- **3. GREY POUR FREEDOM -** Open to improvement after a modest debut 7th but has no more than a place chance. Outsider
- **4. DASHKA -** Improved with the benefit of an introductory outing (9th) to finish 4th last time. Will be a factor
- **5. LADY OF NABEUL -** Has made no impression in either outing, finishing 9th on both occasions. Best watched for now
- **6. DO IT FOR ME -** Has not been far off the mark in recent outings, finishing 5th in her last two starts. Place chance
- **7. SKIMBLESHANKS -** Hasn't gone unnoticed in his last two starts having finished 3rd at this level previously. Lurker

He will, however, be challenged by DASHKA (4) who is likely to pose a threat with further improvement expected. ST BRIAC (2) also made progress last time and could join the fight if building on that performance. STAR PAREILLE (11) is not to be taken lightly either having won at this level on debut.

Summary: Well-bred VEGAS (2) was a convincing winner on debut and should, with any improvement, remain undefeated by preserving his 100% record with another win here. GREY MAN (1) has shown promise in both outings and is likely to pose the biggest threat. On the form of her winning debut, HASHTAG JOA (3) has claims too, so is dangerous to dismiss. SABROSO (4) completes the shortlist.
