C1 - PRIX DE SAINT-FIRMIN - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Condition Race - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 30.000

- **1. SHADIZI -** Finished 4th on debut over 1100m and is entitled to have come on a lot after that run under the belt. Can make his presence felt
- 2. ADORE BLUE Improving with racing and was unlucky last time out when 2nd. Finished 1.5L behind the favorite two starts back and should be held on that. Place chance
- **3. VODNIKOV -** Finished 7th on debut over 1400m but failed to really make an impression and he will need to show more here. Others preferred
- **4. FOLLOW ME -** Ran a cracker in Group 3 company last time out when finishing in 4th position and the drop in class is highly favorable. One to beat
- **5. GENTLEMAN BEAUTY -** Did not manage to confirm the improvement that he had showed, when finishing 6th last time out over 1400m and has his work cut out. Place chance
- **6. GOLUPTIOUS -** Finished 10th on debut over 1400m failing to do anything in the race and a complete turnaround is needed here. Hard to fancy
- **7. BANKIER -** Finished last of the four runners last time out over 1400m and was well held by his rivals. Improvement required

Summary: FOLLOW ME (4) sets quite a high standard on the form he represents and should prove to be a tough nut to crack here. ADORE BLUE (2) has finished behind the selection in the past and that looks unlikely to change so he could place at best. SHADIZI (1) should have good improvement to come in just his second start and could feature. GENTLEMAN BEAUTY (5) is best of the rest but needs to improve.

- **1. BATESCA -** Finished in 3rd position last time out just behind Concertation and there is no reason to suggest that she won't be able to reverse the form. Winning chance
- **2. CONCERTATION -** She is slightly more exposed but is knocking loudly on the door for that maiden success following two runner up finishes in her last two runs. Winning chance
- **3. SUNNY ANGEL -** Ran 5th over 1000m last time out and now stepping up in trip could see her improve but more is required. Others preferred
- **4. BLUE THUNDER -** Finished 5th on debut and is entitled to improve from that run. Drops in trip but she could still get closer to the action. Place chance
- **5. ISLAND FANTASY -** Very pleasing run on debut when finishing 2nd and despite the drop in trip she should go very well. Big runner
- **6. ONE MISTRESS -** Finished 5th last time out behind two reopposing sorts and will have them to beat in this contest. Place chance
- **7. EGIATEGIA -** Newcomer that warrants some sort of respect with the jockey booking but could still be better for the run. Watch the market
- **8. DULINI -** Newcomer that demands healthy respect given the eye catching jockey booking. Follow the market for clues

Summary: ISLAND FANTASY (5) just found one too good on debut and should be able to take a step forward. CONCERTATION (2) has been nothing but consistent and it could finally be her day to shine if all things go according to plan. BATESCA (1) is a lively contender here and could get the job done. DULINI (8) is a first timer that bears close watching in the market

- **1. CELTIC ARYAAN -** Well tried individual that hasn't been at his best of late and will need to show a lot more to warrant respect. Others preferred
- **2. MAWHOB -** Met winners last time out in a handicap and was far from disgraced by finishing in 7th position. Should appreciate being back in Maiden company. One to beat
- **3. FORRO EMERY -** Six starts to date and hasn't really shown much to suggest that he could be close to running a big race. Would be a surprise winner
- **4. AKENATOR -** Twenty two starts in the maiden ranks and he's battling to get it all right which leads us to believe that he is low on confidence. Others make more appeal
- **5. CASE MONEY -** Finished 4th just under 4L behind the winner last time out and could finally be ready for the step up in trip which should suit. Each way chance
- **6. OKAPINA'S LIGHT -** Ran a solid 3rd place last time out over 1650m and can put his experience to good use here. Can make presence felt
- **7. NATCHITOCHES -** His last run was all wrong when taking on winners and he failed to land a blow finishing in last position. Back in Maiden company should suit. Can get involved
- **8. INARO -** Well beaten in 9th position last time out over 1800m and will need to show a better side of himself here. Hard to fancy
- **9. FERNANDO -** Nicely bred son of Australia that could be anything on debut and warrants respect with a top jockey booked to ride. Follow the market

Summary: MAWHOB (2) will love taking on slightly weaker and could go on to get his maiden out the way. CASE MONEY (5) steps up to 1600m which should be right up his alley and there should be more to come. OKAPINA'S LIGHT (6) has the right form to be competitive in a race of this nature. FERNANDO (9) is a newcomer that warrants a market check.

- **2. RANEVSKAYA -** Finished 5th over 1800m last time out and seems like the type that could get better with racing under the belt. Place chance
- **3. PROTOSTAR -** She ran with a lot of encouragement on debut finishing 3rd over 1500m and should come on with that run. Big runner
- **4. SOUL AND ROMANCE -** Ran 4th on debut although she was beaten out of sight and will need to take a significant step forward. Others preferred
- **5. L'EQUILIBRISTE -** She had her first start over in Great Britain when finishing 7th and will need to show more at the second time of asking. Improvement required
- **6. QUEEN OF NIGHT -** Dam won once over 1900m and this individual could be at home over the trip but the lack of experience could well show. Worth a market check
- **7. ROSE BAY -** Dam was unraced and this individual won't need to be to special to land a blow on debut. Follow the market

Summary: PROTOSTAR (3) showed up well on debut and there was lots of positives to take from the run. She should have more to come now going over more ground. ZANDY (1) should improve with the experience and could run a big race over this trip. ROSE BAY (7) warrants respect especially if the market is in her favor. RANEVSKAYA (2) can continue to make improvement and should be on the premises.

- **2. SUN PROJECT -** Finished 2nd on debut and the form has been franked with the winner coming through to win again. Winning chance
- **3. OURO PRETO -** Bumped into a really smart sort on debut who has won again and this individual could make full use of that form holding up. Big runner
- **4. WINNING FORMULA -** He has found one to beat him in his first two starts and it could well be third time lucky for this colt. Strong winning claims
- **5. CARDINALE -** He has finished 6th in his first two starts to date and more is required from him in order to be competitive. Others preferred
- **6. CASAPUEBLO -** Dam won once over 2400m and he represents top connections so therefore warrants huge respect. Follow the market

Summary: In what looks to be quite a useful maiden, a chance is taken on OURO PRETO (3) who finished 2nd on debut and should be able to confirm that promise now upped in trip. WINNING FORMULA (4) has done everything right but win in his two runs and could get it right in this. CASAPUEBLO (6) hails from a top yard and demands respect on debut. SUN PROJECT (2) is another not without a chance at glory with his form working out as well.

- **3. TERREDEGUERRE -** She has had six starts to date and her last two efforts haven't been the greatest but she could fill out a minor position. Should be in the mix
- **4. INTEMPORELLE -** Ran over 2000m on debut and she performed well enough by finishing 5th but the drop in trip could be a concern now. Place chance
- **5. BLACK LULLABY -** Ran a pleasing race on debut when back in 5th position but could be in need of the run returning of a lengthy layoff. Place chance
- **6. TILAK -** Finished 8th in her comeback run last time out and should strip fitter for this but needs to do more. Hard to recommend
- **7. HORTENSIA BASC** She has had two starts to date with neither making much appeal so therefore doesn't have much to offer. Would be a surprise winner
- **8. LADY WINDERMERE -** Good introduction to racing when finishing 3rd on debut and she should have more to offer despite dropping in trip. Each way chance
- **9. METEOR SHOWER -** Comfortably held in 6th position on debut effort and she will need to show more in order to be competitive. Others inspire more confidence
- **10. BALLE PERDUE -** Dam was unraced and this filly could do with a few runs on her side before showing her capabilities. Others preferred

Summary: HERMEVILLE (2) ran with promise on debut and looks to be one of the leading lights in this contest. LADY WINDERMERE (8) should have come on a lot after her debut run and a bold bid is on the cards from this filly. BLACK LULLABY (5) returns from a layoff and if she isn't in desperate need of the run, she could challenge strongly. TERREDEGUERRE (3) could be good enough to run into one of the minor positions.

- **1. DAWN INTELLO** Finished 4th last time out over 1900m and he's a solid individual that is seldom far off the action. Include in all bets
- **2. BEHTAR -** Not beaten too far last time out when finishing in 6th position just under 3L behind the top choice and he should be on the premises. Can make his presence felt
- **3. GREYM -** He has been competing in Listed races over in Germany over the past four months and on what he has shown, he needs to improve. Others make more appeal
- **4. FULL PRECIEUX -** Finished 7th over 1900m last time out failing to make much of an impression and now stepping up a division, more is needed. Hard to recommend
- **5. PARCHEMIN -** Ran a very pleasing 2nd last time out over 1900m and he looks set to go well in search of a second win this year. Big runner
- **6. SELLER ONE -** He has run twice and both efforts leave little to be positive about. He needs to start improving. Would be a shock winner
- **7. NIGHTHAB -** Finished 11th last time out over 1900m and on recent performances there isn't much to fancy about this colt. Improvement needed
- **8. MR COALVILLE -** His two efforts this year have been below par but given they have both been off a rest, this time he is second up and will strip fitter. Can improve
- **9. WOOZLE -** He is in steady form having finished 3rd over 1600m two starts back and he could build on that effort here. Place chance
- **10. MACHETE -** He has been tried over slightly further in his recent outings but doesn't seem to round off his races and the drop back in trip looks ideal. Go well
- **11. WITHERING -** He finished 8th over 2400m at his most recent outing and makes no appeal on form so is hard to fancy here. Would be a shock winner
- **12. VAGALAME -** He has been competing in Listed and Group races quite a lot and that could stand him in good stead in this event. Winning chance

Summary: PARCHEMIN (5) looks ready to strike again on the back of a close up 2nd place finish and he rates the one to beat. VAGALAME (12) could enjoy a slight ease in grade and should be able to run a huge race. MACHETE (10) should definitely get involved over this trip and looks to have quite a bit up his sleeve. BEHTAR (2) is in fair form and will be involved in the finish.

- **1. KARIOITAHI -** She is in good heart at the moment having placed in her last two outings and another honest performance is likely. Each way chance
- **2. BONNIE HOPPS -** She tends to throw in the odd bad run from time to time which she can be forgiven for as her overall form is useful. Include in the play
- **3. LIFE'S A BREEZE -** Solid performance last time out when finishing 3rd and there should be more to come from the best of draws. Big runner
- **4. VARINKA -** She remains a maiden from seventeen starts and it is very difficult to recommend this runner on recent form. Easy to look elsewhere
- **5. LAKE NAIVASHA -** She won her maiden two starts but will need to improve a bit to get involved as this is a stronger contest. Others preferred
- **6. IRBIS -** Maiden from eleven starts that is currently struggling to get his act together in order to run decent races. Would be a shock winner
- **7. DIWAN SENORA -** He ran an okay race last time out without really threatening and he looks like one of the runners that could place at best. More needed
- **8. LOU BALICOT -** Inconsistent type that is currently off form and needs a huge form turnaround in order to be competitive again. Hard to recommend
- **9. MISTER CHARLIE -** His last two efforts have been solid, finishing 2nd in both and he looks set to run a big race once again. Leading claims
- **10. GARDOL MOON -** She represents very uninspiring form and it is hard to see this filly getting anywhere near the winners enclosure. Would be a shock winner
- **11. KING OF TWIST** He has turned his form around in a big way this year after finishing 5th and 2nd in his last two starts, things are looking bright again. Winning chance
- **12. MY FLINDERS -** Her last two efforts have been moderate which could be an indication of a bit too many races this year. Would be a shock winner
- **13. CALAS QUEEN -** Only win to date came way back in 2021 and will need to do more on recent form to get involved in proceedings. Others preferred
- **14. JOYCE GALESTE -** She finished 6th last time out over 1800m and will need to do more in order to win a race of this nature. Others make more appeal
- **15. TAAL -** Finished 3rd last time out over 2100m in a Class 4 event and could be one to outrun her odds. Can improve
- **16. GOFAST -** She ran her best race in some time last time out when finishing in 2nd position but will need to confirm that effort. Place chance
- **17. AYGUEMORTE** His recent form is poor and there is absolutely nothing to work with which leaves him at the bottom in the pecking order. Would be a shock winner
