1. LEMBELIE VERDERIE - Good, consistent filly that finished 4th of 11, at 30/1, in a 2725m Class D here 10 days ago. Not a priority but always gives her best and will generate some interest

2. LOUPIAC DE GODREL - Modest colt that was sanctioned early in a 2725m Class D here 10 days ago. Just front pads fitted this time but still not an obvious choice

3. LUBIN SECRET - In the frame in first 4 before finishing a well-beaten 7th of 8 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C last Sunday and backs up with limited ambition

4. LOTUS DE BEYLEV - Got straight down to business, after a 5 months' break, in a 2200m Caen Class E late-May. Comes here fresh, with a front-row start, and is not one to be overlooked

5. LEMONADE FIZZ - 6th of 10, on first start since the layoff, in a 2700m Vincennes Class C a fortnight ago. Will have come on for the run but still no more than a minor place prospect

6. LET'S GO MAURICIEN - Took his game to a new level mid-June when winning a 2450m Caen Class D. Has earned the right to take his chances here and the 3-timer looks a distinct possibility

7. LIBELLA DU HOULBET - Has not been seen out since coming last of 6, behind LAMATTA (13), in a 2850m Vincennes Class C late-April. Breaks from the front but others still preferred

8. LOVE GLYCINES - Could well have won a 2150m Enghien Class D a fortnight ago had he not hesitated 30m out, but Franck Nivard is unlikely to allow the same thing to happen again. Chance

9. LABEL GEMA - Runner-up in last 2, latterly a 2200m Caen Class D late last month. Benefits from a superb entry in front and can play a leading role

10. LITTLE KING - Complicated type starting for the first time since faulting in a 2175m Vincennes Class A late-January. Has ample ability but will need the race

11. LAZURA PRIOR - Last of 6 in a 2175m Vincennes Class B early last month and even in this company will have too much to do

12. LOVELY TRIP - Drops back in category after faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class A on 21 May. Showed his form that day though, has had time to get his game together and, with shoes back on, can redeem himself

13. LAMATTA - Makes her first appearance since faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class A late-May. Impressive in last 2 racing right-handed and, even though shod, must still be taken seriously

14. LOVER SIXTY ONE - Complicated but promising colt making first start since faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class A late-February and is sure to be race-rusty

15. LOVELY KOOL - Flattering 3rd of 8 finishers in a 2875m Enghien claimer a fortnight ago and will struggle to make any impact

16. LAGNU MAG - Left a good impression at Vincennes before coming close 2nd in a 2950m Vichy Class B on 25 June. Incurs the handicap but in this category looks competitively well-in

Summary: A number of quality elements lining up here but preference must nevertheless go to front-line starters LET'S GO MAURICIEN (6) who debuts at Cabourg on a hat-trick, and LOVE GLYCINES (8) and LABEL GEMA (9) who are plainly close to getting off the mark. Well-engaged at the limit of earnings, LAGNU MAG (16) has done nothing but improve lately and even with an extra 25m to travel, looks a player.

2. FAUST DE BEYLEV - Makes first French start since faulting over 2100m at Kouvola mid-June, and present form does little to inspire confidence

3. DOWHATYOUDODOWELL - Sports modified shoeing after coming 9th of 16 in a 2850m Vincennes Gr.3 late last month. Not a priority but will certainly not be available at 90/1 on this occasion

4. FARCEUR DE MAI - 5th of 12 in a 2875m Enghien Class D a fortnight ago but, in this company, will have his work cut out

5. FERRERO DU LOISIR - Capable on a good day and most recently 5th of 16 in a 2800m Castéra-Verduzan harness Class E late last month. Barefoot for the occasion but other more attractive options available

6. HARMONIOUSLY - Surprise 6th of 10 to HORSY ROYAL (7) in Caen race of reference, but a repeat seems highly unlikely

7. HORSY ROYAL - Surprisingly out of sorts when 6th of 9 in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 3 July but Paul Ploquin will be loathe to let the same thing happen again. Claim

8. FLOPY RUSH - Was pleasing in both codes before flopping to 8th of 10 finishers in a 3100m Class E at La Gacilly last weekend, and hind shoes off or not, is unlikely to spring any surprises

9. HIS DREAM DE CAHOT - Blows hot and cold but in the frame in last 2, most recently 3rd of 9 finishers in a 2875m Enghien Class D earlier this month, and has the capacity to finish close

10. HUGO OCCAGNES - Quickly sanctioned in a 2750m Class D here a week ago. Has otherwise been firing on all cylinders, sports a new configuration and, with application, can finish in the mix

11. GLADYS DU CEDRE - Last but one when preparing for this in a 2675m Class D at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 26 June. Barefoot, as is her preference, and can pick up a thin slice of the pie

12. IBERIK DE MONGOCHY - Last but one when prepping for this in a 2850m Vincennes Gr.3 on 23 June. Shod to preference for return to his code of preference and looks a serious proposition

13. GUAPO MARBOULA - Pleased at Laval before being sanctioned in a 2850m Vincennes Class C 3 weeks ago. Stays shod though and others easier to back

Summary: Although oddly lacklustre last time out, HORSY ROYAL (7) has otherwise been in flying form for some time and, winner of his only Cabourg start, will be expected to make a good go of this. Paul Ploquin will nevertheless be keeping a watchful eye on IMPALA DE VAL (1) who has already imposed 5 times this year, and the complicated but talented IBERIK DE MONGOCHY (12) who flew up in a Vincennes Class D 2 months ago, and who returns to racing unshod-behind. HIS DREAM DE CAHOT (9) reassured in Paris 9 days ago and, with form maintained, can again make the frame.

2. HEIDI DU BISET - Has not got her nose in front for some time but held her own when 5th in last week's race of reference. Gabi Gelormini maintains faith and his mare will not be sent out at 30/1 this time around

3. IOHANNA THIEBEN - Very good 3rd of 13 in a 2750m Class E here last week. Shod as she was here early last month, has never disappointed at Cabourg and, from the 3-spot, should have the measure of the field

4. HEDENN LOVE DE REM - Sanctioned in a 2900m Arras Class G late last month, to continue her poor run of form, and can be confidently ruled out

5. LOAD MASTER - Quality Swedish sort making his French debut not having run since coming last of 12 over 2140m at Solvalla on Boxing Day, but he races barefoot for the occasion and is sure to generate interest

6. NEVELE HALL GRAUX - Not the horse he once was but has been pleasing lately. 4th over 2840m at Mons just over 3 weeks ago and, racing barefoot for the first time in 15 months, will be worth keeping an eye on

7. HUNICOIS - Back in the professional ranks after going down by little in a 2200m Caen Class G on 24 June. Handed a wide berth but excels with his driver and looks principal danger to IOHANNA THIEBEN (3)

8. HIPPONY BOURGEOISE - Pleased twice before coming 8th to IOHANNA THIEBEN (3) in a 3000m Jallais Class E mid-June, and will have nothing to offer

9. IRMINIO KILY - Did not enjoy the best of trips when sanctioned in a 2800m Vichy Class F late last month. Acquits himself respectably for the most part when focused however and even from the 2nd line, can make his presence felt

10. IRON MAN DE HOERDT - Last of 9 in a 2850m Vincennes claimer on 25 June and has no realistic chance

11. OBLIVION - Unraced since faulting in a 2150m Enghien Class D 4 months ago. Is in competition-mode for his comeback though and must be afforded respect

12. CAMPIONE RAL - Races barefoot for the first time this term after finishing last of 5 in a 2250m Enghien monté Class E a fortnight ago, and is unlikely to influence the result

13. COMAND - Sent for a spell after coming last of 11 in a 2950m Vichy Class D early-May. Barefoot this time but is forced to start on back line and others easier to support

14. HERCULE DE L'OISON - Surprise winner of a 2500m Molières Class H last weekend but has been handed a tough draw and is not about to shake things up

Summary: Third to a very good horse here just last week, after having twice come close, IOHANNA THIEBEN (3) finds herself with a top spot behind the car and, with hind shoes back on, will take all the beating. HUNICOIS (7) starts wide but is enjoying a productive run of form and has won 2 of 3 for Yoann Lebourgeois. The complicated OBLIVION (11) starts on the second row but has nothing to prove at this level, and barefoot for re-entry, is not to be underestimated. HEROINE DARCHE (1) finished a place behind David Armellini's mare here last week and will be expected to confirm.

4. HEROS DE BONNEFOI - 10th of 15, when being conditioned, in a 3200m Montmirail Class E late last month. Is hard to fault when focused and the Lebourgeois-factor must be taken into account. Chance

5. GISARO - Races shod after coming 5th of 15 in a 3200m Montmirail Class E on 30 June and will not be influencing the outcome

6. HARMATTAN DU RIB - Unthreatening 8th of 14 in a 2725m Lisieux Class F early-June. Has form here but in current condition is not easy to like

7. GOLIATH DU RIEU - Disqualified from 3rd at Agen before finishing 9th of 11 in a 2700m Graignes conditioner late last month. Is barefoot this time and, while not a priority, is still worth retaining

8. HEPAX SPEED - Made it 2 on the trot when securing a 1609m Vichy Class F last week. Benefits from a good entry here and is worth keeping an eye on

9. HOCHE - Seldom disappoints when barefoot and focused, most recently setting his personal best time when close 2nd in a 2100m Vincennes Class D mid-June. 25m more to travel this time but can still impose

10. GOLDORACK - Makes first appearance since coming last of 16 in a 2650m Alençon Class D late-April. Front pads fitted and no threat

11. HONEY KING - On a cracking run of form since late-March, most recently winning a 2750m Ecommoy Class E on 23 June. Shoes on this time but has excellent Cabourg references and is not going to finish far from the action

12. HASARD D'ERABLE - 3rd, a place behind HOCHE (9), in a 2100m Vincennes Class D mid-June. Is clearly at her best but sports shoes this time and best to wait

13. FREDO GRIFF - Last but one in a 3100m Class E at La Gacilly last weekend, on just 3rd start following an extended layoff. Just front shoes off this time but can still be disregarded

14. HARDI CROWN - Sanctioned in a 2875m Enghien monté Class D 9 days ago after having won 2 in a row, also under the saddle. 4 pads fitted this time and can get in on the action if form transitions

15. FROZEN QUEEN - Unraced since finishing 10th of 12 in a 3000m Châteaubriant monté Class D early-February. Has decent harness credentials but is going to need the outing

Summary: HARRY DE MIENNAIS (2) has taken his game to a new level since moving to Pierre Sorais' yard last summer and, from the front line, can pull off the hat-trick. It's not a done deal though given the present shape of the newly-configured HOCHE (9) who still looks a major player from the second row. HEROS DE BONNEFOI (4) is barefoot following 2 re-entry runs and, entrusted to Yoann Lebourgeois, will not be put down easily. FELICITA D'ECOUVES (16) enjoys a fabulous entry, returns to racing barefoot, and a repeat of her recent Enghien performance would see her finish close.

3. JAGUAR DE KARA - Barring a Meslay sanction has been very hard to fault recently. 3rd of 10 in a 2950m Vichy Class E in the middle of June but looks to be taking on too much this time

4. JADESKA - Honest mare that always gives her best, most recently 3rd of 16 in a 2800m Bernay Class E on 23 June but, at this level, will have too much to do

5. JERICHO DU RIB - Barring his Laval blip, has been in fine fettle this term, reassuringly close 2nd of 14 finishers in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel late-June, and a repeat performance would see him finish in the mix once more

6. JEEDAYA DU VIVIER - Classy mare but sanctioned on re-entry in a Class E over course and distance a week ago. Is still in conditioning-mode and best to hold off

7. JUST AN ARTIST - Springs the occasional surprise but below-par in last 2, most recently 7th of 13 in a 2725m Lisieux Class F last week, and others easier to back

8. JINGALO DU CHENE - Quickly sanctioned in a 2100m Vincennes Class E mid-May. Has had time to get his act together and could well win this if he gets off on the right foot

9. JEZABELLE BIE - Pleased at Vire under harness a month ago before winning a 2675m monté Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel late last month. Has references at the venue but would be preferred under the saddle

8. JOKER BATMAN - 2nd to JOYAU DE JANZE (9) at Meslay before bagging a 2550m Reims Class F 4 weeks ago. Comes here fresh and is not incapable of confirming

9. JOYAU DE JANZE - Won smartly at Meslay-du-Maine before repeating in a 2450m Caen Class E mid-June. Found his way racing right-handed and has a realistic chance of securing the 3-timer

10. JAKVAL DES BORDES - 6th of 11 finishers in a 2525m harness Class F at Les Andelys on 30 June. Has not once disappointed in the ridden code when unshod and, even though stepping up in category, can play a small role

11. JALISCA DE CHENU - Made up for her Castillonnès fault when 5th of 7 in a 2850m Laval Class E a fortnight ago, but still represents no more than a minor place chance

12. JOLIE DES BAUX - Pleasant 2nd of 9 finishers in a 3475m Agon-Coutainville harness Class F late last month. Has made little impression under the saddle since last November and will require more than just a shoeing change

13. JUVACAT DE CAPONET - Won at Graignes before coming 2nd of 6 finishers in a 2175m Vincennes Class E early-February before being put away. Appreciates Cabourg, is barefoot for re-entry and, with application, can finish close

14. JULES DES CHAMPS - 9th of 16, when preparing for this in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class E late-May. Sports a fresh configuration and looks competitive for a first-5 spot

15. JAVA SPORT - Sanctioned on re-entry in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel late last month. Fitted with front pads this time and, if fully-fit, will not be far from the action

16. JOYEUSE D'OCCAGNES - Got back in the game 3 weeks ago when 2nd of 5 finishers in a 2550m Reims Class E and, with form maintained, is unlikely to disappoint

17. JALISCO DE NEUVY - Sanctioned in a 2750m harness Class F here a week ago. Ideallyengaged but has placed just once in 7 monté starts and is not an obvious choice

Summary: Like a horse reborn since returning from his spell, JOYAU DE JANZE (9) made it two in a row at Caen last month and, racing clockwise again, can pull off the hat-trick. That being said, the less-experienced, but no-less-capable, JOKER BATMAN (8) finished runner-up to him at Meslay before winning at Reims just a fortnight later, and will be no pushover. JUVACAT DE CAPONET (13) is never far from faulting but has a big engine and, if fully fit, will be dangerous. JARKA DE BEYLEV (5) ran Clément Frecelle's horse close at Caen before pleasing at Vire, and is not going to be far off the mark.

5. L'INTOUCHABLE - Unremarkable 8th, behind LUCKY DES GAUDINES (10), in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 26 June and, even with front pads fitted, will not be improving on that

6. LOVE DE BELLOUET - Sanctioned when subject of interference in a 2450m Caen Class D on 17 June. Has evident ability, is plainly in shape, and will not be far off the mark if Antonin André can keep him out of trouble

7. LINO DU POMMEREUX - Opened his account at Vire late-May but failed to confirm a month ago when 6th, a place behind L'INTOUCHABLE (5), in a 2700m Vire Class E, and is unlikely to cause an upset

8. LE ROCKER DE PLAY - Made up for his moderate Cholet performance when 3rd, a place ahead of LACERTOSUS (13), in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E mid-June and is not going to be available at 24/1 on this occasion

9. LOBSTER DU BELLAY - Nicely-related colt that has done everything right so far, most recently winning a 2800m Bernay Class F with some ease, and is in with a realistic shout of doubling up

10. LUCKY DES GAUDINES - Defied his 51/1 to finish 3rd of 14 in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel late last month and, if still on the boil, is unlikely to go home empty-handed

11. LITTLEBOY DE PLANY - Complicated sort that came good with 2850m Laon monté Class F victory on 23 June. Here for a change of scenery however and can be ignored

12. LEONARDO DU DERBY - Progressive sort making his first appearance since finishing last of 8 in a 2200m Vincennes Class D mid-April. Trainer at the helm this time and is unlikely to be given a hard race

13. LACERTOSUS - Raced 3 times last month, getting off the mark in a 2525m Class E at Les Andelys late-June. Returns to a hard surface and will be no shrinking violet if he turns

14. LE VOLONTAIRE - Has made excellent progress since his sanctioned debut. Won a 2275m Craon Class F on 24 June and, with Franck Nivard driving, will be afforded every chance

Summary: Put away after giving a fine account of himself on debut, LOBSTER DU BELLAY (9) got off the mark recently on his first start for 3 months, and has the wherewithal to repeat, but Jean-Etienne Le Bec will be justifiably wary of LARGO DE LA BESSE (3) who will be no easy touch if Yoann Lebourgeois gets him off on the right foot, and LACERTOSUS (13) who lost his maiden status just late last month. Regularly object of the stewards' scrutiny, LOVE DE BELLOUET (6) was very unlucky last time out and, with Florian Desmigneux reining, can begin to make amends.
