**C1 - PRIX DE L'ESTUAIRE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness -
EUR € 23,000**

- 1. IRLANDE DU NORD** - Disappointing last run when 9th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 2. ISSU DES LOYAUX** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 28 June. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 3. I LOVE IGNY** - In very good form and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 3 December. Can go one better this time
- 4. IBIZA DE BOURGOGNE** - Only fair of late and was 5th in this class at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 2 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. IVANOVITCH EST LA** - In good form and was a winner last time out in Class G at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 19 November. Could be competitive again
- 6. IBROX PARK** - In good form of late and was third in this class at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 30 November. Not out of it
- 7. ISTORIC MAUZUN** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 3 June. Not barefoot this time and is returning from a break so others are preferred
- 8. INO DE BRION** - A winner of four of his last seven starts, including in this class at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 15 November. Remains barefoot and has a winning chance
- 9. IXEL DE L'AUMOY** - Has disqualification issues but has won his last two starts, with the latest being in this class at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 2 December. Can complete a hat-trick
- 10. ISIS DE POULINE** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Me on 15 August. Not unshod and returning from a break so others are preferred
- 11. INESKA** - In good form and was third in Class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 10 November. Capable of making the frame
- 12. IPSO D'AVIGNERE** - On a very long losing run but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in this class at Châteaubriant over 3000m on 1 December. Could make the frame

Summary: I LOVE IGNY (3) remains in very good shape and was runner-up last time out at Rouen-Mauquenchy earlier this month. He could one better in a competitive starting event. INO DE BRION (8) knows how to win having already won four times in just seven starts and he should be a real threat again. IXEL DE L'AUMOY (9) is hat-trick seeking but is not one to trust entirely. IBROX PARK (6) is also in good form and can contest the finish.

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C2 - PRIX DE L'OISE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. HORTANCE FOLLE** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Saint-Galmier on 24 November. Won his penultimate start and is capable of an upset
- 2. HARALD** - Unreliable and was 8th in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 5 November. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 3. GRAAL DE MY** - Unreliable and was 12th in Class G at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 19 November. Could play a minor role
- 4. FLIRTINI** - Has struggled of late and was 9th last time out in Class G at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 20 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. HERMES SCOTT** - Has struggled of late and 9th in Class E at Nimes over 2750m on 1 December. Others make more appeal
- 6. FIGARO DE BUSSET** - On a very long losing run and was tenth in Class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November. Others are preferred
- 7. FINE DU COLOMBIER** - Disappointing recent form and was 7th in Class F at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 24 November. Others are preferred
- 8. GRANTCHESTER** - On a very long losing run but was barefoot and third last time out in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 27 November. Remains barefoot and can be competitive again
- 9. GALOPIN DE BLOT** - Disappointing recent form and was 11th last time out in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 10. HARLEQUIN** - On a very long losing run but was barefoot and runner-up in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Remains barefoot and can go one better this time
- 11. GENTLEMAN PIYA** - Unreliable and was 7th in Class E at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 16 October. Capable of making three frame when in the mood
- 12. FAKIR DE VILLODON** - Has really struggled all year and was 7th last time out in Class D at Le Croisé-Laroche over this distance on 2 December. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 13. HAUDATIS** - Not reliable and was 6th last time out in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 24 November. Has won twice this year and is not out of it
- 14. HIT DE JOBI** - Has struggled of late and was 12th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 2 December. Better over shorter but does have a winning chance
- 15. FALCOM DU BOCAGE** - On a very long losing run but was barefoot and 5th last time out in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 24 November. Not unshod this time but can contest the finish

Summary: HIT DE JOBI (14) does seem at his very best over a bit shorter but he could be a lively threat to these rivals. FALCOM DU BOCAGE (15) was not disgraced when fifth last time out but is not unshod this time. He is not out of it though. HAUDATIS (13) does pop up and score every now and then and deserves respect in this line-up. HARLEQUIN (10) showed improvement at Saint-Galmier last month and could break a long losing streak.

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C3 - PRIX DES FLANDRES - 2050m (a1m1/4) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. HIANT DU VAL** - Unreliable and was fourth in a class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 10 November. Remains barefoot and can play a minor role in the finish
- 2. HALTESS GRIFF** - Unplaced in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 16 November. Reverts to barefoot. Better than the last two efforts indicate and can bounce back to score
- 3. HARPIE GIBUS** - Finished 7th in a class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 10 November. Others are preferred in this line-up
- 4. HIP HOP DE CHENU** - Finished a good third in a class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 24 November. Remains barefoot. In form and is capable of going close to winning
- 5. HANI BIRD** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a class G at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 2 December. Tries barefoot and has a place chance
- 6. HAPPY DE NICE** - Finished fifth in a class G at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 15 November. Remains barefoot. Improved latest effort and can make the frame
- 7. HELIOS ATOUT** - Finished 7th in a Mounted class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 5 November. Remains barefoot. Needs to find a few lengths to be competitive
- 8. HASHTAG DE TAGOR** - Disappointed when unplaced in a class E at Nimes over 2750m on 1 December. Remains barefoot. A penultimate start winner and Franck Ouvrie can do the job again
- 9. HAMILTON ATOUT** - Disqualified in a class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 13 August. Returns from a break and should need this run
- 10. HEDENE D'ERONVILLE** - Finished 10th in a class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Poor recent efforts and is unlikely to contest the finish

Summary: HIP HOP DE CHENU (4) is in good form and should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. HASHTAG DE TAGOR (8) struggled last time out at Nimes but is better judged on his penultimate start win and can be a threat. HALTESS GRIFF (2) is barefoot this time so should improve after some modest recent efforts. HAPPY DE NICE (6) was not disgraced last time out and could make the frame.

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C4 - PRIX DE DEVOLUY - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. JEU MYSTIC** - Disqualified in the last three, the latest in a class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 24 July. Others make more appeal
- 2. JUNGLE JULRY** - Well beaten 9th in a class G at Nimes over 2750m on 17 November. Struggling and needs to improve to win
- 3. JOLIE ARCTIC** - Disqualified in her last two starts, the latest in a class H at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Reverts to barefoot and could improve
- 4. JADIS** - Well beaten 8th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 November. Remains barefoot. Others are preferred in this line up
- 5. JASON FAC** - A runner-up in a class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 24 November. Improved effort in the latest and is not out of it
- 6. JELINA BENOIT** - Unplaced in a class H at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths
- 7. JACADI D'EVA** - Unplaced in a class G at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 17 November. Can play a minor role if putting the best foot forward
- 8. JARNY DE BERTRANGE** - Unplaced in a class H at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Remains barefoot. Poor recent efforts and others are preferred
- 9. JENJOY MAYBE** - Well beaten 8th in a class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November. Unlikely to be involved in the finish
- 10. JOKAI** - A runner-up in a class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November. Remains barefoot and is a consistent sort who can be competitive again
- 11. JASMIN D'ENOGAT** - Well beaten 8th in a class F at Feurs over 2850m on 22 June. Others are preferred in this line-up
- 12. JOURNEY** - Finished 6th in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 November. Remains barefoot. Missed the start at Vincennes but did finish off well and has a winning chance
- 13. JOHNNY MIX** - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in a class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November. In good form and can complete the hat-trick
- 14. JACKASS LATIN** - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 November. Remains barefoot. Capable of bouncing back to be competitive if wise
- 15. JAKABINO** - Third in a class A at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m over 16 November. Improved in the latest and must confirm that
- 16. JAHA MAN DU PONT** - Only modest of late and was fifth in a class D at Beaumont de-Lomagne over 2400m on 1 December. Seldom far off them and can get closer this time

Summary: JOURNEY (12) ran better than the sixth place finish at Vincennes would indicate. He finished off that race well and could be the right one for this race. JOHNNY MIX (13) is hat-trick seeking after some nice wins and will not go down easily. JACKASS LATIN (14) faulted at this track last time out but is capable of bouncing back to score. JAHA MAN DU PONT (16) is also capable of being competitive.

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C5 - PRIX DE LA CREUSE - 2050m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. KING BOLD** - Finished 8th in a class E at Amiens over 2400m on 15 November. Serge Peltier will give every assistance from the sulky and can bounce back to be a threat
- 2. KATUDI** - Fifth in a class E at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 5 November. Remains barefoot. Yet to taste victory but can play a minor role
- 3. KOKIN DE BELLANDE** - Disqualified in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 2 December. Unreliable but is capable of earning some money when wise
- 4. KRACH NONANTAIS** - Finished 10th in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 16 November. Unshod for the first time and this could contest the finish
- 5. KEILER DU BAS BOSQ** - Third in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 25 November. Remains barefoot. A track winner in January and is in good form. Capable of contesting the finish
- 6. KABYLIE DES EDEL** - Fifth in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 2 December. Some improvement in the latest and is not out of it
- 7. KAMI DU BOURG** - Disqualified in a class E at Nimes over 2750m on 1 December. Remains barefoot. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 8. KANSAS DE CASTELLE** - Disqualified in a class D at Vichy over 2800m on 1 July. The Martens brothers are not traveling to make up the numbers. Good chance
- 9. KOMAN** - Disqualified in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 25 November. Remains barefoot and must be wise to have a chance
- 10. KENJY DE LA VALLEE** - A runner-up in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 2 December. Improved effort when barefoot and is not barefoot now. Others make more appeal
- 11. KINGLY DREAMS** - A runner-up in a class E at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 5 November. Remains barefoot. Knocking on the door and can go close again
- 12. KINGSLEY** - Disqualified in a class A at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 16 November. Must be wise and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 13. KARMA DE MONTCIANT** - Unplaced in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 November. Track-suited and could surprise
- 14. KING DE BASSIERE** - Well beaten 7th in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 2 December. Unplaced this year and others are preferred

Summary: KANSAS DE CASTELLE (8) returns from a break but the Martens brothers have set up this runner for a big performance. KINGLY DREAMS (11) is knocking loudly at the door and would not be a surprise winner. KING BOLD (1) is unreliable but is also capable of winning a race like this. KRACH NONANTAIS (4) is barefoot for the very first time and could shine this time

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C6 - PRIX DE CHAMPAGNE-ARDENNE - 2050m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. **KIARA TIT** - Non partante
2. **KEYPTOWN** - Has struggled of late and was 13th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 26 November. Barefoot and could get involved with the finish
3. **KALOUGA** - In good shape and was runner-up in class F at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 30 November. Has a winning chance
4. **KYRIELLE PRINCESSE** - Disappointing form of late and was 8th in class F at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 30 November. Barefoot this time and can be a threat
5. **KEY WEST DE CHENU** - Unreliable and was 12th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 26 November. Won well in October and is not out of it if in the right mood
6. **KINAYA D'OCCAGNES** - In very good form and was fourth in class G at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 5 November. Big chance
7. **KALINKA DU BLEUET** - Finished 5th in class E at Nimes over 2750m on 17 November. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
8. **KARLA D'AVENIR** - Showed improvement and was runner-up in class F at Reims over 2550m on 7 December. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
9. **KELLE ALLURE** - Finished 9th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 1 December. Unreliable and has disqualification issues
10. **KORA DE VINDECY** - Disqualified in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 1 December. Yet to win this year and others are preferred
11. **KELLY QUEEN** - Unreliable but was fourth in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 1 December when barefoot. Might play a minor role
12. **KALIMA DU GOUTIER** - Disqualified in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November. Won well earlier in November and is capable of an upset
13. **KALINKA DE VANDEL** - Finished 10th in class F at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 30 November. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
14. **KEEN DE MAHEY** - Unreliable and was fourth in class F at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 9 November. Might play a minor role

Summary: KINAYA D'OCCAGNES (6) continues in fine form and gets the vote to score in a very competitive looking line-up. KEY WEST DE CHENU (5) is best judged on her win in October and she can bounce back to score after some disappointing performances. KEYPTOWN (2) will be unshod this time so should improve and be a threat. KALOUGA (3) is in good shape and can also get involved with the finish.

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C7 - PRIX DE LA PLAINE DES MAURES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 20,000

- 1. JHA** - Not easy to trust and was 8th in class H at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Won in July but others make more appeal
- 2. JOKER DE BRY** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in class G at Nimes over 2750m on 17 November. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- 3. JARSO BELLO** - Disqualified in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November. Unreliable and is hard to trust so is best watched for now
- 4. JUST BENOIT** - Finished 9th in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 27 November. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. JOSELITO PHIL** - Finished 9th in class H at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. On a long losing streak and others are preferred this time
- 6. JOLIE LAURA** - Victorious in Class H at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- 7. JACEE DE BUSSIERES** - Unreliable and was third in class H at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Could play a minor role
- 8. JOKER DU RABUTIN** - Disqualified in class H at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 9. JINGLE PACA** - Disqualified in class E at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 6 December. Not easy to trust but is capable of winning when in the mood
- 10. JUPITER PLANCHETTE** - Runner up in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November. Victorious in October and has a winning chance
- 11. JESCO DE LA VALLEE** - Finished 9th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November. In good form before that and is not out of it
- 12. JANDA HAUFOR** - Holding her form well and was third in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 19 November. Be right there at the finish once again
- 13. JAVA DES CHAMPS** - Disqualified in class F at Graignes over 2700m on 2 November. Has struggled of late in Mounted race but is capable of making the frame

Summary: JUPITER PLANCHETTE (10) beat a couple of his main rivals before and is in good form. He can beat them again. JANDA HAUFOR (12) is usually competitive and can fight out the finish once again. JINGLE PACA (9) is not one to put the rent money on but is capable of scoring when in the right mood. JAVA DES CHAMPS (13) has struggled under the saddle of late but could make the frame.

- 1. LAMTARRA DE VANDEL** - Showed improvement when runner-up in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Needs to confirm that run
- 2. LOLA DE CHANLECY** - Unreliable and was 7th in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 10 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 3. LOLITA DE JEMAX** - Only moderate of late and was 8th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 December. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 4. LE PRINCE DU RIS** - Disqualified in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2125m on 24 November. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 5. LOUISETTE FLEURY** - Victorious in Class F Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Has some ability and is not out of it
- 6. LINDIR** - Consistent so and was third in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 10 November. May need to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 7. LAPSUS** - Has disqualification issues and was 7th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 November. Yet to win and others make more appeal
- 8. LORD JULRY** - Finished 8th in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 1 November. Won in August but has been unreliable since and others are preferred
- 9. LOOK AT ME** - Victorious in Class F at Agon-Coutainville over 2200m on 26 August. Won once in four career attempts but might need this run returning from a break
- 10. LIMBO DE BUSSET** - Unreliable but was fourth in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 19 November. Placed twice since winning on debut and can contest the finish
- 11. LUNDU DE LOU** - Not disgraced when 5th in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 19 November. Capable of being competitive in this line-up
- 12. L'ETOILE DE PAME** - Unreliable but was victorious in Class F at this course over 2050m on 1 November. Won twice this year and should fight it out
- 13. LEADER OAKS** - Disqualified in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 November. Unreliable and needs major improvement to win
- 14. LOOPING BEN MAX** - Victorious in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 24 November. Improving and can double up if smart
- 15. LEGATO DE FELLIERE** - Disqualified in class E at Chartres over 2800m on 26 November. Won on debut and has placed twice since. Big chance
- 16. LUCK AND JOY** - Finished 11th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 27 November. Unreliable and needs major improvement to win

Summary: LEGATO DE FELLIERE (15) looked good when winning on debut and should take out this lucky last race if wise this time. LEGATO DE FELLIERE (15) is improving and won well at Reims so is a danger. L'ETOILE DE PAME (12) won at this course last time out but is not reliable. LIMBO DE BUSSET (10) was not disgraced last time out and has some ability.
