- **1. GRANDE PRETRESSE -** 8th of 10 in a Class C over track and trip a fortnight ago. Is significantly better than recent numbers would suggest and from the front line can make first 3
- **2. HARMONY DU RABUTIN -** Drops marginally in category after coming 5th of 14 in a 2700m Class C here on 25 November. Has never failed to deliver in the day's configuration and is not about to start. Claim
- **3. GREAT TIGRESS -** Gave a fine account to run 3rd of 16, at 130/1, in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class D last week. Clearly in competition-mode and, with form maintained, can trot her way onto the podium
- **4. ECUME DE FURETAIS -** 10th of 16 behind GREAT TIGRESS (3) in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class D last week. Has done little of note for some time and must first re-establish her credentials
- **5. FELICITA D'ECOUVES -** Last of 16 behind GREAT TIGRESS (3) in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class D conditioner last week. Barefoot this time and although not a leading contender, enjoys a good draw and can finish in the mix
- **6. FILAE DE SOYORA -** Imposed at Paray-le-Monial and then followed up with 2nd of 10 in a 2200m Salon-de-Provence Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Is pitted against a better lot this time but is sufficiently well-placed to pick up some crumbs
- **7. GAULTHERIA -** Drops in category after running 6th of 13 in a 2700m Class C at Le Croise-Laroche on 25 November. Seldom lets the side down under these conditions and looks a solid first-5 prospect
- **8. HIGH PROPULSION -** Untaxed when 11th of 14, on return from a spell, behind HARMONY DU RABUTIN (2) in a 2700m Class C here on 25 November. Reunited with partner of choice and despite the draw still looks a player
- **9. HERMINE GIRL** Encouraged at Graignes before finishing 9th of 13 behind GAULTHERIA (7) in a 2700m Class C at Le Croise-Laroche on 25 November and appears to have nothing to offer
- **10. MAGGIORE (SWE) -** Unraced since winning over 2350m at Avenches on 11 September. Is confirmed in France but has no love for Vincennes
- **11. HAIDA SAUTONNE -** Game mare that came 4th of 10 in a 2850m Class D here last week. Ran 3rd over course and distance mid-November and even with pads fitted must not be overlooked

- **13. HARIA DU BELLAY -** Back under harness after finishing 9th of 12 in a 2700m monté Class D here a fortnight ago. Won under these conditions 12 months back and, in spite of a 2nd-line draw, must be afforded respect

- **3. MINNEAPOLIS -** Qualified in 1'17"9 at Caen on 22 October. Makes career debut under the saddle and the engagement of Benjamin Rochard can make all the difference. Claim
- **4. MONALYSA DU ROEN -** Racecourse debutante that qualified in 1'20"4 at Caen last May. Has had time to come into herself but still looks out of her depth
- **5. MOON DES CHARRONS -** Made it 2 straight harness sanctions when quickly faulting in a 2175m Class D here a fortnight ago, and again appears to have little to contribute
- **6. MAYA DES GENETS -** 6th of 7 finishers in a 2675m harness Class F 3.5 weeks ago. New to the discipline and others preferred
- **7. MARIGNANA JEEP -** Takes to the monte code after debuting 6th of 9 in a 2250m Auch Class E a month back and is not about to spring a surprise
- **8. MISS DES BESACES -** 6th of 10, on monte debut, in a 2425m Angers Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run and is unlikely to go home empty-handed
- **9. MARBOXIE D'HERIPRE -** Takes first competitive ridden steps after having run 6th of 11 in a 2050m Laval Class F mid-November. William Bigeon stable going good-guns and is not to be underestimated

- **2. LESLIE DE VANDEL -** 7th of 10 behind LUCIANA HAUFOR (3) in a 2175m Class E here late last month. Is clearly capable and it is just a matter of time before she gets back in the game
- **3. LUCCIANA HAUFOR -** Got off the mark at Chartres before running 5th of 10 in a 2175m Class E here on 29 November. Has ample talent and can bring the fight to LILYROSE WIND (1)
- **4. L'ETOILE D'ETE -** Won 2 in a row then faulted in a 2700m Class E here 3 weeks ago. Left a very good impression though and, with application, can contest the finish
- **5. LAMTARA BUISSONAY -** Encouraging 5th of 14 behind LOZEN DE BANVILLE (12), in a 2100m claimer on main track 2 weeks ago, but still has no possible chance
- **6. LEXOVIENNE -** Lost her action in 29 November race of reference and appears to have shown her limits in this category
- 7. LOVELY JENILOU Back under harness after finishing 5th of 9 in a 2700m monte Class E here on

Even though sporting hind pads this time, recent Mauquenchy winner JULIANO DELTO (3) is another to have shown good aptitude for the code and is unlikely to be far off the mark. Bastien Joseph may just have found the configuration-key to JEAN DES GLENAN (7) who will not be sent out at 47/1 this time.

- **3. FILARETE DU VERGER -** Ran 2nd to HELIOS SI (5) in a 2700m Class C at Le Croise-Laroche on 25 November despite being denied a run. Has references over the long course but represents no more than a minor place chance
- **4. HOLLYWOOD DU BOIS -** Steps up in category after running 2nd of 13 in a Class D over course and distance late-November. 25m better off this time and Matthieu Abrivard will be justifiably confident of a good run
- **5. HELIOS SI -** Beat FILARETE DU VERGER (3) in a 2700m Class C at Le Croise-Laroche on 25 November. Seldom seen at Vincennes but has respectable credentials and could yet pick up a thin slice of the pie

- **12. KAPUSHA MIP -** Given a rest after finishing 6th of 9 behind KRACKMANIA (16) in a Class B under these conditions on 19 September. Is barefoot for comeback and at this level will be expected to get in on the action
- **13. KIKA JOSSELYN -** Serious filly that came close in a Class B over course and distance on 30 November. Has never disappointed under these conditions and will be no pushover
- **14. KIPHYLE DESBOIS -** Quality element that ran 6th of 15 in a 3000m Nantes Class B on 6 November. Returns to racing shod though and can be passed over
- **15. KOSANOSTRA -** Sanctioned in last 2, most recently a Class B over course and distance late last month. Has ample ability but others still easier to trust
- **16. KRACKMANIA -** Drops in category after coming 9th of 11 finishers, behind KIKA JOSSELYN (13), in a Class B over course and distance late last month. Is proven at this level but in current condition is not easy to recommend

Summary: Winner of 2 from 3 at the venue, KHAMSA (7) dictated the law late last month and will take all the beating if she stays in stride. That said, KASSYA (11) has won 50% of her Vincennes races and her latest performance bodes well for her chances. The good KIKA JOSSELYN (13) thrives over 2700m here and can play a leading role. KORALIA DE CROUAY (2) steps up in class after outclassing the opposition mid-November and must be taken seriously.
