

**C1 - PRIX MMA COURVILLE - 2825m (a1 3/4m) - Amateurs - Class G -  
Harness - EUR € 6.000**

1. **GALAXY VAUCEENNE** - Unexceptional mare that showed improvement in a minor event last weekend but insufficient to warrant much support
2. **GASBY DU FER** - Modest individual that has done nothing noteworthy since placing at Machecoul two months ago and is unlikely to generate much interest
3. **GARTA MAG** - Honest mare that left a very good impression on recent re-entry here. Again on the front line and should not be overlooked
4. **HIVAR DE CELLAND** - Blows hot and cold but did win in the professional ranks last month and can get a look in if he keeps his action together
5. **HORSE DE GRAMMONT** - Has merit but currently struggling with form and must get his house in order
6. **HEROS DE BANVILLE** - Never far from losing his action but has solid Chartres credentials. Drops back in class and with application can win this
7. **GALGANO** - Delicate but not entirely without merit, although latest form leaves a lot to be desired
8. **GAMME DE BASSIERE** - Not the easiest of horses to handle but is confirmed here. Returns to a category she appreciates and on good behaviour can make a big impact
9. **GOHAKI** - Fine campaigner with solid references at a superior level but shod for comeback and best to hold off
10. **FLICFLAC DU LOGIS** - Twice a winner from his last four starts. Is forced to start on back line but in current condition will be no pushover
11. **ECU** - Capricious type but has ample ability. Unseen since last summer but at this level can get straight back in the game
12. **ECRIN DE VAL** - Serious sort that recently went close at Meslay. On second line but still in with a realistic shout
13. **ESTIME MOI** - Form has regressed somewhat since winning at Reims but went close last time here and must be respected
14. **FEAR FACTOR** - Form has taken something of a hit since placing at Angers and racing shod will do him no favours
15. **ELIOTTNELL ONE** - Totally out of the picture for some time and can be confidently disregarded
16. **ETOILE DES BROUETS** - Previously a good sort at this level but has been off the boil for some time and will have few friends

**Summary :** Very much an open affair this, but it is very hard to ignore HEROS DE BANVILLE (6) who seldom disappoints when focused and shod in his current configuration. He will nevertheless be up against the delicate but capable GAMME DE BASSIERE (8) who won a similar event here two months ago. In excellent shape at the moment, FLICFLAC DU LOGIS (10) incurs the penalty but still has a realistic chance of confirming his Vincennes victory. ECRIN DE VAL (12) starts on the same line and his recent Meslay performance bodes well for his chances.

**C2 - PRIX RACE AND CARE - 2825m (a1 3/4m) - National - Class D -  
Harness - EUR € 22.000**

- 1. KATUDI** - Moderate sort that was thrashed on lone start going left-handed and in current form will have little to offer
- 2. KRECY PONT VAUTIER** - Temperamental filly but has bags of talent. Reassured at Reims late last month and with application can set the cat among the pigeons
- 3. KHEOPS CASTELETS** - Solid in two of three starts to date. Imposed with authority last time and even though in better company here, still looks a serious candidate
- 4. KOLDIMA D'AUT** - Quality filly but still somewhat green. Lost her action at Enghien but can win this if she behaves
- 5. KING MOKO** - Yet to open his account but has placed in two of three since the break and will have his supporters
- 6. KIARA DES MONTS** - Regular sort that has climbed the class ladder in good order. Takes on less exalted horses this time and a big run anticipated
- 7. KINGSTOWN CITY** - Honest type that always gives what she can but in better company on this occasion and unlikely to spring any surprises
- 8. KIBRILLE MONTAVAL** - Consistently in the thick of things. Pleased here recently and should logically show improvement. Place prospect
- 9. KALAMATA BEACH** - Unplaced just once in 4 starts this term. Left a good impression at Amiens three weeks ago and with form maintained can confirm
- 10. KAPS** - Has shown significant aptitude for the other code. Fitted with pads for the first time under harness and should not be underestimated

**Summary** : Even though sanctioned as often as not, KOLDIMA D'AUT (4) has nevertheless shown significant promise. Sanctioned at Enghien, Raffin has nevertheless maintained faith and if he can keep her in stride, she should be able to win a race of this nature. KHEOPS CASTELETS (3), however, won with consummate ease last time out and looks the closest rival. KIARA DES MONTS (6) is a progressive sort and looks to have a good hand to play, as does KIBRILLE MONTAVAL (8) who backs up after having given a decent account here last weekend.

**C3 - PRIX VILLE DE BERCHERES SAINT GERMAIN - 2825m (a1 3/4m) -  
National - Class E - Harness - EUR € 19.500**

1. **JAVA BESP** - Respectable filly but significantly better at a lower level and others preferred
2. **JANNA JAYF** - Yet to get off the mark but can trot. Not disgraced at Châteaubriant and is worth monitoring
3. **JOHANITE** - Modest trotter that seldom makes her mark and is not about to break the mould
4. **JAVANAISE SONG** - Opened her account at Durtal a fortnight ago at the 16th time of asking. Is barefoot again and while unlikely to repeat should still give an honourable account
5. **JULIANA DES LUCAS** - Capable on a good day but yet to get into her stride since the spell and needs to up her game
6. **JOHANNA ELEVEN** - Showed a different side to herself at Vincennes before the break. Just hind shoes off for comeback but is one to watch out for in the coming weeks
7. **JENKA DE MORMOULIN** - Occasionally loses her action but otherwise a useful filly. Clearly in good shape and if behaved should not be far off the mark
8. **JAVA DU PLESSIS** - Seldom gets her nose in front but is confirmed in this category. Left a good impression last weekend and looks principal threat to JAVA FAST (9)
9. **JAVA FAST** - Hardy individual up against a relatively manageable bunch this time and should be able to have her way, provided she can stay in stride
10. **JUSTINE DU MESNIL** - Seldom far from the action when applied. Oddly below-par last time out but can make amends
11. **JULIETTE MIXO** - Left a good impression at Laval on re-entry last month. Will have come on for the run and can go closer this time
12. **JAVA DU BAS BOSQ** - Mixes the good with the less good but won a similar event here late April and is not one to be ignored

**Summary :** Still somewhat green, JAVA FAST (9) is nonetheless a filly with ample talent and with application should have the measure of most here. JAVA DU PLESSIS (8), however, did catch the eye at Pontchâteau and in similar form can put on a good show. Course-and-distance winner on her penultimate start, JAVA DU BAS BOSQ (12) must be considered a serious candidate, as should JENKA DE MORMOULIN (7) who has been solid in two of her last three.

**C4 - PRIX LECLERC DRIVE CHARTRES/MAINVILLIERS - 2825m (a1 3/4m)  
- National - Class E - Harness - EUR € 19.500**

1. **JEU DE PARME** - Blows hot and cold but appears to be getting back in the game. At this level though will have his work cut out
2. **JET DE LA FERME** - Handy type that improved at Laval on second start back. Should be at peak fitness by now and will not be far from the action
3. **JULIUS BERRY** - Opened his seasonal account at Laon last month. Is clearly at the top of his game and can give JACARANDO (4) a run for his money
4. **JACARANDO** - Finally rewarded at Saint-Malo last month for his efforts and in current form can repeat
5. **JEWEL** - Modest sort that has placed just once in 12 career outings and can expect to have few friends
6. **JACKPOT JOMUNA** - Moderate sort with two races in him since the break. Is proven in better company but still no more than a minor place prospect
7. **JEU DECISIF** - Not the easiest to handle and needs to reassure but has nothing to prove at this level and with stride in check can make a big impact
8. **JAGUAR SPIRIT** - Unexceptional trotter that showed some improvement last time out but still has a lot more to find
9. **JACKPOT DE VIETTE** - Useful sort that confirmed his handler's belief when given the chance to race barefoot. Same formula here and can go close
10. **JAZZ D'OLIVERIE** - Respectable in both return runs but needs to find more if he wants to finish in the mix

**Summary** : JACARANDO (4) showed significant potential last season but failed to get off the mark, however he has returned in cracking form this term and finally struck gold a fortnight ago. He is up against marginally better horses this time but still looks good enough to double his money. It will not be all plain sailing though given how well JULIUS BERRY (3) acquitted himself at Laon last time out. JACKPOT DE VIETTE (9) showed a different side to himself at Rambouillet when first time barefoot and with shoes off again can figure prominently. JET DE LA FERME (2) is clearly on the way back up and must also be respected.

**C5 - PRIX DU PMU "LE CHIQUITO" - COURVILLE - 2825m (a1 3/4m) -  
National - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22.000**

- 1. IDYLLE DE CHARDET** - Moderate sort but is confirmed at this level. Just one race in her this term though and unlikely to shake things up
- 2. ISERIA DE PLAY** - Tricky character but will be fresh and fit. First time barefoot this term and if applied should not be far off the mark
- 3. ILLUSION DE BETTON** - Useful dual-purpose mare returning to the harness code after a stint under the saddle. Never the easiest to trust but worth monitoring all the same
- 4. IDOLE D'ATLAS** - Has been a total write-off so far this season and on current trajectory has no realistic chance
- 5. IBIZA DE CONNEE** - Serious sort when she can keep her action together. Dynamic when focused and barefoot and can more than make amends for recent sanction
- 6. INTENSE ACE** - Not the most reliable of mares but boasts an excellent record at Chartres. Top driver in charge this time and can make another big splash
- 7. ISIS DU LEARD** - Sanctioned in three of four this term but has ample ability at this level and on good behaviour should figure prominently
- 8. IN FINE FLASH** - Disappointing on the whole this season but in this company could yet get a look in
- 9. INTERACTIVE** - Useful type making her first appearance since September and will not be over-taxed
- 10. IDEE NOIRE** - Went into her break on a high note but has just one race in her since and with shoes on will have little to offer
- 11. INNEE DU RIL** - Quality mare with a decent record when unshod. Has previously won here and even from the 2nd line can challenge for a place on the podium

**Summary** : Sanctioned when heavily backed at Nantes last week, IBIZA DE CONNEE (5) gets another crack at redemption and with application can set the record straight. Tony Le Beller will still be keeping an eye on the delicate but no less talented ISIS DU LEARD (7) who can apply the pressure if she stays in stride. ISERIA DE PLAY (2) can also prove a handful but is no pushover when barefoot and must be taken seriously. After three return runs, INTENSE ACE (6) will be fully fit and, entrusted to Eric Raffin for the occasion, and can play a leading role.

**C6 - PRIX DU CINEMA "LES ENFANTS DU PARADIS" - 2825m (a1 3/4m) -  
National - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22.000**

- 1. IMPEC D'ECOUVES** - Showed promise earlier in the year but has since come off the boil and needs to reaffirm
- 2. IMPERIAL ROMAIN** - Decent campaigner but has not been seen out since late March and is sure to need the run
- 3. IN LOVE DARLING** - Barefoot for first time since winning at Nancy last season. Will be fully fit and can give INDY DE MUZE (6) something to think about
- 4. IMPERIAL DURABUTIN** - Good, consistent type going barefoot for the first time and in current form looks a player
- 5. ISUTAH** - Has ability but sanctioned more often than not and will be hard to back
- 6. INDY DE MUZE** - Flew up at Le Touquet last month before losing his action next time but hind shoes off and with a leading driver at the helm will be no soft touch
- 7. I LOVE DE VIETTE** - Has not won for 11 months but always gives his best. Goes first time unshod behind and looks competitively well in
- 8. INFANT DU LOIR** - Moderate type that has so far struggled to recapture last season's form and a minor place chance at best
- 9. I AM A FAN** - Has shown marked improvement since the turn of the year. In his category here and should logically give another competitive account
- 10. IMBASI RAINBOW** - Very disappointing since placing at La Rochelle two months ago and unlikely to shake things up
- 11. INDY FLIGNY** - Has been giving a good account for the most part this term but the extra 25m do nothing to help his cause
- 12. IDEM JIHEM** - Honest sort with two races under his belt since the spell. Incurs the penalty but shoes off this time and if fully fit can trot into the money

**Summary** : Barring his recent Arras sanction, INDY DE MUZE (6) has been a model of consistency this term. He goes unshod behind this time and with Eric Raffin in charge can confirm his Touquet success. IN LOVE DARLING (3) was sanctioned that day but is barefoot on this occasion and with application can run him close. IMPERIAL DURABUTIN (4) has raced solidly since his return to competition and going first time unshod all four could pleasantly surprise. I LOVE DE VIETTE (7) makes his Chartres debut in decent shape and the new shoeing formula will only work to his advantage.

**C7 - PRIX DU CAFE DU COMMERCE - AUNEAU - 2825m (a1 3/4m) - Class  
F - Mounted - EUR € 24.000**

- 1. HOUKO SPORT** - Delicate but has bags of ability and has won in superior company this year. With application can give this a good go
- 2. HOTEBO DE BREMONT** - Opened his account in a minor provincial event late last month and although unlikely to repeat can still make his presence felt
- 3. HELIA DAIRPET** - Handy mare that has placed three times in her last five. Different shoeing formula here and must be taken seriously
- 4. FORJET VOGOULIERE** - Won over course and distance last month. Has twice failed to confirm but will have his supporters
- 5. HERMINE DU GUELIER** - Winner of her last two monté starts when barefoot. Gets on like a house on fire with her jockey and looks a serious proposition
- 6. GAVROCHE D'IDEE** - Yet to disappoint in this branch of the business. Enjoying a decent run at present but others still preferred
- 7. GELADOR** - Faithful servant in both codes. Left a good impression at Lisieux recently and should not be entirely overlooked
- 8. HOTKATISSIME** - Dynamic sort that has won three from four under the saddle this term and looks set to achieve the hat-trick
- 9. HAUTE SPHERE** - Quality element that has taken well to the ridden discipline. Enjoying a decent run of form and can figure more prominently this time

**Summary :** Simply superb since returning to the monté code this spring, HOTKATISSIME (8) looks eminently capable of pulling off the three-timer. Paul Ploquin will not however be underestimating recent Durtal winner HERMINE DU GUELIER (5) who has won three times for Marine Beudard. HAUTE SPHERE (9) has never disappointed under the saddle and while unlikely to impose can still get in on the action. HELIA DAIRPET (3) alternates the good with the less good but is clearly in form and, fitted with pads this time, should not be underestimated.

**C8 - PRIX AMICALE RETRAITES CHARTRES M.M.A. - 2825m (a1 3/4m) -  
Class F - Harness - EUR € 25.000**

- 1. HOLD UP NOCTURNE** - Capable in both branches of the business and evidently in form but has other priorities and best to hold off
- 2. GOLDWYN DU CAUX** - Has been racing respectably of late and is known for her decent turn of foot. Shoes off this time and can figure prominently
- 3. HELLENISTE** - Decent sort that showed marked improvement on her second start back. Will be close to her best and should not be far off the mark
- 4. GAZ OIL** - Very hard to fault when applied and focused. Should be fully fit by now and going barefoot for the occasion can pick up a cheque
- 5. GITANE DU ROCHER** - Gives a good account of herself for the most part but shoes back on here and not an obvious choice
- 6. GENTLEMAN GWEN** - Showed improvement at a lower level last time out but still looks to have too much to do
- 7. HORACIO DE CERISY** - One of the better horses in this field. Has had time to get back in shape following a fine Caen performance and has a good opportunity to open his seasonal account
- 8. HARMONIE DE BREVOL** - Capable on a good day but makes first start of the new season and can be passed over
- 9. GALAXY DU RABUTIN** - Got back in the game recently with an excellent run. Raffin at the helm this time and looks a serious proposition
- 10. HERBES FOLLES** - Can prove a handful but otherwise a hardy mare with references at a superior level. Benefits from an excellent entry and will justifiably garner considerable support
- 11. GALAXIE DU HOME** - Second in all three starts this year. On the back line this time though and a minor place prospect at best
- 12. GAMIN BAZOQUAIN** - Has demonstrated good consistency this term. Returns to racing left-handed and can improve on his recent Argentan effort
- 13. FABULEUX HONEY** - Considerably better horse in the monté code and will have little to offer

**Summary :** Beaten with honours at Caen last time out, HORACIO DE CERISY (7) has had time to freshen up and from the front line can impose here. Anthony Dollion will still want to be wary of GALAXY DU RABUTIN (9) who gave a reassuringly good account at Châtillon late last month. HELLENISTE (3) appears to be close to her best and even racing shod will have her chances. HERBES FOLLES (10) is clearly in form and with application will be a tough nut to crack.
