- **3. LORIE DE LA PRADE -** A two-year-old filly by Earl Simon out of Bali de la Prade who is making her debut. Can win
- **4. LOTUS DE BEYLEV -** A two-year-old colt by Rolling d'Héripré out of Divine Dairpet who is making his debut. Can win
- **5. LANARA** Disqualified in her only start but was well qualified before that and is capable of being a lot smarter this time. Can win
