6. JINNOVE DAB - Fine servant that won a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on re-entry late last month. Takes on marginally better this time but is a tenacious trotter and will be expected to compete for victory

7. JOGGER KILY - Has made decent progress this term, latterly 2nd of 16 in a 2200m Caen Class F a fortnight ago. 4 pads fitted for the first time which may be just what the doctor ordered. Chance

8. JACK DU PONT - Good consistent trotter that came 3rd of 18 on comeback in a 2800m Cholet Class D 10 days ago. Will have come on for the run and has the class to defy the draw and win this

9. JUHELLET - Back under harness after trotting 3rd in a 2850m Mauquenchy monté Class F on 18 March. Won here under harness earlier in the year but others still easier to back

10. JOPANI - 11th of 12 in a 2575m Saint-Brieuc Class E on 26 March. Shoes off this time but still not easy to like

11. JOEYSTAR DE NIRO - Gave a fine account to win a 2850m Loudéac Class F 10 days ago, on first start following the winter break. Aimed higher on this occasion and chances limited

12. JAIRO DE GUOZ - Pleasantly surprised on re-entry a fortnight ago when 2nd of 12 finishers in a 2825m Durtal Class F. Hind shoes off this time but is not about to confirm

13. JET STUD - Has not been seen out since coming 3rd in a 2725m Pornichet Class E mid-September. Debuts right-handed and is going to need the run

14. JAGUAR DE GINAI - Disappointing 9th of 11 finishers in a 2825m Durtal Class F on 24 March. Has ability but best to wait until he reestablishes his credentials

15. JEDI DE CAHOT - Tricky type that got back in the game 2 weeks ago when 3rd, a place behind JOGGER KILY (7), in a 2200m Caen Class F. Bites off more than he can chew this time though and others preferred

8. JAZZ SESSION - Capable mare that was sanctioned on re-entry 10 days ago in a 2525m Class F at Bihorel-lès-Rouen on 1 April. Runs barefoot this time but may be one race shy

9. JOUE PAS AVEC MOI - Unraced for over 2 months after being sanctioned in a 2175m Vincennes monté Class E on 6 February. Has little aptitude for the harness code and can be ruled out

10. JAVELOT DE HOUELLE - 13th behind JERENAL D'HAMELINE (18) in a 2800m Cholet Class D 10 days ago. Has merit though, and while not the easiest to trust, is still worth retaining for a minor place cheque

11. JENUFA - 7th of 11 finishers in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 19 March after having pleased across town the time before. Benefits from a front-row start and will have claims on a place in the frame

5. LOVE LETTERS FERM - 8th of 10 finishers, behind LOVA BLUE (2) in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 22 March. 4 pads fitted and even with Matthieu Abrivard reining will have too much to do

6. LOOKING BEST - Promising individual that came 3rd of 8 in a 2450m Caen Class E on 23 March. Sports front pads for the first time and, from the front line, will be in a position to challenge for a place in the frame

7. LORIE DE LA PRADE - 3rd of 9 in a 2450m Caen Class E 3 weeks ago. Is clearly close to getting off the mark but the draw will do her no favours

8. LYXIE KNIGHT - Has not been seen out since opening her account in a 2700m Graignes Class E on 5 February. Front pads on this time but starting wide on the front line will not aid her cause

9. LOUNA D'ESTIEU - Unremarkable filly returning to the harness code after faulting in a 2750m Ecommoy Class E on 31 March. Has never shown exceptional aptitude and will have few takers

10. LORD DU GERS - Good future prospect that confirmed his fine qualification with victory in a 2425m Class F here on 23 March. Takes on tougher this time and is not ideally-drawn, but still looks capable of maintaining his perfect record

11. LARA DE SURVILLE - Untried filly that qualified in a superb 1'17"0 late-February but takes on some serious horses first time out and best to hold off

12. LOVE DANCER - Missed out by little for 3rd in a 2450m Caen Class E a month ago after having won on debut. Forced to break from the 2nd line but could still get a look-in

13. LUMINEUX - Has struggled since returning to competition, latterly finishing 7th of 15 in a 2450m Caen Class E a month back, and can be ruled out

14. L'AZIMUT DU CEBE - Pleasant but beaten 3rd of 7 finishers in a Class F over course and distance last week, first time out. Will have come on for the run but will struggle with the draw

15. LASCA PRIOR - Got off the mark at Meslay-du-Maine before faulting early in a 2850m Laval Class E 12 days ago. Should not be too harshly judged but still no more than a minor place prospect

16. LE RETOUR VRIE - Valiant 2nd to LILIAN DU PARADIS (1) in a 2550m Reims Class E 3 weeks ago. Handed an unwanted draw but is plainly on the way up and will not be far off the mark

Summary: After having qualified well last summer, LORD DU GERS (10) made no bones about imposing first time out and despite the poor draw, and the presence of recent Reims winner, LILIAN DU PARADIS (1), he still looks the one to beat. LE RETOUR VRIE (16) finished runner-up to Raffin's horse 3 weeks ago and although handed an unenviable draw, still looks a serious player. The improving LAVASINA (4) races with pads for the first time and , from the 4-spot, will be no soft touch.
