## R5 CABOURG [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX DES ASTERS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR  
€ 26,000**

- 1. JUNON DES ROSES** - Reliable performer (disqualified in only 2 of 25 appearances) with sound references/form credentials, even with her irons (shod). Finished 2nd in both starts last month, the latest (barefoot) over this track and trip on 19 July
- 2. IVORY DU CHERISAY** - Has won and finished 2nd in 2 associations Yoann Lebourgeois. Didn't go unnoticed when 6th (plated in front) over this track and trip on 23 July - presented unshod in front for this commitment
- 3. JUST AN ARTIST** - Tricky customer and currently out of sorts - unplaced in 4 consecutive starts before her last-start disqualification over 3125m at Granville on 6 August. Others preferred
- 4. JADE DE TOUCHYVON** - Has improved/looked more assured in 4 starts with this shoeing configuration - confirmed as much by finishing a good 3rd over 2875m at Meslay-du-Maine on 30 July. Dark horse
- 5. JULIE DU CLOS** - Complicated mare but usually acquits herself well when avoiding disqualification - seldom far off the mark. Needs to reaffirm after her latest faux pas at Granville on 6 August
- 6. JAZZ MELODY** - Consistent mare with sound references/form credentials at this level and in a higher grade, especially in this (barefoot) configuration. Acquitted herself well (6th) in a better race/field at Enghien over 2150m on 4 August
- 7. JADE FOR EVER** - Most effective in this (unshod) shoeing configuration - 4 wins and a 2nd in her last 5 barefoot appearances. Last-start winner without shoes at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 30 July - will be a factor
- 8. JEEP DE DALINE** - A proven track-specialist with sound references/form credentials, especially under these/similar conditions (barefoot) - has won 3 and finished 2nd last time (over track and trip on 26 July) in her last 4 unshod outings
- 9. JUSTESS VIKING** - Has finished 4th (over 2500m at Reims in June) and 7th four times in her last 5 appearances in this shoe-fitting, including last start over 2150m at Enghien on 4 August. For lovers of outsiders
- 10. JENKA DE MORMOULIN** - Confirmed under these conditions and in good form/physical condition. Won her last start (2150m) at Argentan on 15 July - wasn't winning out of turn (rewarded for consistency) - and should remain competitive
- 11. JENY DES MALBERAUX** - Returned to form with a reassuring 2nd in this shoe-fitting over 2875m at Meslay-du-Maine on 21 July. Ought to remain competitive
- 12. ITALICA** - Consistent trotter, confirmed under these conditions/in this (barefoot) configuration, but has achieved her best references at a lower level. Finished 4th in a 2800m harness race at Compiègne on 27 July

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**13. IDEALE D'ARCEY** - Delicate mare, rarely far from a fault, but was a reassuring winner of her penultimate outing at Francheville over 2475m last month. Failed to confirm that form/improvement when disqualified at La Ferté-Vidame on 21 July

**14. JOUVENCE D'AVRIL** - Rarely far from a fault but has undeniable means. Didn't go unnoticed when 7th (plated) at Meslay-du-Maine last month (on 21 July) over 2875m and shouldn't be underestimated with her shoes removed (barefoot) - beware

**15. JAVA DES CAILLONS** - Consistent mare, in good form and physical condition, and ideally engaged under these conditions. Won over 2050m on this course last month before finishing 2nd over 2875m at Enghien on 27 July - sets the standard

**Summary:** JAVA DES CAILLONS (15) has maintained a good level of form when racing unshod and should take advantage of this favourable commitment by bouncing back to winning ways in this opening event. JADE FOR EVER (7), also very effective/competitive in this (barefoot) configuration, and track-specialist JEEP DE DALINE (8), whose two starts on this course last month yielded a win and a 2nd, seem best equipped to threaten. JAZZ MELODY (6) and IVORY DU CHERISAY (2), with Yoann Lebourgeois at the helm, appeal most of the remainder.

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## C2 - PRIX DES CYPRES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. LOKY DE JIEL** - Improving last-start winner who has turned a corner/raised his game in this shoe-fitting. Absent since his victory at Caen on 24 June but cannot be taken lightly
- 2. LOTUS DE BEYLEV** - One of several in the race to have turned a corner/raised his game with this shoe-fitting applied. Runner-up over track and trip on 12 July
- 3. LAGON DU POMMEREUX** - Revealed considerable promise earlier in the year but his form has tailed off recently - unplaced in consecutive recent outings, the latest (10th) over 2875m at Enghien on 3 August
- 4. LEMON FLEURY** - Undefeated in this shoe-fitting and recently completed a hat-trick with a course-and-distance victory on 26 July. Has subsequently joined Marius Coignard's stable and seems likely to continue his momentum/winning streak
- 5. LAST QUEEN** - Inconsistent filly but certainly isn't devoid of means/ability. Blotted her copybook by finishing 9th over 2700m at Vincennes on 21 May
- 6. LATINOS DU NOYER** - Showed early promise but has finished unplaced in back-to-back recent starts, the latest (9th) at Enghien over 2875m on 3 August. Watch for now
- 7. LATINO PURA VIDA** - Looked a smart prospect last year but has seen his form tail off recently. Made no impression last time out over 2875m at Enghien on 3 August
- 8. L'EXPERT** - Smart sort but is a tricky customer - disqualified in 2 of 5 appearances, including his latest at Rochefort-sur-Loire over 3000m on 5 August. His 4 completed starts have yielded 3 wins and a 2nd - shouldn't be underestimated
- 9. LEADER DU CHATAULT** - Most effective in this shoe-fitting and boasts sound form references/credentials. Wasn't disgraced (8th) returning from a 2-month break at Enghien (over 2150m) on 13 July - attractive outsider
- 10. LA PAIX** - Progressive filly and winner of her last 3 completed races (4 starts), including back-to-back course-and-distance victories - the latest on 30 July
- 11. LOVE GLYCINES** - Improving last-start winner (over track and trip on 12 July) - has turned a corner/raised his game racing plated. Ought to remain competitive with plates on all 4 four feet
- 12. LOVELY TRIP** - Relatively consistent colt with sound references/form credentials, including back-to-back 5th-place finishes over track and trip (12 July) and at Enghien over 2875m on 3 August
- 13. LUCKY CASTELETS** - Consistent performer with sound references and form credentials at a higher level, which include a last-start 4th over 2875m at Enghien on 3 August. Dark horse

**Summary:** Great race. Mansour Krouchi's thriving colt LEMON FLEURY (4), who is unbeaten in this (plated) shoeing configuration, joined Marius Coignard's stable after his hat-trick win over this course and distance success last month and his momentum/winning sequence isn't likely to be halted. He gets the nod ahead of LA PAIX (10), whose back-to-back recent wins have been convincing/impressive, as well as fellow last-start winner LOVE GLYCINES (11) who, in a new shoeing configuration, may have even more to offer. Both L'EXPERT (8) and LOKY DE JIEL (1) are competitive for the places.

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## C3 - PRIX DES BOULEAUX - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. KAVALO BELLO** - Disqualified in the initial stages of his last start on 19 July over this course and distance but didn't go unnoticed thereafter. Showed enough to fight for victory if avoiding disqualification
- 2. KALOU LA TRIGALE** - Crossed the lines first on his reappearance/first outing for Alexis Grimault but was subsequently disqualified for a mistake on the penultimate turn (at Rochefort over 2400m on 5 August). Not taken lightly
- 3. KIRIK DE SEG** - Confirmed the form/improvement of his Moulins-la-Marche success (7 July) by finishing 2nd at Brehal last time over 2850m on 29 July. Has more to do here
- 4. KRYSTAL DES FANES** - Delicate but undeniably talented - has always performed well when avoiding disqualification/remaining wise. Confirmed as much with a reassuring 4th over 2300m at Châteaubriant 6 August
- 5. KID DE LA BANIO** - Lightly raced colt with sound references in this shoe-fitting, including a 3rd over 2200m at Le Mans on 16 July. Must bounce back from a disappointing last start (9th) over track and trip 30 July
- 6. KRUSTY** - Has revealed considerable ability/promise, winning 2 of 4 starts and finishing 2nd (barefoot) last time over track and trip on 19 July. Candidate for success
- 7. KALOU D'IROISE** - Rarely far from a fault but isn't entirely incapable of getting into the picture, judged on his best references. Needs to reaffirm after a last-start disqualification over 2400m at Amiens on 1 August
- 8. KILOU** - A tricky customer with undeniable means - usually acquits himself well when avoiding disqualification. Proved as much with a reassuring 4th over course and distance on 26 July
- 9. KOPECK DU LOUVET** - Last-start winner of a 2875m mounted race at Meslay-du-Maine on 21 July. Best watched until back under the saddle
- 10. KEEP TIME** - Still in contention for the leading places when faulting over track and trip last time (19 July). Shouldn't be hastily condemned
- 11. KRACKER PIYA** - Never finished worse than 3rd in his 6 completed outings (7 starts) - finished 3rd once and 2nd twice, winning 3 times, including his latest appearance on 30 July over this course and distance

**Summary:** KAVALO BELLO (1) didn't go unnoticed last time despite being disqualified and, on the evidence of what he showed that day, needs only to avoid disqualification to redeem himself. KRUSTY (6), ideally entered at the first post, and KRACKER PIYA (11), who has both the form and consistency to play a leading role, are also considered candidates for success. KALOU LA TRIGALE (2), KEEP TIME (10) and KILOU (8) appeal most of the remainder.

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## C4 - PRIX EQUIN NORMAND (PRIX DES ASPHODELES) - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. KYMIJALLY** - Disqualified in her first start for trainer Alexis Grimault last month but quickly erased that failure with a last-start victory over 2725m at Pornichet on 25 July. Should play a leading role with a repeat of that performance
- 2. KEENNESS** - Consistent 16-start maiden with sound references/form credentials, albeit without a victory. Proven under these conditions/in this (unshod) configuration and finished 2nd over 2950m at Saint-Malo on 12 July - upset potential
- 3. KIGUELLA D'ALTAR** - Has regained momentum recently after a 2-month break, finishing 3rd (shod) at Amiens and 5th (barefoot) over 2700m at La Capelle on 29 July. Place chance
- 4. KALINKA DU HOME** - Won her first barefoot appearance (at Saint-Malo in April) but, judged on subsequent performances, has lost her way/form since. Finished 10th over 2675m at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 18 July
- 5. KIONA DU SKY** - Consistent hard-knocker with sound references, including an improved last-start 4th over course and distance in this shoe-fitting on 16 July. Attractive outsider
- 6. KALINE JULMA** - Tricky customer and currently out of sorts - disqualified in consecutive starts and unplaced in her 2 most recent outings, the latest (9th) at Châteaubriant on 6 August. Others preferred
- 7. KARA DE KER** - Lightly raced filly, revealed considerable promise in the provinces - won once, finished 3rd in consecutive starts, and been 2nd twice (from 5 outings), including her latest over 2825m at Sablé-sur-Sarthe on 28 July. Dark horse
- 8. KORAYA EFBE** - Confirmed the improvement of her previous start (4th) by winning at Dozulé last time over 2900m on 7 August. This is tougher but
- 9. KLARA** - Tricky customer but undeniably capable - usually acquits herself well when not disqualified - confirmed as much by finishing 5th over 2400m at Amiens on 1 August. Can't be underestimated with Benjamin Rochard at the helm
- 10. KRACOTTE VERGNIER** - Rarely far from a fault but has revealed/retains undeniable ability. Shouldn't be hastily condemned for her recent failure (disqualification) at Enghien on 4 August, especially with Yoann Lebourgeois engaged on this occasion
- 11. KALEA DREAM** - A tricky customer (disqualified in 8 of 18 appearances) but retains sufficient means - confirmed as much with an improved/encouraging 2nd at Mauquenchy over 2850m on 25 July. Beware
- 12. KEEN ACTION** - Has regained after 2 much-needed comeback appearances following a lengthy 7-month layoff. Showed her form and well-being with an improved/encouraging 4th (shod) over track and trip on 5 July - presented unshod here
- 13. KEEP ON ROLLING** - Returned to winning ways with a last-start course-and-distance success on 30 July. Confirmation expected with all 4 shoes removed (barefoot) for the first time
- 14. KATARINA DE LOU** - Complicated filly, disqualified in 7 of 15 starts, including her latest over track and trip on 16 July. Watch for now
- 15. KYARA** - Rarely far from a fault but isn't incapable of getting into the picture. Finished unplaced (8th) over this course and distance on 2 August - best watched for now

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**16. KOUMBA MESLOISE** - Last-start winner (over 2150m at Argentan on 15 July) whose 2 career wins were achieved racing plated in front. Ideally engaged here at the limit of earnings and ought to remain competitive with her hind shoes now removed

**Summary:** KEEP ON ROLLING (13) returned to winning ways with a course-and-distance success last month and, unshod on all four feet for the first time, is good value to follow up under these conditions. However, KYMIJALLY (1) could make life difficult from her ideal starting position. Enigmatic KRACOTTE VERGNIER (10), KEEN ACTION (12), unshod after 2 comeback outings, and last-start winner KOUMBA MESLOISE (16) are also contenders for the podium. KLARA (9), with Benjamin Rochard, is an attractive outsider. .

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## C5 - PRIX DES GODETIES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 19,500

- 1. KALMIE VICTORY** - Has shown nothing in 2 harness appearances to suggest that she will have a role to play here. Disqualified in her last start at Château-du-Loir on 28 July
- 2. KANDY DES RUETTES** - Disqualified in 4 of her 8 starts, including her latest in a 3125m harness race at Granville on 6 August as well as in her only start under the saddle at Villedieu-les-Poêles last month. Others preferred
- 3. KATANGA DE L'ITON** - Delicate filly, disqualified more often than not (in 7 of 13 starts), including her last 2 appearances in the mounted category. Only 9th in a 2400m harness race at Granville on 4 August - Benjamin Rochard is notable engagement
- 4. KALINA DES ROCHERS** - A 15-start maiden in the harness category and was disqualified last time at Sainte-Marie-du-Mont over 2425m on 4 August. One to note on her debut under the saddle, especially with Paul Ploquin booked to ride
- 5. KASANGA** - Disqualified in her first start under the saddle but caught the eye last time with an improved/encouraging 2nd at Rochefort in a 3000m mounted race on 5 August. Dark horse
- 6. KALAMITY GABY** - Disqualified more often than not (in 9 of 15 appearances), including each of her last 3 starts - the latest a harness race over 2925m on 7 August. Hard to make a case for
- 7. KYARA ARROW** - Should not be hastily condemned for her last-start disqualification at Durtal on 14 July. Retains sufficient means to play a leading role, if remaining wise throughout
- 8. KEEP ON RUNNING** - Well-beaten 10th in 2700m harness race at La Capelle on 29 July but showed enough in back-to-back mounted races before that (both in June) to warrant respect back under the saddle
- 9. KORINA DE BASSIERE** - Confirmed the form/improvement of her penultimate start (2825m Villedieu-les-Poêles victory) by finishing 4th over 2675m at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 18 July. Candidate for success
- 10. KARYNNA FLOMART** - A tricky customer but didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th in a 3000m mounted race at Rochefort on 5 August returning from a 3-month absence. Dark horse
- 11. KORINA DE BEYLEV** - Complicated filly (disqualified in 8 of 14 starts) but looked better than ever when opening her account on 9 June at Laon over 2850m in this shoe-fitting. Not taken lightly
- 12. KISS ME DE CORTEM** - Rejuvenated filly with 2 wins from her last 3 starts, albeit on turf - the latest at Rochefort over 3000m on 5 August
- 13. KANELLE LA RAVELLE** - Disqualified in her sole appearance under the saddle Montignac on 18 July and finished unplaced in subsequent harness races, the latest (8th) at Châteaubriant over 2300m on 6 August. For lovers of outsiders
- 14. KARAIRES FROMENTIN** - Won and finished 2nd in consecutive course-and-distance outings late last year (9 and 27 December). Unplaced in 2 comeback/harness appearances recently (13th over track and trip on 2 August) - is better under the saddle
- 15. KRISTINA DU CLOS** - Lightly raced and versatile filly with sound references under the saddle, including a last-start 5th over 2675m at Le Mont-Saint Michel on 18 July. Outside chance



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**Summary:** With the benefit of 2 much-needed (harness) comeback outings under her belt, it could pay to side with KARAIBES FROMENTIN (14) on her return to the mounted code with this shoe-fitting adopted for the first time. KORINA DE BASSIERE (9) has the means to pose a threat, as does KISS ME DE CORTEM (12) who returned to winning ways recently, albeit on turf. KYARA ARROW (7), if not disqualified, should make her presence felt too. KATANGA DE L'ITON (3) and KALINA DES ROCHERS (4) have upset potential.

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## C6 - PRIX DES LOBELIAS - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. LA BELLE VIE** - Consistent filly, steadily improving with each outing - confirmed as much with an encouraging career-best 2nd over 2400m at Granville on 6 August
- 2. L'AMETHYSTE** - Improving last-start winner who confirmed/built on the progress of her penultimate start (3rd) at Montmirail to open her account over 2200m at Clairefontaine on 20 July. High on the shortlist
- 3. LADY MAJOR** - Consistent performer with sound references/form credentials, albeit without a win. Acquitted herself well (3rd) over 2675m at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 18 July and cannot be taken lightly with Benjamin Rochard engaged
- 4. LEGENDE DU LOISIR** - Consistent filly, confirmed in this (plated) shoeing configuration - showed her form/well-being by finishing 3rd at La Capelle on 26 July
- 5. LA BELLE MIKA** - Complicated but undeniably capable of staking a claim if bouncing back to the form/promise she showed earlier in the year. Shouldnt be hastily condemned for her recent failure at Caen over 2450m on 20 June
- 6. LADY DIGEO** - Honest performer with sound references, including a 2nd and two 3rd-place finishes. Unplaced (7th) at Langon over 200m on 30 July - needs to reaffirm, best watched for now
- 7. LIBERTY PIYA** - Delicate filly - disqualified in 4 of 5 appearances - but showed sufficient means when 2nd over 2150m at Enghien on 13 July to win a race of this nature, if avoiding disqualification. Worth another chance
- 8. LA PERLA DE LOU** - Made an eye-catching debut at Mauquenchy on 22 July, finishing 2nd (shod) over 2850m. Would've gained from that experience - races plated in front
- 9. LADY DU JOUR** - Inconsistent but isnt entirely incapable of making her presence felt, judged on her 2nd at Craon over 2275m on 23 June. Outsider
- 10. LADY DE LA COTE** - Improved from her debut disqualification to finish an encouraging 6th on this course over 2750m on 6 August. Could have more to offer
- 11. LOVELY SURPRISE** - Delicate filly but is certainly not devoid of means/ability - confirmed as much by winning Brehal over 2325m last month (22 July). Shouldnt be hastily condemned for her recent failure on this course over 2750m on 6 August
- 12. L'ETOILE BLEUE** - Improved with the benefit of an introductory outing (7th) to open her account at the second attempt, winning at Argentan over 2875m on 27 January. Disqualified in all 4 subsequent outings, the latest at Granville (6 August)
- 13. LA SEGNORA PIYA** - Runner-up over 2725m at Lisieux in June but has failed to confirm that form/improvement in either subsequent outing - disqualified in both, the latest over 2750m at this venue on 6 August
- 14. LUCRECE DU BELLAY** - Finished 2nd at Bihorel-lès-Rouen in May and filled the runners-up berth again at Genêts over 2600m on 7 July. Shouldnt be hastily condemned for her recent failure at Le Mont-Saint Michel on 18 July

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**Summary:** LIBERTY PIYA (7) would certainly have played a leading role at Enghien last time were it not for her unfortunate fault, and she could be worth another chance. Promising last-start winner L'AMETHYSTE (2), and LA PERLA DE LOU (8), who finished an eye-catching 2nd on debut, should improve to fight for victory. LADY MAJOR (3), LA BELLE VIE (1) and LOVELY SURPRISE (11) complete the shortlist.

**C7 - PRIX DES SOUCIS - 2050m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR  
€ 18,000**

- 1. MAKE A WISH** - Finished a promising 3rd (behind Marshal de Celland who subsequently repeated at Enghien) on debut at Brehal over 2325m on 22 July. One to beat
- 2. MODESTO** - Showed promise on debut at Bernay, finishing 4th over 2300m on 28 July. Would have gained plenty from that experience
- 3. MALBROUGH DE PLAY** - Unplaced in both starts - finished 8th on debut and 6th over 2400m at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre on 4 August. Others preferred
- 4. MAESTRO** - Unplaced in both starts - the latest (7th) over 2150m at Ranès on 13 July - but hasn't finished far off the mark in either. Place chance
- 5. MAMBO THORIS** - Showed promise on debut at Carentan, finishing 4th over 2400m on 28 July. Would have gained plenty from that experience
- 6. MAJESTIC D'AVE** - Unplaced in both starts - the latest (5th) over 2400m at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre on 4 August - but could play a minor role here
- 7. MIX D'ERONVILLE** - Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th on debut over 2250m at Enghien on 24 July. Showed enough on that day to be competitive here with improvement expected
- 8. MILKA LIO** - Soundly beaten (unplaced) on debut at La Ferté-Vidame over 2250m on 4 August. Best watched for now
- 9. MIKTYSON DE VIETTE** - Missed his start on debut at Rânes last month (13 July) but showed his form/ability thereafter. Not taken lightly
- 10. MUST GO FAST** - Django Riff colt on debut with Pierre Houel in the sulky. Warrants respect representing a renowned stable
- 11. MONTVASON** - Christophe Petrement-trained Falcao de Laurma colt making his debut. Best watched for now

**Summary:** MAKE A WISH (1) finished a promising 3rd on debut at Bréhal in a competitive/well-composed field and looks good value to open his account here with improvement expected given the benefit of that experience. MIX D'ERONVILLE (7), whose encouraging debut 5th also revealed promise, and MIKTYSON DE VIETTE (9), whose debut disqualification at Rânes is best forgotten, could pose the biggest threat. MODESTO (2) is another likely improver with legitimate ambitions of finishing on the podium.

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**C8 - PRIX DES GAZANIES - 2050m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness -  
EUR € 18,000**

- 1. MAGDALENA** - Finished 6th on debut in Class G at La Ferté-Vidame over 2250m on 4 August. Capable of improvement and can make the frame
- 2. METAVERSA** - Not disgraced when fourth on debut in Class G at La Ferté-Vidame over 2250m on 4 August. Can contest the finish
- 3. MERYTATON** - Finished 6th on her debut in Class F at Bernay over 2300m on 28 July. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 4. MASCOTTE DU STADE** - Finished 6th on debut in Class G at Bréhal over 2325m on 22 July. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- 5. MANZANA** - Finished 7th on her debut in Class D at Enghien over 2250m on 20 July. Can fight out the finish
- 6. MARBOXIE D'HERIPRE** - Was not disgraced when 6th on debut in Class D at Enghien over 2250m on 20 July. Can win this time around
- 7. MADNESS** - Did not run too badly on debut when 6th in Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2150m on 9 August. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- 8. MILKY DE LA VALLEE** - Disqualified on her debut at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre on 4 August. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 9. MOONLIGHT SHADOW** - Disqualified on her debut at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre on 4 August. Capable of improvement but is best watched for now
- 10. MISS DES ECUS** - She qualified well (1'18"5) in Caen at the end of July. Entrusted to David Thomain. A two-year-old filly by Fairplay d'Urzy out of Havane Turgot who is making her debut

**Summary:** MARBOXIE D'HERIPRE (6) acquitted herself well (6th) on debut in a stronger race/field at Enghien last month and needn't improve a great deal with that experience under the belt to take advantage of this drop in class. William Bigeon called on Yoann Lebourgeois. Newcomer MISS DES ECUS (10), who revealed promise during qualification, isn't underestimated and may make life difficult for the selection. METAVERSA (2) and MAGDALENA (1), who were 4th and 6th respectively on debut, renew rivalry and are likely to improve with the benefit of that outing/race experience - they have legitimate podium prospects.
