- **2. LASCAR D'ENFER -** Made it 2 straight sanctions when faulting in a 2750m Craon Class B on 23 September. Has ample ability and returns to a hard surface with a reasonable chance of getting around unscathed and into the mix
- **3. LIBERTY PIYA -** Tricky filly that got off the mark at Cabourg before faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class D earlier this month. Has a big engine though and, on good behaviour, will be no easy touch
- **4. LADY DE GREZ -** Has not been seen out since coming 4th in a 2725m Lisieux Class C early-June. Has won here under the saddle, sports pads again, but is unlikely to cause an upset
- **5. LA CHENEVIERE -** Sanctioned when never threatening in a 2700m Vincennes monté Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Makes harness debut for a change of scenery and can be ruled out
- **6. LABORANTIN -** Has merit but has looked ordinary lately, most recently sanctioned in a 2950m Le Mans Class D a month back, and must get his house in order

- **8. LITTLEKING FOXGLEN -** Disappointing in 2 after winning at Mauquenchy, latterly last of 10 in a 2100m Vincennes Class C 8 days ago, and others easier to trust
- **9. LETTY DE BEYLEV -** Won her only start here earlier in the year, but has not been seen out since faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class C late-May, and can be passed over
- **10. LODESTAR -** Left a very good impression when successful in a 2275m Nantes Class D a fortnight ago. Races shod this time though and a minor place prospect at best
- **11. LYSANDRA -** Unopposed winner of a 2725m Cabourg Class E 9 days ago, and if still on the boil can double up
- **12. LIBERTE DU GOUTIER -** Quality element that ran 8th of 11, on return from a spell, in a 2600m Cherbourg Class B 2.5 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run but is still in conditioning mode and best to hold off

- **3. LOTUS PAULOIS -** Showed the limits of his capacity when 7th of 10 behind LOCHAN (9) in a 2700m Vincennes Class A 3 weeks ago. Ignore
- **4. L'AS DE COEUR -** Hard to fault lately in this branch of the business, most recently 2nd of 8 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 3 September, but at this level of competition, will have too much to do
- **5. LUXOR DE VILLABON -** Back in the discipline after finishing 6th of 7 in a 2950m Toulouse harness Class B a fortnight ago. Hind pads fitted but is not made for this class of racing and can be ruled out
- **6. LAMBADA DU GOUTIER -** Went into her summer break on a high note, returning 3 weeks ago to finish 4th behind LOCHAN (9) in a 2700m Vincennes Class A. Will have progressed, sports 4 pads for first time, and looks an interesting outside chance
- **7. LUZ FATALE** Courageous 6th of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class A 3 weeks ago, but has never finished better than 4th in a Gr.3 and will have her work cut out
- **8. LEGENDE DU GOUTIER -** Won 3 from 4 before finishing 3rd of 10, a place behind LOCHAN (9), in a 2700m Vincennes Class A 3 weeks ago. Similarly-configured and is worth keeping an eye on
- **9. LOCHAN -** Progressive colt taking a big hike in class after coming 2nd of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class A 3 weeks ago. Is clearly a progressive colt and will not be far from the action if he turns
- **10. LIBERTINE DJOB -** Defied her odds to run 4th of 7 in 2700m Vincennes Gr.2 Prix de Basly on 13 September. Unlikely to repeat but can still hold her own
- **11. LUCAS -** 2nd of 7, at 29/1, in 2700m Vincennes Gr.2 Prix de Basly on 13 September. Pads fitted this time and is thoroughly capable of making his way into the mix
- **12. LOVISSIME -** Won first 3 monté starts before coming 5th of 7 finishers, behind LUTIN DES BORDES (15), in 2700m Gr.1 Prix d'Essai late-June. Sports pads for re-entry, will be fresh, and looks a respectable first-5 prospect
- **13. LYZIA DES AGETS -** 9th of 10, on re-entry, in a 2700m Vincennes harness Gr.3 a fortnight ago. 5th in Caen race of reference, has won in this class, and justifiably warrants significant respect
- **14. LET ME SHINE GIO -** Last but one when being conditioned for this in a 2700m Vincennes harness Gr.2 late-August. Has bags of ability but also has a temperament. Change of shoeing though and with application, can get a look-in
- **15. LUTIN DES BORDES -** Sanctioned on first start since the break, in a 2700m Vincennes harness Gr.1 on 14 September. 2nd to LITTLE ORELIE (16) in Gr.2 Prix de Basly late-June and, with hind pads fitted, will be no soft touch

16. LITTLE ORELIE - Sanctioned on return to competition a month ago, in 2700m Vincennes Gr.2 Prix de Basly. Won Gr.2 Prix Pierre Gamare over track and trip during the spring and if she disposes of LUTIN DES BORDES (15), the race is hers for the taking

Summary: On paper, this looks a 2-horse race between LITTLE ORELIE (16) who won the Gr.2 Prix Pierre Gamare over course and distance in May, and the reconfigured LUTIN DES BORDES (15) who finished runner-up to her that day before turning the tables on her in the Prix d'Essai. But racing being what it is, nothing is a guarantee, which leaves the door open for the padded LYZIA DES AGETS (13) who beat Mathieu Mottier's filly during the spring, and the reliably-performant LOCHAN (9) who races here on his merits.

- **1. KYMJO DE BELFOND -** On a decent run of form these days, latterly 5th of 9 in a 2950m Toulouse Class C 3 weeks ago. Would, however, be preferred at a lower level
- **2. KASSOUMAYE -** Good future prospect making first start since coming 2nd of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D late-May. Shoes on though and best to wait
- **3. KANAK DU BOCAGE -** Last but one, on return to competition, to KYLEBEAU DU LUOT (9) in a Class E over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the run and looks a serious candidate
- **4. KALEO DE BANVILLE -** Steps back up in class after dominating a 2850m Vincennes claimer on 5 September. Unlikely to repeat but the draw will do his prospects no disservice
- **5. KAISER GRIFF -** Produced 4 good efforts before failing to fire, coming last of 8 in a 2775m Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne late-August. Returns fresh, is ideally-placed in front, and should logically play an active role
- **6. KASH DE TILLARD -** Unraced since finishing 11th of 13 in a 2850m Bréhal Class E 2 months ago. Has looked ordinary this term and can be ruled out
- **7. KISS YOU PIYA -** Returns to racing clockwise after running [a somewhat unlucky] 6th of 12 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D early last month. Is plainly in form and looks good enough to make first 5
- **8. KING BLACK DANOVER -** Failed to confirm his Cabourg performance when sanctioned in a 2950m Toulouse Class C on 20 September. Starts wide and others easier to back
- **9. KYLEBEAU DU LUOT -** Comfortable winner of a Class E over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Has shown a different side since starting to race barefoot and, with Lebourgeois in the bike, can defy the draw and repeat
- **10. KOKA RIGHT -** Courageous 5th of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Won twice right-handed over the summer and will not be far off the mark if Franck Nivard successfully navigates the start
- **11. KOUROUX -** Encouraged at Vire before running 7th to KYLEBEAU DU LUOT (9) in a 2450m Class E here 3 weeks ago. Not a priority but can play a small part if he gets off on the right foot
- **12. KEKOA -** 6th of 10, a place behind KOKA RIGHT (10), in a 2700m Vincennes Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Honest mare with form at the venue but still no more than a minor place prospect
- **13. KRYSTAL DU RUEL -** 8th of 16, behind KYLEBEAU DU LUOT (9) in a 2450m Class E here 3 weeks ago. Proved himself right-handed at Bréhal and will not be far off the mark if David Thomain manages to keep him trotting
- **14. KEOPS BEGONIA -** Has not been seen out since faulting early in a 2150m Vichy Class D on 3 August. Has had time to recalibrate and will be no pushover if Anthony Barrier assures his initial strides
- **15. KINOS DE CRENNES -** Got off the mark at Le Sap before faulting in a 2725m Lisieux Class F 3 weeks ago. Takes a big step up in category and the draw only compounds matters

16. KART HAUFOR - 14th of 16, behind KYLEBEAU DU LUOT (9,) in a 2450m Class E here 3 weeks ago. Has bags of talent but stays shod and will not be given a hard race

Summary: KYLEBEAU DU LUOT (9) showed his superiority over longer here late last month, continuing his rejuvenating barefoot streak. Winner of 2 from 3 with Yoann Lebourgeois reining, he returns to the venue and, despite the draw, can confirm. KEOPS BEGONIA (14) does not enjoy the best position either but he comes fresh to Caen and, with application, can play an important role. KANAK DU BOCAGE (3) has a run under his belt following the summer break and, barefoot from the 3-spot, will have his chances. KRYSTAL DU RUEL (13) sports a new configuration and will be expected to show marked improvement on his latest effort.
