- GLASGOW ELLIS Disqualified in class F at Monpazier over 3125m on 7 July. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred

- 3. ICE HAUFOR Not easy to trust and was 5th last time out in Class D at Chartres over 2825m on 30 June. Capable of earning some money when wise
