes on 19 October. Attractive outsider

Summary: MOUNTAIN SONG (1) fluffed her lines in the Group II Prix Daniel Wildenstein last time but retains the means to win a race of this nature. She should play a leading role and could make amends in these calmer waters, though does concede weight to several genuine threats. OCEAN VIKING (5) leads the opposition ahead of last-start comeback winner SUCHET (7) and BLUE BROTHER (4), with the shortlist completed by ZOOM (3).

- **1. GALORD -** Won a Quinté+ at ParisLonchamp in October 2023 and regained momentum recently with 3 comeback appearances, the latest (6th) on heavy ground in a Quinte+ over track and trip on 14 October. Keep safe
- **2. SHORT FINAL -** Consistent performer with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 2nd at this level over 1300m at ParisLongchamp on 6 October. The return to 1600m on heavy ground holds no fears
- **3. AMEDRAS -** Veteran hard-knocker whose references at this level off his current mark, include a 1500m Quinte+ win at Cagnes. Returned to form to win with a last-start 3rd over 1700m at Marseille-Borely on 22 October
- **4. HALF HALF -** Capable colt, 5th in a 1400m Group III on 26 May but unplaced in 3 subsequent appearances, including consecutive Quinte+ races the latest (8th) over 1600m at ParisLongchamp on 5 October. Dark horse
- **5. TIGRR -** Versatile hard-knocker whose references at this level (on both surfaces) include a course-and-distance 4th on 14 October and last-start 6th on PSF at CHantilly on 29 October. Shouldn't be underestimated
- **6. TUMBLER -** Proven Quinte+ performer whose competitiveness off this mark is beyond doubt. Confirmed as much by finishing 2nd in the course-and-distance reference race on 14 October player under Stéphane Pasquier
- **7. PANDIA SELENE -** Inconsistent filly whose references include a course-and-distance Quinté+victory on 14 May. Runner-up in a Quinte+ at Chantilly in September but 10th in the benchmark race over track and trip on 14 October
- **8. JOH SPIRIT -** A rejuvenated handicapper who thrives on deep/heavy ground. confirmed as much by winning the benchmark Quinté+ over course and distance on 14 October. Remains competitive under a 3kg penalty
- **9. AVENUE MONTAIGNE -** Finished on the podium in all 9 starts, including 2 handicap/Quinté+ appearances finished 3rd on both occasions, the latest over track and trip on 10 October. Candidate for success under Maxime Guyon
- **10. BENIMARU -** Runner-up in a 1600m ParisLongchamp claimer (12 September) before joining Stéphanie Penot. Made a winning stable debut in a course-and-distance handicap on 10 October. Penalised 2,5kg for that victory
- **11. DIVINE CHRISNAT -** Outran market expectations (70/1) when 4th in a 1600m Quinté+ at ParisLongchamp last month but was unplaced (8th) in the course-and-distance benchmark race on 14 October. Will tempt lovers of outsiders
- **12. MARZOUK -** Consistent performer with sound references/form credentials at this level, especially with this headgear fitted. Showed his form and well-being with a last-start 1800m win at Le Croisé-Laroche on 18 October
- **13. LORD SINCLAIR** Improving 3-year-old who opened his account over 1600m at ParisLongchamp in September and didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th on his handicap debut in a course-and-distance Quinte+ on 10 October

Summary: SHORT FINAL (2) has repeatedly proven his competitiveness in this category off his current mark and has nothing to prove on deep/heavy ground. The return to a mile also holds no fears so he has a legitimate winning chance. JOH SPIRIT (8) left a great impression when winning over this course and distance last time and she remains competitive for the leading places, despite a resultant penalty. AVENUE MONTAIGNE (9), never worse than 3rd, and TUMBLER (6), whose consistency in Quinte races stands him in good stead, should also have a say in the outcome. HALF HALF (4), GALORD (1) and AMEDRAS (3) aren't taken lightly either in a typically competitive Quinte+ event.

- **7. BALTIC EMPRESS -** Bounced back to form with a reassuring last-start 2nd against male opposition in a Listed race on heavy ground over 1800m at Chantilly on 12 October. Keep safe
- **8. FOREST FAIRY -** Won the Listed Cheshire Oaks at Chester in May beating subsequent Group II winner Port Fairy. Finished 3rd in a 2800m Listed race at Bath on 10 October candidate for success in her first start on French soil

Cheshire Oaks scorer FOREST FAIRY (8), with Rossa Ryan in the irons, boasts strong form credentials and gets the vote ahead of PRINCESS CHILD (13) whose experience at this level augurs well for her winning ambitions. Unexposed SHAHA (15) isn't taken lightly given the likelihood of improvement, and progressive GALAXY VEGA (9) seems well-equipped to handle this rise in class. Good race!

- **2. WORDS OF PEACE -** Consistent filly with sound references/form credentials, albeit at a lower level. Finished 5th in a 1600m Listed race at Chantilly in June won her latest outing at Cologne (Germany) over 1600m on 13 October
- **3. WILD GODDESS -** Unplaced (6th of 9) in a course-and-distance Group III on 27 October but won a 1650m Craon Listed race in her previous start on 22 September. Shouldn't be hastily condemned
- **4. PEMBA BAY -** Unplaced in consecutive Group III appearances, the latest (9th) over 1800m at Chantilly in September, though did win a 1600m Listed race at La Teste before that on 21 July. Not taken lightly at this level
- **5. SEA OF THIEVES -** Won a 1400m Listed race at ParisLongchamp in April but has finished unplaced in 3 of her 4 subsequent outings, albeit in Group III events the latest (5th) over this course and distance on 27 October. Retains sufficient means and should fare better in these calmer waters
- **6. ATAKAMA -** Debut winner at Chantilly in April last year but failed to add to her tally in 12 subsequent starts, though has maintained her form and consistency. Runner-up to SPARKS FLY (1) in the Listed course-and-distance Prix Coronation on 4 October
- **7. INCRACKABLE -** Soundly beaten (unplaced) in both appearances at this level and in back-to-back Quinte+ handicaps recently, the latest (16th) at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 5 October. For another day
- **8. UNCANNY -** Has done little wrong in her 4 starts in Ireland, winning once and finishing 2nd three times. Runner-up on heavy ground in a 1600m Listed event at Leopardstown on 20 October. Wears first-time headgear in her first start on French soil, keep safe
- **9. VASDA -** Finished behind UNCANNY (8) when 3rd on heavy ground in a 1600m Listed event at Leopardstown on 20 October. Won't be far off the mark

Summary: Undefeated AROLLA (13) has impressed in both outings and is good value to maintain her 100% record. She will, however, have to thwart the likely challenge of DOLLERINA (11) who was a wide-margin winner on her reappearance last month and is also open to further progress. UNCANNY (8) and VASDA (9), closely matched on the form of a recent Listed race in Ireland, have the means to make their presence felt too.

- **4. LEOPARDUCCIO -** In good form and was a winner last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over this distance on 29 October. Carries a 3kg penalty but is not out of it
- **5. LAURENT -** Unreliable but did run well when runner-up last time out in a handicap at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1800m on 25 October. Can go one better this time
