- **1. MALDIVES FLIGNY -** Sanctioned in both starts to date, latterly a 2275m Nantes Class F on 17 November. Top pilot reining this time but others still preferred
- **2. MALICE BLEUE -** Would have finished in the money on debut in a 2000m Class F at La Capelle on 11 November had she stayed in stride. Unlikely to spring a surprise but, with application, can pick up some prizemoney
- **3. MERVEILLEUSE -** Never at her ease when sanctioned in a 2100m Class C here 3 weeks ago and appears to have no possible chance
- **4. MY WAY SKY -** Sanctioned on debut in a 2825m Class F at Le Croise-Laroche 2 months ago. Comes here fresh but still not a contender
- **5. MAMZELLE DREAM -** Never dangerous when 6th of 9 in a 2100m claimer here last week and can be confidently passed over
- **6. MISS WILLIAMS -** Reassuring 2nd of 7 over 2300m at Mons on 12 November. Takes on a better lot here and can expect to have few friends
- **7. MISS IS DU CANET -** Showed the limit of her capacity when 7th of 11 in a 2050m Laval Class F mid-November and is unlikely to trouble the judge
- **8. MAGIE DE CHAHAINS -** 6th of 8 behind MYSTIQUE LADY (15) in a 2175m Class D here on 27 November. Will be more suited to the inner course but still cannot be considered a priority
- **9. MOLLY WHITE -** Dependable filly that finished 5th of 11 in a Class D over course and distance a month ago. Will have found her feet and has a decent chance of making first 5
- **10. MONA D'AVRIL -** Authoritative winner of a 2800m Chartres Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Is clearly on the way up and will not be sent out at 52/1 this time. Claim
- **11. MAVISTA -** Has potential but has been struggling lately, most recently last of 7 in a 2200m Class B here on 4 November. On good behaviour though, can play a small role
- **12. MIDWAY LADY -** 3rd of 9 in a 2200m Class D here on 31 October. Comes here fresh and the longer trip may be just the ticket
- **13. MIRATISSIME** Has had time to recalibrate after faulting in a 2175m Class A here on 1 October and Yoann Lebourgeois will be eager to set the record straight
- **14. MADEMOISELLE JANE -** Got off the mark at Cabourg prior to an early sanction in a 2100m Class C here 3 weeks ago. Is clearly a capable sort and will be expected to put things right
- **15. MYSTIQUE LADY -** Got off the mark at Hyeres before running 3rd of 8 in a 2175m Class D here on 27 November. Will appreciate the more even surface and will have her chances

Summary: Winner at Chartres, beating a progressive Guarato colt, MONA D'AVRIL (10) has just her own sex to contend with this time and has a realistic chance of doubling up. Just 155 Euros from elimination and clearly in form, MYSTIQUE LADY (15) moves over to the inner course for the occasion and looks the principal threat. MIRATISSIME (13) failed to confirm her Cabourg victory when sanctioned over the long course but should find these conditions more to her liking. MIDWAY LADY (12) has yet to disappoint and it will not be long before she loses her maiden tag.

- **1. LUKOMEDES -** Sanctioned on return to competition early-November in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F. Just front pads fitted this time and Mathieu Mottier will afford him every chance
- **2. LIEUTENANT COLONEL -** Sanctioned when unsupported in a 2700m Graignes Class F a month back. Has never delivered in the discipline and is unlikely to buck the trend
- **3. LILIUS DE GUEZ -** Made decent monte debut at Amiens before being sanctioned in a 2700m Class E here 2.5 weeks ago. Showed his form that day though and, if focused, can make a big splash
- **4. LOREL DE L'ORMERIE -** Sanctioned in last 2, latterly a 2000m Nancy harness Class G a fortnight ago, and even with Benjamin Rochard in the saddle, is unlikely to spring any surprises
- **5. LIKE YOU MADRIK -** Last but one in a 2100m harness claimer here on 27 November and will have nothing to offer
- **6. LEMON KING -** 5th of 14, on monté bow, in a 2400m Chateaubriant Class F on 1 December. Goes left-handed for first time, sporting pads for the occasion, but cannot be considered a priority
- **7. LEODAGAN -** Makes ridden debut after being sanctioned in a 2550m Reims Class F on 24 November. Has shown enough potential in the other code to be considered a leading candidate this time
- **8. LOVE'S SECRET -** Debuted 4th at Cordemais last month prior to being sanctioned last weekend in a 2850m Laval Class F. In good company here but has merit and Eric Raffin has been engaged for the occasion
- **9. LEOPOLD DU CLOS -** Showed improvement when 4th of 14 in a 2850m Laval Class F last Sunday. Yet to show much liking for Vincennes and others easier to back
- **10. LASCAUX DEL PHEDO -** Opened his account in good order on 1 December, winning a 2400m Chateaubriant Class F. Takes on a better bunch this time but with Anthony barrier in the irons, can confirm
- **11. LORD DE LA FUTAIE** Last of 8 on ridden debut before coming 5th of 9 in a 2550m Reims harness Class E a month ago. Useful on a good day but would have better prospects in another category
- **12. LOVE ME DO MESLOIS -** Tricky sort that ran 4th of 10 finishers under similar conditions mid-November. Is unlikely to cause an upset but is fitted with 4 pads this time and has the wherewithal to get in on the action
- **13. LIVE MY DREAM -** 5th of 8 finishers, on monté debut, in a 2700m Class E here on 5 November. Should find the inner track more to his liking and can figure more prominently
- **14. LIPTON DU NOYER -** Raced better in a 2200m Class E here mid-November than his 9th of 10 would suggest. That said, he faces stiffer competition this time and can be passed over
- **15. LICARI -** 4th of 8 finishers, on monté debut, in a 2700m Class E here on 5 November. Moves to the inner track this time and again looks a solid first-5 chance

Summary: Always destined for a career under the saddle, LASCAUX DEL PHEDO (10) nevertheless took time to come good, but is clearly on the boil and a repeat of his Chateaubriant performance could well see him secure the double. Anthony Barrier will still be wary of the promising LEODAGAN (7) who debuts under the saddle with Alexandre Abrivard aboard, and the temperamental LILIUS DE GUEZ (3) who will be dangerous if Jean-Yann Ricart assures his initial strides. LIVE MY DREAM (13) will have progressed for his recent monté debut and will be expected to finish closer this time.

- **2. LOOKING FRANCE -** 9th of 13 behind LAURELINA (10) in a Class B over course and distance on 2 December and in current form has no possible chance
- **3. LISSANDRA JIEL -** 2nd at Mauquenchy before finishing 11th of 13 in 2 December race of reference. Has never delivered at Vincennes and is unlikely to break the mould
- **4. LAMIE DU MESNIL -** Gave a decent account, at 89/1, to run 5th of 13 behind LAURELINA (10) in a Class B over course and distance on 2 December. In similar shape, should not be far off the mark
- **5. LAGUNE PIYA -** Lacklustre 7th of 12 behind LETTRE D'AMOUR (13) in a Class A over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Is significantly better than that but must first re-establish her credentials
- **6. LA DIVA SUPREME -** Sanctioned in 3 of last 4, latterly a Class A over track and trip 3 weeks ago. Would have finished 3rd otherwise and Léo Abrivard will be eager to put things right
- **7. LEDA MESLOISE** Progressive type that finished a fine 3rd of 13, a place behind LAURELINA, in a Class B over course and distance on 2 December. Pierre Belloche in the bike and has every chance of imposing this time
- **8. LAMATTA -** Valiant 6th of 13 behind LAURELINA (10) in a Class B over course and distance on 2 December. Races shod this time and best to hold off
- **9. LOLITA BOURBON -** Serious filly that ran 4th of 13, a place behind LAMATTA, in a 2175m Class B here last Monday, on first start for 3 months. Reunited with the champion driver and can settle scores. Chance
- **10. LAURELINA -** Surprisingly beat a number of these on 2 December when 2nd of 13 in a Class B over course and distance. Sports 4 pads once more and will again be expected to finish close

Between these two, one would be hard-pushed not to insert LOLITA BOURBON (9) who won with Eric Raffin across town during the summer. Nicely-entered here, LUMINOUS STAR (14) will not be sporting pads following his Class A disappointment and, back in her category, will be no soft touch.

- **2. KIRA D'OBRET -** Highly-consistent filly that imposed for Eric Raffin in a 2275m Nantes Class E on 27 November. Steps up in category but in current condition is very easy to recommend
- **3. KANELLE CASTELETS -** Decent 5th of 13 in a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 25 November. Has no Vincennes references but is good enough to pick up a minor place cheque
- **4. KALISKANA -** Debuts for new stable after having finished last of 12 in a 2200m Class D here on 30 October. Has already won with Paul Ploquin and is not incapable of repeating
- **5. KALINE DE VIRE -** 2nd on re-entry at Nantes before easily winning a 2150m Mauquenchy Class F on 10 November. Has turned a corner since starting to race barefoot and and once again looks the horse to beat
- **6. KELOMA DREAM -** Imposed at Chartres before running 5th of 14 in a 2850m Laval Class E on 8 November. Pitted against better this time though and others easier to back
- **7. KISS ME DUTOLLEM -** Respectable 4th of 11 in a 2200m Class E here a month ago but in this category will have too much to do
- **8. KIARHA DE NAPPES -** 9th of 14, when preparing for this, in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E a fortnight ago. Is barefoot as she was when imposing at Le Croisé-Laroche early-November and should not be overlooked
- **9. KALINKA DU GRENAT -** 3rd of 13 in a 2700m Class E here 2.5 weeks ago. Is plainly on the way up and will not be easily ignored. Place chance
- **10. KERNEZIA DU CORTA -** Sanctioned when being conditioned in a 2050m Feurs Class D late-October. Trainer back in the bike and debuts over the main track with a decent chance of making first 5

Summary: Simply excellent since returning from a lengthy absence, KALINE DE VIRE (5) made short work of a Mauquenchy Class F early last month and returns to Paris with a realistic chance of repeating. She may still be forced to dance with KALISKANA (4) who returns to racing barefoot on her first start for Matthieu Abrivard, and a similarly-barefoot KIRA D'OBRET (2) who will be piloted by Eric Raffin on her first appearance at this level. KALINKA DU GRENAT (9) went close here late last month and Guillaume Martin has kept the drive.

- 3. KHEOPS SAINT CLAIR 10th of 11 behind KEN FERFAY (12) in a 2850m Class D here a fortnight ago. Is a long way from his best and must first reaffirm
- **4. KEL PRESTANCE -** Won 2 on the trot before losing his action when en route to victory in a 2850m Class D here 2 weeks ago but, with his mind on the game, can set the record straight
- **5. KENZO DU MONT -** 6th of 11 behind KEN FERFAY (12) in a 2850m Class D here a fortnight ago. In the frame in 2 of 3 over the main track though and will be worth monitoring
- **6. KIBRILLE MONTAVAL -** Respectable, but beaten, 4th of 14 in a 2100m Class D here last week. Is confirmed on the main course but others still easier to back
- **7. KAMOUR -** 4th of 11 behind KEN FERFAY (12) in a 2850m Class D here a fortnight ago. Is nearing his race and looks a serious proposition
- **8. KING DE GINAI** Not as sharp since the summer but left a good impression when 6th of 14 in a 2100m Class D here mid-November and, with stride in check, will have his chances

- **4. LIQUIDATEUR -** Smart winner of a 2700m Class E here on 18 November but can expect to find the going tougher this time
- **5. LUDO PAROYO -** Won 3 in a row before being coming 4th of 12, a place behind LUCKY LOVE (12), in a 2200m Class D here on 4 December. May be taking on too much this time but should still give an honourable account
- **6. LEONARDO DU DERBY -** In the frame in 3 of last 4, most recently 2nd of 10 in a 2850m Class E over the inner track on 27 November. In better company this time but still looks a respectable place prospect
- 7. LORENZO DE CHENU By no means disgraced when 7th of 11 in a 2700m Class D here a month ago.

Will be fully fit and the choice of driver speaks volumes

- **8. LUGANO DE LOU -** Showed improvement when 6th of 9 finishers in a 2850m Class D over short course 2.5 weeks ago, but still has more to find
- **9. LE CASHMAKER -** Failed to confirm late-October performance when 8th of 9 finishers in a 2850m Class D over the short course 2.5 weeks ago. Is considerably better than that and, with hind pads fitted, should be retained
- **10. LE MAGNIFIQUE DJOC -** Takes the trip north after finishing 4th of 9 in a 2850m Parilly Class A mid-November. Benjamin Rochard reining this time but others still preferred
- **11. L'AMIRAL GAGNANT -** Useful sort making first start since running 2nd of 13 on comeback in a 2150m Enghien Class D on 19 October. 4 pads fitted this time but may first need the run

- **4. KARELIA -** 11th of 15 in a Class E over course and distance a month ago. Has previously placed with her driver and the drop in class should help her to get some morale back. Place chance
- **5. KELLE EAU -** 7th of 10, on return to competition, in a 2725m Graignes Class F on 2 December, and looks out of her depth
- **6. KINA DU GOUTIER -** Sanctioned in last 2, most recently a Class E over course and distance last Sunday, and even though reconfigured, must still get her house in order
- 7. KHADIDJA CASTELETS Last of 12 in a 2100m Class E here 3 weeks ago and has no realistic chance
- **8. KRYSTAL PALACE -** Last but one in a 2725m Grenade Class E last weekend. Has been struggling since July and will have nothing to contribute
- **9. KAISER DE LARRE -** Back under harness after coming 5th of 9 in a 2825m Chartres monté Class F 2.5 weeks ago and has nothing to offer
- **10. KIWI DE LARRE -** 3rd of 10 finishers in a 2550m Bordeaux claimer last Monday but makes the long trip to Paris with only a moderate chance of picking up a slice of the pie
- **11. KLIF DU DEZERT -** 5th of 15 behind KALIKA DU RIS (18) in a 2100m claimer here 2.5 weeks ago. Will not be sent out at 60/1 this time but will not be as competitive either
- **12. KAMOVA DU RILER -** Surprise 7th of 15 in 26 November race of reference and, even racing barefoot, a repeat looks decidedly unlikely

KERGOMAR SIBEY (13) finished down the field that day but with Eric Raffin reining this time, Jean-Michel Baudouin means business. KARELIA (4) is reunited with Gabi Gelormini who placed with her on their lone association and, at this level, can start to redeem herself. A claiming winner here last winter, KANGOUROU (15) most recently reassured in the race of reference and, already a winner over the long course, is not to be underestimated.

- **3. GARRY THORIS -** Last but one in a 2700m Class D at Le Croise-Laroche 11 days ago and even racing barefoot has no realistic chance
- **4. HOLLY SHINE -** 2nd of 15, at 68/1, in a 2600m Nancy Class F a fortnight ago. A repeat, however, seems improbable
- **5. FRENCHY BERRY -** Oddly below-par 7th of 16 in a 3000m Nantes Class F last week. Has form under these conditions though and starting in front will only work to his advantage

- **10. GAZOLINE DU SEUX -** 3rd of 10 to GLOIRE DU PERCHE (13) in a 2100m Class C here a fortnight ago. Has not got her nose in front since February 2023 but always gives her best and returns to Vincennes with morale restored. Place chance
- **11. FALCO DES ROCHERS -** Makes first appearance since running 9th of 13 in a 2450m Caen Class C 2 months ago. Reconfigured for the occasion but others still preferred
- **12. HULYSSE DIGEO -** Won 2 of last 3, latterly a 2700m Class C here on 31 October. Incurs the handicap but in current form will take all the beating
- **13. GLOIRE DU PERCHE -** Stayed on well to secure a 2100m Class C here 2 weeks ago. Dependability not her strong suit but can contest the finish if still firing on all cylinders
- **14. GALA DE CRENNES -** 4th of 10 to GLOIRE DU PERCHE (13) in a 2100m Class C here a fortnight ago. Erno Szirmay could not have dreamed of a better entry and has a respectable chance of making first 5

Summary: Back at his best with 2 wins in his last 3 starts, HULYSSE DIGEO (12) drops in category with every chance of repeating. Jean-William Hallais will still be keeping a watchful eye on the well-engaged GLOIRE DU PERCHE (13) who, while not the most dependable, will still be a tough nut to crack if she replicates her latest performance. Close 3rd to her that day, the same caveat applies to GAZOLINE DU SEUX (10). HISTORY MAJYC (6) reassured at Cherbourg recently and benefits from a 25m head-start.
