- **1. GONIKA DE VASTERIE -** Has struggled all year and was 9th last time out in Class H at Villeneuve over 2625m on 8 June. Needs major improvement to win
- **2. GENIUS DE BRAYE** Has been fair of late and was fourth last time out in Class H at Gémozac over 2600m on 9 June. Runs well with this shoe arrangement and is not out of it
- **3. GASTON GAILLARD -** Battling to regain winning form and was 7th last time out in Class H at Monpazier over 3125m on 2 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
