1. MUELHEIMER PERLE - Hard-knocker with references in handicaps and course-and-distance claimers. Won a 2000m handicap at Salon-de-Provence last month and finished 4th under a penalty there in a conditions race on 30 September

2. GIRAFFE - Consistent and versatile filly with sound references in handicaps on both surfaces. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for a recent failure (10th) in a 1900m Quinté+ on PSF Chantilly on 1 October - not taken lightly

3. FORCE TRANQUILLE - Hard-knocking handicapper and last-start winner of a 2100m handicap at Marseille-Borely on 28 September

4. GIMANZOR - Absent since finishing 3rd at Vichy over 1850m on 19 August. Lightly raced gelding open to improvement on his reappearance

5. BURSARD - Won a 1600m Complegne handicap in May but struggled under a penalty in 2 subsequent starts, the latest (10th) in a 1600m Vichy handicap on 20 July. Best watched for now

6. MAMA IMELDA - Honest hard-knocker with sound references in handicaps off a higher mark. Proved her form and well-being with a 2nd at Hyères over 1850m on 29 September

7. IVORY SPRING - New addition to Christophe Escuder's stable. Finished unplaced (9th) in a 1200m Marseille-Borely handicap on 2 September - headgear worn that day dispensed with

8. DENIA - A model of consistency since fitted with this headgear and should continue her momentum after a pleasing last-start 3rd in a 2100m turf handicap at Marseille-Borely on 28 September. High on the shortlist

9. MELBORA - Won a 1900m PSF handicap at Deauville in July and finished 3rd in both subsequent starts under a penalty (current mark), the latest over 1900m in a PSF handicap at Chantilly on 7 September. Candidate for success

10. WILD SWEETHEART - Won a 2000m Vichy handicap in August but struggled under a penalty in 2 subsequent starts, finished 8th on both occasions - the latest in a 2100m handicap at Marseille-Borely on 28 September. Others preferred

11. KENZAL - Unplaced and soundly beaten in 3 consecutive recent appearances, the latest (10th) in a 2000m handicap at Vichy on 23 September

Summary: GIMANZOR (4) is returning from a break but represents a stable enjoying a good spell so he gets the nod ahead of consistent DENIA (8) and in-form MELBORA (9). Versatile GIRAFFE (2) also has the form and experience to play a leading role, so cannot be underestimated. MUELHEIMER PERLE (1), who gets along wonderfully with Cheyenne Banz, isnt incapable of making her presence felt either.

1. THREE DREAMS - Disappointed recently, finishing 7th in consecutive stars - the latest at Toulouse on 18 September in a 1400m handicap. Has 3 podiums in 4 outings at this venue so shouldn't be hastily condemned

2. BELL SONG - Rarely seen on this surface and currently out of sorts in turf handicaps off a higher mark - finished 6th in a 1350m handicap at Lyon-Parilly on 11 September. Dangerous at this value on her return to the PSF

3. MAFALDA STORY - Veteran mare in good form and physical condition and a model of consistency on this track. Proven her form and well-being by finishing 3rd over 1350m at Lyon-Parilly on 29 September

4. BOOMERANG - Versatile hard-knocker who reaffirmed off his current mark by finishing 5th in a 1700m turf handicap at Marseille-Borely on 28 September. Not taken lightly

5. PURPLE RAIN - Soundly beaten in 7 consecutive appearances and unlikely to trouble the judge here on the evidence of his last-start 11th in a 1300m PSF handicap at Deauville on 20 August

6. RED TORCH - Unreliable veteran who usually runs well at this venue. Dangerous to discount off his current mark, despite finishing 10th over 1350m at Lyon-Parilly on 11 September

7. COLBY CHOP - Won a 1600m Lyon-Parilly handicap last month and proved his competitiveness off this mark (under a 2,5kg penalty) by finishing 4th in a 1700m turf handicap at Marseille-Borely on 28 September. Dark horse

8. TOUTELUSIVE - Honest hard-knocker with sound references in handicaps off a higher mark - seldom far off the mark. Didn't go unnoticed when 7th in a 1200m turf handicap at Marseille-Borely on 2 September

9. CERVARO - Unplaced and downfield in each of his last 11 appearances, the latest (8th) in a 1000m turf handicap at Vichy on 24 September. Others preferred

10. HAARICIA - Has regained form/momentum in 2 recent starts off her current mark, the latest (4th) in a 1000m handicap at Vichy on 24 September. Keep safe

11. MICOLEO - Soundly beaten in 6 consecutive appearances and unlikely to trouble the judge here on the evidence of his last-start 14th in a 1300m PSF handicap at Deauville on 8 August

Summary: BELL SONG (2), returning to the course of her last success, and MAFALDA STORY (3), who is at home on this track, could find themselves fighting for victory. However, HAARICIA (10) wouldn't be winning out of turn and could challenge those rivals for race honours. THREE DREAMS (1) enjoys this track and should acquit herself competitively while hard-knockers RED TORCH (6) and BOOMERANG (4) are competitive for the places.

2. CALBIGNY - Made no impression (9th) on debut over 1600m on turf at Lyon-Parilly on 11 September. Best watched for now

3. GEOPOLITICAL - Caught the eye on debut (4th) in a 1600m newcomers' race at Chantilly on 21 September. Would've gained plenty from that experience

4. PERCALE - Didn't go unnoticed when 5th on debut over 1200m at Marseille-Borély on 16 September. Not taken lightly

5. RED TOO HOT - Caught the eye when 4th on debut in June and better was expected of her last time, when only finishing 6th over 1700m at Marseille-Borely on 28 September. Dark horse

3. SHOWPOWER - Finished 3rd in his only handicap appearance and improved in first-time headgear to finish 2nd in a 1600m claimer at Toulouse on 25 September. Not taken lightly

4. COEUR D'ARGENT - Appeared in need of her comeback outing (8th) over 1400m at Le Liond'Angers on 15 September. Could fare better

5. NEW YORK NEW YORK - Opened his account in style on handicap debut over 1200m at Marseille-Borely on 28 September. Ought to remain competitive for victory

6. VITESSE - Model of consistency with sound references/form credentials, including 3rd-place finishes in 4 consecutive appearances - the latest in a 1600m handicap at Lyon-Parilly on 11 September. High on the shortlist

7. BAIGNADE - Progressive filly at the top of her game, after consecutive victories - the latest in a 1400m Vichy handicap on 23 September. Big player in her hat-trick bid

8. DELPHINE - In good form and physical condition in the handicaps - confirmed as much with a good 2nd over 1600m in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly on 11 September. Dark horse

9. PATRICIA - Unplaced in both handicap appearances, the latest (7th) over 1200m at Marseille-Borely on 28 September
