- **1. ISLA MUJERES -** Quality mare returning to racing barefoot after coming 6th, behind INDIANA D'ESPACE (13), in a 2625m Class F at Saint-Omer 2.5 weeks ago. Has a lot going for her here and Franck Nivard will be eager to capitalise
- **2. HOLLENBOURG -** Quality dual-discipline sort with 2 races under his belt since the break, most recently last but one in a 2725m Graignes Class E. Handed a decent draw but may just be one run shy
- **3. HOSCOTTE DE MAUPAS -** 3rd of 12 in a 2525m amateurs conditioning Class F late last month. Well-positioned behind the car here and can make a big splash
- **4. FILS D'HAUFOR -** Last of 12 in a 2725m Graignes Class E 10 days ago and in current condition, has no realistic chance
- **5. HIROSS -** Steps back up in category after coming 5th, behind HOSCOTTE DE MAUPAS (3), in a 2525m amateurs Class F at Les Andelys on 31 August. Is confirmed here though and, from the 5-spot, should not be ruled out
- **6. GOSSIP BOY -** Returns to the professional ranks after coming 4th of 10 in a 2875m Enghien amateurs Class F early last month. Trounced on lone appearance here and can be passed over
- **7. INVICTUS DE HOERDT -** Defied his odds to come 4th of 13 in a 2500m Reims Class E late-August and will need to be taken more seriously this time around. Chance
- **8. HIATUS -** Steps up in category after dominating a 2100m Vincennes claimer last week. Breaks from the wide outside but, in current form, is hard to ignore
- **9. IN VIVO -** Encouraged at La Capelle but failed to convert when 8th of 10 in a 3000m Class F at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre on 4 August, and can expect to have few friends
- **10. GOWEN CHALEONNAIS -** Honest type that finished 4th of 9 in a 2900m Amiens amateurs Class G last Saturday but faces a much stiffer test this time around
- **11. INFIEL -** Failed to confirm his mid-August Vincennes success when faulting in a 2625m Saint-Omer Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Form is not in doubt though, has front pads fitted, and will not be far off the mark if Pierre-Yves Verva defies the draw
- **12. IMIKO JIEL -** Has ability but 11th of 13 in a 2500m Reims Class E on 31 August. Entrusted to Yoann Lebourgeois for first time though and will generate some interest
- **13. INDIANA D'ESPACE -** Won at Saint-Omer before coming 3rd of 11, ahead of ISLA MUJERES (1), in a 2625m Class F at the same venue 2.5 weeks ago. Could have wished for a better draw but still looks a player
- **14. HEXCELLENTE -** 6th of 11 in a 2875m Enghien Class D early-July and, in present form, can be confidently disregarded

Summary: It has been just over a year since ISLA MUJERES (1) got her nose in front but she is clearly in shape, races barefoot for the occasion, and the engagement of Franck Nivard will only facilitate her cause. INVICTUS DE HOERDT (7) is forced to start wide on the front line but has been going good-guns for some time, and is not incapable of making his Mauquenchy debut a winning one. HOSCOTTE DE MAUPAS (3) has been handed an ideal draw, is proven here, and races unshod-all-4. Currently enjoying a fruitful run of form, INDIANA D'ESPACE (13) sports a new configuration and will be dangerous if Alexis Garandeau successfully navigates the start.

- **2. KRONOS DE TROIS -** Sanctioned in a 2100m Vincennes claimer on 24 August. Won on only start at the venue, but even going barefoot, will not find the going easy
- **3. KUZCO -** 6th of 9, on return from a short spell, in a 2550m Dieppe Class F 10 days ago. Races first-time barefoot but still has a lot to find
- **4. KITA DU RIB -** Opened her account [at 17th time of asking] in a 2650m Class F at Divonneles-Bains 3 weeks ago. Has previously raced and placed here but, on this occasion, looks out of her league
- **5. KLARA DESBOIS -** Reassured somewhat when 4th of 8 in a 2400m Class F at Nort-sur-Erdre earlier this month. Has bags of untapped potential and will be no soft touch if Adrien Lamy can keep her trotting
- **6. KHEOPS DU PERRON -** Won twice at Biarritz before running 6th of 10 in a 2475m Villeréal claimer a month back. Faces a stiffer test this time however and chances limited

Summary: Beaten only by a very good horse at Vire when barefoot for the first time, KASSYA (15) enjoys an excellent entry here and most certainly has the wherewithal to impose. Yoann Lebourgeois will still be keeping a watchful eye on the better-placed KLARA DESBOIS (5) who races first-time barefoot after having reassured earlier this month, and the erratic but capable KAPTAIN DE L'OCEAN (8) who debuts for his new handler in a fresh configuration. KLASSIC WINNER (10) is superbly-entered on the front line and should logically bounce back from his recent Laval disappointment.

Summary: Nicely-entered here, JADE (16) was by no means disgraced in Paris after having imposed at Meslay and looks a marginally better bet than the similarly well-engaged JET SET DU BELLAY (17) who is significantly better than recent results would suggest. JAMBIER (11) is never far from faulting but has otherwise been in fine shape and looks a player. 25m better off, JULIUS ECUS (6) is plainly on the way up and, sports front pads for the first time, and can pleasantly surprise.

- **3. ILVICA DE HOUELLE -** 6th of 9 over course and distance before faulting, when never in touch, in a 2725m Pornichet Class E 3 weeks ago. Pierre-Yves Verva onboard this time but still no more than a minor place prospect
- **4. ISIS DU LEARD -** Failed to pull off the 4-timer when sanctioned, with gas in the tank, in a 2400m Châteaubriant Class F on 9 August. Is a force when applied though and will be expected to put things right

- **6. GALOPIN DE POTES -** Reassured at La Capelle before faulting early in a 2400m Amiens Class G on 1 August. Is plainly capable when focused but others easier to trust
- **7. IMAIL DE CARSI -** Makes first monté appearance of the summer after trotting 3rd of 11 in a 2775m Craon harness Class F on 1 September. Front pads fitted and looks dangerous on his Mauquenchy debut
- **8. GERONIMO STARDUST -** Back under the saddle after coming 9th of 10 in a 2800m Strasbourg harness Class E 2 weeks ago and will have few, if any, friends
- **9. ICARE DU POMMEREUX -** 5th of 11 in a 2550m amateurs Class F at Les Andelys on 31 August. Has previously won under these conditions and, although not a contender, can still pick up a thin slice of the pie
- **10. HOLLYWOOD GIRL -** Good 2nd of 7 in a 2750m Class G at La Capelle late last month. Andréa Roussel onboard again and seems up to the task of challenging for a place on the podium

- **3. KOCKTAIL DE CARA -** Light on experience but has placed in 2 of 3, most recently 3rd to KORINA DE BEYLEV (15) in a 2850m Laon Class F early-June. Shod to preference for re-entry and looks competitively well-in
- **4. KHEOPS CAILLERIE -** Reassured at Bacqueville-en-Caux before being sanctioned early in a 2750m Cabourg Class F mid-August. Front shoes off this time and should not be entirely overlooked
- **5. KOLOMBO -** Returns to racing with hind pads fitted after trotting 9th, behind KOOKY LA HURETRY (6), in a 2700m Graignes Class F 10 days ago, but others still easier to back
- **6. KOOKY LA HURETRY -** Pleasantly surprising 5th of 13 in a 2700m Graignes Class F 10 days ago, but a repeat seems improbable
- **7. KALINE ERCA -** Takes to the monté discipline for the first time following 2 straight sanctions, latterly in a 2750m Class F at La Ferté-Vidame late-July. Sports a new formula, with Jean-Yann Ricart on board, but others still preferred
- **8. KEEPSAKE -** Debuts in the discipline after trotting 4th of 9 in a 2800m Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles earlier this month and looks the sort that can do well in the code. First 3
- **9. KAHIRO -** Ability not in doubt but reliability is, most recently sanctioned in a 2675m Divonneles-Bains Class E, and must first reassure
- **10. KISS ME DE CORTEM -** 5th of 9 in a 2825m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on Monday. Is capable when focused but is being aimed too high this time
- **11. KAYAK GEMA -** Produced 2 good performances before being sanctioned in a 2775m Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne 2 weeks ago. Is clearly close to his race and, with application, can play a prominent role
- **12. KALOU DE TESS -** 7th of 8 in a 2550m Cherbourg Class E 3.5 weeks ago on return from a spell. Showed marked improvement in the spring and, if fully-fit, can play a role
- **13. KOLCANI JEEP -** Failed to confirm his Divonne-les-Bains performance when 10th of 13 in a 2200m Vincennes Class E last week, and can be passed over
- **14. KILLER MELOC -** Tricky character taking first competitive monté steps after finishing 9th of 11 in a 2750m harness Class E at La Capelle last Sunday, and appears to have no possible chance
- **15. KORINA DE BEYLEV -** Won at Laon before coming 2nd of 11 in a 2750m Cabourg Class F on 13 August. Is making up for lost time and has a reasonable chance of getting her nose in front

That said, KORINA DE BEYLEV (15) has proven more dependable lately and present form augurs well for her chances. KEEPSAKE (8) makes his first appearance under the saddle but has shown enough in the other code to be considered a decent place chance. Shod this time, KAYAK GEMA (11) will not be far from the action if Mathis Champenois keeps him trotting.

- **3. LILY MARGOT -** Has had time to freshen up after coming 2nd of 6 over track and trip late-July. Is plainly an improving filly and is well-placed to challenge L'AMIRAL TURGOT (6) for the win
- **4. LUSANIO DE WARNOC -** Honest colt that trotted 4th behind LILY MARGOT (3) in a Class E over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Always gives his best and has the capacity to finish in first 5

- **9. LOKI FACTIER -** Sent for a break after winning at Le Neuborg in May. 4th, close behind L'ECLAIR DE PLAY (2), on re-entry in a 2050m Cabourg Class E 3 weeks ago. On 2nd row but still worth keeping an eye on
- **10. LEA D'AMOUR -** Lost her maiden tag in a 2200m Class E at Agon-Coutainville 2 weeks ago. Draw will not be an issue in this small field and the engagement of François Lagadeuc will only work in her favour

Summary: Comfortable winner of both starts to date, L'AMIRAL TURGOT (6) sports hind pads, takes to the sand for the first time, with Yoann Lebourgeois reining, and looks eminently capable of pulling off the hat-trick. Similarly progressive, LILY MARGOT (3) finished 2nd over course and distance late-July and, from the 3-spot, will not go down easily. Sanctioned when going well here last month, LITTLEKING FOXGLEN (8) is better than his Vincennes result would suggest and entrusted to Franck Nivard, will be afforded every chance. Although not exactly a model of consistency, LEA D'AMOUR (10) opened her account late last month and is not incapable of picking up a place cheque.

- **1. HEDENN LOVE DE REM -** Sanctioned in a 2475m Francheville Class F mid-August. Has done nothing noteworthy for some time and can be ruled out
- **2. HIJO MOKO -** Drops back to his preferred category after coming 5th of 12 in a 2700m Graignes Class F a fortnight ago and the draw only works to his advantage. Chance
- **3. HURRICANE STEED -** 5th, a place behind FREGATE HAUFOR (6), in a 2725m Graignes amateurs Class G 10 days ago. Has a good spot on front line and, with form maintained, can repeat
- **4. HYGNUS PRIOR -** A tough individual in the amateur ranks, most recently 5th of 11 in a 2850m Carentan amateurs Class H mid-August. Should appreciate Mauquenchy profile and from the 4-spot, can bring home the bacon
- **5. HENZO D'ARC -** Returns to the amateur division after coming 10th of 12 in Graignes race of reference. Positioned well on front line but chances still limited
- **6. FREGATE HAUFOR -** Pleasant 4th of 9 in a 2725m Graignes amateurs Class G 10 days ago. Starts in front and while not a priority, is still capable of getting a look-in
- **7. HIMEROS DU GOUTIER -** Blows hot and cold but reassured when 4th of 10 over 2300m at Mons last week. Has form with Béatrice Demoulin and is capable of making first 5 here
- **8. GUESS LUFFY -** Drops down the class-ladder after coming 8th behind HIJO MOKO (2) at Graignes but is still unlikely to improve on that
- **9. FENOMENON -** Unremarkable 6th behind FREGATE HAUFOR (6) in a 2725m Graignes amateurs Class G 10 days ago and has no possible chance
- **10. HUMBERSTON -** Has solid amateur references but currently out of sorts, most recently 8th of 10 in a 3475m Agon-Coutainville claimer 2.5 weeks ago, and appears to have little to contribute
- **11. HARDI DE LAUMIERE -** Sanctioned when unsupported in a 2850m Vincennes claimer a fortnight ago and can be confidently ignored
- **12. GYPSIE MAGIQUE -** Somewhat below-par since winning at Amiens in July, most recently last but one, behind HIJO MOKO (2), in a 2700m Graignes Class F 2 weeks ago. Is better than that however and, if focused, can figure prominently
- **13. GAVROCHE BOCAIN -** Good 2nd of 8 in a 2150m Cagnes amateurs Class G 3.5 weeks ago. Has hardly put a foot wrong this summer and despite the draw, still looks competitively well-in
- **14. FARMONY DE JUPILLE -** Showed marked improvement when close 2nd of 8 in an 1800m amateurs Class G at La Capelle last week. Handed a tough draw but is still worth monitoring

Summary: Faithful for the most part, HYGNUS PRIOR (4) made up for his Enghien blip at Carentan last time out and, reconfigured and superbly-positioned behind the car, can win this. Grégory Rochna-Dumont will still be wary of the in-form HIJO MOKO (2) who has thrived at this level in 2024, and the less-fortunately-placed GAVROCHE BOCAIN (13) who is close to winning another. Already 3 times a winner in the amateur category this season, GYPSIE MAGIQUE (12) has a fine opportunity to get back in the game.
