- **2. O SOLE MIO** Did not show his best when 8th last time out in a Listed race at Vichy over this distance on 17 July. Won his first two starts and is not out of it
- 3. THE BLACK SKY Won on debut but has been a disappointment since and was 6th last time out in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 28 July. Might play a minor role
- **4. PIC PEN -** Holding is form well and was runner-up last time out in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 21 July. Should contest the finish
- **5. RUE DU DOME -** Did not do much wrong when scoring on debut in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 22 July. Can follow up
- **6. GAYLE -** Yet to win a race and was 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Pompadour over 1200m on 3 August. More is needed to beat these rivals

- **3. SILVER SILENT -** On a very long losing run but is in good shape and was runner-up last time out in a handicap at this course over 1600m on 22 July. Can go one better this time
- **4. LADY LUNE -** Unreliable and was 9th last time out in a handicap at Mont-de-Marsan over this distance on 5 July. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- **5. AZUR AS WELL -** Very consistent of late and was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Mont-de-Marsan over this distance on 19 July. Has a winning chance
- **6. HONG KONG STAR -** Holding her form and was fourth last time out in a handicap at Mont-de-Marsan over this distance on 5 July. Can make the frame

- **3. PRINCESSE VERA -** Unreliable and was tenth last time out in a handicap at Tarbes over 1500m on 5 June. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- **4. RICHMOND -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when third last time out in a handicap over this track and trip on 28 July. Should fight out the finish
- **5. NIGHT OF THE OPERA -** Battling to regain his best form and was 7th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 1200m on 24 April. Could need this run returning from a break
