C1 - PRIX ROGER CERAN-MAILLARD - 2875m (a1 3/4m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 18.000

- 1. JIMINIE DIDJEAP Late developer that made a modest career debut on Sunday and backs up with little ambition
- **2. JAMAICA PHEDO -** Delicate filly but showed significant promise at Meslay last time out. Lebourgeois on board for monté debut and looks a serious proposition
- **3. JEZABEL MAHCATH -** Has started to show some potential but insufficient to warrant much support
- **4. JINGER -** Has little experience but reassured at Elbeuf earlier in the month. In this company though will have too much to do
- **5. JAVA DE LAUMONT -** Got the year off to a decent start but has since come off the boil and needs to find more
- **6. JUNON TWIN -** Sanctioned more often than not under harness but left a good impression on recent monté debut and, shod for competition this time, should logically finish in the mix
- **7. JARKA DE BEYLEV -** Filly with decent credentials going clockwise. Pleased on just second start back and even though in better company this time will nonetheless generate interest
- **8. JOKE CAPTAIN -** Honest filly but has done little of note for some time and is unlikely to shake things up
- **9. JOFESCA BUISSONAY -** Moderate type that was not disgraced here late last month. Shoes back on though and not an obvious choice this time
- **10. JUSTESSE DAIRPET -** Versatile type that has been acquitting herself well of late. Returns to racing barefoot and looks a decent place prospect
- **11. JEUNE ET JOLIE -** Tricky sort but can trot when applied. Is confirmed racing clockwise and with application can play a prominent role
- **12. JANE QUICK -** Showed considerable promise last year but unraced for some time and will need the outing
- **13. JOYEUSE D'OCCAGNES -** Sanctioned on lone appearance here but appears to be back in shape and with shoes off for the occasion should not be underestimated
- **14. JOUVENCE -** Reliability not her strong suit but has ample ability and has twice won under the saddle. With application can impose
- **15. JOYEUSE DE FLAM -** Useful type with solid harness references and can make a big splash on her first foray into the monté code
- 16. JAVA D'ANTAN Useful sort making her first appearance for 2.5 months and best to hold off

Summary: Although not the easiest of horses to handle, JOUVENCE (14) is nonetheless very capable when applied and after a freshener under harness should be able to win a race of this nature. She will still be up against the in-form JOYEUSE DE FLAM (15), and recently reinvigorated JAMAICA PHEDO (2), both of which are capable of making a big splash on their respective monté debuts. JEUNE ET JOLIE (11) won going right-handed earlier in the year and on good behaviour should not be far off the mark.

- **2. KIARA D'ECOTAY -** Sanctioned on lone appearance under harness. Here for a change of scenery and no threat
- **3. KAPTAIN DE HOERDT -** Placed just once in three starts going right-handed but is an honest sort and will give what he can
- **4. KALIMA DU GOUTIER -** Not the most faithful of trotters but has merit. Sanctioned in last two but fitted with hind pads this time and can begin to make amends
- **5. KABRIO D'OR -** Yet to get off the mark but can trot. Benefits from a good spot in front and will have his chances if he can stay in stride
- **6. KISKA ISLAND -** Sanctioned more often than not but is unbeaten going clockwise and with application can put on a good show
- **7. KING DRY -** Showed a different side to himself at Rânes on his seasonal re-entry. Guarato takes advantage of his form and looks eminently capable of repeating

- 13. KUANG CHINE Sanctioned in both public appearances to date and will have few takers
- **14. KIRA DE CAHOT -** Unexceptional filly that showed marginal improvement at Reims but still needs to show significantly more
- **15. KASH DES RIOULTS -** Handed a tough draw but is clearly in shape and with Lebourgeois in the wagon will be afforded every chance
- **Summary**: Facile winner on his return to competition late last month, KING DRY (7) should appreciate the Argentan profile and can double up. Christophe Thierry will still be paying heed to KASH GAGOU (9) who gave an excellent account of himself at Enghien recently, and the capable KASH DES RIOULTS (15) who is good enough to defy the draw. KLASSIC DREAM (1) opened his career account ten days ago and from the front line can give this another good go.

- **3. JALANSKI -** Lost his action early on ridden debut last time out. If he can get off on the right foot, Lebourgeois can guide him to a competitive spot at the finish
- **4. JAPAN TIGER -** Has placed just once in 15 starts under the saddle and three straight sanctions this term do nothing to inspire confidence
- **5. JEFS DES CHAMPS -** Has shown considerable aptitude for his new vocation. Is first time barefoot as he steps up in class and must be respected
- **6. JULIUS DU THEIL -** Regularly a case of all-or-nothing under harness. Takes his chances under the saddle for the first time and is not incapable of imposing
- 7. JELLY BELLY WELL Moderate trotter that always gives his best but still unlikely to make much of an impact on monté debut

- JEANNE D'ALEX 25 starts and yet to lose her maiden tag but by no means the worst horse here and should not be written off
- **3. JAMAIQUE DAIRPET -** Useful filly with excellent references racing clockwise. Has one race under her belt and if fully fit can figure prominently
- **4. JADE THORIS -** Regularly loses stride but otherwise in fine shape. Pleased at Caen and is ideally positioned to play a leading role
- **5. JAMAICA DE LOU -** Quality filly but never far from losing her action. Already a winner this term and from the 5-spot can make a big impact
- **6. JOSY D'OCCAGNES -** Got the year off to a promising start but has struggled in this category and others easier to back
- 7. JOTA QUICK Course and distance winner this day last year. Has yet to repeat but is barefoot for the occasion and should not be far from the action

- **4. JAZZ DU CHATAULT -** In the frame in five of last six but has never delivered going right-handed and a minor place prospect at best
- 5. JOKER DU GERS Solid as a rock in recent weeks. Benefits from a good spot behind the car and looks a major player once more
- **6. JOB DU CEBE -** Blows hot and cold but can trot when focused. Takes a hike in class though and chances limited
- **7. JASPE DU DOLLAR -** Appeared to be back in shape during the spring but well-beaten in last two and must reaffirm

- 16. JAURES Useful sort with a decent future but likely to be race-rusty and best to hold off
- **Summary:** More dependable with experience, JULLOU (8) has been in fine condition this season and even though starting wide still looks capable of having his way here. Twice a winner in his last three starts, JACK DU CEBE (13) has earned the right to step up in class and looks the principal threat. JOKER DU GERS (5) has been enjoying something of a renaissance and the good spot in front can only work to his advantage. Solid racing right-handed, JANOU POULOT (1) has turned a corner this term and is competitive for a place on the podium.

- **3. IRMA BABEL -** Not the most dependable but is confirmed at this level. Benefits from a good position on the front line and should not be ruled out
- **4. ICE BAR GIRL -** Got back to doing what she does best at Gournay. Steps up in category but is well-placed in front and will justifiably garner support
- **5. ISBA DU DOME** Consistently in the thick of things at this level. Has two races in her since the break and going barefoot for the occasion looks a major player from the 5-spot

I LOVE ELDE (9) caught the eye at Caen despite being sanctioned and in similar form will be no soft touch. - **3. IDEAL DE NGANDA -** Back in business following a tough start to the year. Impressed last time out and is well-placed to confirm
- **4. ILLICO FLIGNY -** Tough campaigner that showed his form at Maure 8 days ago. Is barefoot this time and from the 4-spot can have his way
- **5. IZIO D'ECHAL -** Seldom seen at this level but consistently gives his best. Well-positioned and with Benjamin Rochard at the helm will be afforded every chance

ILIO MANNETOT (1) seldom disappoints when he can stay in stride and the modified shoeing formula has worked for him in the past. IDEAL DE NGANDA (3) showed great courage at Lisieux last time and will justifiably garner support.

- 2. FRONSAC DU SAPIN Good class of trotter that went into his break on a high note but has not been seen out for 10 months and will need the run
- **3. FOND OF YOU -** Tricky type that tends to show more in the amateur category but does benefit from a front-line start and should not be ruled out
- **4. ELITE DES RIOULTS** Moderate mare with better prospects when barefoot and even with a distance advantage will struggle to make any impression
- **5. HAMILTON STAR** Considerably better trotter than his formcard would suggest. Hind shoes off for the occasion and on good behaviour will be dangerous
- **6. FALAISIEN DU RIB -** Considerably better sort in the other code and can be confidently passed over
- **7. HIPPOMENE QUESNOT -** Good dual-purpose type that showed his form under the saddle recently. Is a good finisher and with Lebourgeois in the sulky should not disappoint
- **8. ENDO D'AZIF -** Previously a good sort but lost his way last season and has picked up this term where he left off
- **9. HARMONISTA -** Seldom disappoints when barefoot and applied. Left no doubt about her form on Maure return and in similar condition can give HAMANDINA (13) a run for her money
- **10. HIS LOVELY HAUFOR -** Quality element with nothing to prove at this level. Gave a good account last time out and looks thoroughly capable of making the frame this time
- **11. FROZEN QUEEN -** Erratic but is not lacking ability. Has one race under her belt since the break and at peak fitness can get a look in
- **12. HELIOS SI -** Highly consistent sort that could have gone closer at Saint-Malo. Is nearing his best and has already won at the venue

HARMONISTA (9), however, will be no pushover given how well she won on comeback at Maure a month back. On paper, HAMILTON STAR (5) is not the most attractive of propositions but he has buckets of ability and with stride in check will have a lot to offer. HIS LOVELY HAUFOR (10) showed improvement at Saint-Malo and looks competitive for a place in the frame.
